










Keep your child/children at bay during the assembly process.



**Assembly Preparation**

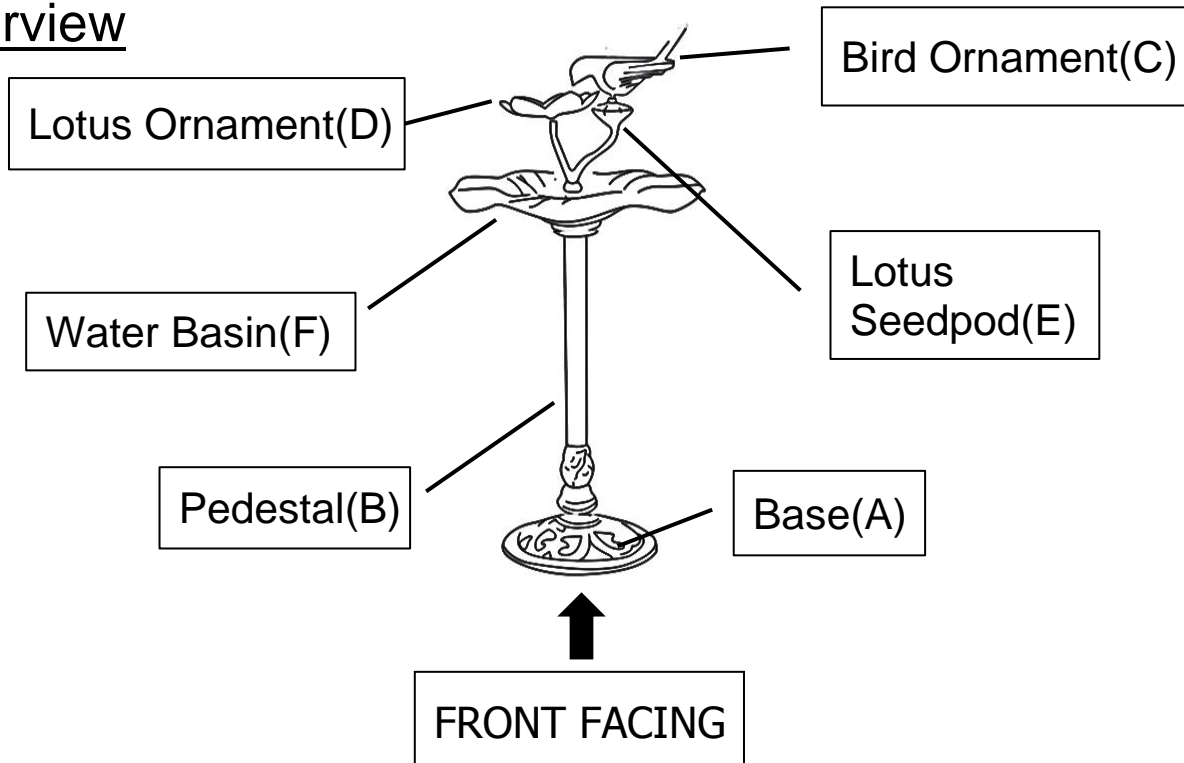
Before Beginning Assembly:



-  • Read instructions, cover to cover-
-  • Have 2 adults on hand for assembly-
-  • Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-
-  • Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-
-  • Save all packaging until finished-

## Assembly Step

### Overview

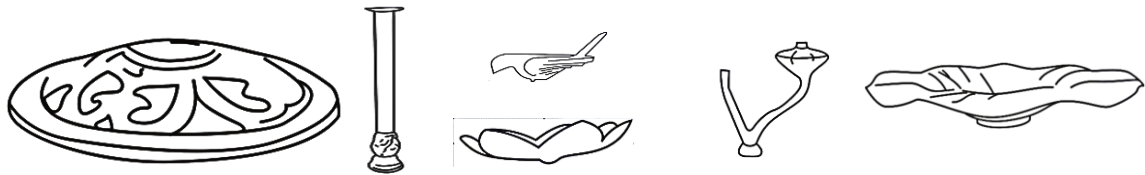


This Bird bath has multiple parts and may require up to some 30 minutes to assemble.

To give you an overview of the Bird bath parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective.

