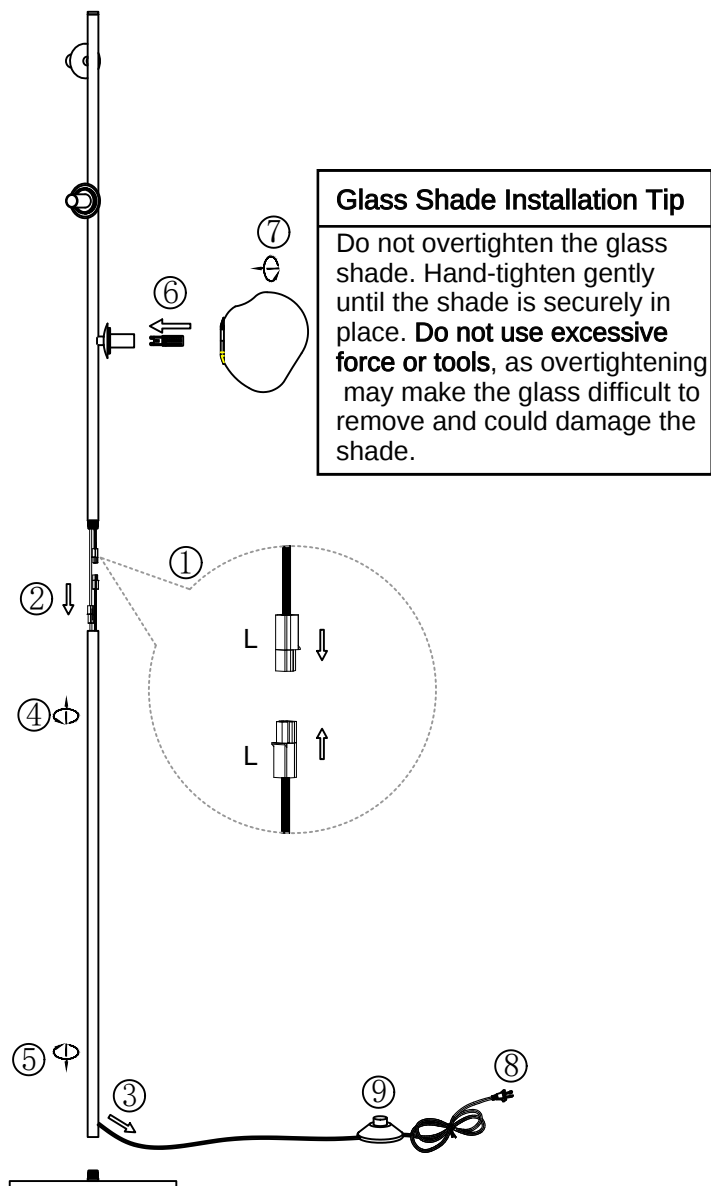


ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.



Before You Begin:

- Ensure power is turned off at the circuit breaker before installation.
- Read all instructions carefully.
- Installation should be performed by a qualified electrician if you are unfamiliar with wiring.

Step-by-Step Installation:

Step 1: Connect the socket wire L to the plug wire L by mating the male and female connectors with a 180° reverse alignment.

Connect the socket wire N to the plug wire N in the same manner.

Step 2-3: Tuck the 4 connected plug assemblies into the metal rod containing the plug connectors, leaving approximately 5.91" of plug wire extending outward.

Leave approximately 0.39" of exposed wire between the two rods.

Step 4: Screw the metal rod containing the plug connectors onto the metal rod with the socket assembly and tighten securely.

Step 5: Secure the metal rod containing the plug connectors to the base.

Step 6: Install the bulb (not included) into the socket.

Step 7: Align the shade threads with the socket threads and carefully screw the shade onto the socket. ***Do not overtighten***.

Step 8: Plug the power cord into a power outlet or power strip.

Step 9: Press the foot switch to turn on the fixture.

Safety Instructions:

To avoid fire, shock, and serious personal injury, follow all instructions carefully.

1. Do not install or use the light fixture if any part is missing or damaged.
2. To avoid possible electrical shock, be sure electricity is turned off at the main fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring.
3. Make certain no bare wires are exposed outside the wire connectors.
4. All wiring must conform to national and local electrical codes.
5. Follow the recommended instructions for the proper method of wiring your new light fixture. If you feel you do not have enough electrical wiring knowledge or experience, have your light fixture installed by a licensed electrician. Any electrical work not described in this manual should be performed by a licensed electrician.
