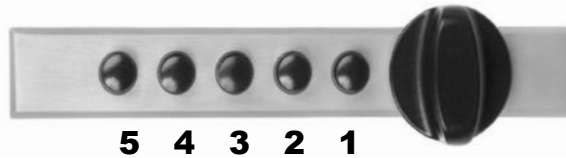


Simplex Pushbutton Lock Instructions

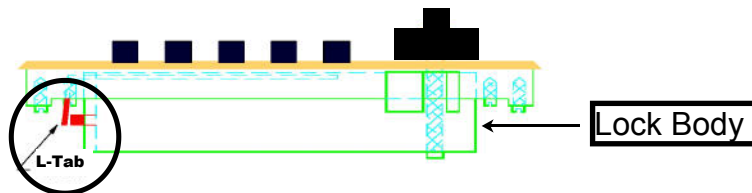
Your **Simplex Pushbutton Lock** is presently set with a combination of: First, **push #2 and #4 together, and then #3.** Make a habit of turning the knob **LEFT** (counter-clockwise) before pushing the combination. Should anyone have attempted an improper combination, this action clears off such an attempt and reactivates the buttons.

TO OPEN

- 1) Turn knob **LEFT** (counter-clockwise) to active all buttons.
- 2) Push proper buttons in present order for the combination.
- 3) Turn knob **RIGHT** (clockwise) to open.

TO LOCK

Turn knob **LEFT** (counter-clockwise) until it stops.



TO CHANGE YOUR COMBINATION

You may easily change to a new combination, using one, all five, or any number of buttons you wish in any order. Two or more buttons may be pushed at one time as part of your new combination. Simple two and three button combinations are easy to remember and still provide top security. Note: a particular button can be pushed **only once** in establishing a new combination. **RECORD YOUR NEW COMBINATION AND KEEP IN A SAFE PLACE.**

- 1) Open the door or drawer and relock your lock.
- 2) Press the correct buttons in the proper order for your **EXISTING** combination.
- 3) On the back side of the lock there is a "L" TAB, push the "L" TAB into the lock as far as it will go.
- 4) Turn the knob **LEFT** (counter-clockwise) to "clear-out" the existing combination.
- 5) Press the buttons firmly and deliberately in the desired sequence for your new combination.
- 6) Turn the knob to the **RIGHT** (clockwise) to set your new combination into the mechanism.

Turn the knob full LEFT to lock the lock. Your new combination is now installed. Test your combination with the door open a few times before locking your safe.

LIMITED WARRANTY

This warranty applies only to new security cases and cabinets purchased from V-Line Ind. or its authorized distributors and dealers. Purchaser must provide proof of purchase and location of purchase in order to obtain service under this warranty.

V-Line Ind. has its option and may repair or replace any defective parts or unit.

This warranty does not apply to damage or loss resulting from accident, misuse, improper installation, scratching of paint, normal wear and tear or negligence.

Purchaser must notify V-Line Ind. of any defect promptly upon delivery. All unauthorized repairs or modifications performed will void warranty.

The responsibility of V-Line Ind. under this warranty is limited to replacement or repairs of defective parts at the V-Line Ind. factory or at a point designated by V-Line Ind. with all transportation charges paid by the original purchaser.
