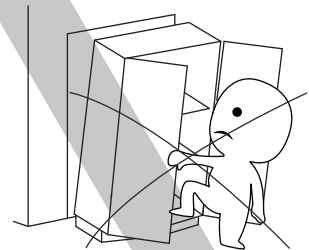
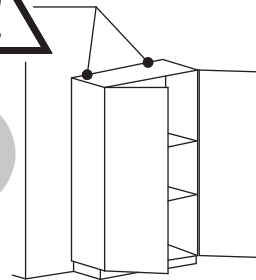
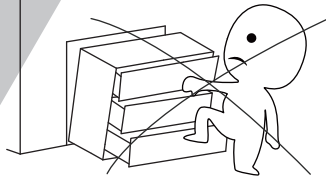
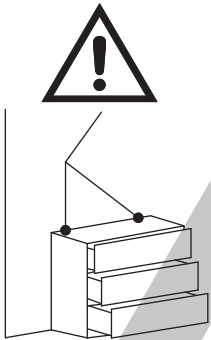
AVOID SCRATCHES!

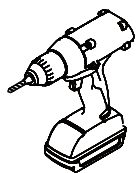
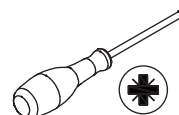
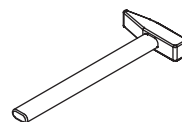
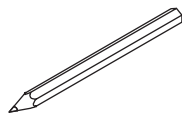
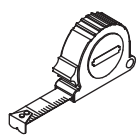
It is important that any product which is assembled using any kind of screw is re-tightened 2 weeks after assembly, and once every 3 months - in order to assure stability through-out the lifespan of the product.

For regular maintenance and cleaning of the product, for the frame, please use a rag dipped in neutral detergent to fully wipe it, and then dry it with a clean rag. For glass materials, wipe with a rag dampened with water glass cleaner, and then dry with a dry rag.

Do not use an electric screwdriver, and do not use too much force when installing, because the board is easy to break.

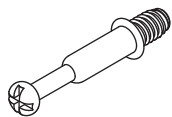

IMPORTANT WARNINGS

Risk of serious injuries if the wall bed tips over.

To prevent wall bed from tipping over, mount it permanently to the wall.

Only a qualified person* must carry out the installation and any possible adjustment of the wall bed (including disassembly). If the wall bed is not firmly mounted (anchored) to the wall, it might tip over and cause serious injuries to the installer, users of the bed as well as the people near the bed.

The choice of wall anchoring depends on the type of wall. Use wall anchors suitable for the wall material.

*Qualified person: it is necessary to have a good understanding of the wall structure where the bed is anchored, including the positioning of the joists and structural components in the case of a wood or metal structure. If you do not have the necessary skills, make sure that the installation is done by a person who has the qualifications and required knowledge. When you choose the installer, make sure to comply with all applicable regulations in the province, state or country where the furniture is installed.

