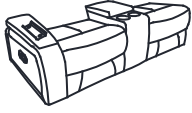
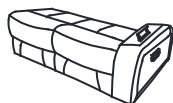


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

MANUAL RECLINING SECTIONAL

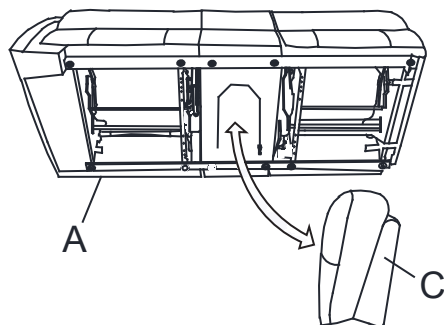
NOTE: Do not use power tools for assembly. Power tools increase the risk of over tightening which lead to splitting or cracking the wood. It is recommended to have two people during assembling.

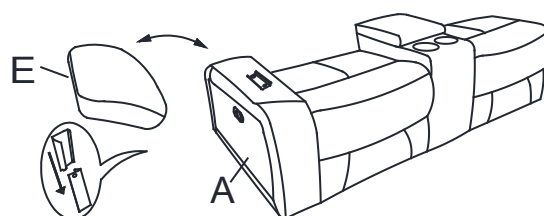

Please follow the drawings below to assemble the item

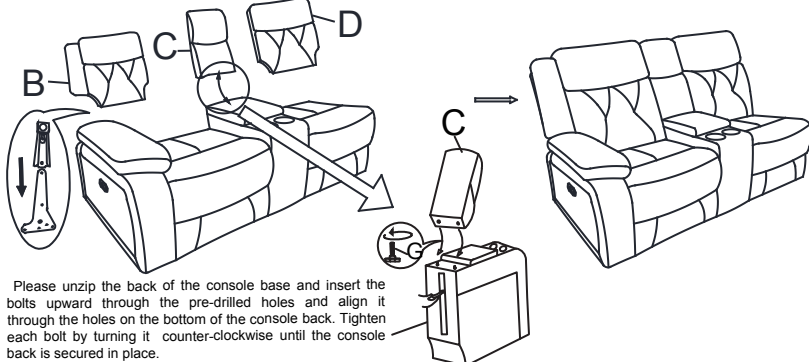
Step 1: Console back rest is stored in PE cover and put in the bottom of console. Please take out for assembly.



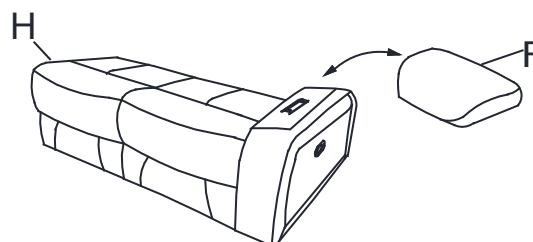
Step 2: Please insert the LSF armrest to the bracket on arm. Make sure it is secured in position.



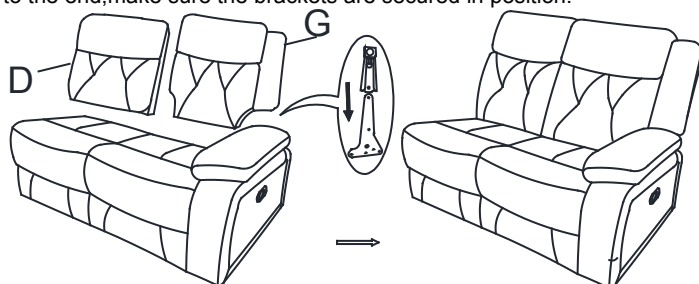
Step 3: Align the female brackets at the back onto the male brackets at the seat, insert and push to the end, make sure the brackets are secured in position.



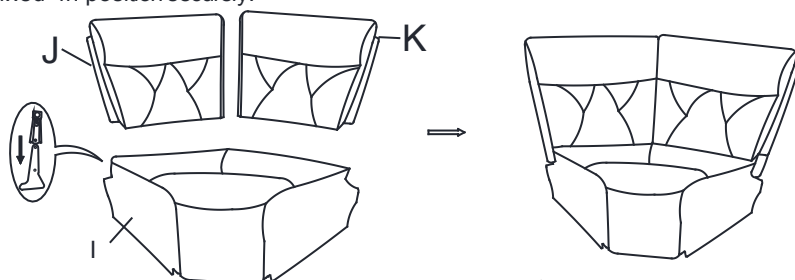
Step 4: Please insert the RSF armrest to the bracket on arm. Make sure it is secured in position.



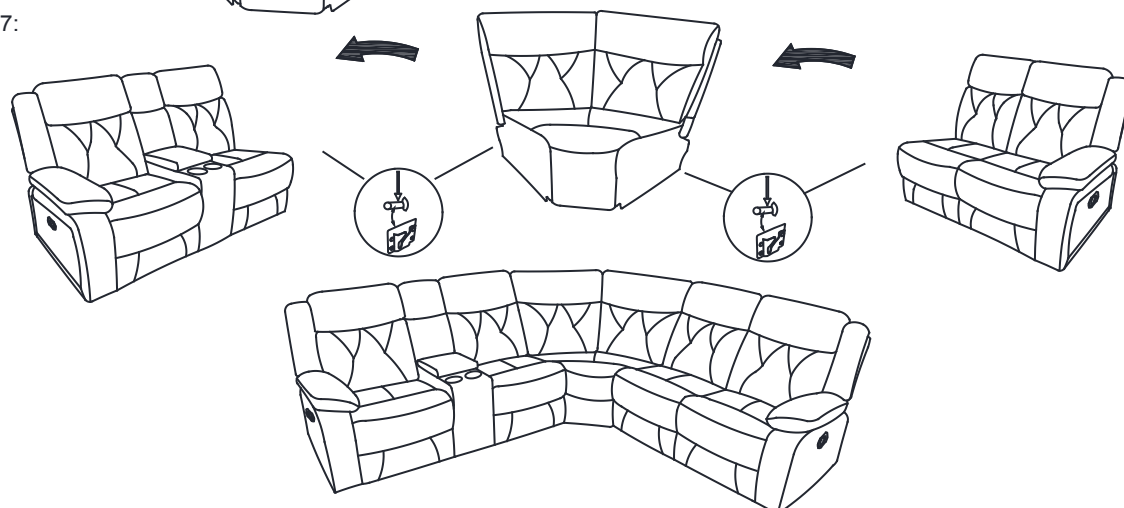
Step 5: Align the female brackets at the back onto the male brackets at the seat, insert and push to the end, make sure the brackets are secured in position.



Step 6: Align the female brackets at the back onto the male brackets at the seat, insert back rest to the seat then push to the end and make sure it is fixed in position securely.



Step 7:



- Avoid exposing furniture directly with sunlight or heating and air conditioning outlets. Exposure to sunlight or heating and air conditioning outlets will fade/damage leather gel.
- Wipe gently with a damp soft cloth to remove dust, dirt and any grime build up.
- Wipe the leather gel with professional cleanser.
