## WARNINGS AND CAUTIONS

### READ AND SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

Please read and understand this entire manual before attempting to assemble, install or operate the product.

#### WARNING

- RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK - Before beginning installation, turn off electricity at the circuit breaker box or the main fuse box.

- RISK OF FIRE - Use bulbs specified by the markings and/or labels on the fixture.

- RISK OF PERSONAL INJURY - DO NOT bend the blades when installing the fan, or cleaning the fan.

Do not insert foreign objects in between rotating fan blades.

- RISK OF FIRE, ELECTRIC SHOCK, OR PERSONAL INJURY - mount to outlet box marked and use mounting screws provided with the outlet box.

- All set screws must be checked, and re-tightened where necessary, before installation.

- After making the wire connections, the wires should be spread apart with the grounded conductor and the equipment-grounding conductor on one side of the outlet box and the ungrounded conductor on the other side of the outlet box.

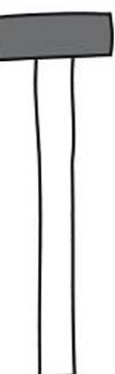
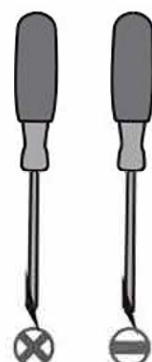
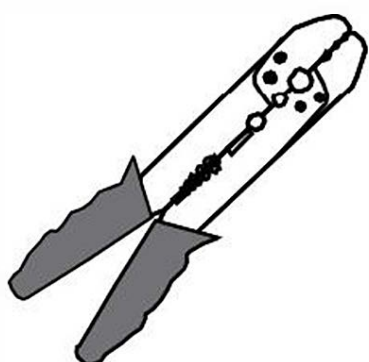
#### CAUTION

- If in doubt about electrical installation, consult a licensed electrician.

- Disconnect fixture from the power source before replacing bulbs or cleaning. Make sure the bulbs are given sufficient time to cool be before removing.

#### CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Wipe clean using soft, dry cloth or static duster. Always avoid using harsh chemicals and abrasives to clean fixture as they may damage the finish.

