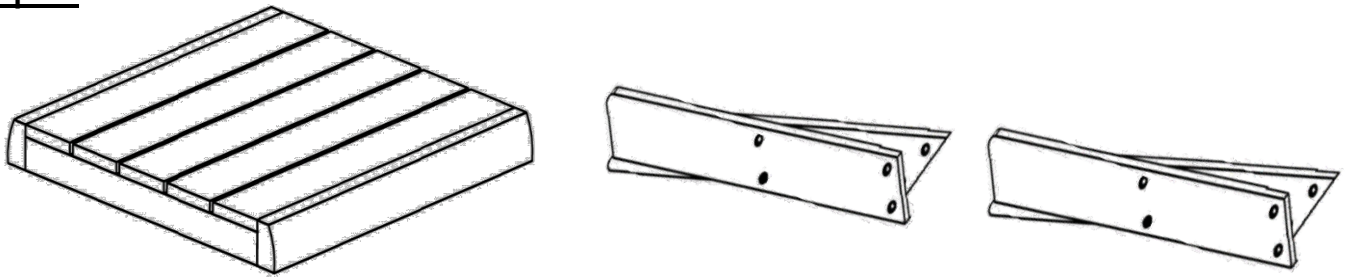
Assembly Steps

Overview



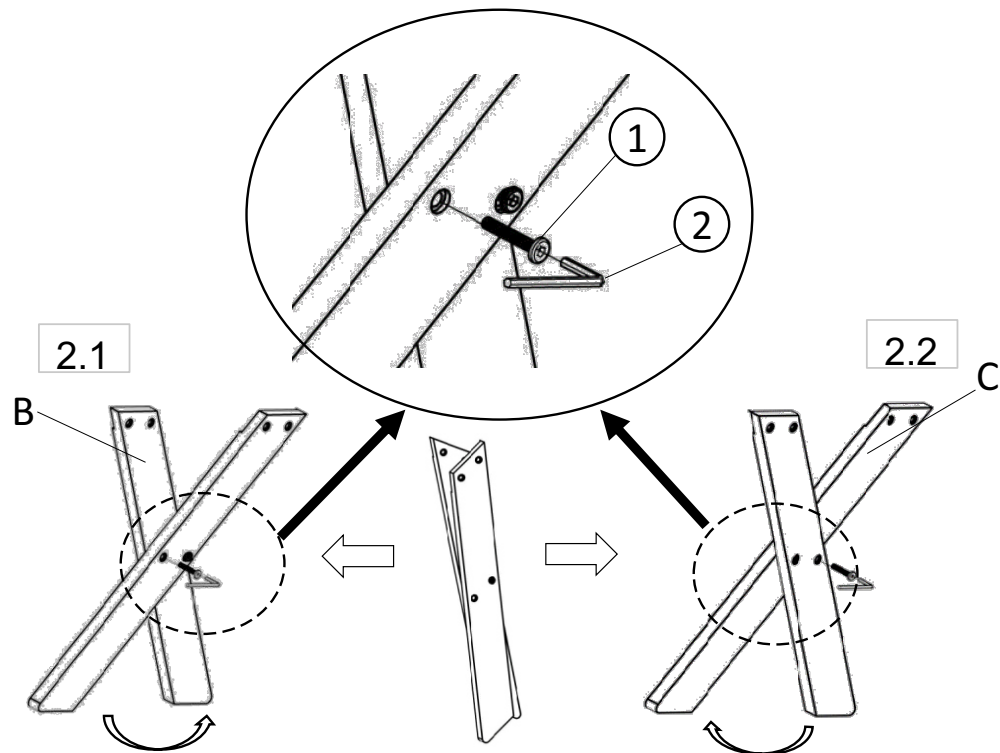

Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.

