

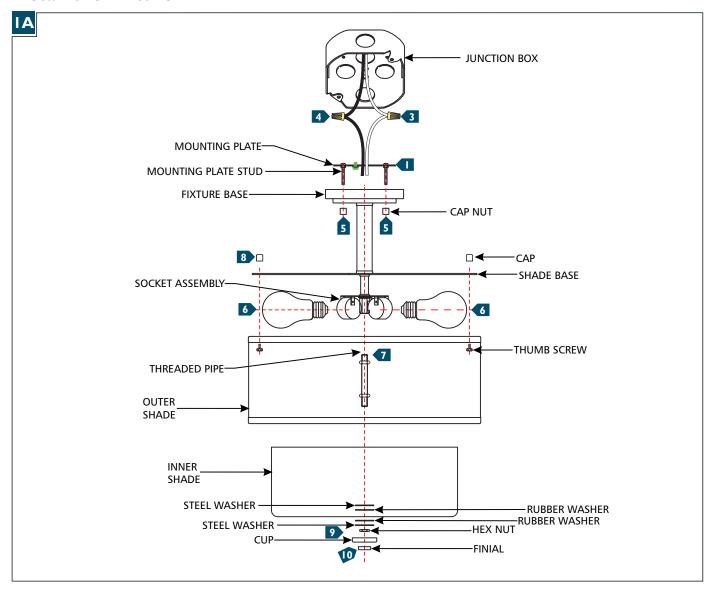

Install the Fixture



- I Secure the mounting plate to the junction box.
- Connect the fixture to a suitable ground in accordance to local electrical codes.
- 3 Connect the white fixture wire to the neutral power line wire with a wire nut.
- 4 Connect the black fixture wire to the hot power line wire with a wire nut.
- Place the fixture base onto the mounting plate studs and secure it in place by screwing the cap nuts onto the mounting plate studs.
- 6 Screw the lamps into the sockets. Refer to the label on the socket for Max Wattage Information.
- Screw the threaded pipe to the bottom of the socket assembly.
- 8 Attach the outer shade to the shade base with the thumb screws and caps.
- Place a steel washer, rubber washer, the shade, rubber washer, and steel washer (in that order) onto the threaded pipe, then secure them in place by screwing a hex nut onto the threaded pipe.
- Place the cup onto the threaded pipe and secure it by screwing the finial onto the threaded pipe.