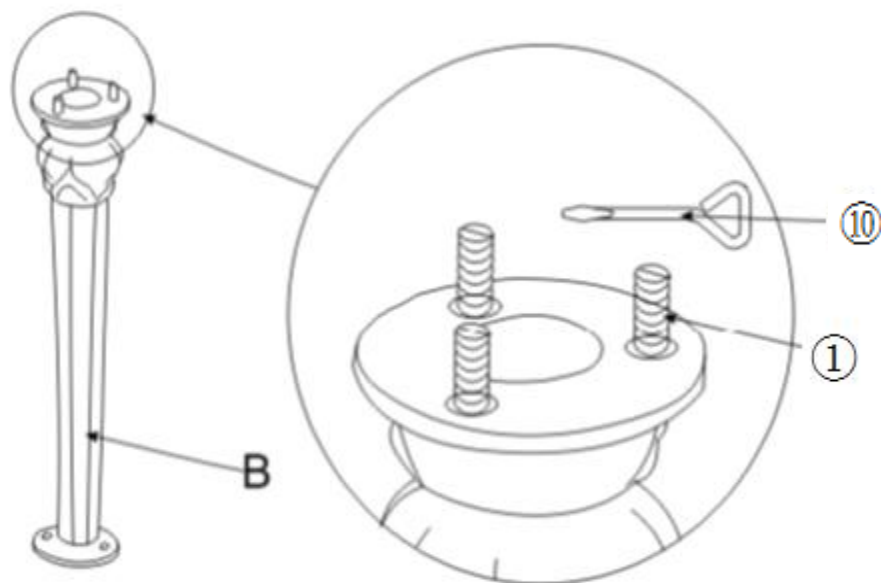
Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

### Step 1



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, soft surface.

## Step 2

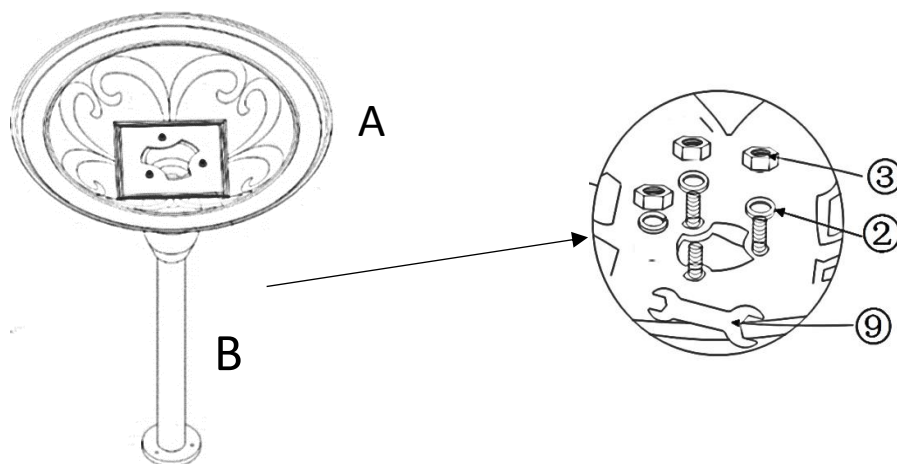


Turn the Pedestal(B) upside down and you will see 3 (three) mounting points.

Lock Bolts(①) to the mounting positions on Pedestal(B) by using Screwdriver(⑩).

**Need tighten the bolts.**

## Step 3

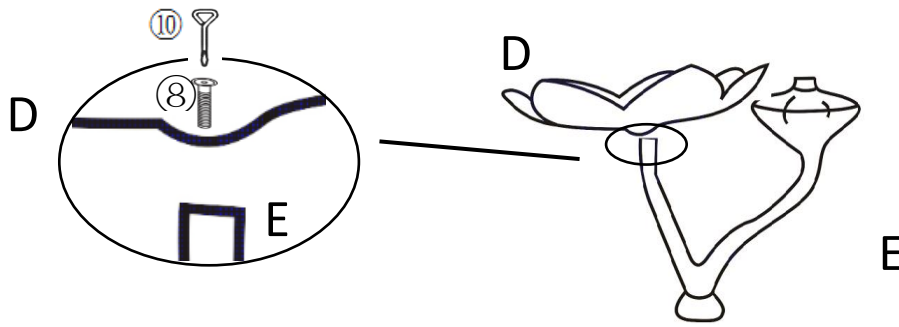


Align bolts on Pedestal(B) to the mounting positions on Base(A), attach Pedestal(B) to Base(A) with Washers(②) and Nuts(③) by using Spanner(⑨).

Make sure the Base is turned upside down for this assembly.

