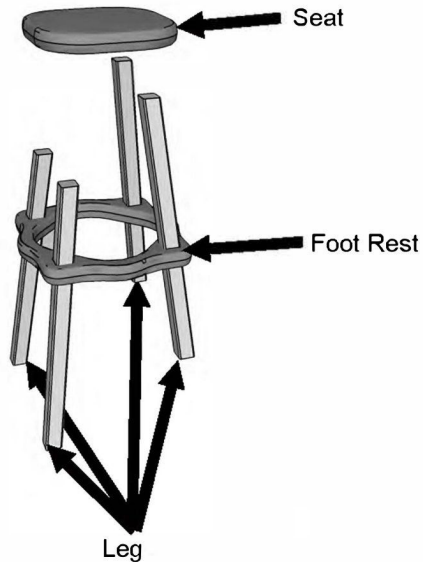

Labeled Diagram



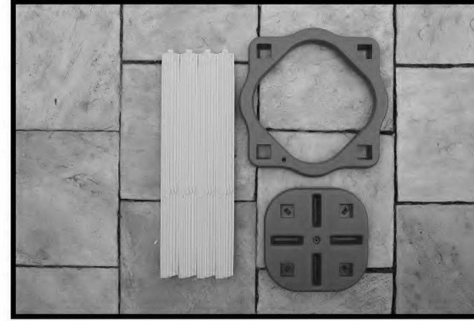

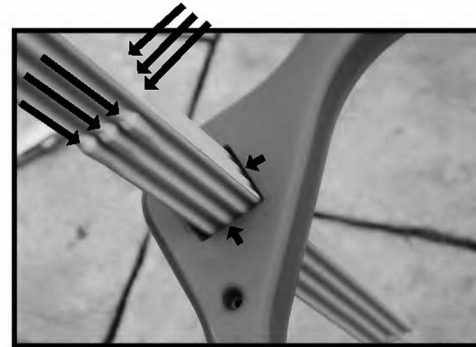

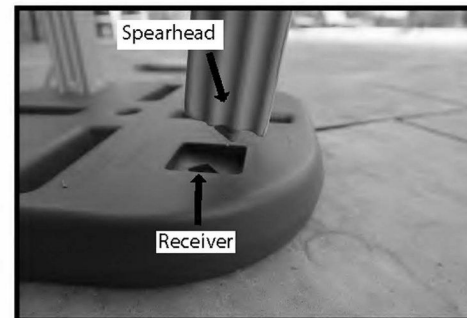
ASSEMBLY:



1. Using a utility knife, carefully separate the barstool legs. **WARNING** - Never cut towards yourself!



2. Place the barstool leg through the bottom of the foot rest such that the arrows molded into the bottom of the foot rest are pointing at the locking nubs on the barstool leg. Tap the footrest down until the arrows on the footrest meet the locking nubs on the leg. Repeat this step for all 4 barstool legs.



3. Place the seat upside down on the installation surface. Line the spearheads on the barstool legs with the receivers on the barstool seat. Hit the bottom of the barstool legs with the rubber mallet, engaging the legs into the seat. Refer to the image to the right most image to see the proper hole and lug location.
