Helpful Hints

- Open your item in the area you plan to keep it for less heavy lifting
- Identify, sort and count the parts before attempting assembly
- Compression dowels are tapped in with a hammer
- Slides are labeled with an R (right) and L (left) for proper placement
- Make sure to always face the point on the top of the Can Lock towards the outer edge
- Use all the nails provided for the back panel and spread them out equally
- Back panel must be used to make sure your unit is sturdy
- Do NOT use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners on this item
- Never push, pull, or drag your furniture

- * Failure to follow these warnings and assembly instruction could result in serious injury or death.
- * Read all instructions before assembling crib. **KEEP INSTRUCTIONS FOR FUTURE USE.**
- * Check this product for damaged hardware, loose joints, loose bolts or other fasteners, missing parts or sharp edges before assembly and frequently during use. Securely tighten loose bolts and other fasteners. **DO NOT** use crib if any parts are missing, damaged or broken. Contact a customer service representative for replacement parts and instructional literature if needed. **DO NOT** substitute parts.
- * Infants can suffocate on soft bedding. Never add a pillow or comforter. Never place additional padding under an infant.
- * Stop using the crib when child begins to climb out or reaches the height of 35 inches (89 cm).
- * To reduce the risk of SIDS, pediatricians recommend healthy infants be placed on their backs to sleep, unless otherwise advised by your physician.
- * **DO NOT** place crib near window where cords from blinds or drapes may strangle a child.
- * Strings can cause strangulation! **DO NOT** place items with a string around a child's neck, such as hood strings or pacifier cords. **DO NOT** suspend strings over a crib or attach strings to toys.
- * To help prevent strangulation tighten all fasteners. A child can trap parts of the body or clothing on loose fasteners.
- * If refinishing, use a non-toxic finish specified for children's products.
- * When child is able to pull to standing position, set mattress to lowest position and remove bumper pads, large toys and other objects that could serve as steps for climbing out.
- * Never use plastic shipping bags or other plastic film as mattress covers because they can cause suffocation.
- * Replace teething rail if damaged or loose (if teething rail is provided for this model).
- * **CAUTION: ANY MATTRESS USED IN THIS CRIB MUST BE AT LEAST 27-1/4 IN. (69 CM) BY 51-5/8 IN. (131 CM) WITH A THICKNESS NOT EXCEEDING 6 INCHES (15CM).**
- * Infants can suffocate in gaps between crib sides and a mattress that is too small.
- * Follow warnings on all products in a crib.

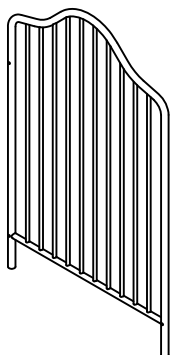

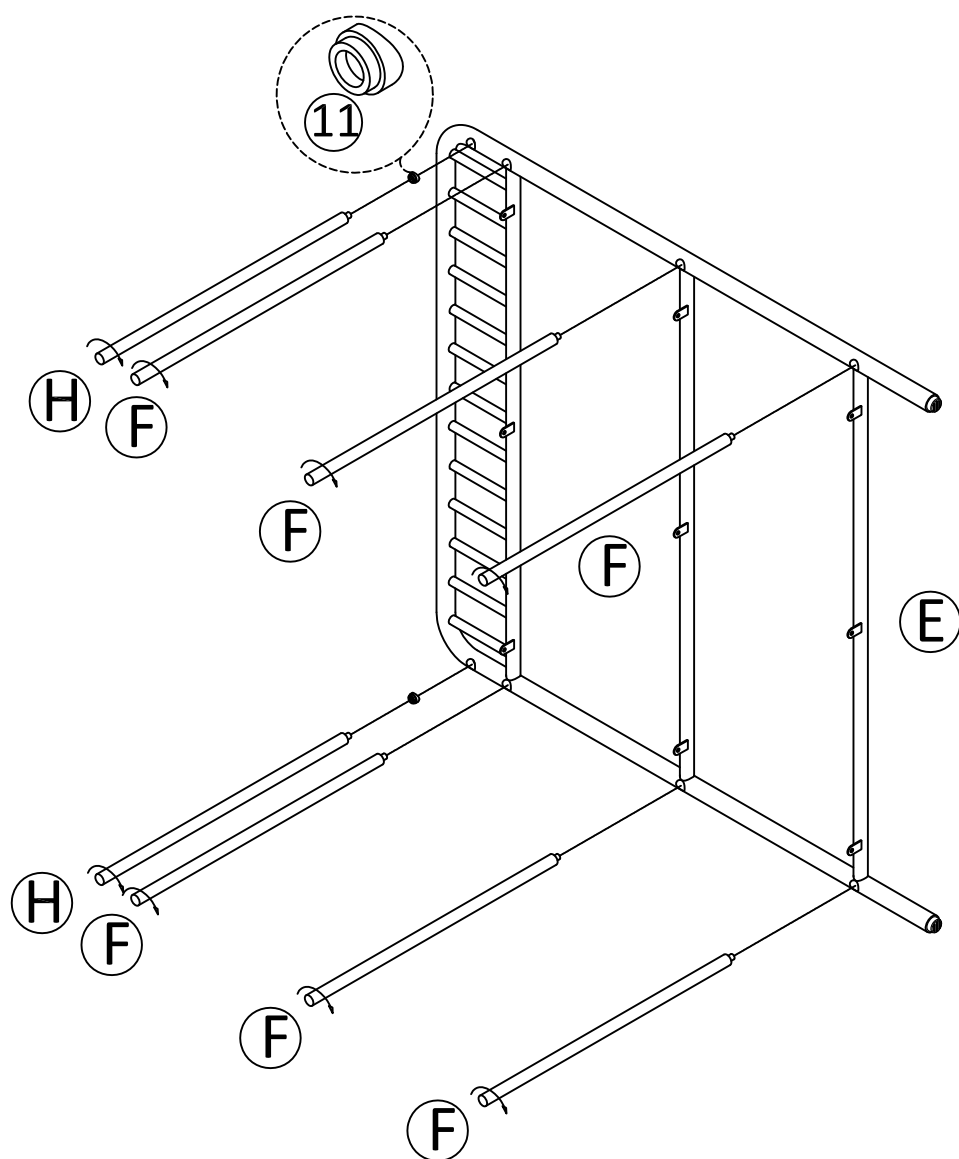
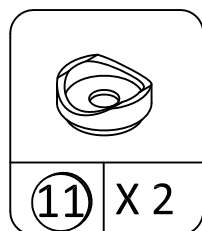
The remaining 8 Height-adjustment holes need to be fitted with bolts (H2) to prevent the baby from putting fingers in and getting injured.



