
Fire Pit Table

Assembly Instruction



Important Information

- ☆Safety Distance:Keep the fire pit table at least 1.5 meters away from any flammable materials during use.
- ☆Ventilation: Use the fire pit table in a well-ventilated outdoor area. Avoid using it in enclosed spaces.
- ☆ Protective Measures:Wear protective gloves while using the fire pit table to prevent burns.
- ☆ Child Safety:Keep children away from the fire pit table and do not allow them to use it unsupervised to prevent accidents.
- ☆Cleaning and Maintenance:Clean the fire pit table only after it has cooled down. Wipe the surface with a soft cloth and regularly remove ashes from the fire pit.
- ☆Extinguishing the Fire:Use a fire extinguisher or let the fire burn out naturally by reducing the amount of wood.
- ☆Fuel Preparation:Use dry firewood and avoid using wood that contains chemicals.

Frequently Asked Questions

- Why is the fire pit table producing a lot of smoke?
 This may be due to using damp firewood or kindling. Make sure to use dry firewood and avoid materials containing chemicals.
- 2. How do I deal with rust spots on the surface of the fire pit table?

 Gently sand the rust spots with sandpaper and then apply high-temperature anti-rust paint to repair them.
- 3. How do I clean the fire pit table after use?

 Once the fire pit table has cooled down, wipe the surface with a soft cloth and warm water.

 Regularly clean out the ashes inside the fire pit to maintain proper ventilation.
