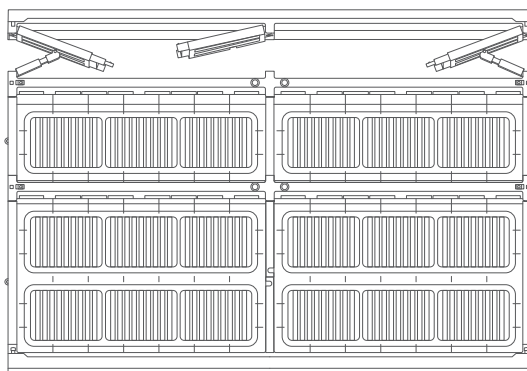
# Assembly Steps

## Step 1

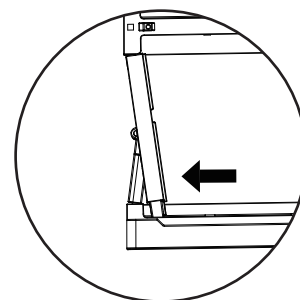
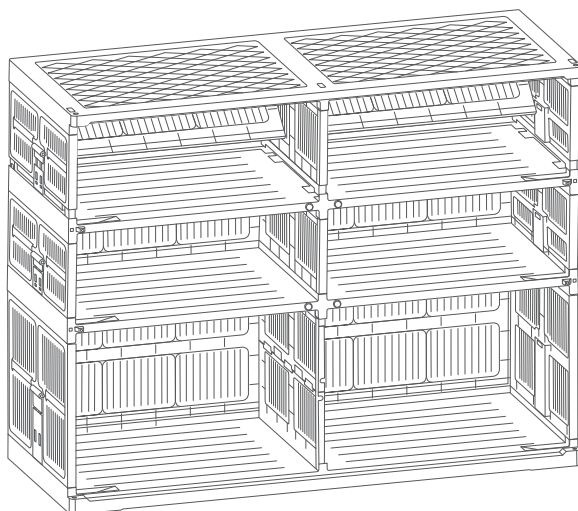
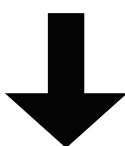
Take out the shoe box, lay it down and stretch the frame of the shoe box.

Lay it down

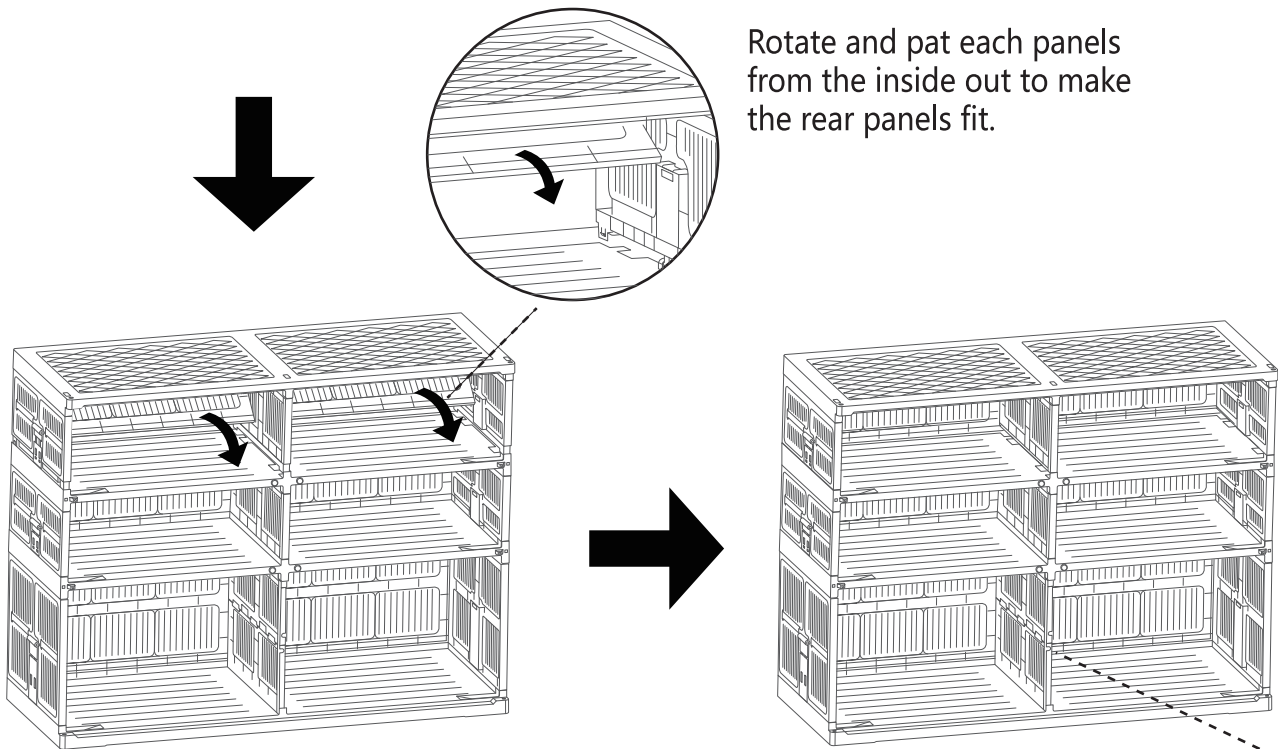
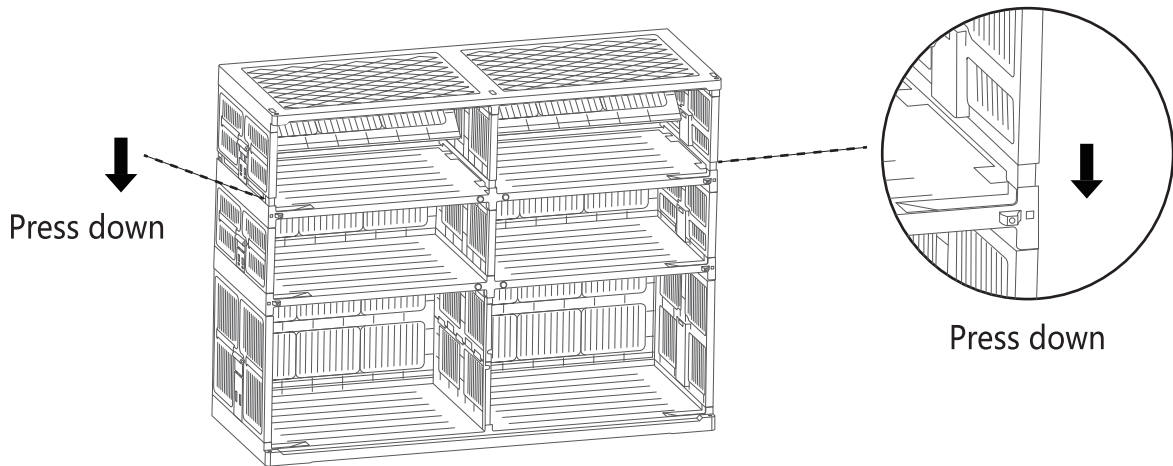


