
STEP 1: LAY OUT MATERIALS



STEP 2: ASSEMBLE FENCE FRAME


STEP 2.1)

▶ Identify the Top Rail (F), and Bottom Rail (E) as shown below. Pressure fit (1) loose Rail End Cap (G) into the end of each rail.




STEP 2.2)

- **1.** Orient (2) Posts **(C)** with the post tabs facing down.
- 2. Slide (1) top rail down over the posts until the pre-drilled holes in the posts and top rail align.
- **3.** Drive (4) ¾" Stainless Steel Screws (H) into the pre-drilled holes in the top rail.




STEP 2.3

Slide bottom rail over the posts and align the predrilled holes in the posts with the pre-drilled holes in the bottom rail.




STEP 2.4)

- **1.** Slide the bottom rail, with picket holes facing towards the top rail, over the posts until the pre-drilled holes align.
- **2.** Slide the Post Anchors (I) up the posts until the pre-drilled holes in the anchors align with the pre-drilled holes on the bottom of the posts.
- **3.** Drive (2) ³/₄" stainless steel screws into the pre-drilled holes in the bottom of the posts.
- **4.** Drill holes in the post anchor through the (4) pre-drilled holes in the bottom rail using the $\frac{1}{8}$ " Drill Bit (J).
- **5.** Drive (4) ³/₄" stainless steel screws into the pre-drilled holes in the bottom rail.




STEP 3: INSERT FENCE PICKETS



STEP 4: ASSEMBLE SECOND FENCE PANEL

STEP 4.1

▶ Repeat steps 2-3 to assemble the second fence panel.



STEP 5: INSTALL FENCE INTO GROUND

STEP 5.1


- **1.** Move the fence to its final location and mark the locations of the posts.
- 2. Attempt to push the fence into the ground.






STEP 5.2

- ▶ Steps 5.2 5.3 only to be completed if ground is too hard for Step 5.1
- **1.** Loosen the top 6" or 7" of the ground with a claw hammer as illustrated.
- 2. Add water to loosened soil.
- **3.** Use a block of wood to protect the top of post, and gently hammer the post into the ground.




STEP 5.3

▶ If the ground is too hard, you may need to dig a hole large enough to accommodate one post from each panel in the same hole, as shown below.



STEP 5.4)


Level the screen, backfill excavated dirt, and tamp as necessary.



STEP 6: CONNECT THE FENCE PANELS

STEP 6.1

- **1.** Straight Line Application: Fasten screens together with Joiner Clips **(B)** using (4) ³/₄" stainless steel screws as illustrated.
- **1.** Corner Application: Fasten screens together with Joiner Clips **(B)** using (4) $\frac{3}{4}$ " stainless steel screws as illustrated.



STEP 7: INSTALL POST CAPS

STEP 7.1)

Push the Post Caps (A) down over the posts to lock into place.
