

ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER WHILE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.

NOTE: Before installing, consult local electrical codes for wiring and grounding requirement.

RIDGED STEM MOUNT

1. Shut off the power at the circuit breaker and remove existing fixture, including the mounting hardware.
2. Carefully unpack your new fixture and lay out all the parts on a clear area. Be careful not to lose any small parts necessary for installation.
3. Pass wire through stems and screw stems into couplings on top of fixture body.
NOTE: Thread locking compound must be applied to all stem threads as noted with symbol (3) to prevent accidental rotation of fixture during cleaning, relamping, etc.
4. Pass fixture wire through remaining stems and screw stems together.
5. Screw short threaded pipe into top of stem.
6. Install canopy by screwing in stem.
7. Position the mounting plate over the outlet box. Secure the mounting plate to the outlet box using outlet box mounting screws provided.
8. Now connect the electrical wires as follows:
Connect the black wire from the fixture to the black house (hot) wire. Connect the white wire from the fixture to the white (neutral) house wire. Make sure all wire nuts are secured. You may wrap the connections with electrical tape. If your outlet has a ground wire (green or bare copper), connect fixture ground wire to it. Otherwise, connect fixture ground wire directly to the mounting plate using the green screw provided. Tuck the wire connections neatly into the outlet box.
9. Fasten the fixture through the mounting screw on the mounting plate with the knob.
10. Install the bulb (not included). Please follow the wattage label located on the fixture body. Do not exceed the recommended wattage.

LOOP/CHAIN LINK MOUNT

1. Follow steps 1 - 5 from Stem Mount Instructions.
2. One end of the chain is screwed into the stem and the other end into the canopy.
3. Follow steps 7 - 10 from Stem Mount Instructions.
