#OPTION 3
 12" HEIGHT OF HEADBOARD



Prepare 6 bolts assembly by inserting lock washer (#C), then flat washer (#D) onto bolts (#B). Align left HB leg (#2) and right HB leg (#3) to the holes of the headboard (#1) as shown in the diagram. Secure by using bolts (#B).

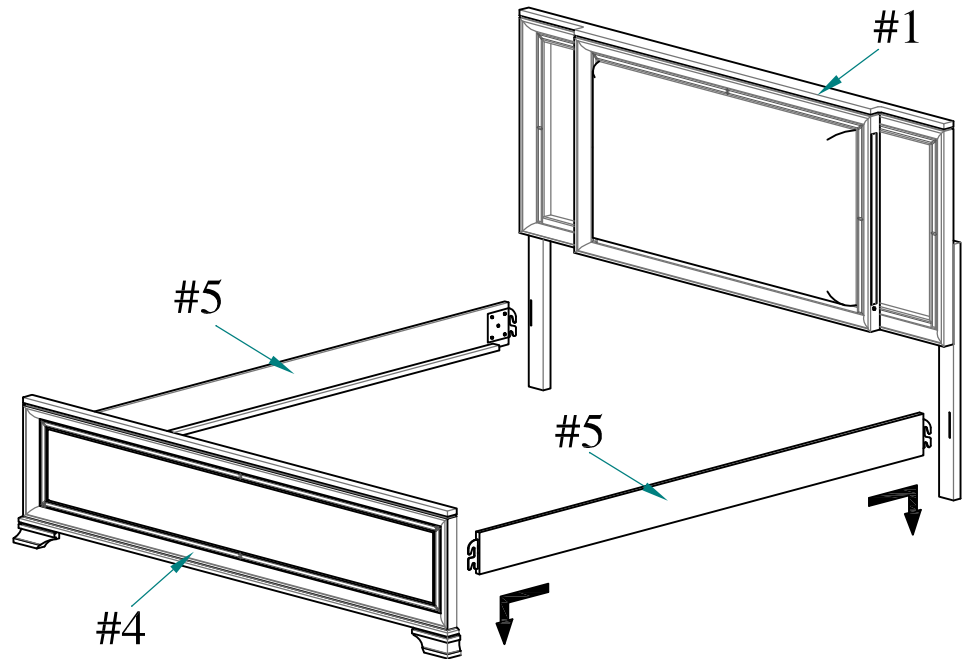

Align and hook side rails (#5) to the latch of the headboard (#1) and footboard (#4). Make sure it is firmly secured.

