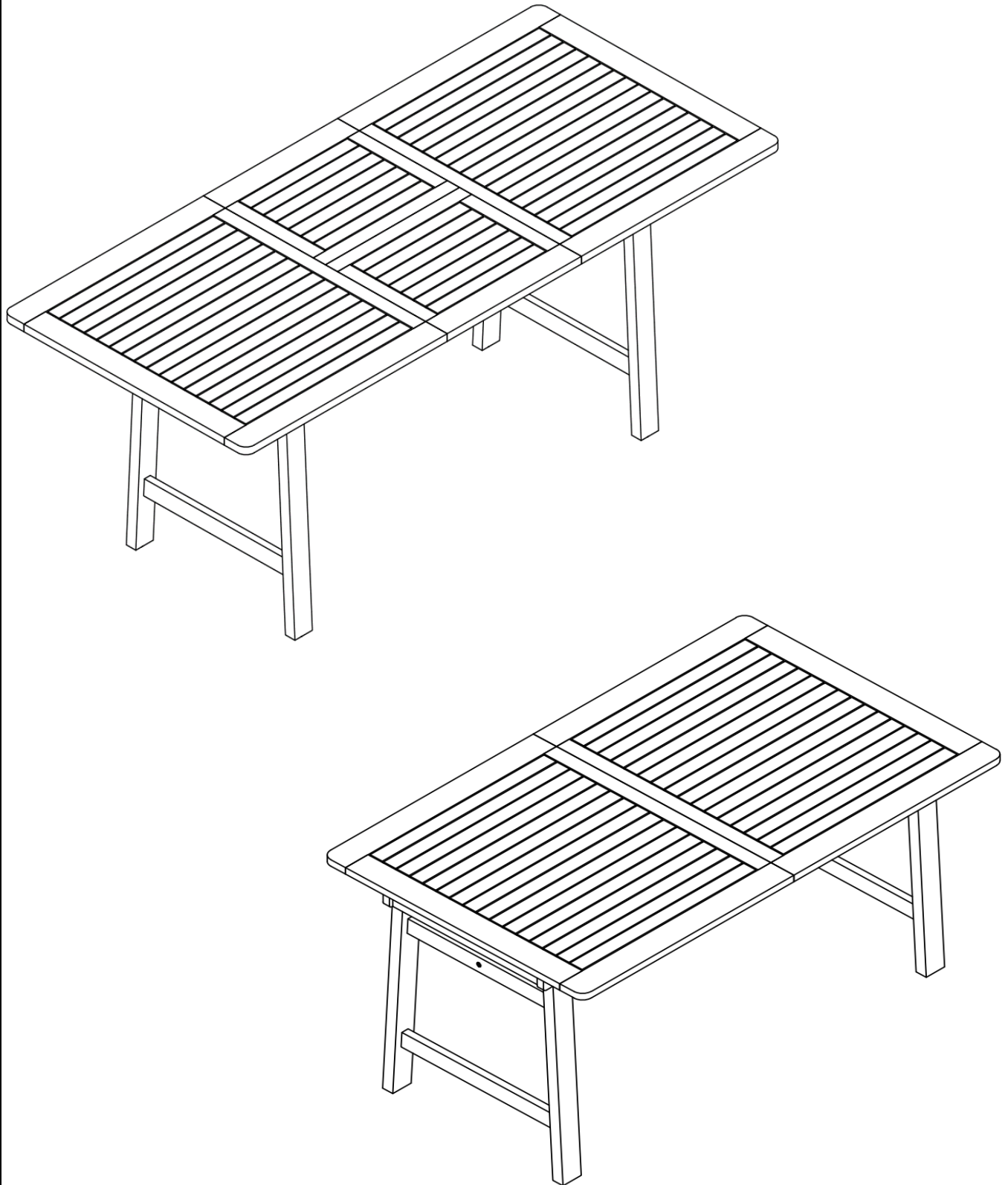

Care & Maintenance

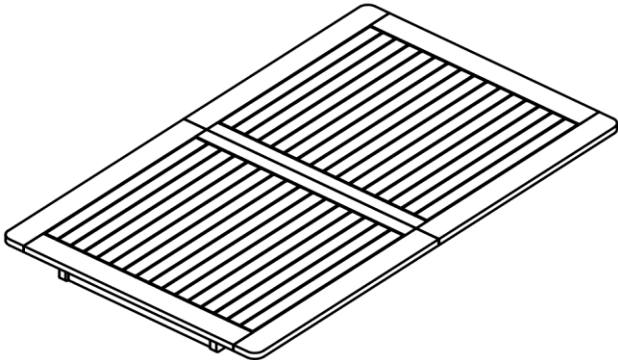
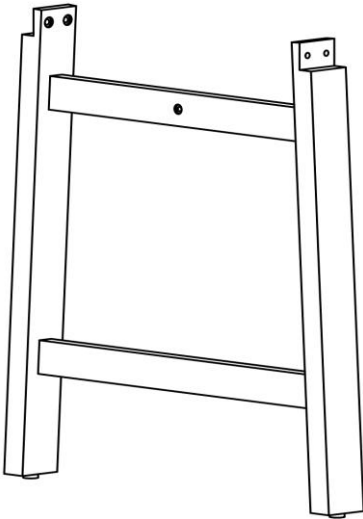
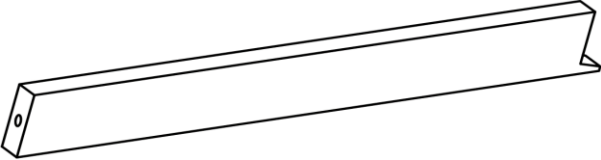
-  • Not for commercial use. For residential use only.
-  • Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.
-  • Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
-  • To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor product minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.
-  • Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
-  • Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
-  • To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.
-  • Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.
-  • Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint- free cloth.

