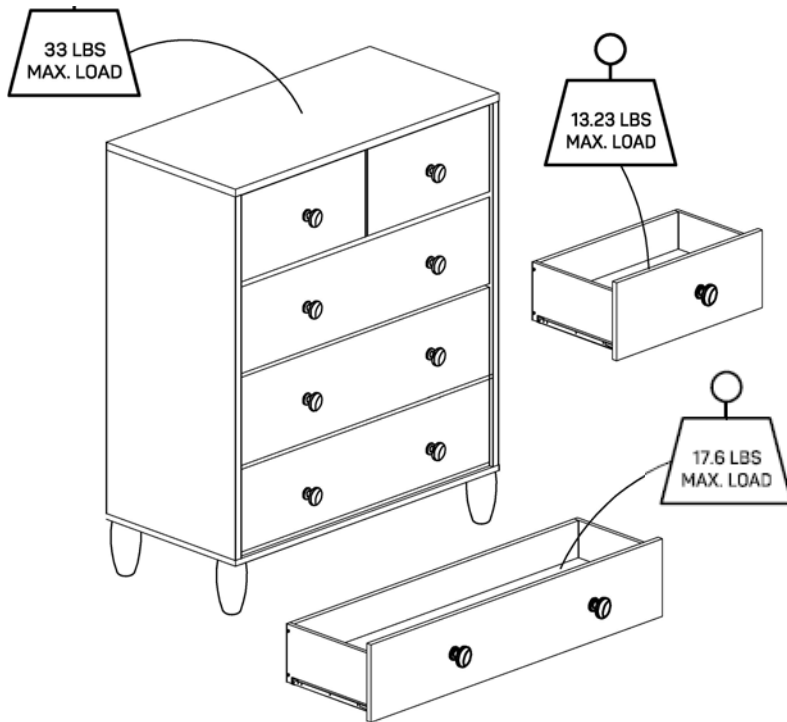

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Before You Begin:

Please identify all component parts and hardware pieces required before you begin. Carefully remove all of the components from the packaging and set aside for assembly. Assemble on a soft surface to prevent scratching during assembly.

Caution:

Tighten all components securely before use. Failure to do so may result in personal injury. DO NOT use any sharp objects to open plastic wrapped components as damage to product or components may result.

Warning:

CHOKING HAZARD - Small Parts. Adult Assembly Required.

Injuries may result from tipping furniture. You must install Tipping Restraint Hardware with the unit to prevent the unit from tipping and causing any accidental injury, instability, death or damage. The tipping restraint is intended only as a safety measure, it is not a substitute for proper adult supervision.

The tipping restraint is not an earthquake restraint. If you wish to add the extra security of earthquake restraints, they must be purchased and installed separately.

Serious or fatal crushing injuries can occur from furniture tipping over. To prevent furniture from tipping over it must be permanently fixed to the wall. Fixing devices for the wall are not included since different wall materials require different types of fixing devices. Use fixing devices suitable for the walls in your home.

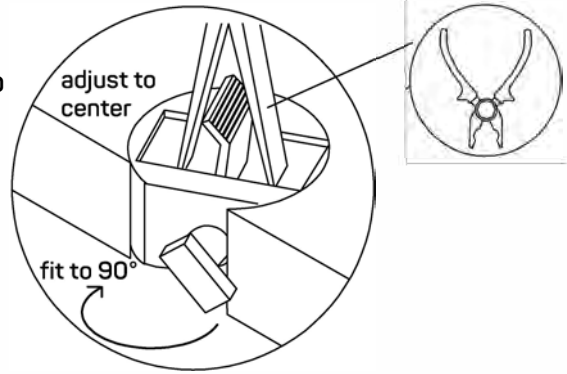
















** If the pin position is offset, use pliers to hold the flip switch in the upright position and carefully turn the switch lock to the center of the opening.