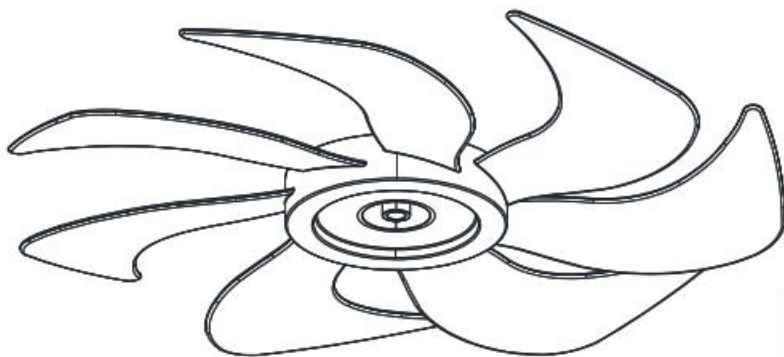

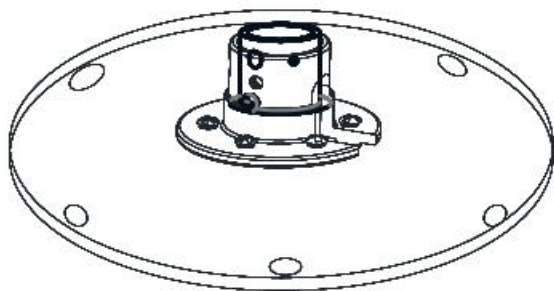

## 1 Choose Suitable Downrod

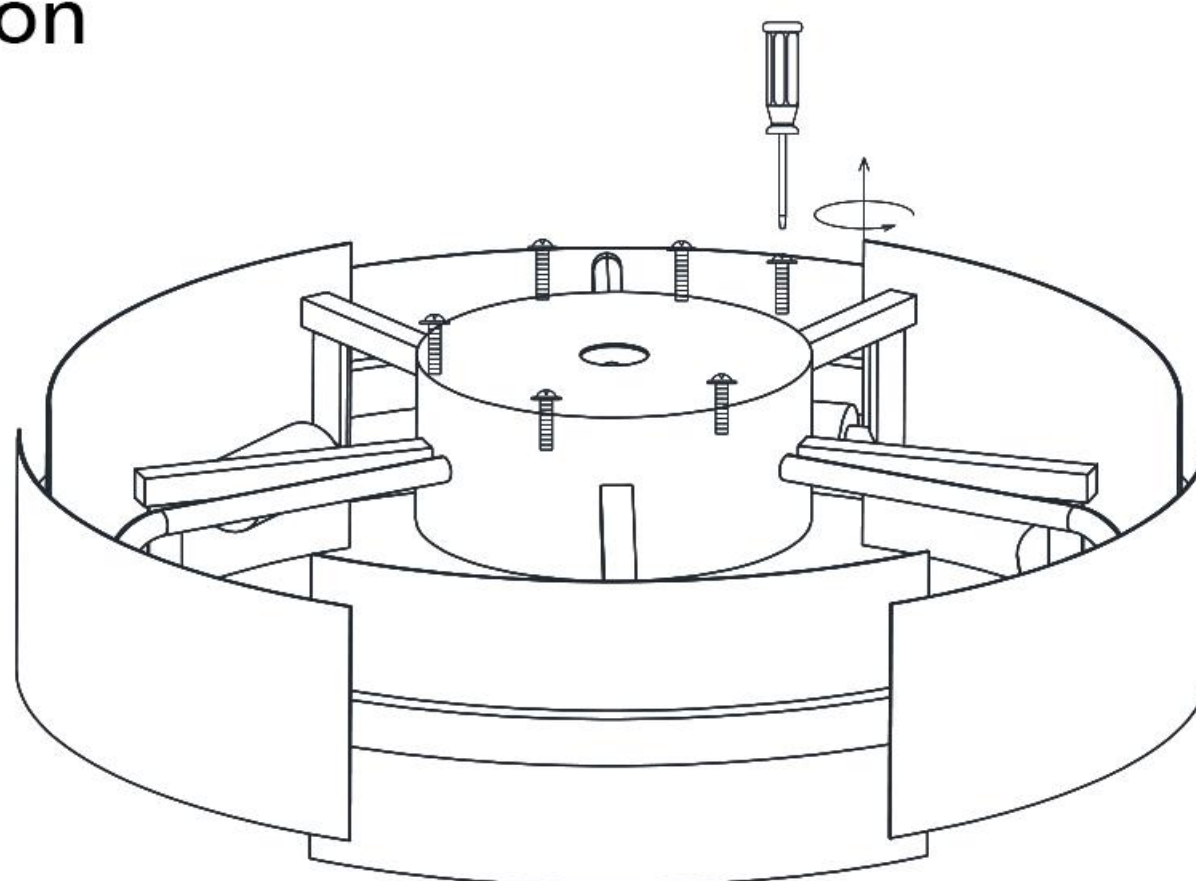


