
Please read all instructions for **Zone Support**^{\mathbb{N}} and **Express Pump**^{\mathbb{R}} prior to inflation. This air mattress should be at room temperature before inflating or possible air leaks may occur.

- **1.** Carefully unpack contents of carton.
- **2.** Remove **Zone** Support[™] from its convenient duffel bag.
- **3.** Place mattress in unobstructed area free of sharp objects and unfold.

NOTE: Read separate **EXPRESS PUMP**[®] instructions prior to operation.

- **4.** Unscrew cap covering **Zone Support**™'s inflate/deflate valve.
- **5.** Plug pump into a grounded 120 volt AC electrical outlet (a).
- **6.** Locate **EXPRESS PUMP**® inflate port (b).
- **7.** Align arrow on pump with arrow on valve (c). **Arrow Arrow**






8. Push **EXPRESS PUMP**[®] firmly into valve (d). Do not force. Twist pump to lock into place (e). Turn on switch to begin inflating (f).







- **9.** Inflate **Zone Support**™ until firm. To avoid stretching or bulging do not overinflate.
- 10. To achieve desired firmness level, lie on the Zone Support™ and depress patented spring loaded valve to gradually release air (g). If too much air escapes, simply reinflate with pump.
- 11. Your Zone Support™ is now ready to use.
 Replace valve cover and make up bed with
 deep pocket sheets and bedding.



TO DEFLATE AND STORE

- Unscrew cap covering the inflate/deflate valve.
- **2.** Plug **EXPRESS PUMP**® into a grounded 120 volt AC electrical outlet (a).
- **3.** Locate **EXPRESS PUMP®** deflate port (h).
- 4. Align arrow on pump with arrow on valve (c).
- **5.** Push **EXPRESS PUMP**® firmly into valve (i). Do not force. Twist pump to lock into place (e). Turn on switch to begin deflating (f).
- 6. When mattress is completely deflated turn pump off and twist pump to unlock and remove. The Zone Support™ is now ready for storage.





WARNING: EXPRESS PUMP® will burn out if left in "on" position after mattress is deflated. Monitor deflation progress. DO NOT LEAVE PUMP UNATTENDED.

7. Roll and place **Zone Support**[™] in convenient duffel bag.

LIMITED 1 YEAR WARRANTY

If defect occurs in months 4 - 12 from the original purchase date the manufacturer will offer a credit of 50% of the current manufacturer's Suggested Retail Price for any mattress/component that has a manufacturer's defect. This credit is to be applied towards the purchase of a replacement Zone Support™ mattress. Shipping and handling charges to ship the replacement mattress/component are the responsibility of the consumer.

The **EXPRESS PUMP*** will be guaranteed to the original purchaser against defects in materials and workmanship for a period of 90 days from the date of purchase provided that the pump has been operated according to the provided instructions.

Our obligation under this warranty shall be limited to the repair or exchange of any part which may prove defective under the conditions and during the periods described above.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Mattresses are constructed of heavy duty vinyl designed for optimum comfort when used at normal household temperatures.

WARNING:

Avoid extreme cold, as vinyl will become brittle. Do not overinflate. Do not use high pressure or compressed air inflation systems.

Avoid sharp objects. Do not use hair dryer to inflate.

WARNING: FLAMMABLE

VINYL IS FLAMMABLE. Do not locate bed near fire, fireplace or any other heat source, such as a space heater. Avoid placing bed over a heat emitting floor vent.

PVC, the material used to make air mattresses, will naturally stretch and expand during use. After being inflated for several hours and/or having been slept on, the air mattress may loose some of its initial firmness and feel softer because the PVC has naturally expanded. This expansion is normal and not the result of a leak. To regain your desired firmness level, add air to the mattress using the pump that was provided with the mattress.

Clean only with mild soap and water. Harsh cleaners can damage materials. Use repair kit to patch any holes, tears or punctures. Store at room temperature only AFTER cleaned and dried. Do not store outdoors or in a garage.

USES

Use the **Zone Support**[™] any time an extra temporary sleep surface is needed. The **Zone Support**[™] is intended for normal indoor use only. The **Zone Support**[™] is not intended to be used in place of your present everyday sleep surface.



WARNING

Risk of Suffocation

- Infants have suffocated on inflatable mattresses. Never place an infant 15 months and younger to sleep on an inflatable mattress.
- When used by children over 15 months old:
 - Provide at least a shoulder width space between mattress and walls, dressers or other vertical objects to avoid entrapment.