Please look in underneath of Table Top for hardware packs.

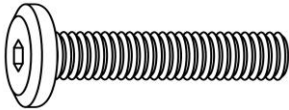
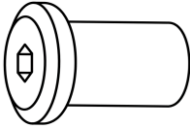
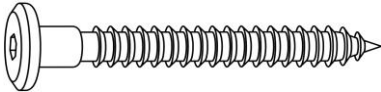

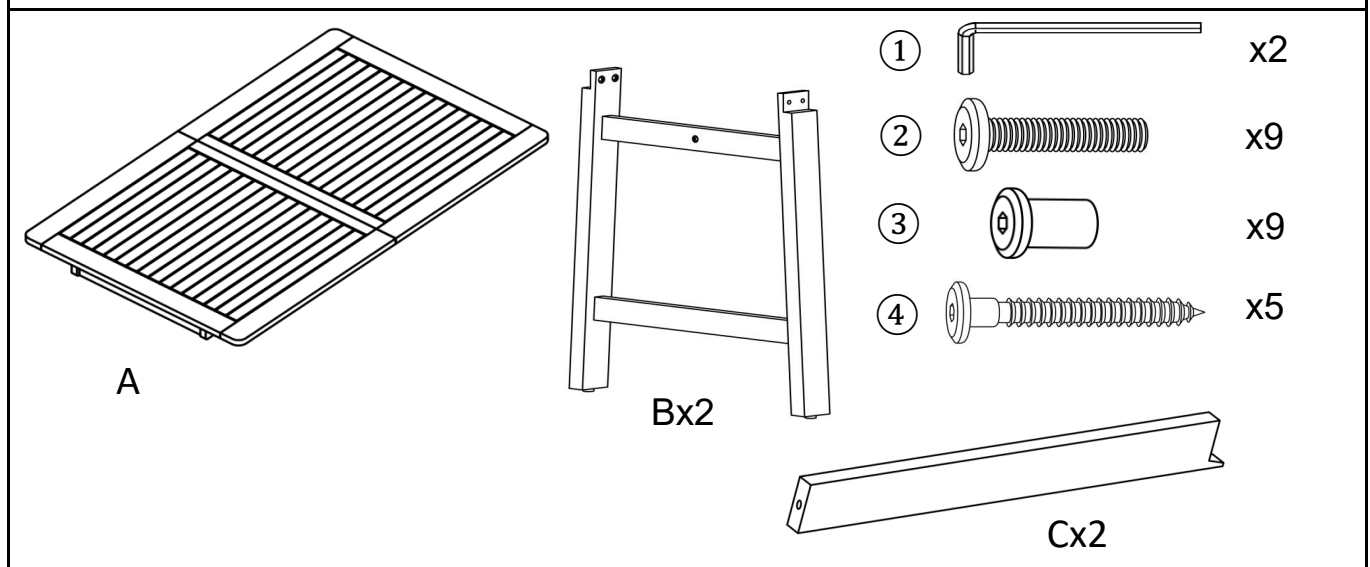
Label	Picture	Description	Qty

Before Beginning Assembly:



- Read instructions, cover to cover-



- Have 2 adults on hand for assembly-



- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-



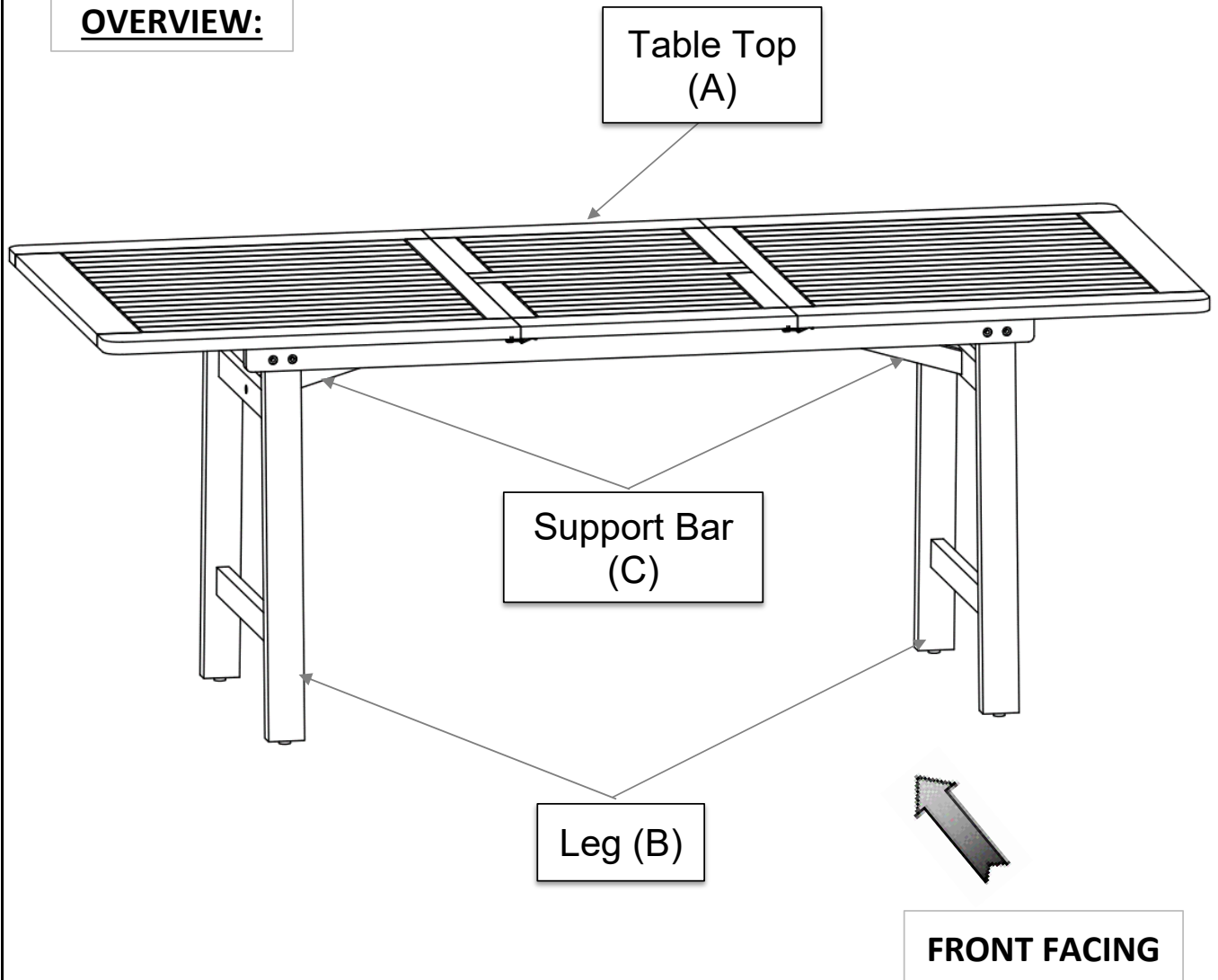
- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-