## 2 Install Downrod to Fixture Body

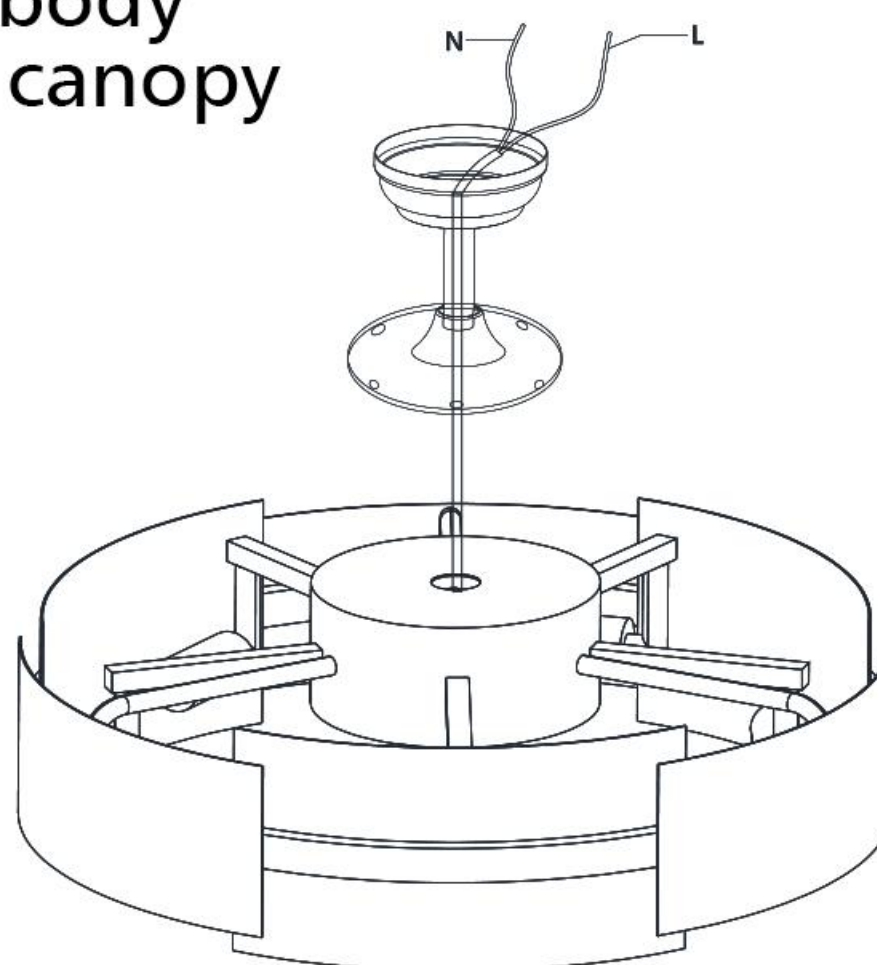

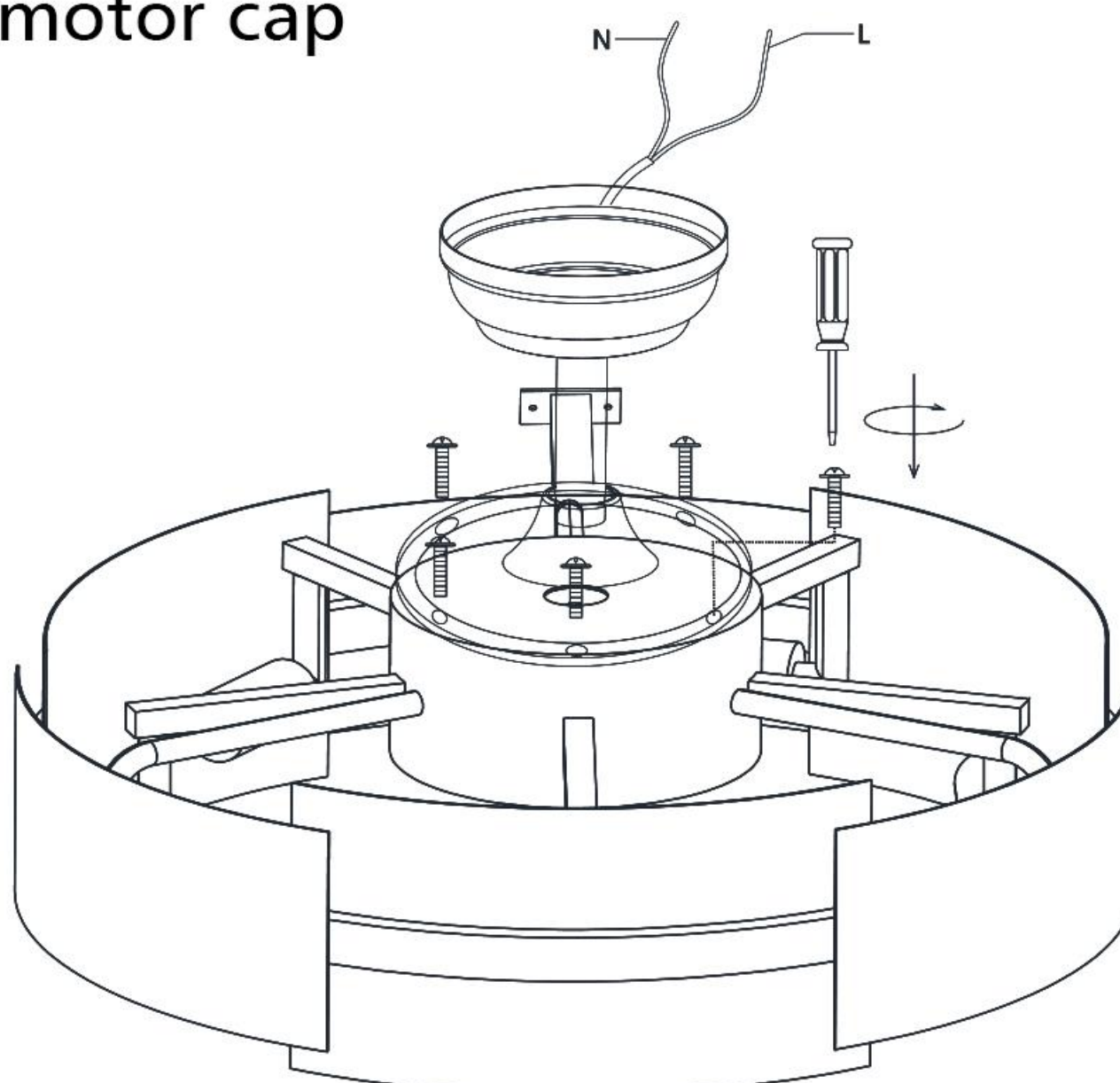
- 3** Remove the set screws on the fixture body



