

Dear Customer,

End user health, welfare and satisfaction is our top priority. Our nursery products comply with all relevant legal and regulatory requirements.

For ALL of our products

PVC: We use a specially formulated nursery grade PVC, free of the group of what are considered harmful phthalates.

Foam: The foam we use (VitaFoam FE24-130) is a specific nursery grade foam, free of TCPP (liquid phosphate fire retardants) and many other suspect chemicals found in standard furniture foam.

GPSD: (General Safety Product Directive); details following.

REACH: (Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals); details following.

Printed PVC Goods

There are no formal construction standards nor special fire requirements for nursery PVC goods not designed to be slept on (e.g. changing mats, splash mats).

All PVC goods are tested to, and satisfy BS EN 71-3.

To be noted that Wedge changing mats which are designed for, and supplied with elevated changing towers are subject to regulation and require specific testing. Any products certified to this standard would be clearly marked as such, items not marked as such do not comply.

Chemical Composition (REACH)

It is important to note that from 1 January 2021 EU REACH and UK REACH are separate chemical regulatory regimes.

Melamine was added to the European REACH (EC/1907/2006) Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) (January 2023). It has so far NOT been added to the UK REACH Candidate List (available from the HSE website).

Polyurethane Foam, including FE24-130 used in our products contains Melamine at a %w/w higher than the 0.1% limit and so under Article 33.1 of EU REACH, companies selling into the EU have certain

obligations for communication, notification and the provision of information for the safe use and disposal of relevant items.

All PVC goods; components and products, with the exclusion noted above satisfy the requirements of UK and EU REACH requirements.

GPSD

All of our products are designed with the end user safety as a primary concern. We remain vigilant to information contained in relevant standards, codes of practice and the literature of authoritative bodies in order to satisfy our requirements under the GPSD (General Safety Product Directive).