- Save all packaging until finished-

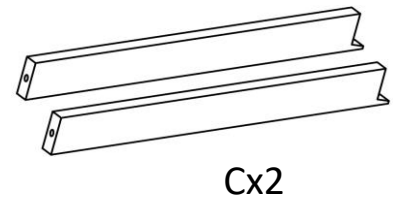
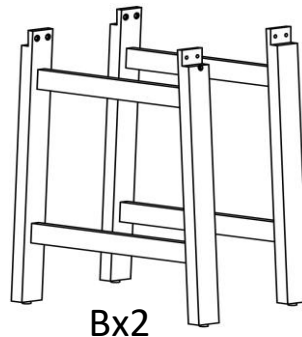
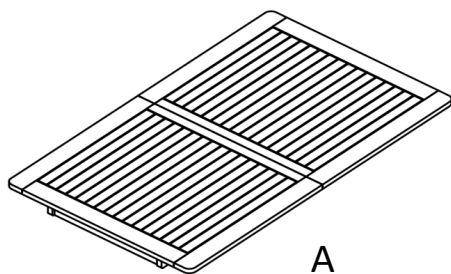
Assembly Steps:

OVERVIEW:



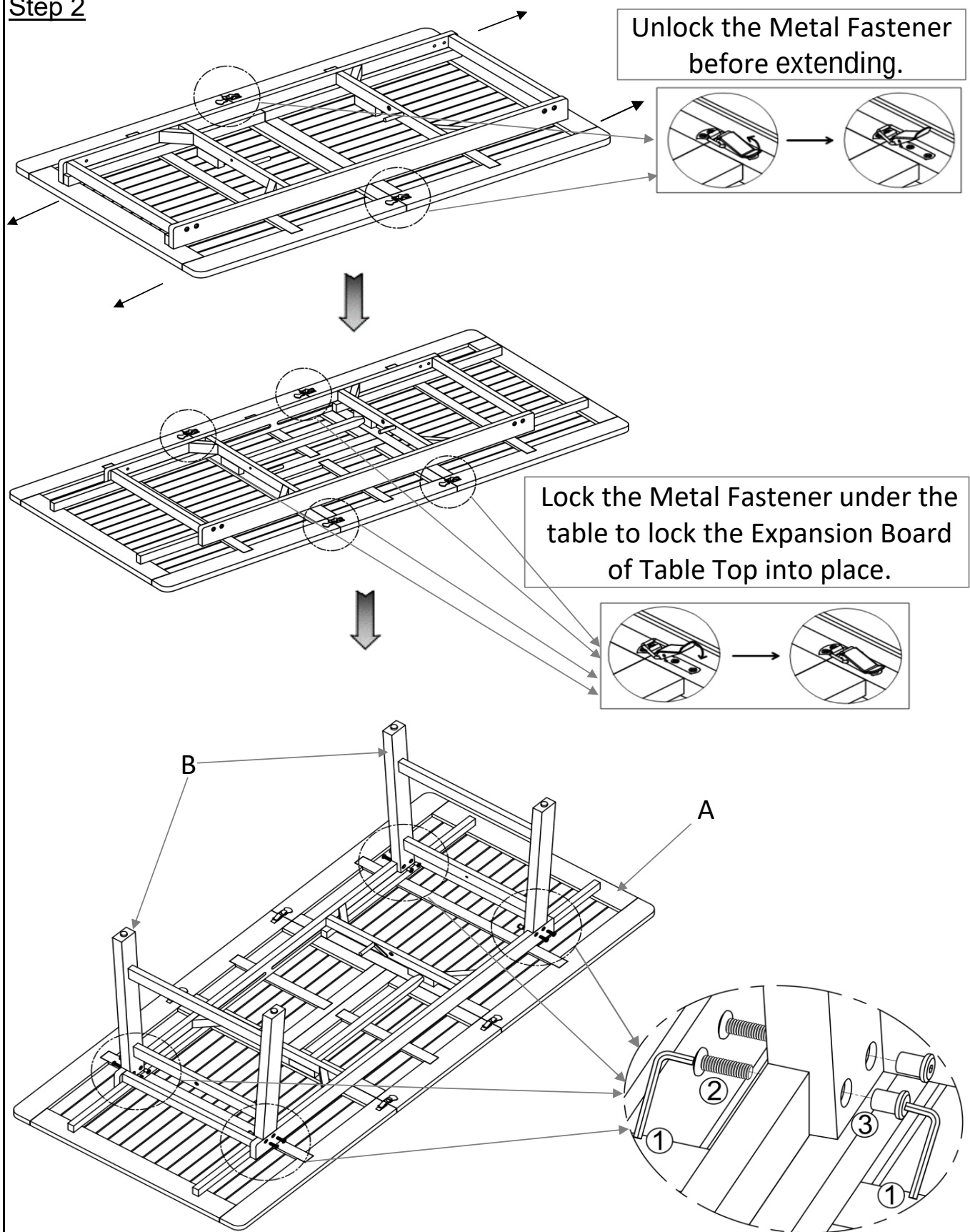
This Table has multiple parts and may require up to 15 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Table, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions here below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.

