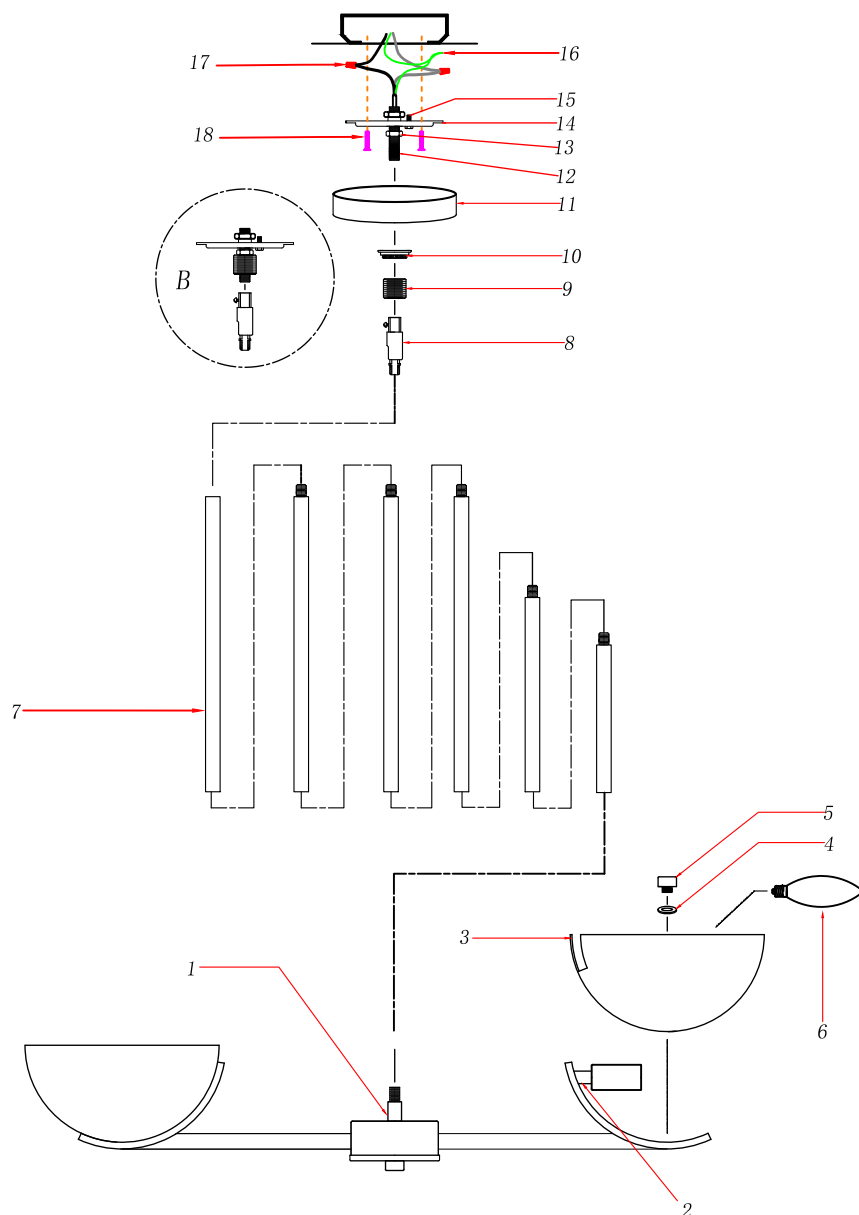


ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.



Before You Begin:

- Ensure power is turned off at the circuit breaker before installation.
- Read all instructions carefully.
- Installation should be performed by a qualified electrician if you are unfamiliar with wiring.

Step-by-Step Installation:

1. Adjust suspension rods (7) to desired length. Thread the fixture (1) wires and ground wire through the rods, then screw the rods clockwise into the fixture.
 2. Adjust Height
 - Assemble the threaded connector (9) onto the threaded tube (12) as shown, ensuring 8-10mm of threads remain exposed at the bottom. Secure the connector with a hex nut (13).
 - Attach the swivel joint (8) to the bottom of the threaded connector (9).
 - Mount the mounting plate (14) onto the threaded tube (12), adjust its position to junction box, and secure with a hex nut (13). The bottom of the threaded connector should sit 30-35mm from the ceiling.
 3. Thread the fixture wires and ground wire through the threaded ring (10), canopy (11), and the assembled component (Diagram B). Slide the threaded ring and canopy down to the rod base.
 4. Lift the assembled fixture, and secure the mounting plate (14) to the junction box using screws (18).
 5. Wiring Connections
 - Use wire connectors (17) to connect the fixture's positive wire ("L"), negative wire ("N") to the corresponding wires from the junction box.
 - Secure the ground wires to the mounting plate (14) using the green screw (15).
 - Ensure no exposed conductors remain outside wire connectors or outside the junction box.
 6. Neatly tuck all wires into the junction box. Secure the canopy (11) to the threaded connector (9) using the retaining ring (10).
 7. Align the notch of the glass shade (3) with the tube (2), tilt and slide it upward from below. Secure the shade to the fixture using the screw (5) and rubber gasket (4) as shown.
 8. Install the light bulb (6) into the socket (bulb not included). Do not exceed maximum wattage marked on the socket.
- Installation is complete.

Safety Instructions:

To avoid fire, shock, and serious personal injury, follow all instructions carefully.

1. Do not install or use the light fixture if any part is missing or damaged.
2. To avoid possible electrical shock, be sure electricity is turned off at the main fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring.
3. Make certain no bare wires are exposed outside the wire connectors.
4. All wiring must conform to national and local electrical codes.
5. Follow the recommended instructions for the proper method of wiring your new light fixture. If you feel you do not have enough electrical wiring knowledge or experience, have your light fixture installed by a licensed electrician. Any electrical work not described in this manual should be performed by a licensed electrician.