- 4** Thread the wires from the fixture body through the downrod and ceiling canopy

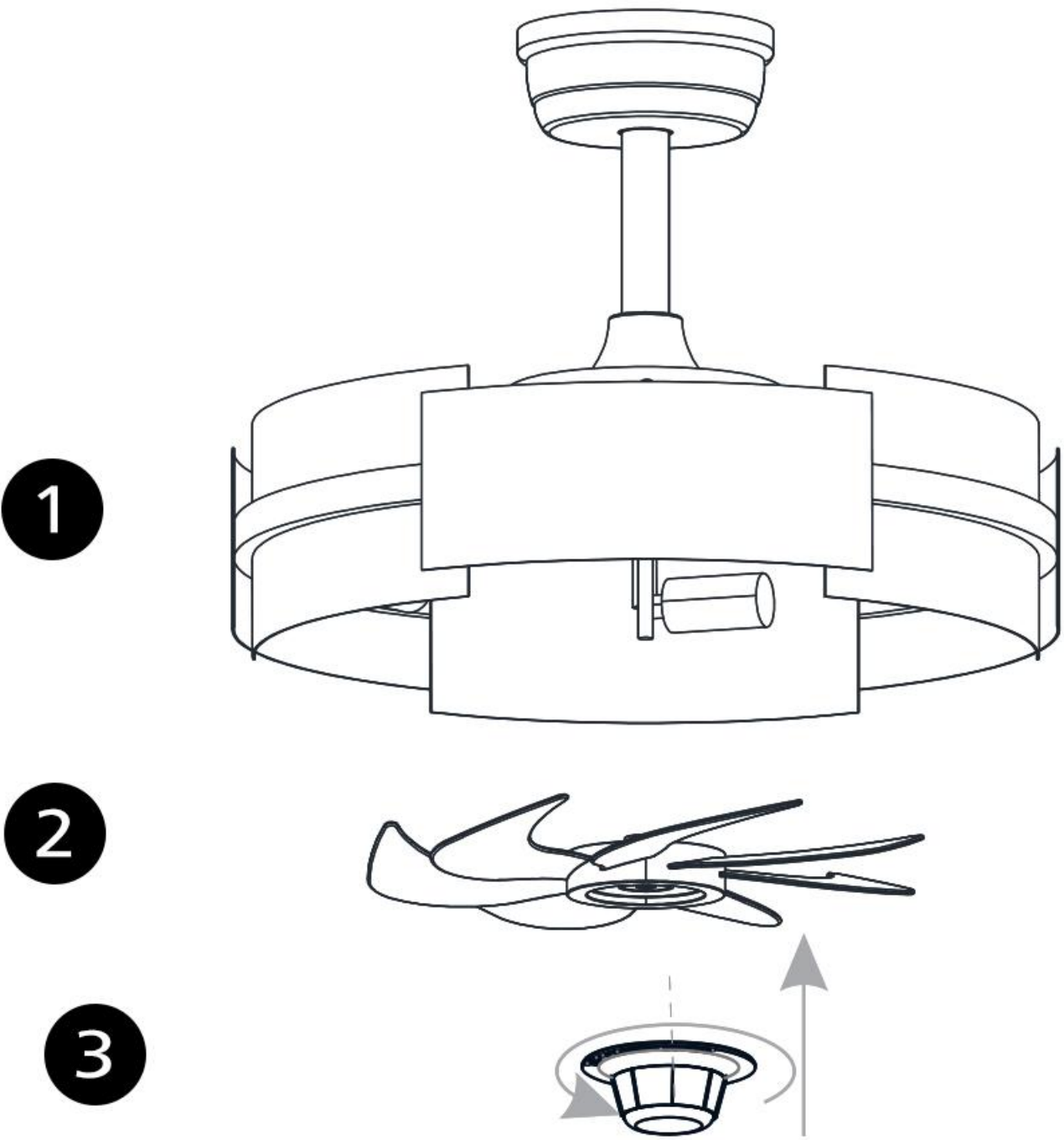


- 5** Install the screws into the motor cap



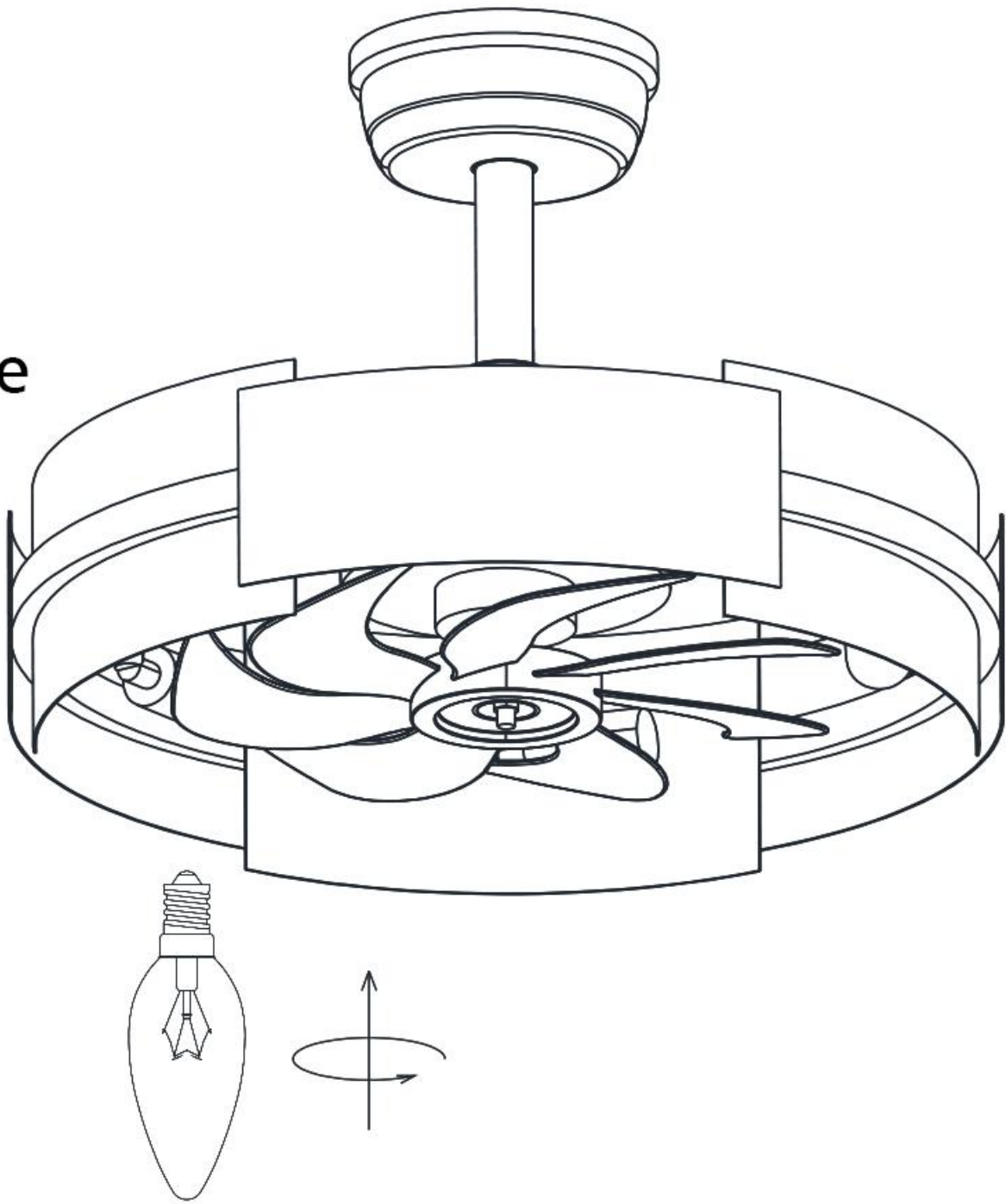

6 Install Fan Blade



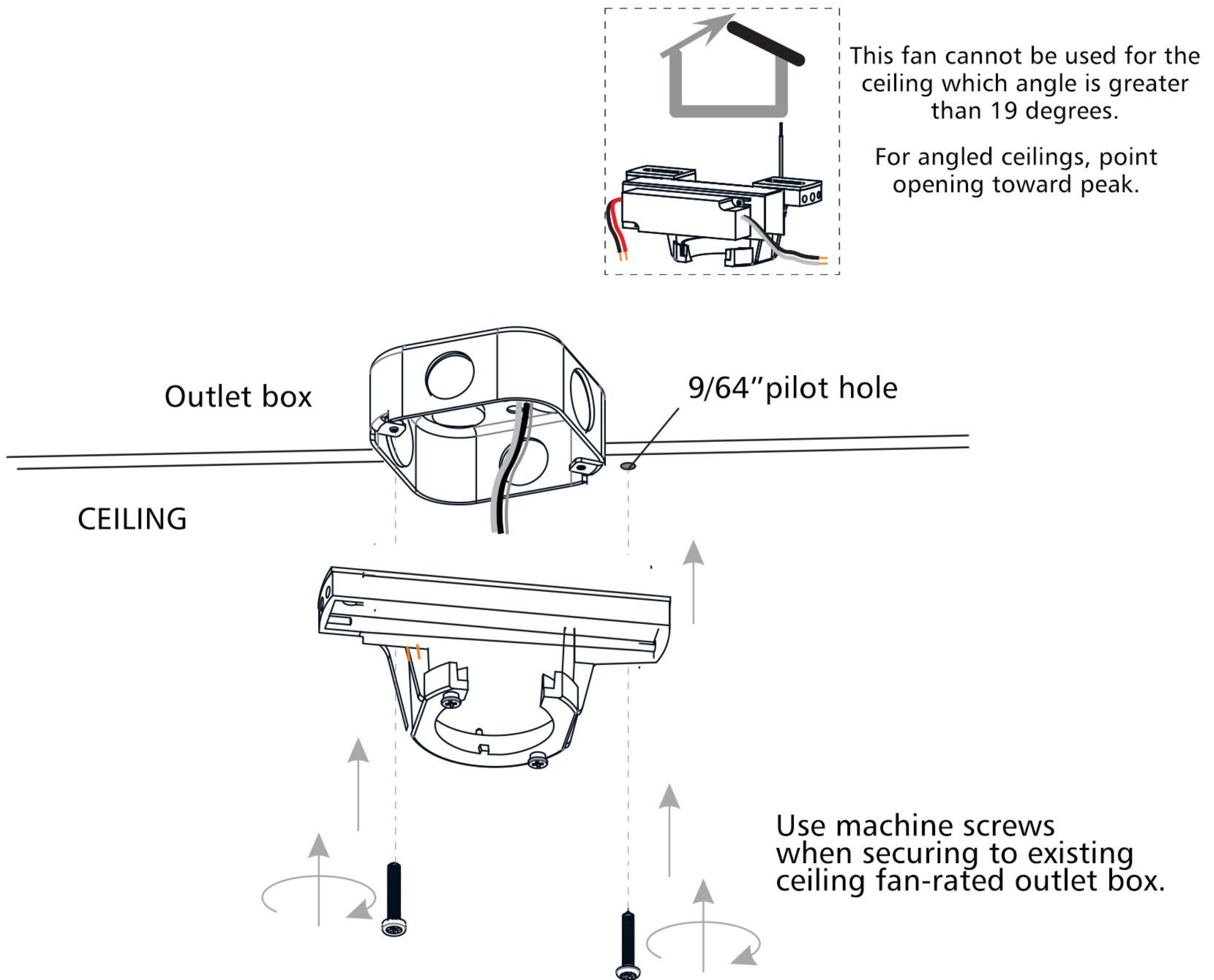
7 Install Bulbs

Install 5 correct light bulbs according to the fixture markings or labels for maximum wattage. Before installing the bulb, rotate the lamp base 45 degrees to facilitate the installation of the bulb. If you need to change the angle, please disconnect the power supply first.