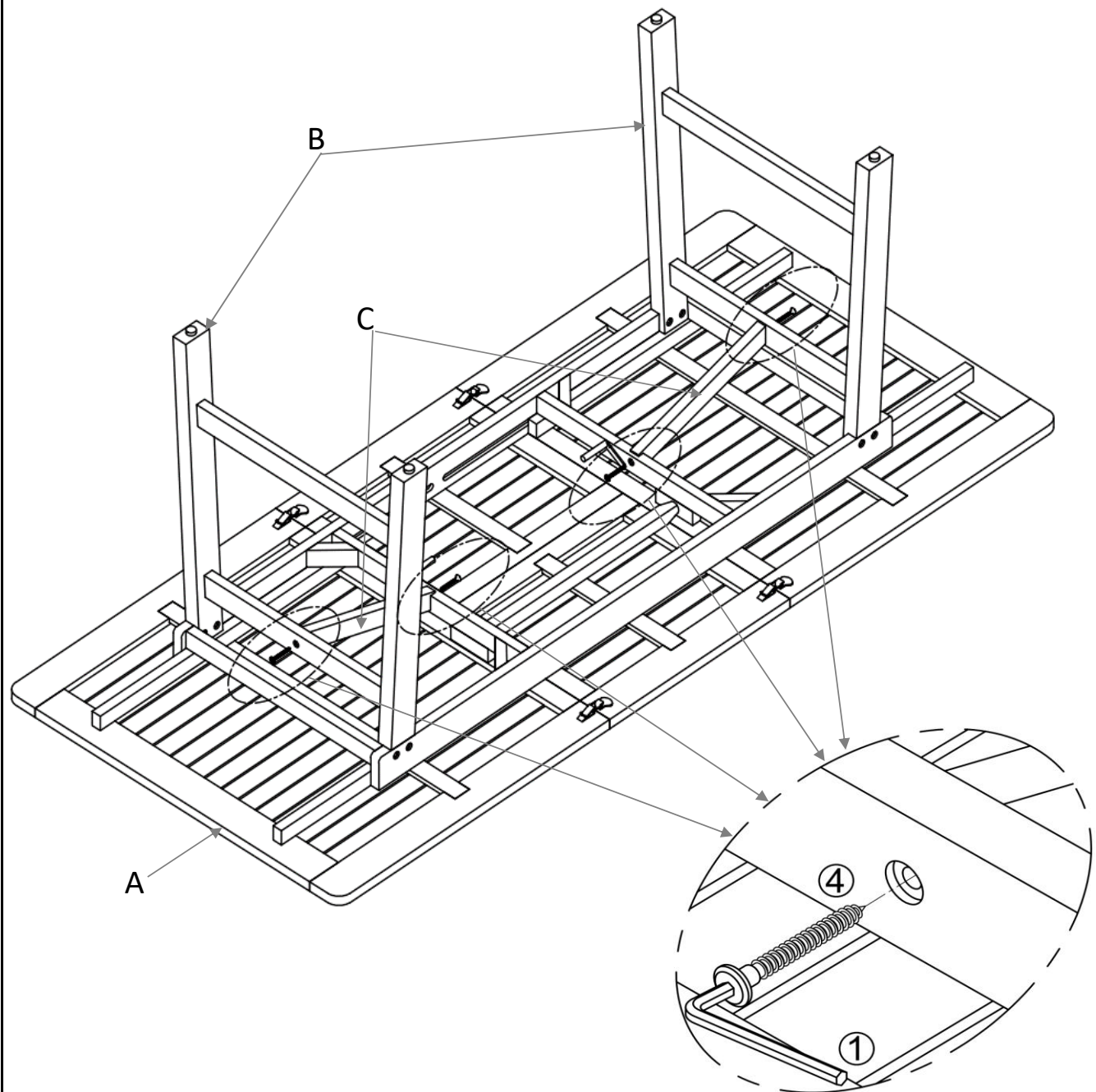
Step 2



With assistance from your adult partner, place the Table Top (A) facing down then attach Legs (B) to Table Top (A) by using Bolts (②) and Sleeve Nuts (③) with Allen Wrenches (①) as shown above.

DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts.