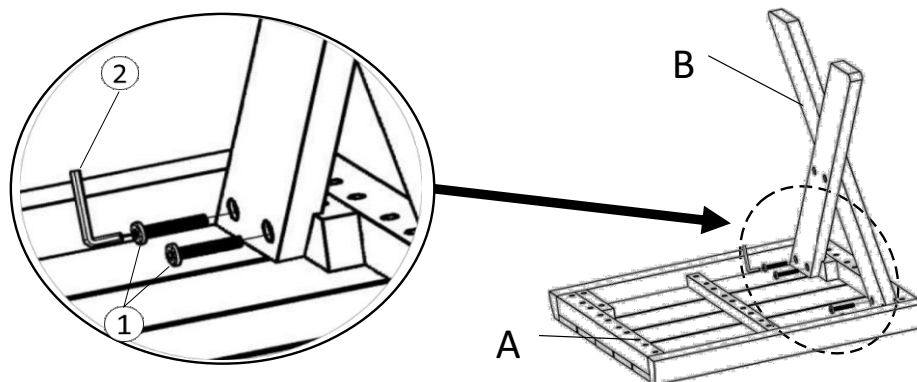
Step 2



2.1) Unfold the Right Leg(B) then secure using Bolt(①) with Allen Wrench(②) as pictured above.

2.2) Repeat the process with the Left Leg(C).

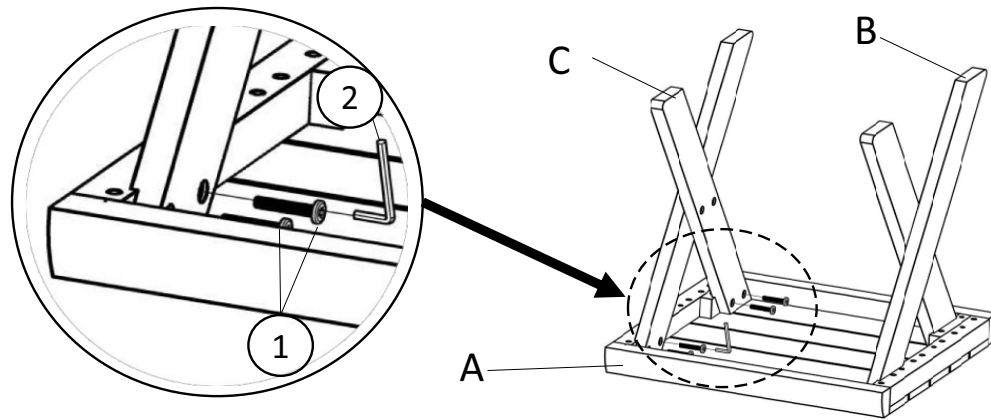
Step 3



Attach Right Leg(B) to Table Top(A) by using 2 Bolt(①) with Allen Wrench(②) as shown above.

Do not fully tighten the Bolts.

Step 4



Attach Left Leg(C) to Table Top(A) by using 2 Bolt(①) with Allen Wrench(②) as indicated.
Do not fully tighten the Bolts.

Step 5



Place the Table onto a level surface, then EXERT pressure, floorwards, onto the Table. This pressure will help the Legs and Table Top reach full alignment at all joints.

In a sequential manner, gradually tighten all Bolts until evenly secured.

Inspect the Table and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

Your Side Table is ready for use.

This Side Table can only be used on a flat, level surface.

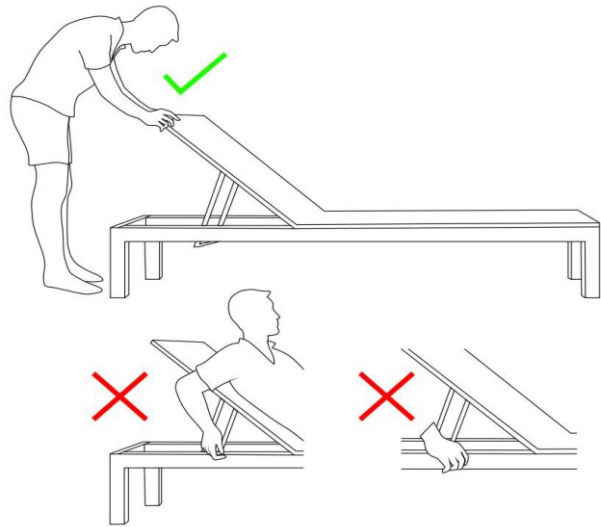
SAFETY WARNING

Never adjust chaise lounge or recliner backrest while seated.

Always make sure the backrest is flat before moving the chaise lounge.

Keep all limbs clear from under the backrest when it is in a raised position.