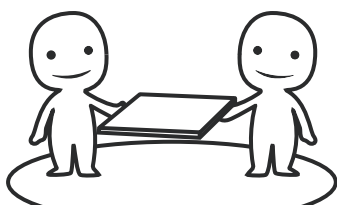
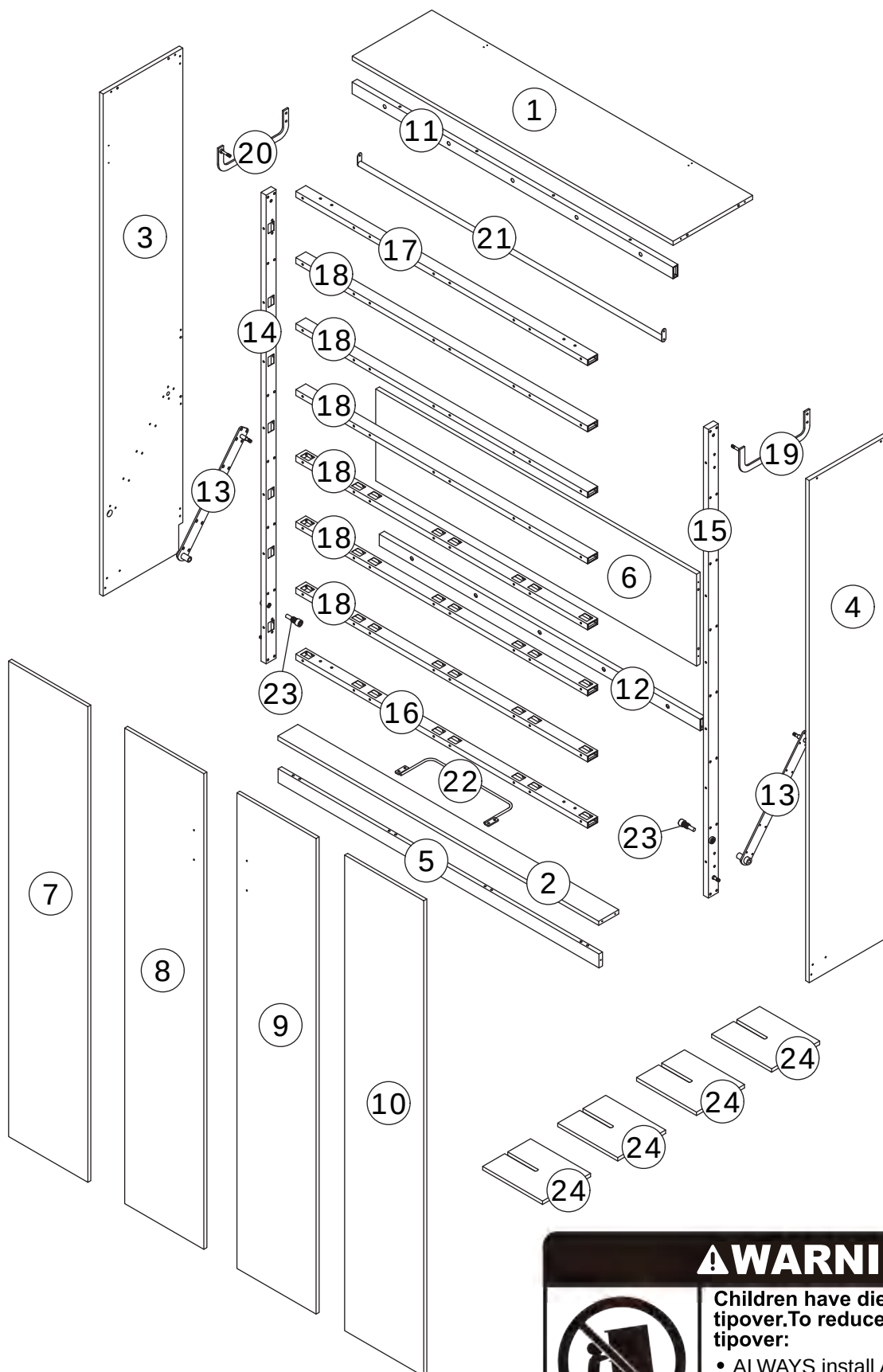
IMPORTANT: BEFORE STARTING ASSEMBLY

Be sure to confirm the following information:

- 1.The installer has the qualifications * and required knowledge.
- 2.Only wall anchor screws for wood-frame walls are provided with this bed. See anchor requirements and installation notes provided in the instruction manual, according to the type of wall, and use the appropriate anchors such as described in this manual.
- 3.Your bed can hold a maximum distributed weight of 800 lb (362 kg), including the weight of the mattress.
- 4.Maximum thickness of mattress: 10 in (25 cm), and must stand in vertical position without sagging.
- 5.The bed will not stay open without the weight of the mattress which must be between: 38 lbs (15 kg) and 90 lbs (41 kg).
- 6.Minimum ceiling height requirements for installation: 90 in (2.286 m).
- 7.It is recommended to assess the structural integrity of the floor and wall and to make sure that the wall anchoring devices can withstand the forces generated. More specifically, before installing the wall bed, it is necessary to verify that the floor and the wall on which you want to install the bed are flat and have no structural damage that could affect the installation of the wall bed or its anchoring to the wall. Do not install the bed on weakened or rotten structures.
- 8.It is necessary to ensure that wall anchors of the bed can withstand forces generated. The value of the holding power (F_h) of each anchor should be 630 Newtons (142 lbf).