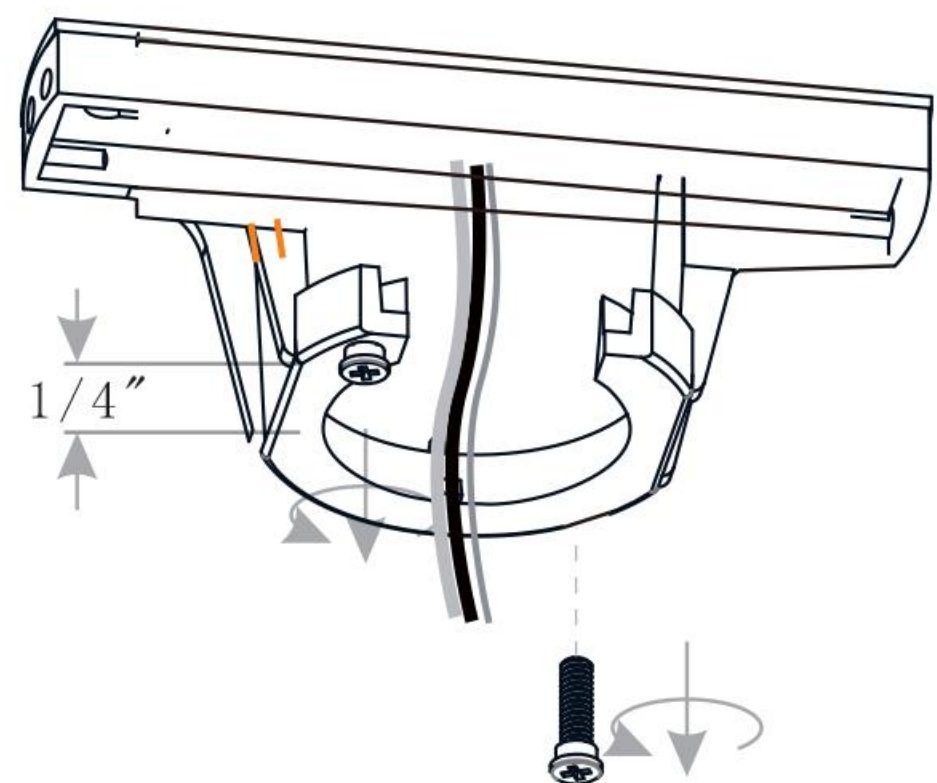

### 8 Install Hanger Frame

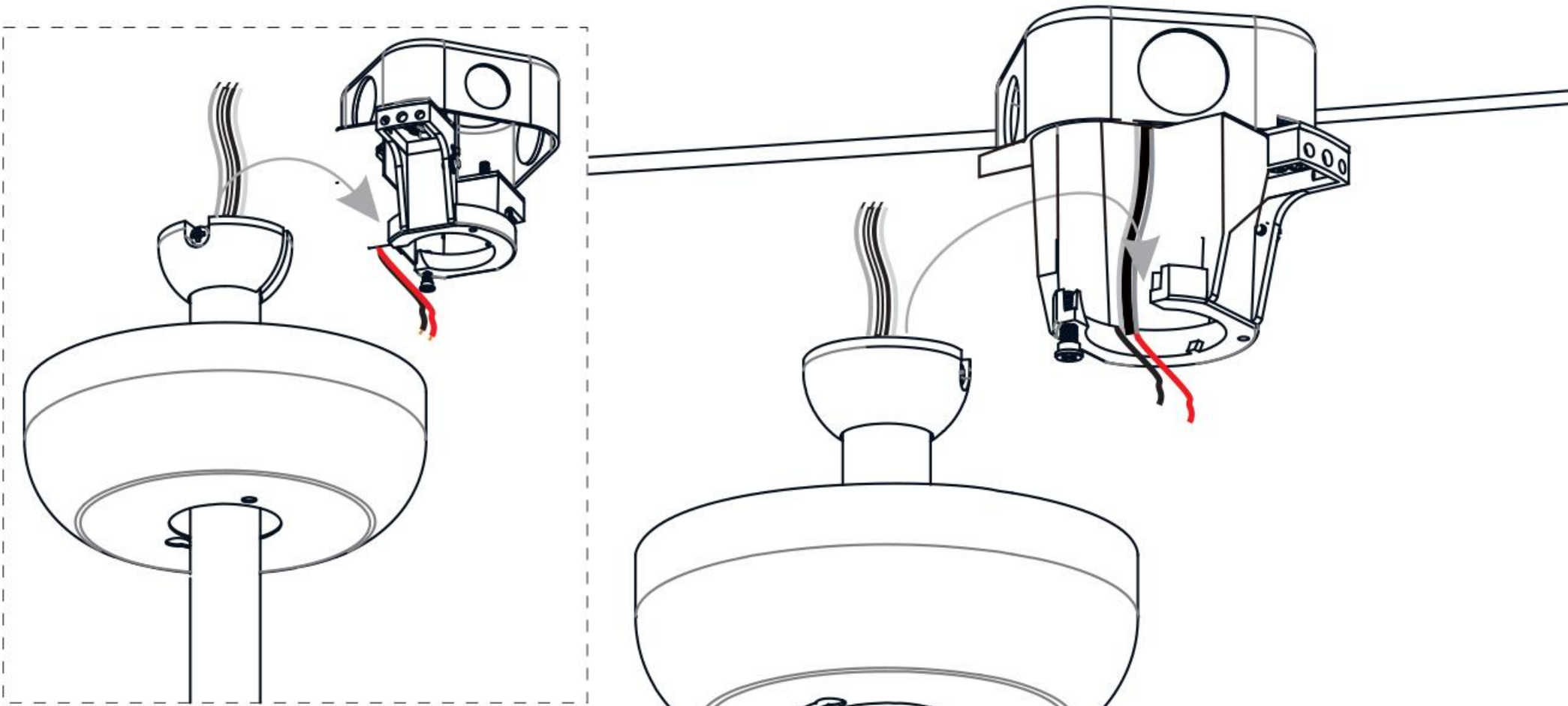


### 9 Loosen Shoulder Screws

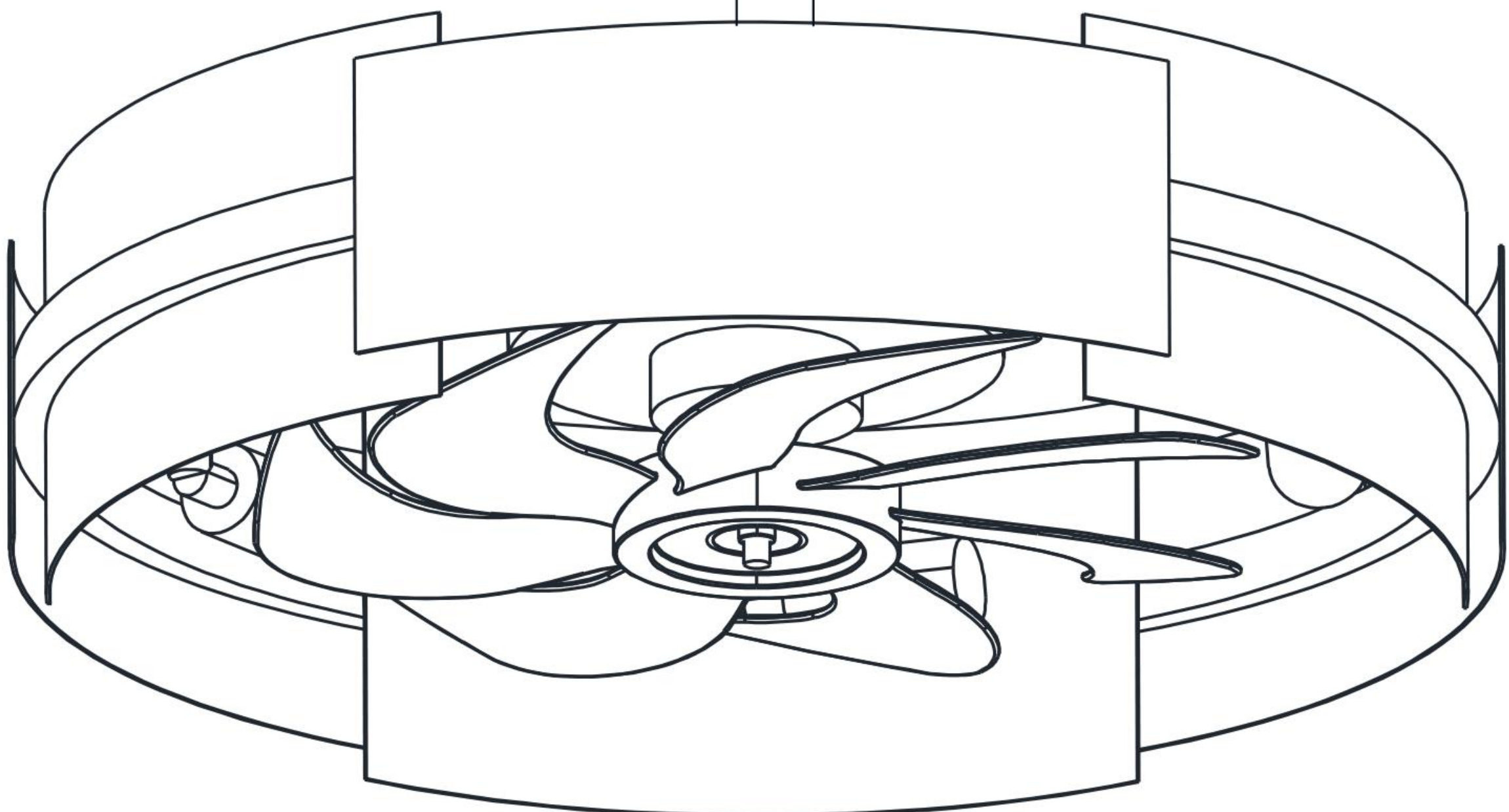
Remove one shoulder screw from hanger frame. Loosen the other shoulder screw approximate 1/4" and retain it on the hanger frame.