Serious finger, hand, or other bodily injuries may result from adjusting the chaise lounge backrest position while seated.



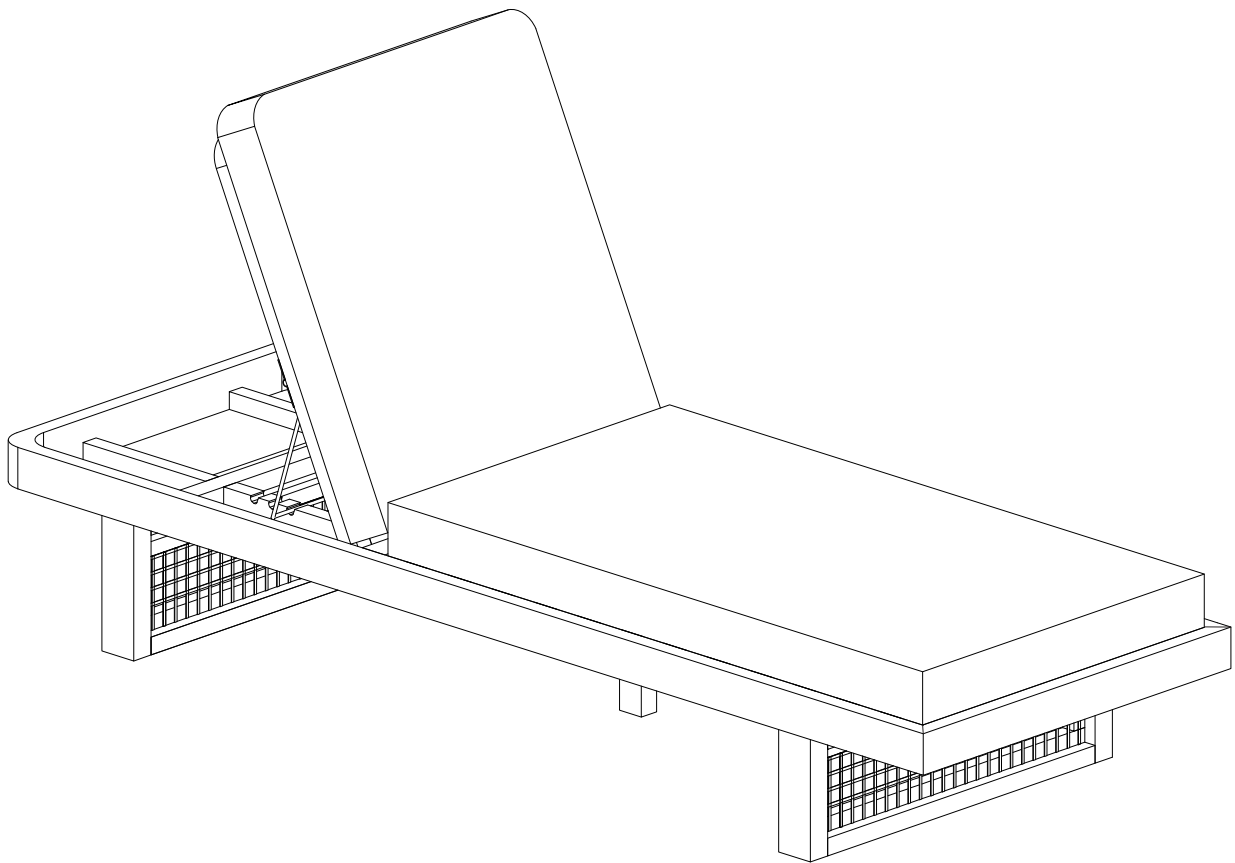

FRONT FACING

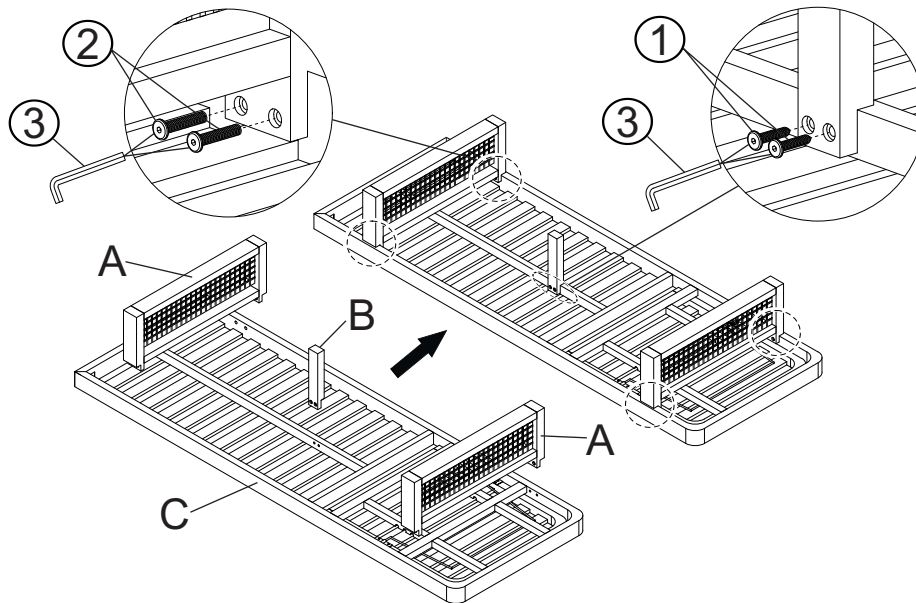
This Bed has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Bed parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