If the wall bed is not installed properly, the latter might close unexpectedly or could open involuntarily.

In addition, if the wall bed is installed incorrectly, one of its structural components may break and fall off.



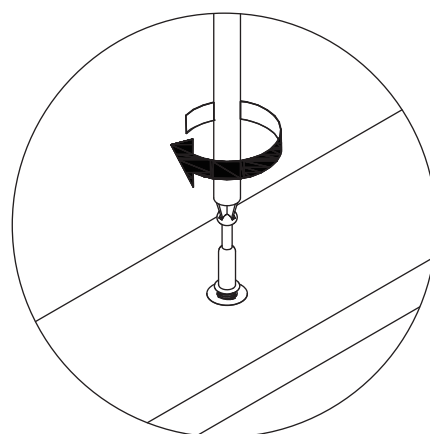
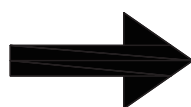
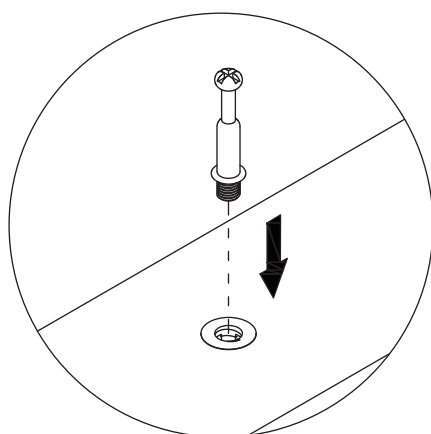
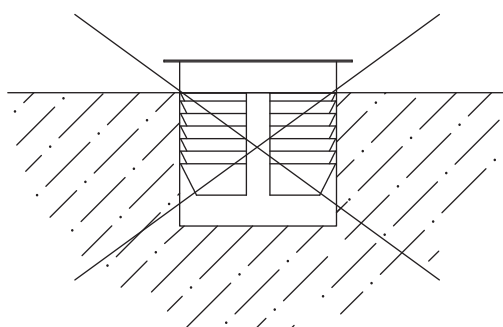
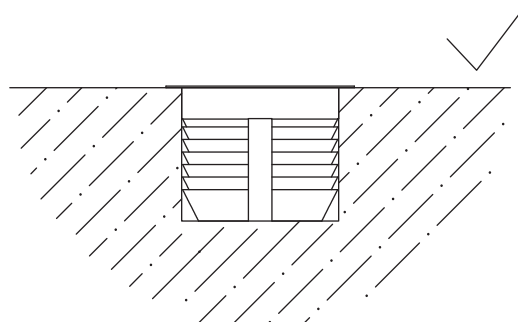
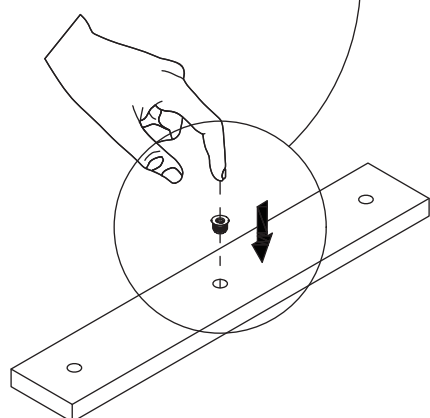
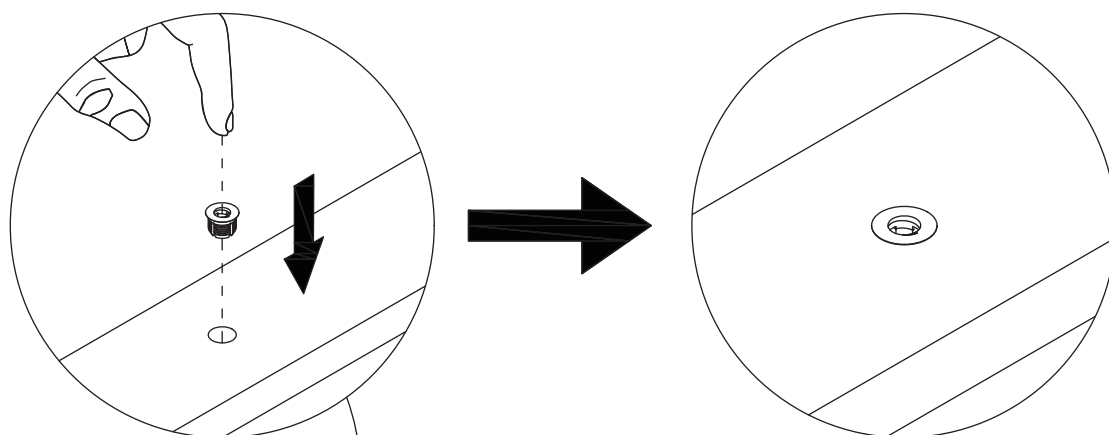