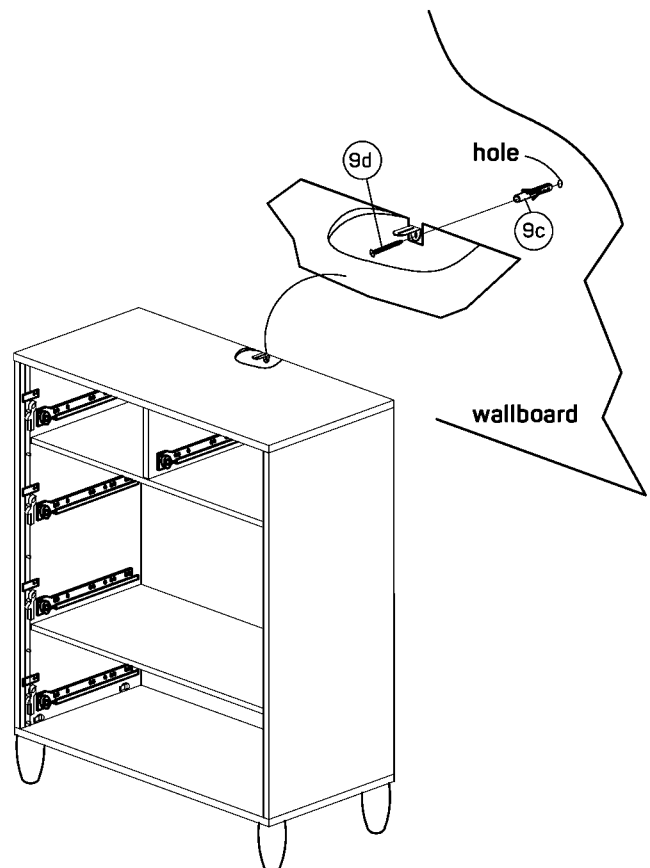
WARNING

- Never allow children to climb or hang on drawers, doors or shelves
- Never open more than one drawer at a time

Use of tipover restraints may only reduce, but not eliminate the risk of tipover.



OPTION 1: Attachment into a wall stud (preferred method)

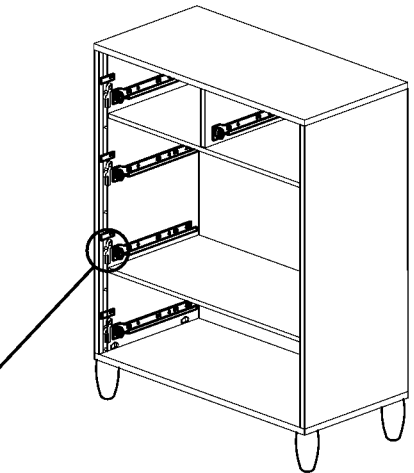
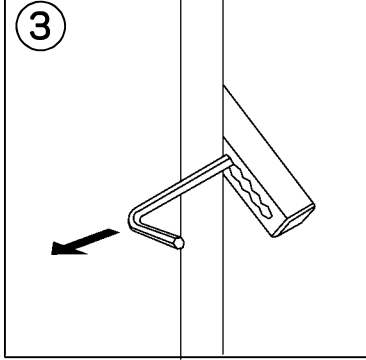
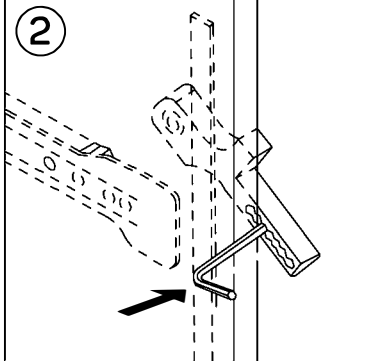
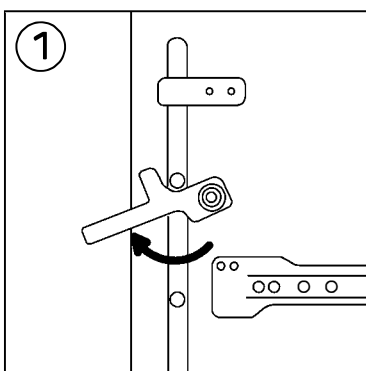
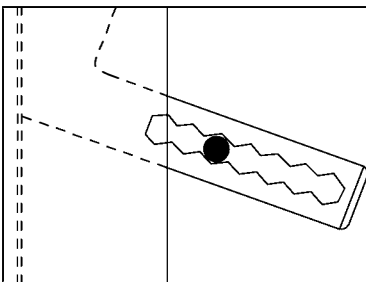
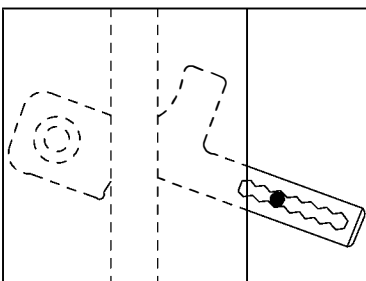
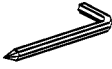
Using a stud finder, locate a stud in the wall. Place your unit against the wall, with the safety bracket aligned in this location. To make driving the screw easier, you can drill a 1/8" diameter pilot hole (3mm) through the safety bracket into the stud. Drive the screw through the safety bracket into the wall stud. Tighten the screw that was not fully tightened in step 35.