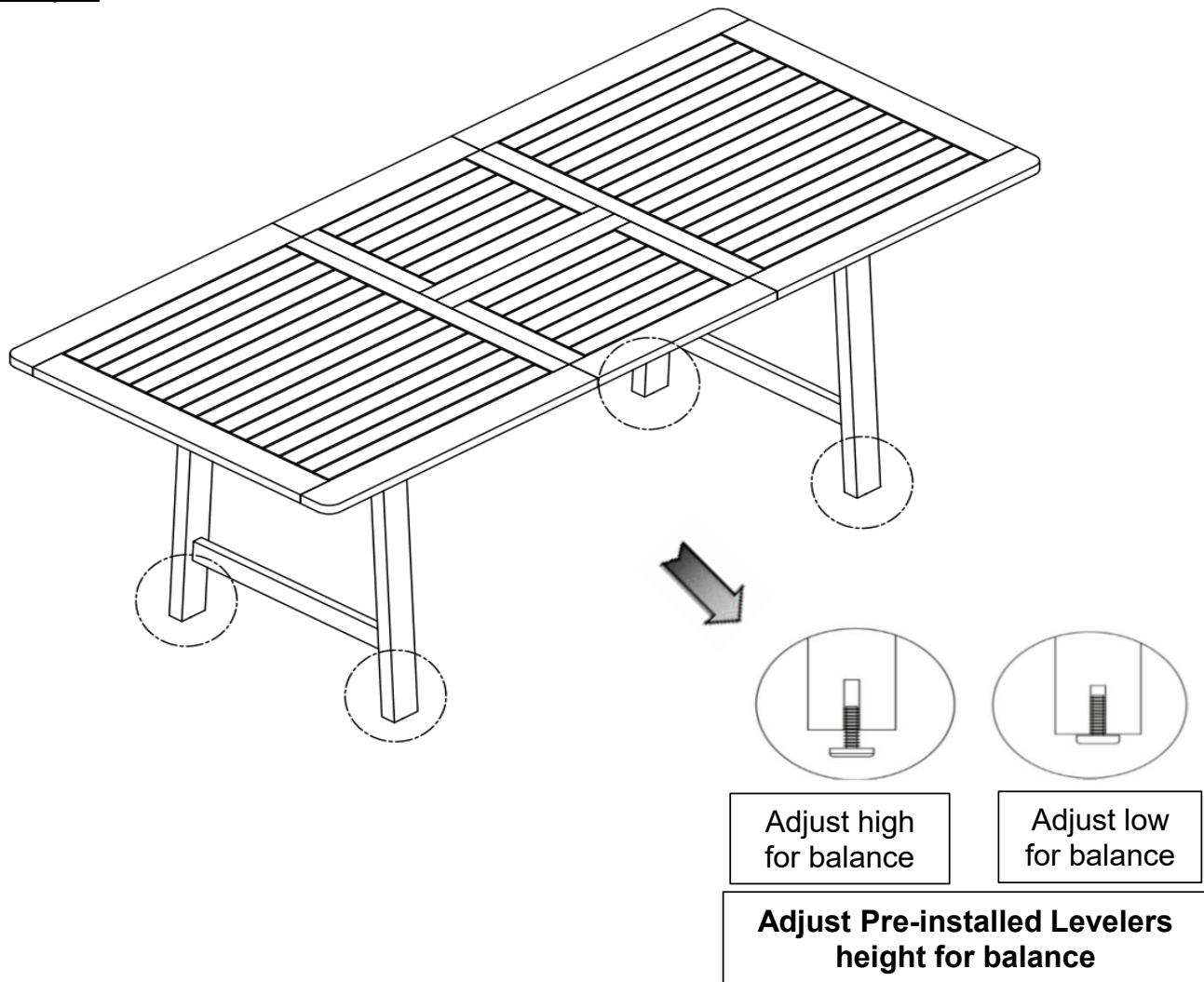
Step 3



With assistance from your adult partner, attach Support Bars (C) to both Legs (B) and Table Top (A) of the assembled part in Step 2 as shown above. Then secure Support Bars (C) to Legs (B) by using Screws (④) with Allen Wrench (①).

DO NOT fully tighten the Screws.

Step 4



Inspect it and make sure all parts are adequately connected.
With assistance from your adult partner, stand the Table up.
Exert pressure floorwards, onto the Table with both your hands.
This pressure will help the Legs and Table Top reach full alignment status.
Check for wobbles on a LEVEL surface.
If no wobbles are found proceed to tighten the Bolts and Screws in a sequential manner, until evenly secured.
When tightening the Bolts and Screws tighten sequentially.
Do not tighten any Bolt, Screws fully and then move on towards the next one.
If there are still wobbles, loosen the Bolts, Screws and execute the same above process.
Adjust Pre-installed Levelers height for balance.

