Cloth

Always use a soft, grit-free cloth when cleaning mirrors in order to reduce chances of scratching surfaces.

Cleaner

The safest and best cleaning product for a mirror is clean, warm water used with a soft cloth. Be careful not to allow the edges of the mirror to get or remain wet over long periods of time.

If using a commercial glass or mirror cleaner, be sure to use a product that does not contain ammonia or vinegar.

Application

Never spray cleaning product directly onto a mirror. Instead, apply the cleaner to a soft cloth and then proceed to wipe the mirror in circular motions.

Finish

Be sure to dry all joints and edges thoroughly to ensure that no commercial cleaner comes in contact with the edges and backing.

Take great care to avoid getting the edges of the mirror wet with any liquid or substance. Failing to do so can lead to damaged mirror edges, commonly referred to as "black edge". Should mirror edges become wet, they should be dried off immediately with a clean and dry soft cloth.