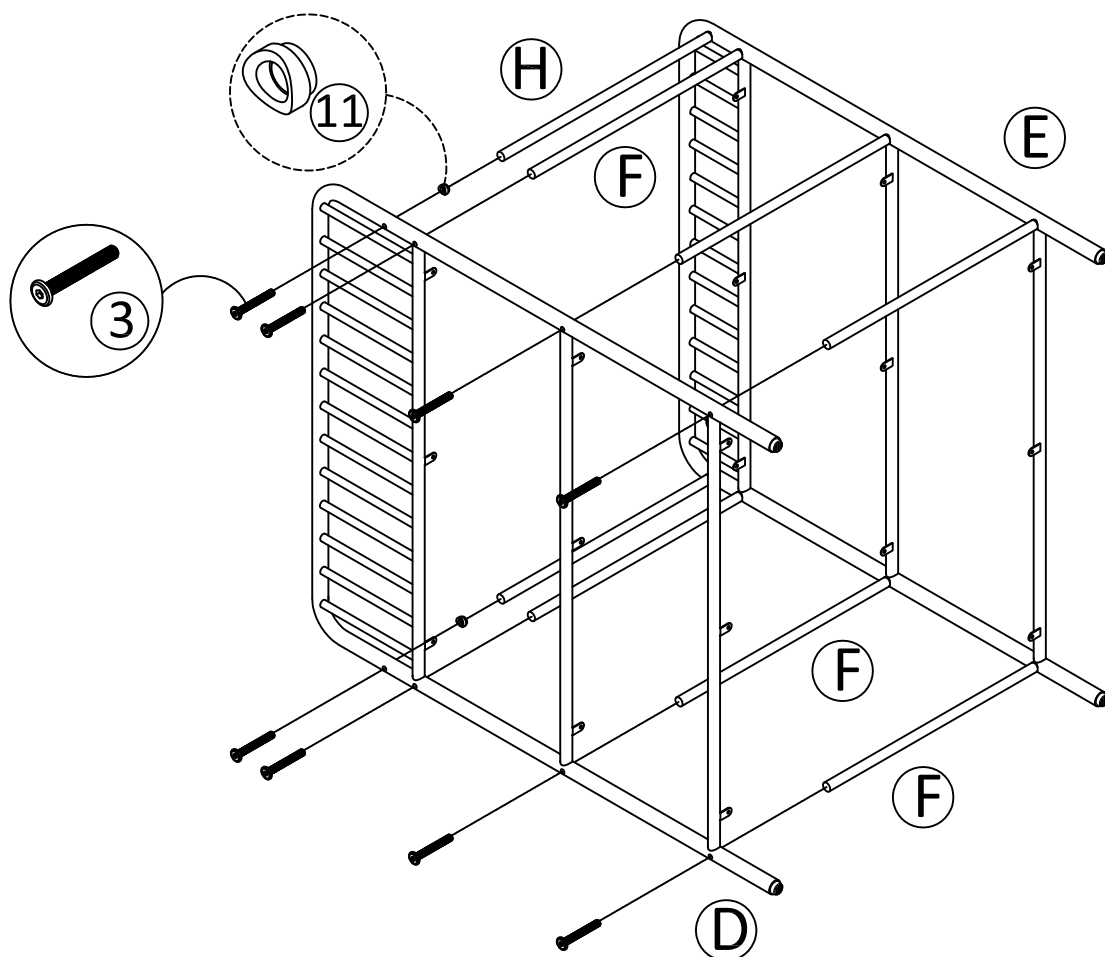
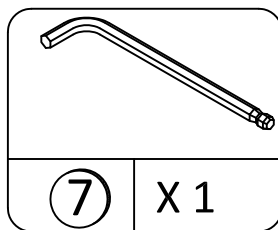
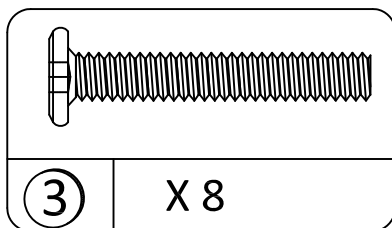