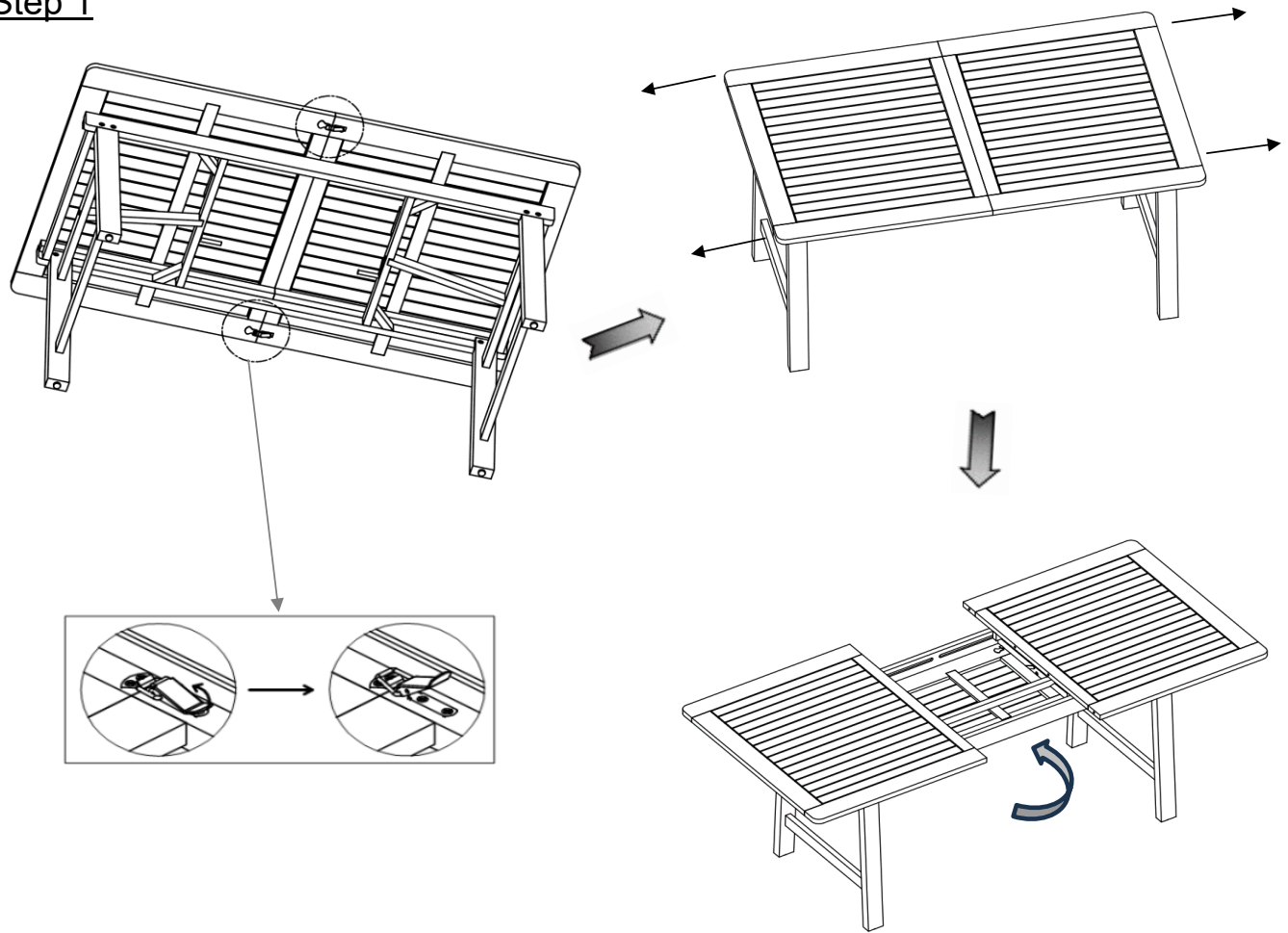

Extension Steps: To Extend the Table

Step 1



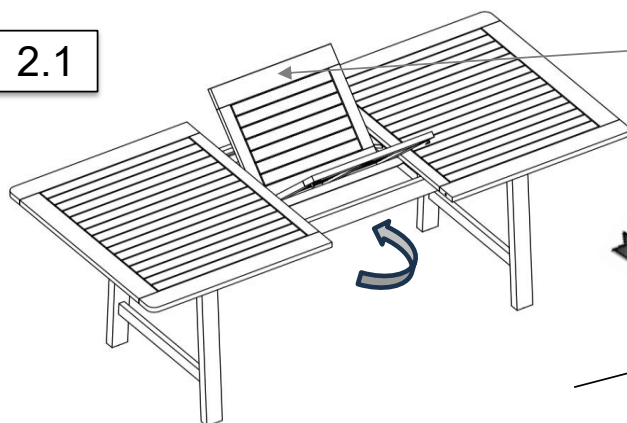
Unlock the Metal Fastener before retracting.

Gently pull the Table Top (A) outwards to open and stop when it could see the extension board frame support.

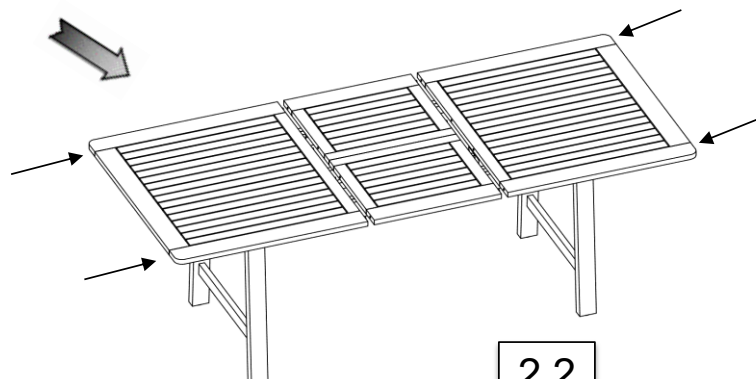
Caution: Do not Lean on or apply pressure to the table when it is pulled open. This could cause damage to the product.

