



## Installation Steps:

Thank you for using our products. Please read the operating instructions before installation. Keep these instructions for reference. Disconnect the power supply before installing this product. Installation by a professional electrician is recommended.

1. Open the two round ball covers, install the square tubes on the fixed round iron pieces in turn with nuts and lock them with a wrench. Then install the two round ball covers.
2. Pass the wire through the long iron pipe, then fix the iron pipe to the screw above the lamp head, then install the assembled lamp head on the long iron pipe inside the assembled frame.
3. Install the short iron pipe in order to fix it in the nut above the lamp body.
4. Install the ceiling disk onto the assembled short iron pipe.
5. Fix the mounting bracket into the reserved mounting box.
6. Connect the black wire to the fire wire with a wire cap and the white wire to the zero wire with a wire cap and wrap tightly with insulating tape. Connect the fixture ground wire to the junction box ground wire. If the house does not have a ground wire, connect it to the green screw on the siding. (Secure the bulb to the suspension pipe with the round head nut.
7. Remove the plastic ring from the lamp head and install the glass cover in the lamp head position, securing it with the plastic ring just removed.
8. Install the bulb onto the lamp head, ensuring good contact.

## Attention:

1. The input power of the lamp is AC 120V 50Hz.
2. Any behavior that violates residential fire protection regulations is prohibited.
3. Under no circumstances should the lamps be covered with heat insulation pads or wooden materials.
4. Before maintenance, make sure that the power supply of the lamp has been cut off and the light source has cooled down. Before powering on, make sure that the light source and the lamp holder are connected correctly.
5. Please wipe with a towel or flannel, and clean the lamp body with a non-corrosive detergent. Do not scrub directly, wipe with water or a damp cloth.