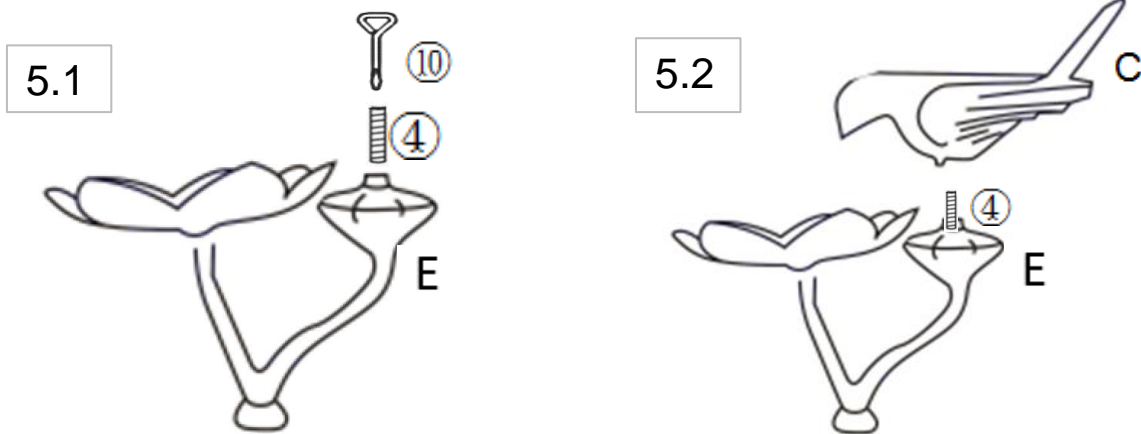
**Need tighten the bolts.**

**Step 4**



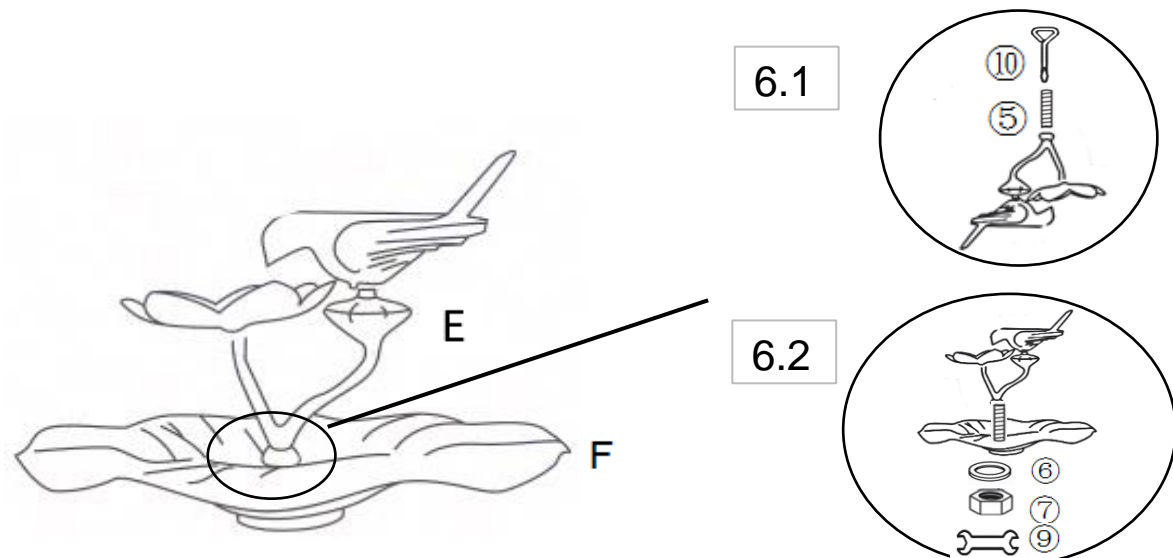
Attach Lotus Ornament(D) to the Lotus Seedpod(E) with Bolts(8) by using Screwdriver(10).