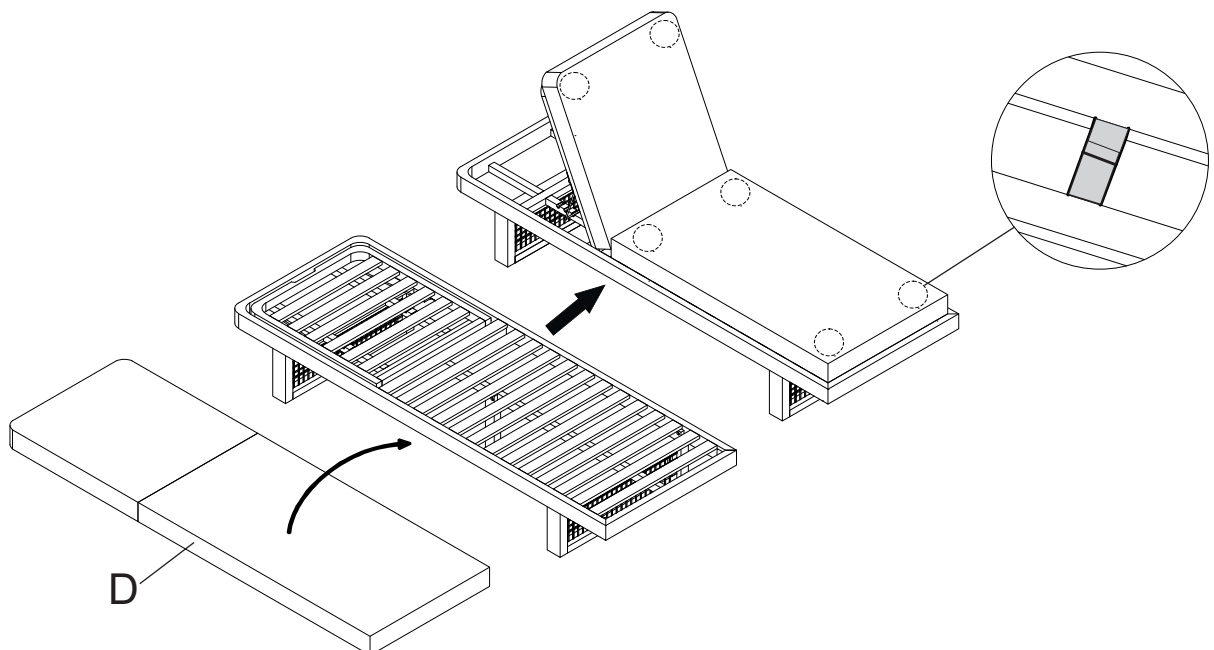
Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.

Step 2



Place the Bed Panel (C) face down onto a clean , non-marring surface.
2.Attach Leg (A) and Support Leg (B) enter Bed Panel (C) to the using Bolt (2) and Screws (1) with Allen Wrench (3).
Do not fully tighten the Bolts and Screws.