Press each side panels and snap them into slots.

# Assembly Steps

## Step 2

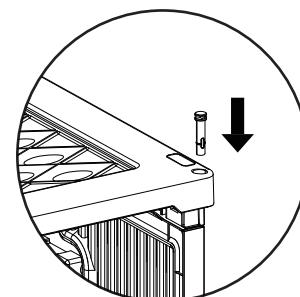
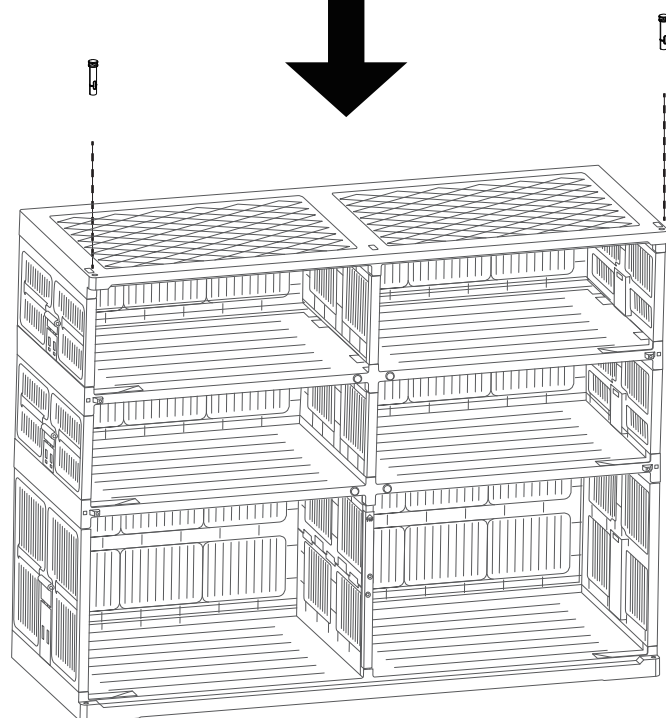
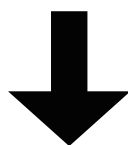
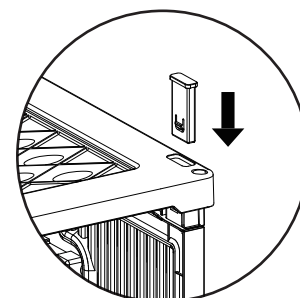
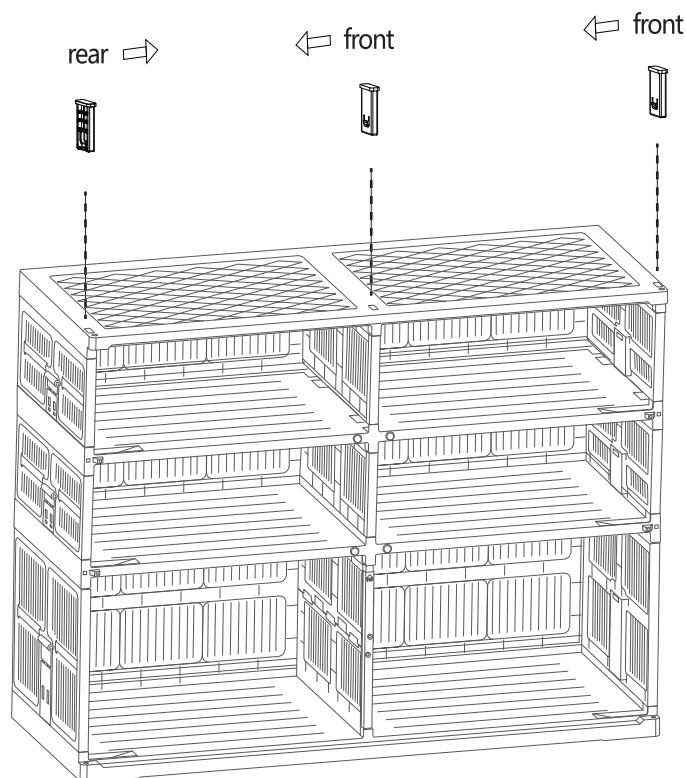
Set the shoe box upright, press the side panels down to make them snap into the frame grooves, rotate the rear boards and press them to make them mesh with the bottom boards.