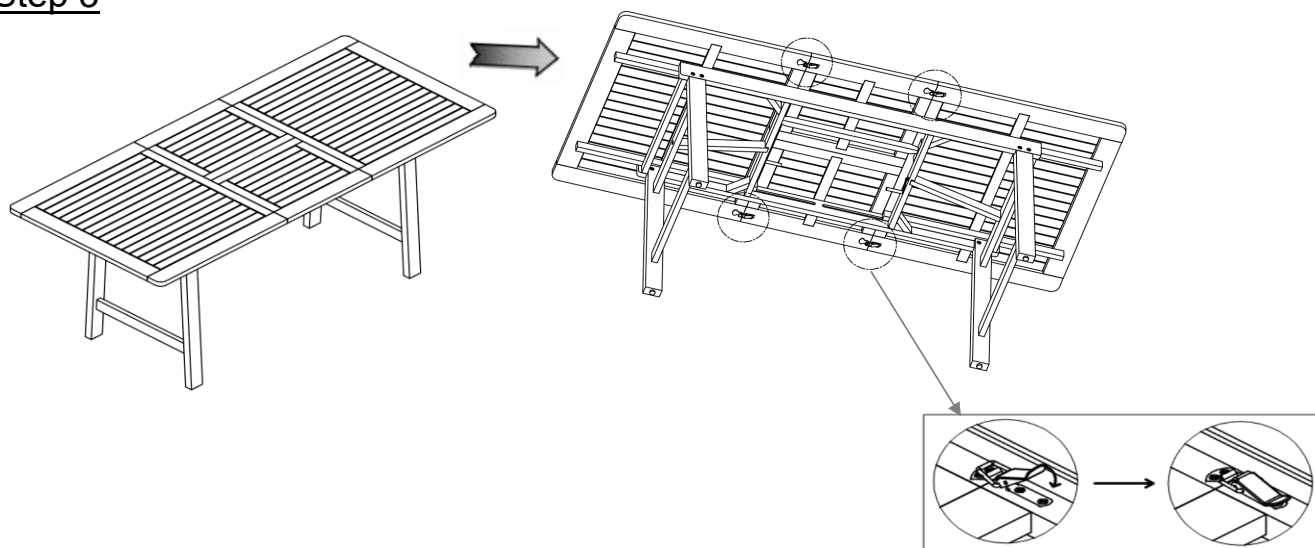

2.1) Turn the Expansion Board of Table Top, located inside of the table as shown above.

2.2) Push the Table Top (A) inwards until the Top Table (A) fits in the Expansion Board of Table Top.

Caution: Keep hands away from the Table Top (A) and Expansion Board of Table Top when pushing the Table Top (A) to avoid pinching hazards. If you can not push the Table Top (A) inwards, just slightly shake the Table Top (A).

Step 3

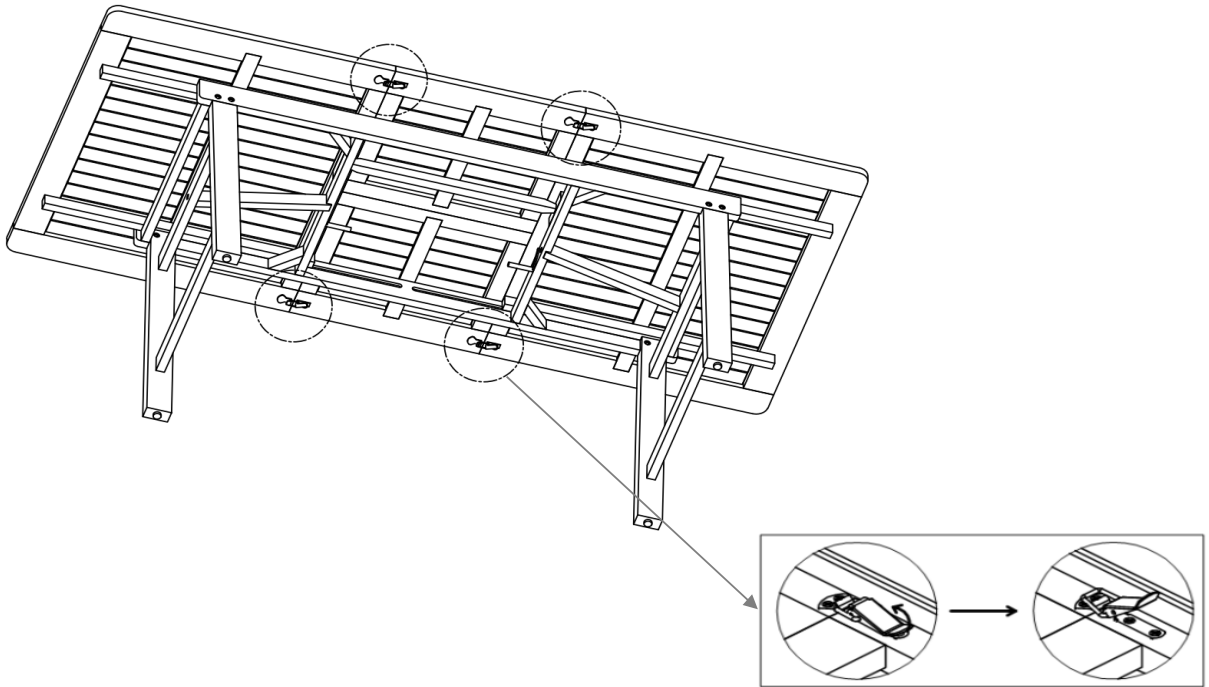


Lock the Metal Fastener under the table to lock the Expansion Board of Table Top into place.

Your Table is extended and is now ready for use.

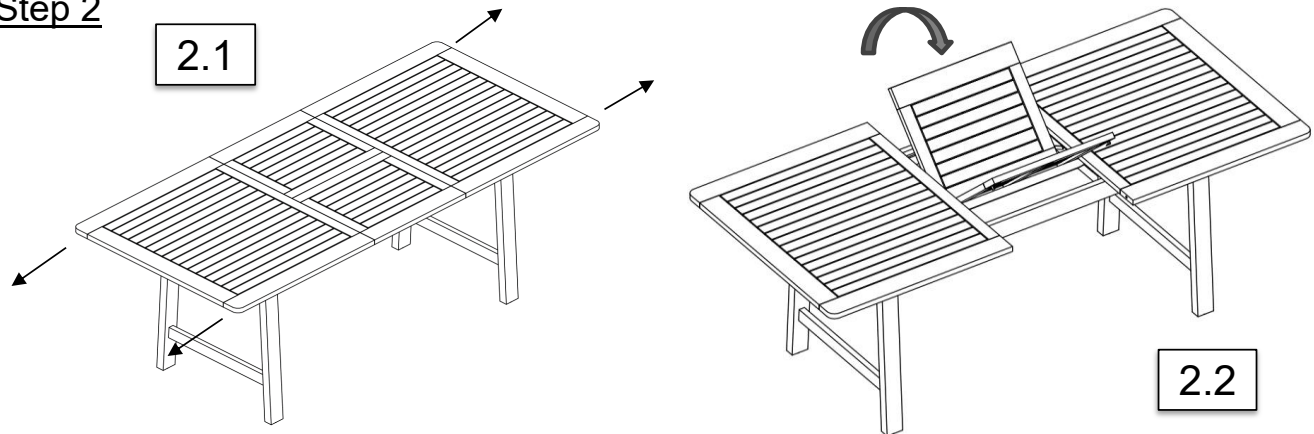
Extension Steps: To Retract the Table

Step 1



Unlock the Metal Fastener before retracting.