## 10 Install Rod to Hanger Frame

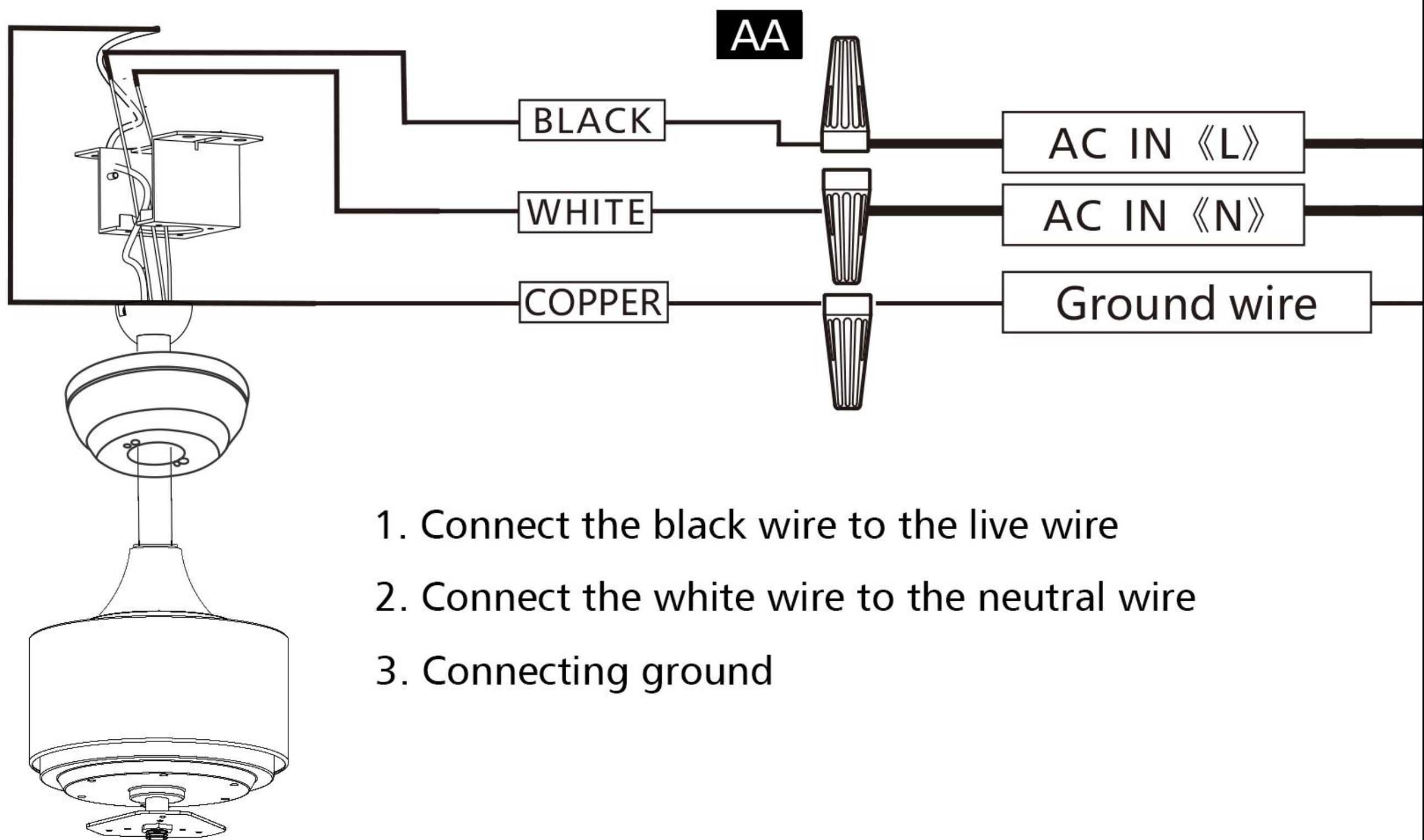


Pick the fan up by the down rod only.  
Place the downrod hanger ball into the slot in the hanger frame.



