Remove the fixture and the mounting packages from the box and make sure that no parts are missing by referencing the illustrations on the installation instructions.


Be sure to read these installation instructions and review the diagrams thoroughly before installation.

#### LIGHT BULBS REQUIRED

This lamp uses 12 E12 bulbs, compatible with bulb up to 40W. Fully dimmable when used with dimmable bulbs and compatible dimming switches (not included).

## **Installation Preparation**

#### **Tools You Need**




If mounting to a support structure, you will also need the optional tools.

## **Installation Step 1** (Assemble the Light Arm)

#### 1. Install light arm

- Step 1. Rotate the lift ring and nut to open the box with holes.
- Step 2. Insert the light arm into the box with holes as shown in the diagram.
- Step 3. Fix the light arm to the box through the fixing nut.




## **Installation Step 2** (Wire the Light Arm Wires)

#### 2. Wire the light arm wires


Step 1. Connect the wire of lamp arm A to the bottom of the wire in the lamp pole, (black to black, white to white).

Step 2. Connect the wire of lamp arm B to the top of the wire in the lamp pole and connect it to the main wire (black to black, white to white).



Step 3. Fix the cover of the top and bottom wire boxes securely.

Step 4. Fix the screw on the lift ring with a screwdriver.




## **Installation Step 3** (Assemble the Light Body)

#### 3. Assemble the light body


Step 1. Fix the lamp arm to the lamp body through screws that fixed by flower branch nut (outside) and fixed nut (inside) at both ends.

**Note:** The screws at the splice are longer than others, please pay attention to distinguishing during installation.



#### 4. Install the Mounting Bracket

Step 1. Secure the mounting bracket to the ceiling outlet box or solid wood structure with the screws and washers provided.



## **Installation Step 4** (Hang and Wire)


#### 5. Hang and Wire

Step 1. Pass the sling chain through the fixed buckle and canopy in sequence, and connect both ends to the bracket and lift ring.

Step 2. Pass the main wire through the lift ring, fixed buckle, canopy, and bracket in sequence.

Step 3. Wire according to the diagram, ground wire (green, green/yellow, or bare copper) to ground wire, neutral wire (white or blue) to neutral wire, and hot wire (black or brown) to the hot wire. Wrap the connection with electrical tape.

Step 4. Slide the canopy up to the ceiling, rotating fixed buckle to fix the canopy.




Note: Please test the fixture before installation to ensure it's working properly.

## **Installation Step 5** (Assemble the light)

### 6. Assemble the light

Step 1. Install the E12 bulbs on the socket.



#### **LIGHT BULBS REQUIRED**

This lamp uses 12 E12 bulbs, compatible with bulb up to 40W.Fully dimmable when used with dimmable bulbs and compatible dimming switches (not included).

## **Trouble Shooting**

#### 1. Missing/Broken Parts

 Make a list of the missing/broken parts according to the packing list, take photos for broken parts, then email us for free replacements.

#### 2. Bulbs Do Not Light Up

- Check your power and switch to make sure it's power on.
- Check the bulb to make sure it's installed correctly.
- · Change a new bulb.
- Check the wires to make sure they are connected correctly.

#### 3. Bulbs Flicker/Noisy Operation

- Check the bulb to make sure it's installed correctly.
- · Change a new bulb.
- Make sure your bulb is dimmable if you use a dimmer switch.

#### 4. Could Not Install/Assemble

- Take photos of the ceiling/fixture, contact seller for technical support.

#### **Clean And Care**

To clean, wipe the fixture with a soft cloth. Spraying from chemical cleaners can discolor the finish of the fixture. Do not use scouring pads, powders, steel wool, or abrasive paper to clean this fixture.

## **Ordering Parts**

Keep this manual for future reference, and in case replacement parts are needed. Available parts can be ordered from the place of purchase. Use exact wording from diagrams when ordering parts.