## Step 3

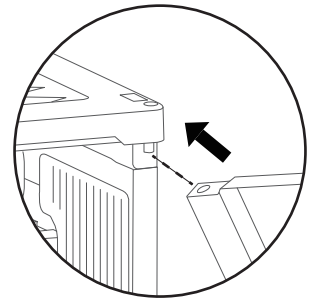
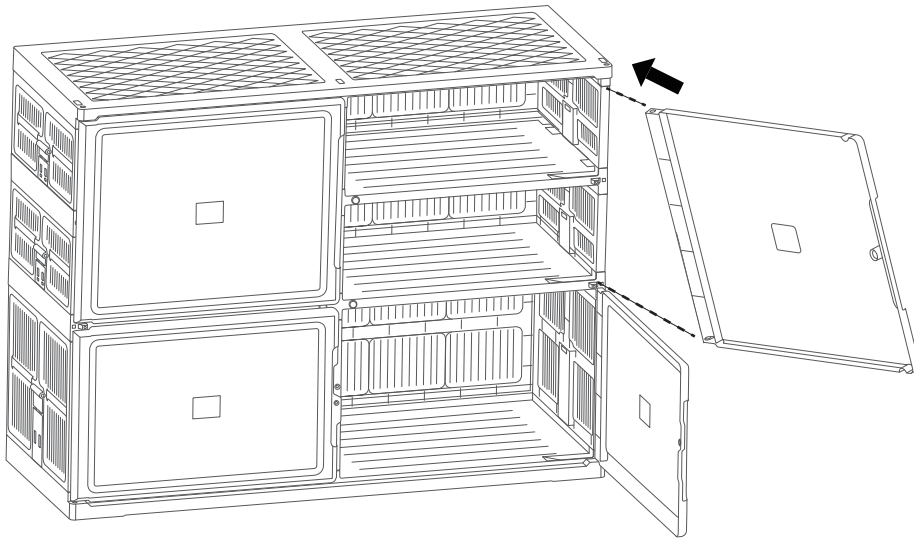
Insert 3 plugs into the top holes to keep the shoe box from shaking.

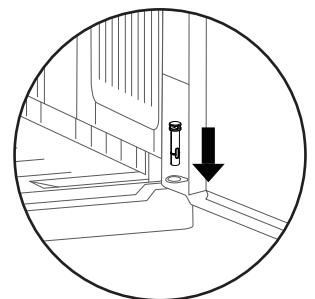
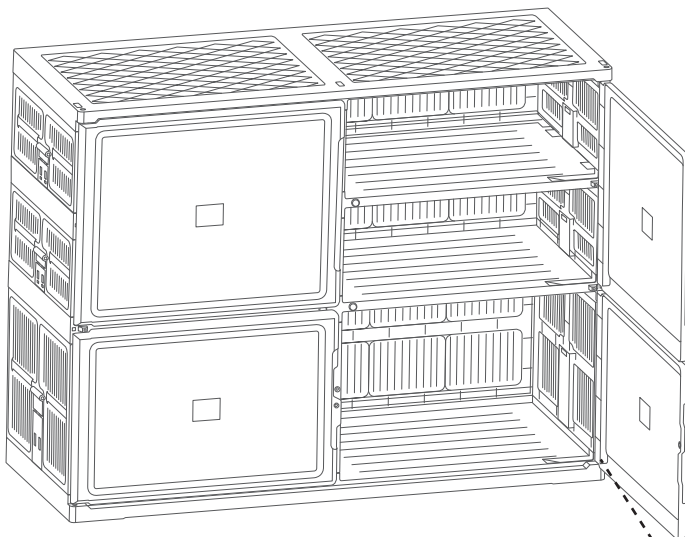
## Step 4

Connect the door panels to the cabinet body, insert bolts to fix door panels.



Tilt the door panels and make them fit into the bolts on the cabinet as shown.

**Note:** Slot into at a 45 angle



Insert the shoe box bolts

**Note:** Door panels are parallel to the cabinet body after installation, please align the door panels horizontally with the cabinet.
