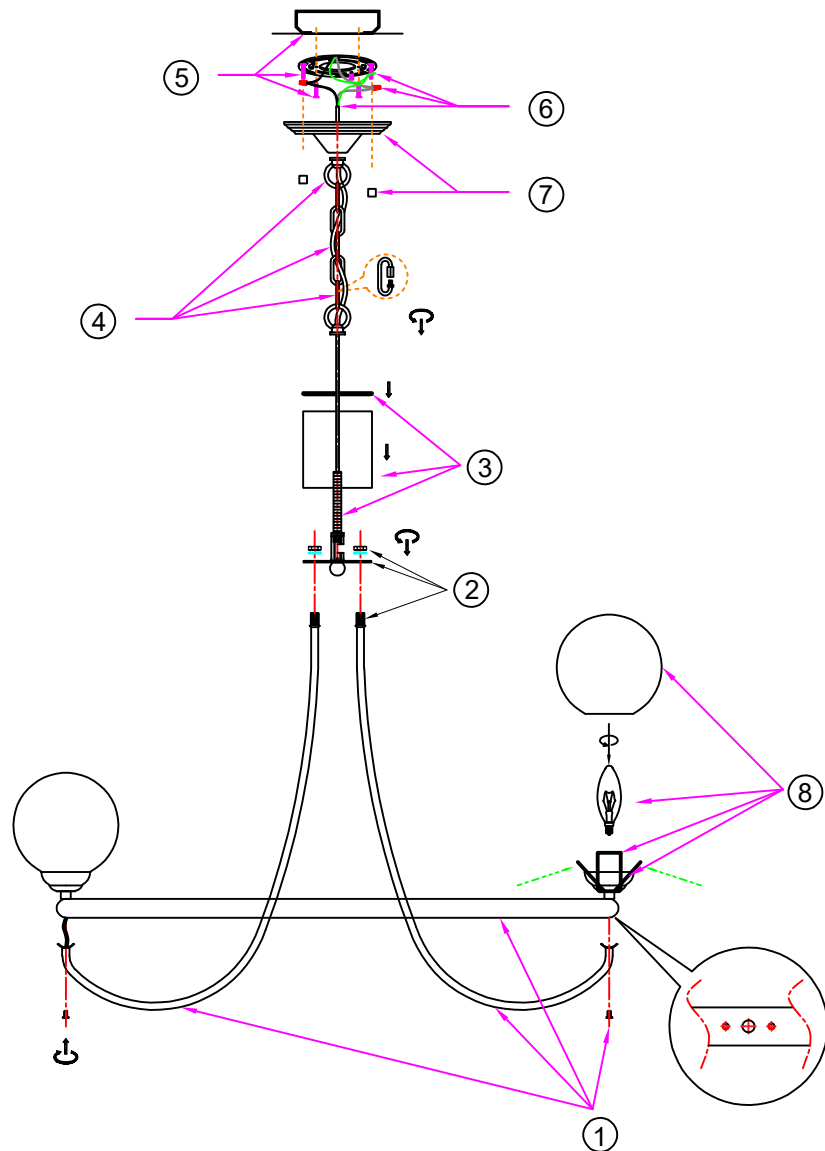


ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.



Before You Begin:

- Ensure power is turned off at the circuit breaker before installation.
- Read all instructions carefully.
- Installation should be performed by a qualified electrician if you are unfamiliar with wiring.

Step-by-Step Installation:

1. Align the bent arms with the holes on the fixture body ring as shown in the diagram, and secure them with screws. Note: For the arm containing the main wire, ensure the wires are pulled back and kept clear before installation.
2. Insert the bent arms through the holes in the metal plate and secure them with nuts. Adjust the orientation of the arms as needed.
3. Slide the round cap down over the threaded pipe and secure it in place with the hanging ring.
4. Adjust the chain to the desired length. Connect the ends of the chain to the hanging ring on the fixture and ceiling canopy using the quick links. Feed the main wires through the chain and the ceiling canopy.
5. Secure the mounting bracket to the junction box using the provided screws.
6. Wiring Connections
 - Use wire connectors to connect the fixture's positive wire, negative wire to the corresponding wires from the junction box. Connect the ground wires to the grounding terminal.
 - Ensure no exposed conductors remain outside wire connectors or outside the junction box.
7. Secure the ceiling canopy to the mounting bracket using the provided nuts.
8. Install the light source into the socket to test (bulb not included), then restore power to verify operation. Finally, place the shade into the retaining clip and adjust for proper alignment. Installation complete.

Safety Instructions:

To avoid fire, shock, and serious personal injury, follow all instructions carefully.

1. Do not install or use the light fixture if any part is missing or damaged.
2. To avoid possible electrical shock, be sure electricity is turned off at the main fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring.
3. Make certain no bare wires are exposed outside the wire connectors.
4. All wiring must conform to national and local electrical codes.
5. Follow the recommended instructions for the proper method of wiring your new light fixture. If you feel you do not have enough electrical wiring knowledge or experience, have your light fixture installed by a licensed electrician. Any electrical work not described in this manual should be performed by a licensed electrician.
