

Read before assembling and using

- Failure to follow these warnings and the assembly instructions could result in serious injury or death.
- Keep instruction manual for future use.
- Proper assembly of this item requires 2 people.
- Do not throw away packaging material until assembly is complete.
- To prevent suffocation keep plastic bags away from children.
- This product has many moving parts, serious injury can occur if not used properly. Keep hands, fingers and body parts away from the mechanism. To reduce the risk of head entrapment and other injuries, keep children and pets away from openings and moving parts in and around the recliner chair.
- Check this product for damaged hardware, loose joints, missing parts or sharp edges before and after assembly and requently during use. DO NOT use this product if any parts are missing, damaged or broken. Contact your retailer for replacement parts and instructional literature if needed. DO NOT substitute parts.
- Indoor dry location use only.
- DO NOT operate the unit until the back is installed and locked.
- Maximum Weight Capacity:300 pounds (136kgs)

Important Safety Instructions

WARNING

-To reduce the risk of electric shock, serious injury or death:

- We do not recommend the use of throws or additional loose covers on or near the moving mechanisms.
- Plug the power lead directly into an wall electric socket. Do not use an extension cord, adapter or surge protector.
- To avoid over heating do not cover the transformer.
- Disconnect the electrical plug from outlet before cleaning, moving, servicing or when not in use for an extended period of time.
- Do not use this product if it is wet, in water, around water or any liquid. Do not handle the plug or remote control with wet hands.
- Keep cord out of reach of children, and do not use where it may be a trip hazard.
- Closely supervise children and disabled persons using this product.
- Check the condition of the power supplies, electrical cords, plugs, and connectors often. Keep the power supplies and electrical cords away from heat sources. Never operate the unit with a damaged power supply, electrical cord, plug, or connector.
- Do not allow electrical cord to be pinched between moving parts or between the frame and the floor. Do not place cord under carpet or in a location where it could become worn.
- Do not attempt to disconnect the power plug by pulling the power cord. Always hold the power plug and pull it out.
- Never operate the unit except when it is on its base in the upright position.
- Always keep open flame and lit cigarettes away from upholstered furniture.


Sighting









-To reduce the risk of damaging the cord: **DO NOT** put the cord under the metal base

Assemble finished






Beating and Aligning


Your recliner chair just went on a long trip. During storage and transport, some upholstered parts may have been pushed in and stitching lines may have been moved.


Take a couple of minutes to straighten and beat the upholstered parts. If you followed all steps correctly, your chair is now perfectly set up.

Connect the power adapter with a wall outlet








Green LED light indicates that the power is on

Note: If your chair is not functioning after following these steps, please check the cord underneath the chair is fully plugged into the chair motor.


Comfort Functions



Power Recliner Instruction

From Chair to Recliner

When sitting on the chair, simply press the button located at the outside right armrest, the chair will be made to recliner.




Note:

Before first use, the chair should be tested to ensure that all functions are working correctly.

Power Recliner Instruction

From Recliner to Chair

Simply press the button, this moves your chair's footrest back under the seat and your chair is returned to the upright position.




CAUTION

Before closing, make sure that there are no persons, pets or extremities in the way. Do not allow children to play on this chair or operate the mechanism.


Always leave in an upright and closed position.

2.Pull up the back cover














Take care when adjusting positions to avoid trapping or pinching of body parts.

DO NOT stand/sit on the edge of the seat, armrests, open footrest or on the backrest as this could make the recliner tip over.





To reduce the risk of head entrapment and other injuries, keep children and pets away from openings and moving parts in and around recliner. **DO NOT** leave children unattended on or beside the recliner.



Note:

Do not expose your chair to direct sunlight. Keep an adequate distance to radiators. Extensive heat may also damage the chair.

ONE YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY

We will replace any missing parts at the time of purchase or any defective item within a one year period from the date of original purchase. Please keep your receipt so that we may process your warranty request.

PLEASE DECLARE SUCH DAMAGES IMMEDIATELY AFTER DELIVERY.

This warranty only covers new units with original packaging and ownership, and is not transferable. It does not cover any used, secondhand or demo models. The specific legal rights of this warranty may vary from state to state. Some states do not allow any exclusion or limitation of incidental damages. Some states do not allow limitation on how long an implied warranty lasts.

Please bear in mind that warranty claims are excluded in the following cases:

- Damages caused by improper installation and assembly
- Damages caused by sharp or pointy objects or pets
- Staining caused by deficient maintenance

- Damages caused by heat exposure (hot objects and liquids)
- Damages caused by improper cleaning or use of wrong maintenance products

- Willful damage

Leather Care

Clean your chair regularly using a soft, damp cloth to make sure that dust cannot get into the pores. To dampen the cloth, please only use clear warm water. For thorough cleaning, please use professional leather maintenance products once a year. Let the leather set dry completely after maintenance. Avoid direct sunlight and do not use a blow-dryer for this.

Apply a suitable leather protectant.