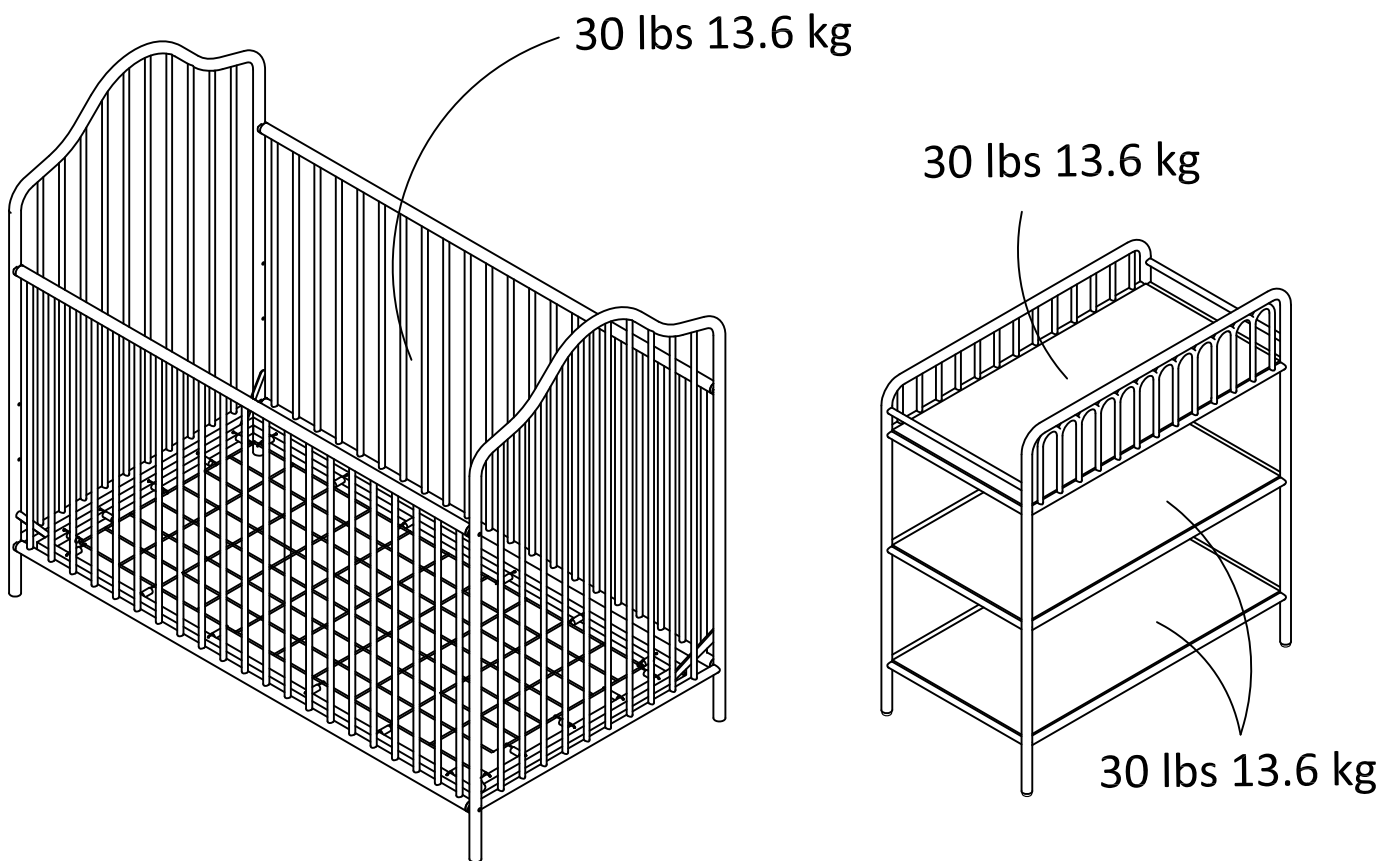


Drill a 3/16" diameter hole (5mm) in the wallboard. Tap the wall anchor(10) into the hole until it is flush. Fasten the safety strap (9) to the wall anchor (10) with the screw (8).