**Step 5**



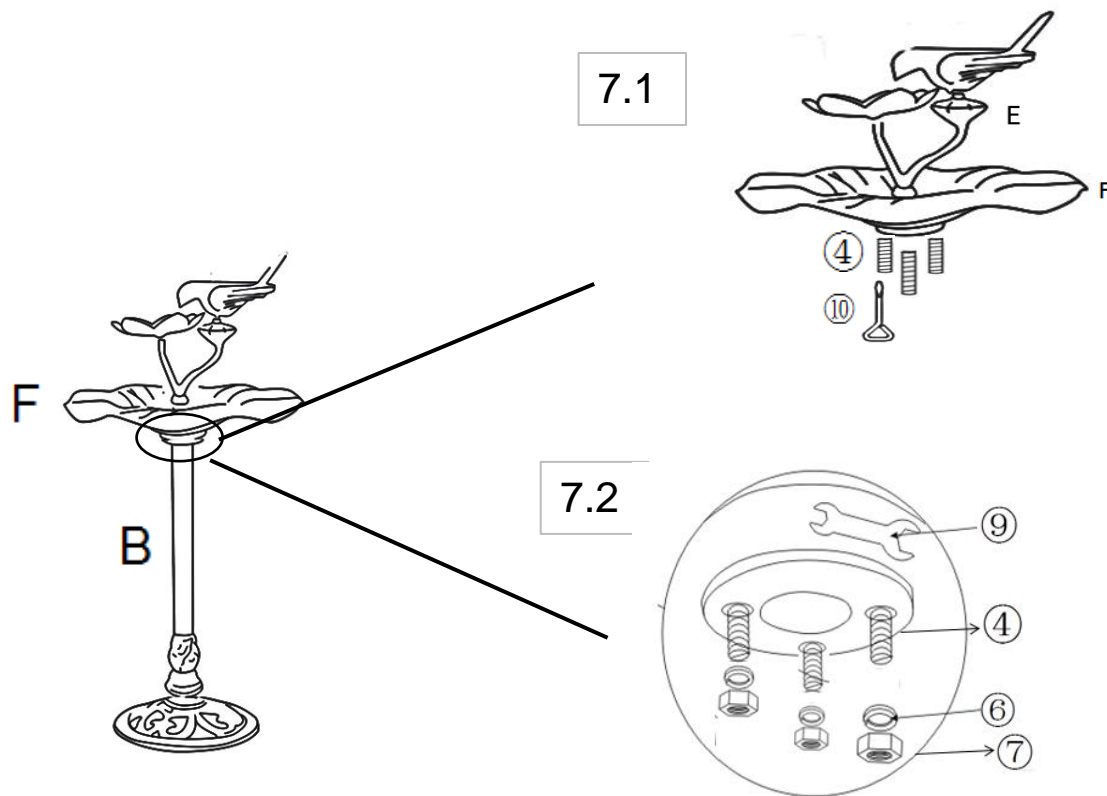
**5.1)** Lock Bolt(4) to the Lotus Seedpod(E) by using Screwdriver(10).  
**5.2)** Attach Bird Ornament(C) to the Bolt on Lotus Seedpod(E) by turning Bird Ornament, adjust to make the bird face the lotus, no need overtighten

**Step 6**



**6.1)** Turn Lotus Seedpod(E) over as pix above.  
Lock Bolt(5) to Lotus Seedpod(E) by using Screwdriver(10).  
**6.2)** Turn Lotus Seedpod(E) over as pix above.  
Attach Lotus Seedpod(E) to Water Basin(F) with Bolt(5) Washers(6) and Nuts(7) by using Spanner(9).  
**Need tighten the bolt.**

Step 7



Stand the Bird bath upright.

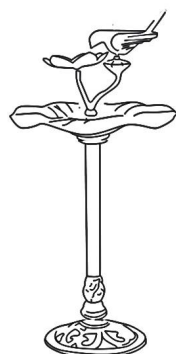
**7.1)** Lock Bolt(④) to Water Basin(F) by using Screwdriver(⑩).

**7.2)** Align the bolts on Water Basin(F) to the mounting positions on Pedestal(B), attach Water Basin(F) to Pedestal(B) Washers(⑥) and Nuts(⑦) by using Spanner(⑨).

Attachment points shall be locked in from the underside of the Water Basin(F).

**Need tighten the bolts.**

Step 8





















Now, in a sequential manner, fully and securely tighten all bolts at all joints.

Then Add Rubber Caps(⑪) on 3 bolt ends on the bottom of Water Basin(F) to protect skin or clothing from getting snagged.

Your Bird bath is ready for use.

**Caution: This Bird bath can only be used on a flat, level surface.**

## Care & Maintenance

-   ● Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface
  -   ● Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
  -   ● To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.
  -   ● Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
  -   ● Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
  -   ● To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.
  -   ● Not for commercial use. For residential use only .
  -   ● Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.

-   ● Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth .

### Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

#### • What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment.

By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals.

Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.

#### • What types of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list?

The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust.

#### • What does a warning mean?

If a warning is placed on a product label or posted or distributed at a workplace, a business, or in rental housing, the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing individuals to one or more listed chemicals.

By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