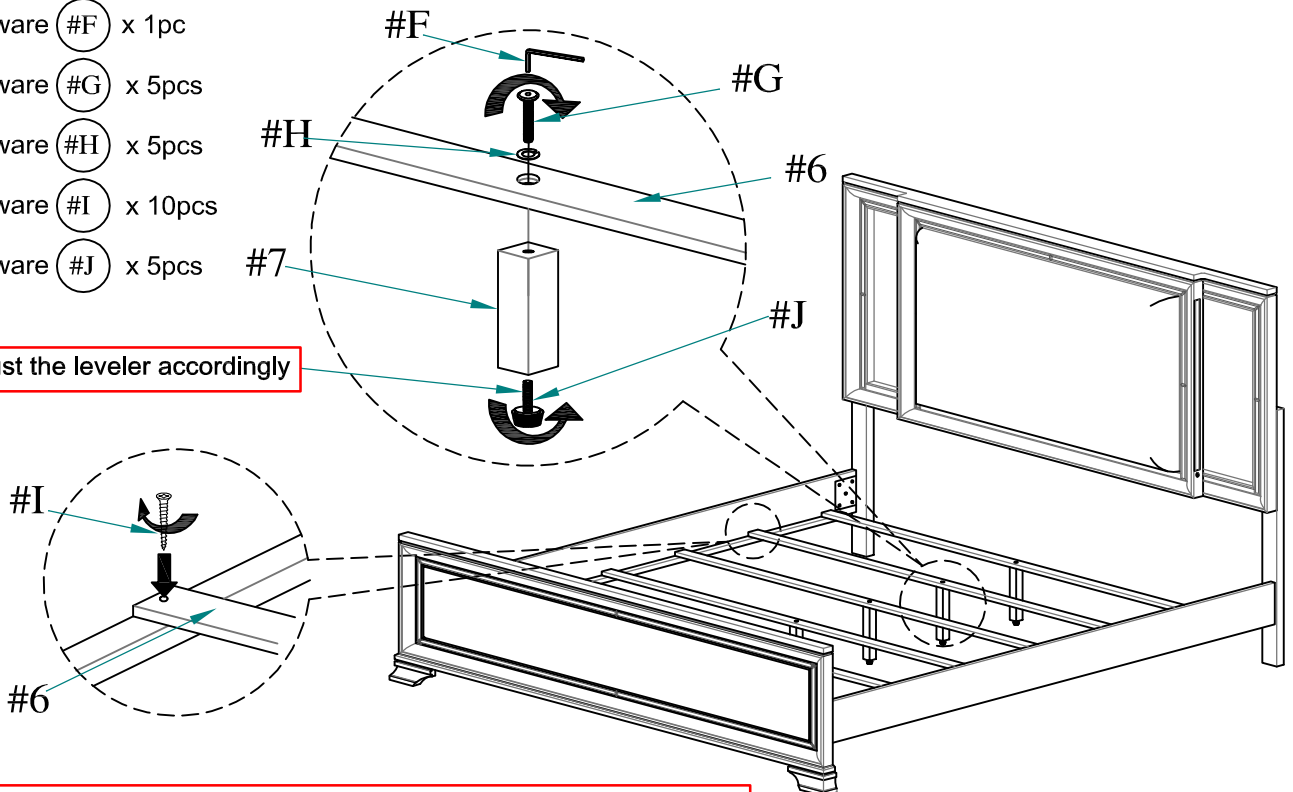

2) Prepare 3 bolts assembly by inserting lock washer (#H) onto bolts (#G). Align slat support legs (#7) to each slat (#6), then secure by using bolts (#G).

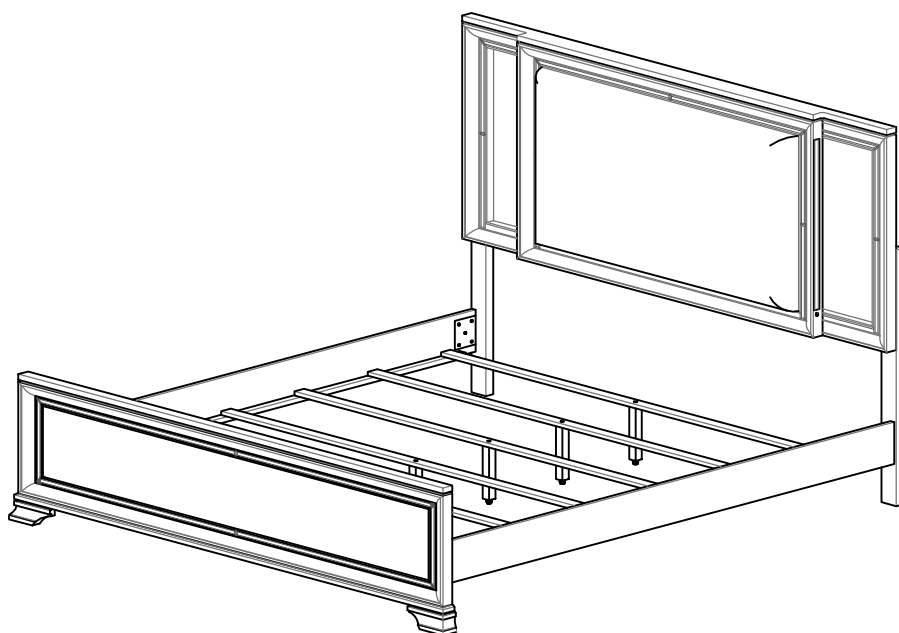
Adjust the leveler accordingly
