



Installation steps:

1-2. Insert the A/B light arms into the side holes of the central hub base, and then tighten them with nuts.

3. Connect wires of the same color as follows:

We recommend splitting the 16 white/black wires of the light arm into two equal groups of wiring:

---Connect the 8 white wires to the short white wires provided using a wire nut.

---Connect the remaining 8 white wires and the short white wires provided to the white main wire using a wire nut.

---Connect the 8 black wires to the short black wires provided using a wire nut.

---Connect the remaining 8 black wires and the short black wires provided to the black main wire using a wire nut.

4-5. Attach the bottom cover on the center hub base with a flat nut.

6-8. Determine the wanted height or look of the fixture with the provided down rods, and assembled them by screwing them together.

9. Attach the canopy to the fixture body.

10. Attach the mounting bracket to the outlet box using two mounting screws.

11. Pull out the source wires from the outlet box. Make wire connections using wire nuts as follows:

--Connect the white wire from the fixture to the white wire from the power source.

--Connect the black wire from the fixture to the black wire from the power source.

--Attach the fixture grounding wire to the mounting bracket with the green grounding screw, and then connect it to the house grounding wire with a wire nut.

Carefully tuck the wires back into the outlet box.

12-13. Attach the canopy to the outlet box and tighten it with two ball nuts.

14. Install the bulbs. (Bulb not included)

15. Attach the shade to the lamp holder.

Safety Instructions:

To avoid fire, shock, and serious personal injury, follow all instructions carefully.

1. Do not install or use the light fixture if any part is missing or damaged.

2. To avoid possible electrical shock be sure electricity is turned off at the main fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring.

3. Make certain no bare wires are exposed outside the wire connectors.

4. All wiring must conform to national and local electrical codes.

5. Follow the recommended instructions for the proper method of wiring your new light fixture. If you feel you do not have enough electrical wiring knowledge or experience, have your light fixture installed by a licensed electrician. Any electrical work not described in this manual should be performed by a licensed electrician.
