
Assembly Instructions



ASSEMBLY RATING

The Assembly Rating is a 5-point system that shows the degree of effort needed in assembling a specific product (with 1 being easy and 5 being difficult). For some products, two persons are recommended.






BASIC ASSEMBLY TECHNIQUES




When lock or spring washer is used in an assembly, please make sure the lock or spring washer is placed between the larger flat washer and the head of the screw or bolt.




Position each part correctly and insert screws or bolts into their respective holes by hand tighten or using the proper hand tool. Only tighten when step is completed or when instructed to do so.




Use cardboard or carpet area when assembling furniture to prevent scratches. Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.



Some furniture comes with height adjustment knobs underneath each leg. To lower or to raise each leg, you need to turn clockwise or counterclockwise, respectively.



Make sure all parts are properly aligned, then use the appropriate hand tool to completely tighten the bolts or screws. Do not use power tools and do not overtighten.




Save the instructions and store the Allen wrench or any supplied tool for later maintenance. After two weeks, check and tighten any loose hardware and repeat again every six months thereafter.





#2 x 1 pc Base



#B x 8 pcs Bolt 5/16"x2"



#3 x 4 pcs Leg




#C x 1 pc Allen Wrench




#D x 16 pcs Lock Washer




#E x 16 pcs Flat Washer



Due to the size and/or weight of this product, it is highly recommended that the assembly should be done near the area of its intended location. Make sure you have enough space to move around during the assembly. ALWAYS have at least two people to help with transporting and assembling the product to avoid any potential injury and/or damage.

- I. Align the last leg (#3) with the predrilled holes on the bottom of the table top (#1) and the base (#2).
- II. Prepare 2 bolt assemblies by inserting FIRST the lock washer (#D) onto the bolt (#B) and then the flat washer (#E) onto the SAME bolt (#B), in that order.
- III. Insert the bolt assemblies through the pre-drilled holes on the bottom of the table top (#1) and secure those bolts using the Allen wrench (#C) to lock them in with the leg (#3).
- IV. Prepare 2 bolt assemblies by inserting FIRST the lock washer (#D) onto the bolt (#A) and then the flat washer (#E) onto the SAME bolt (#A), in that order.
 - Insert the bolt assemblies through the pre-drilled holes from the inside of the base (#2) and secure those bolts using the Allen wrench (#C) to lock them in with the leg (#3).



With the help of another person, carefully turn the completed table upright. Make sure the table is rested on a flat surface and it does not feel loose or wobbly. If it does, double check that the bolts are secured and properly tighten.