OPTION 2: Attachment into drywall

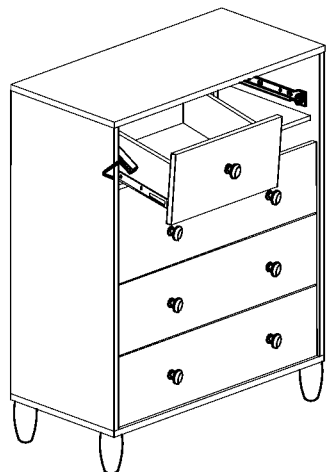
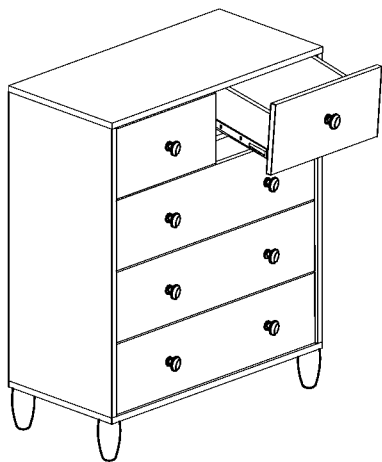
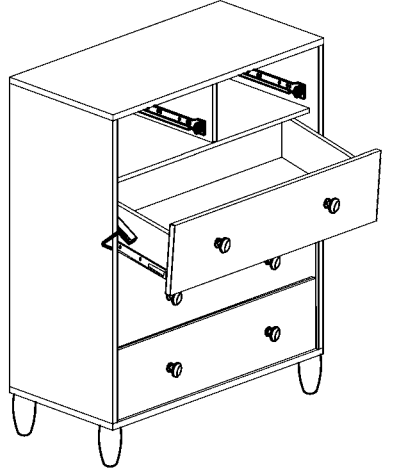
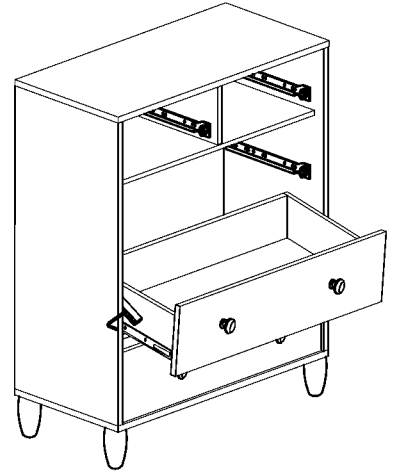
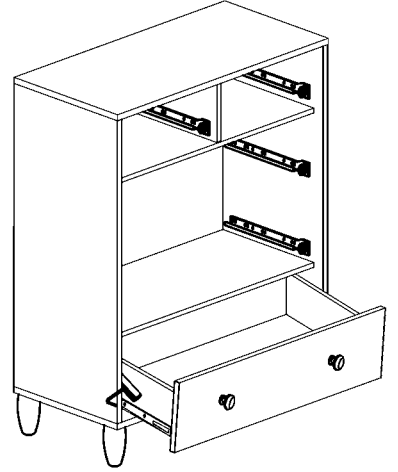
Locate your unit where desired against a wall and mark the wall through the safety bracket, then move your unit aside. Drill a 3/16" diameter hole (5mm) into the wallboard. Tap the wall anchor into the hole until it is flush. Move your unit into location and fasten the wall bracket to the wall anchor with the screw. Tighten the screw that was not fully tightened in step 35.

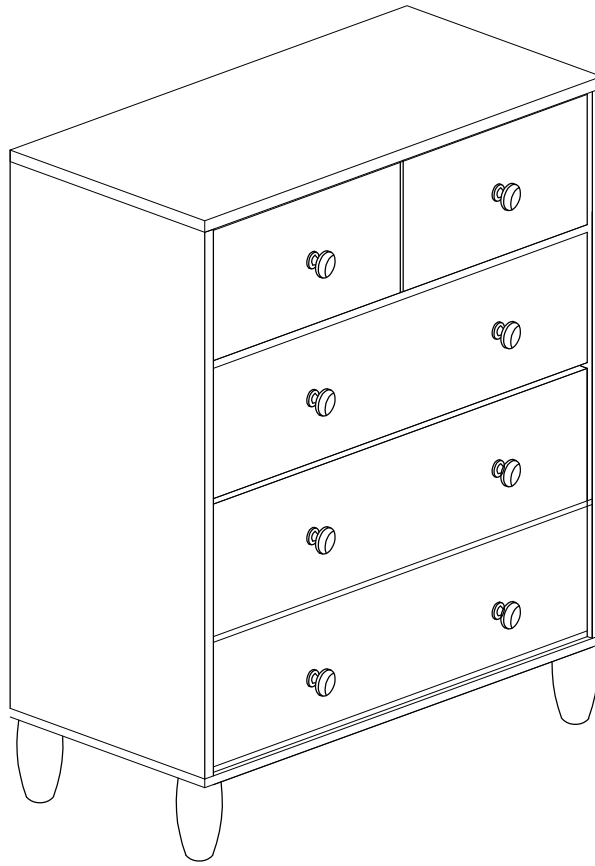

Note: Before inserting each drawer, lift the drawer lock on the inside of the left side panel and insert the Allen Key into the 5th hole. Partially insert drawer, remove the Allen Key from the lock and let it fall back into the cabinet then close the drawer.