Step 2

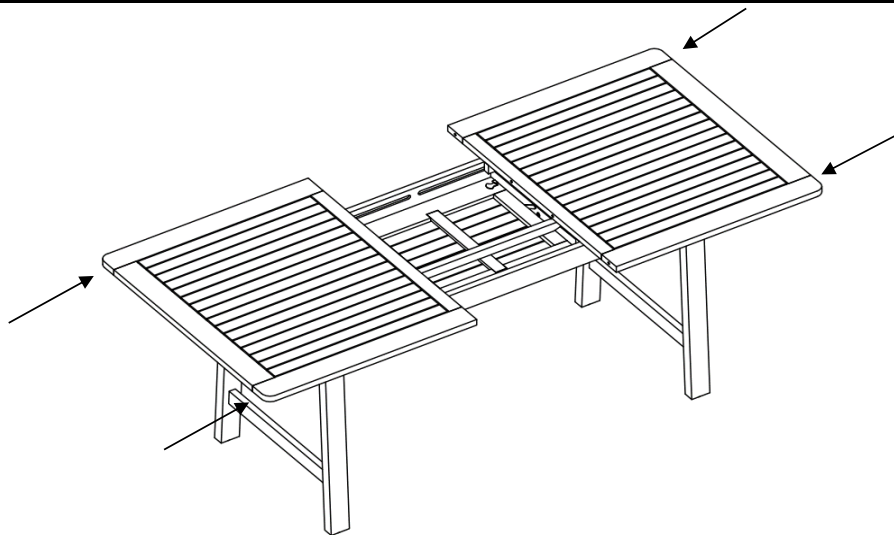


2.1) Gently pull the Top Table (A) outwards to open and stop when it could see the extension board frame support.

2.2) Turn the Expansion Board of Table Top, located inside of the table as shown above.

Caution: Do not Lean on or apply pressure to the table when it is pulled open. This could cause damage to the product.

Step 3

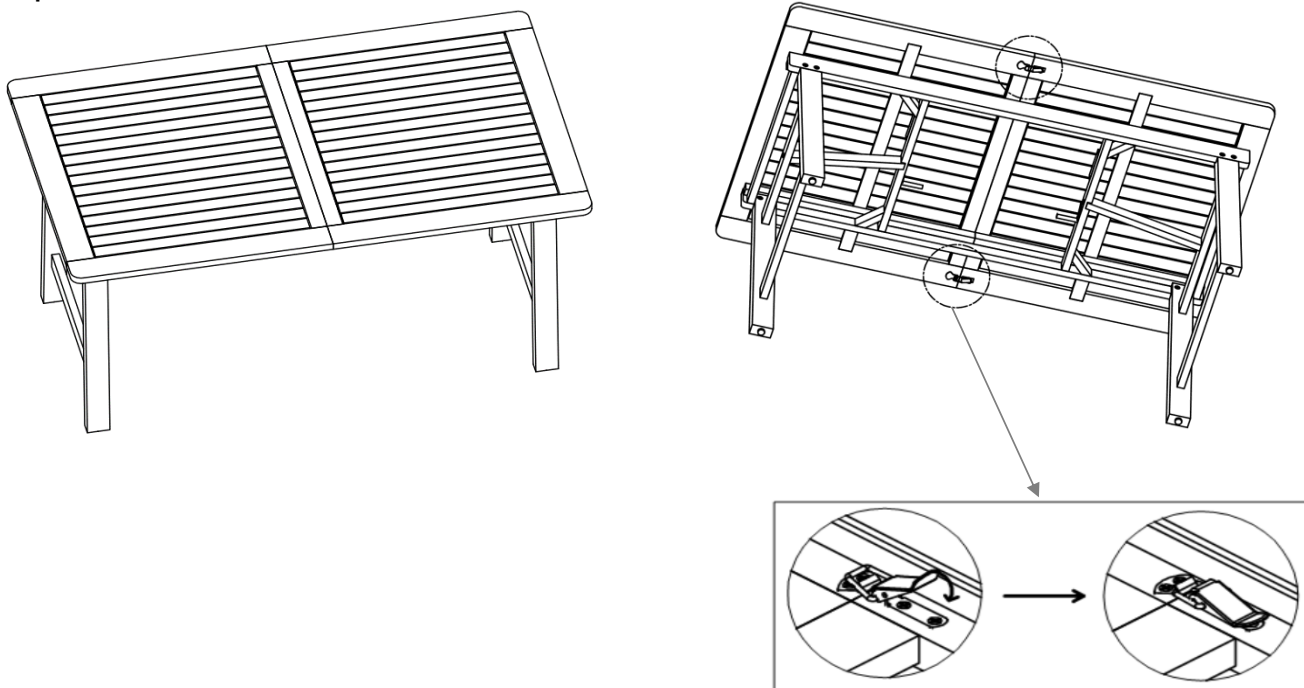


Push the Table Top (A) inwards until two wings of Table Top (A) align.

Caution: Keep hands away from the Table Top (A) and Expansion Board of Table Top when pushing the Table Top (A) to avoid pinching hazards.

If you can not push the Table Top (A) inwards, just slightly shake the Table Top (A).

Step 4



Lock the Metal Fastener under the table to lock the Table Top (A) into place.

Your Table is extracted and is now ready for use.