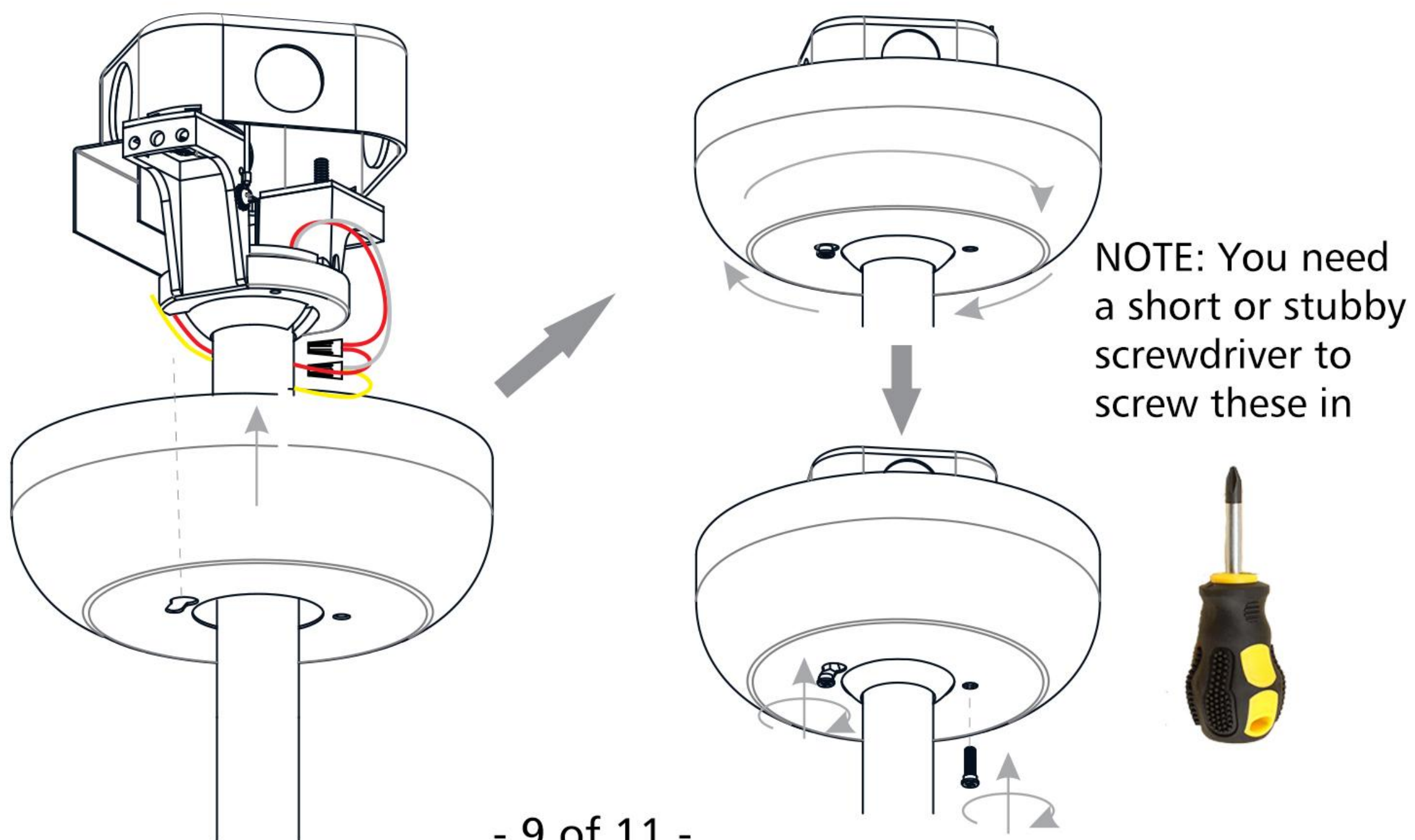

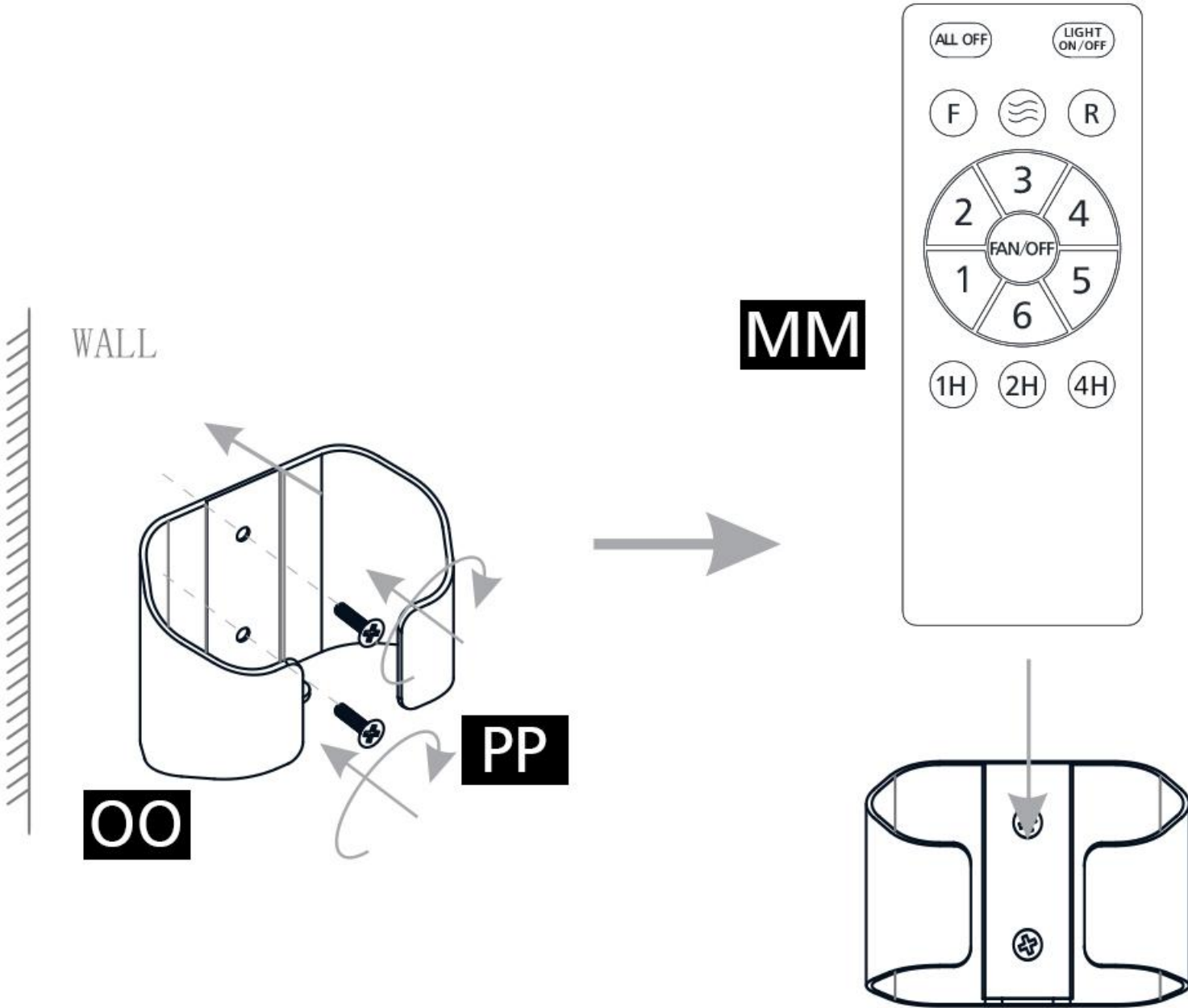


### 12 Install Ceiling Canopy

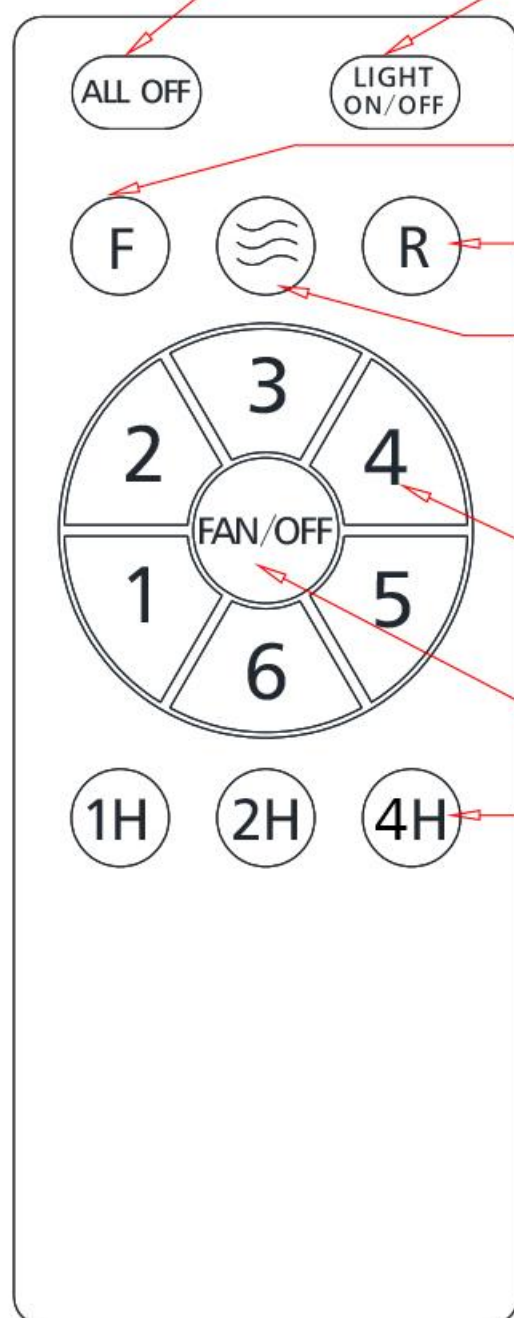
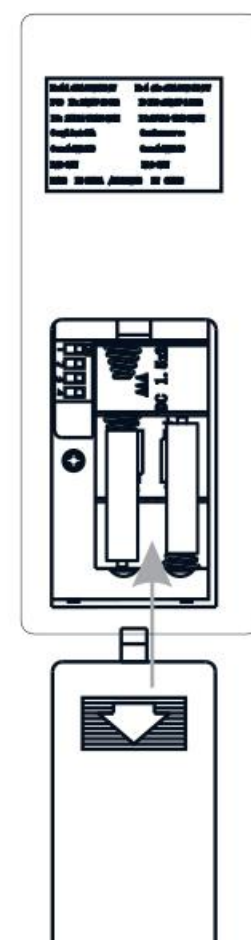
Installing the battery

Free selection of wind speed

Fan stop and remote pairing

**Remote Control Pairing Instructions:**

(If the remote is not working, please refer to this method)

1. Turn on the wall switch (if it's already on, please turn it off first, then back on).

2. Press and hold the FAN OFF button for 5 seconds to pair the fan light with the remote control.

3. After pairing, press several random buttons on the remote to test whether the fan light responds correctly.

Note: There will be no indication when pairing is successful.
