

GEOMETRIC MAGNETIC CURTAIN TIEBACK

Installation Guide

What's Included

In Your Package:

- 1 or 2 × Geometric magnetic tiebacks (depending on selected quantity)
- Hexagonal wooden tips (1.4" each)
- 13" braided faux leather cord each
- Flexible wrap-around closure system
- Available in your selected color: White, Gray, Black, or Gold

Your Color Selection:

Your geometric tieback(s) come in the sophisticated color you selected. Each color features the same premium faux leather cord and flexible wrap-around system.

- **White:** Clean, minimalist aesthetic - perfect for modern and Scandinavian interiors
- **Gray:** Versatile, contemporary tone - complements most modern color schemes
- **Black:** Bold, dramatic statement - ideal for high-contrast and industrial designs
- **Gold:** Luxurious, elegant accent - perfect for upscale and glamorous spaces

Tools Needed:

- None required - no drilling or hardware installation needed!
- Clean, dry cloth (for initial cleaning if desired)

Important Safety Information

- Ensure cord is not wrapped too tightly to avoid fabric damage
- Check curtain weight capacity before use
- Keep small parts away from children under 3 years
- Inspect cord regularly for wear or fraying

Step-by-Step Installation

1 Prepare Your Curtains

Ensure your curtains are clean and properly hung. The geometric tieback works best with medium to heavy curtains that complement modern decor.

Tip: If curtains are new, let them hang for 24 hours to settle before installing tiebacks.

2 Determine Tieback Position

Choose where you want the tieback positioned on your curtain:

- **High position:** 1/3 from the top - sleek, architectural drape
- **Middle position:** Center of curtain - balanced, contemporary look
- **Low position:** 2/3 down - relaxed, modern casual style

3 Gather the Curtain Fabric

Pull your curtain to one side and gather the fabric at your chosen position. The gathered fabric should be no more than 4 inches in circumference for optimal magnetic connection.

Modern Advantage: The geometric design adds architectural interest while the flexible cord maintains clean lines.

4 Position the Front Hexagon

Place one hexagonal element on the front-facing side of your gathered curtain where you want it to be visible. The geometric shape becomes a design accent.

Consider the angle - the hexagon can be positioned flat or slightly rotated for visual interest.

5 **Wrap the Cord Around**

Bring the braided faux leather cord around the back of the gathered curtain fabric. The flexible cord should wrap comfortably around the curtain bundle.

The premium faux leather provides durability while maintaining the modern aesthetic.

6 **Wrap and Secure**

Continue wrapping the cord around the curtain and connect the hexagonal ends by threading one through the other or using the cord's natural flexibility to secure the tieback in place.

Adjust the tightness to ensure a secure hold without damaging the fabric.

7 **Adjust and Perfect**

Adjust the curtain draping and the position of the front hexagon until you achieve the perfect modern look. The tieback should hold securely while allowing natural curtain movement.

Ensure the geometric element is positioned for maximum visual impact.

Pro Installation Tips

- For heavier curtains, position the tieback slightly higher for better support
- With a set of 2, install tiebacks at the same height for perfect symmetry
- For wide windows with multiple panels, use one tieback per panel
- The hexagon can be rotated to different angles for varied visual interest
- Consider the geometric element as part of your room's design scheme
- The 13" length accommodates most modern curtain thicknesses
- Practice wrapping technique before final installation