WALL ANCHORING REQUIREMENTS & INSTALLATION RECOMMENDATIONS

Important information to read before starting the assembly.
Keep this information for future reference.

IMPORTANT WARNINGS

Risk of serious injury if the wall bed overturns.

To prevent overturning, the wall bed must be permanently secured to the wall.

Installation, adjustment (including disassembly), and anchoring of the wall bed must be performed exclusively by a qualified professional*. Failure to securely anchor the wall bed to the wall may result in overturning, posing a risk of serious injury to the installer, bed users, and nearby individuals.

The selection of appropriate wall anchors depends on the wall substrate. Use only anchors specifically rated

* Qualified person: it is necessary to have a good understanding of the wall structure where the bed is anchored, including the positioning of the wall studs and structural components in the case of a wood or metal structure. If you do not have the necessary skills, make sure that the wall anchoring is done by someone who has the qualifications and required knowledge. When you choose the installer, make sure to comply with all applicable regulations in the province, state or country where the furniture is installed.

IMPORTANT WARNINGS

INSTALLATION AND APPROPRIATE HARDWARE

Using appropriate hardware, all anchor screws for the wall bed must be securely fastened to wood or metal studs, structural framing members, or a masonry wall. Only anchor screws suitable for wood-frame walls are included with this bed.

NEVER USE DRYWALL ANCHORS OR ATTACH THE BED DIRECTLY TO DRYWALL.

Refer to the wall anchoring requirements and installation instructions provided in the user manual—specifically those corresponding to your wall type—and use only the approved anchors specified therein.

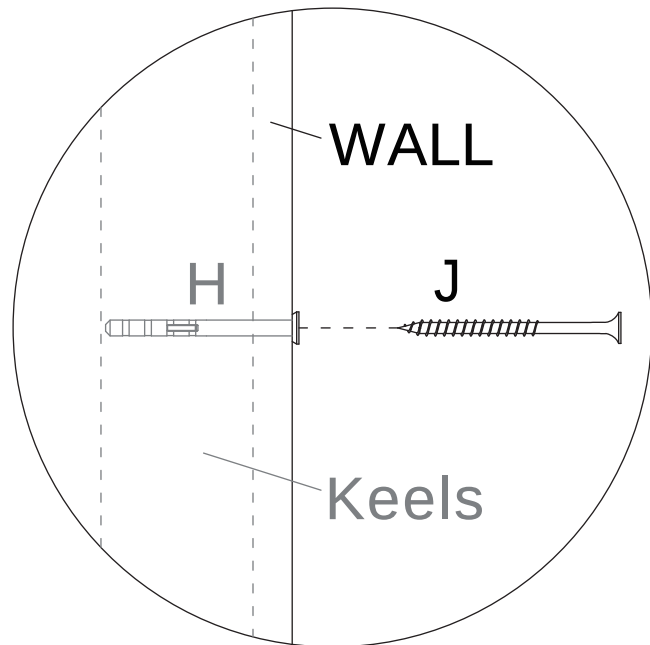