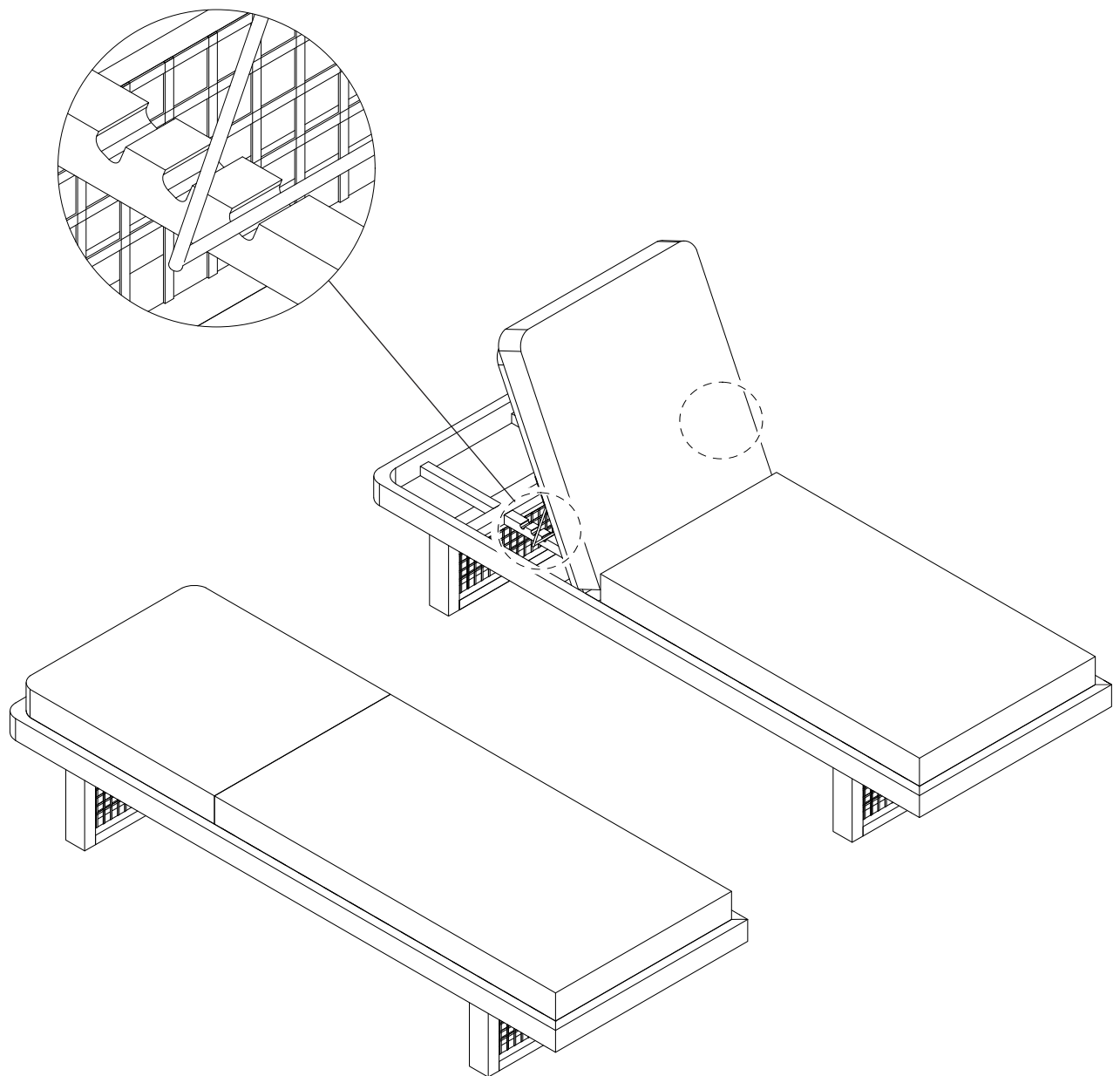
Step 3



3. Place Bed Cushion (D) onto the Bed ,and affix the magic tape straps around the Bed as shown above.

This Bed can only be used on a flat, level surface.

Step 4



With assistance from your adult partners, turn the Sunlounge right side up. EXERT pressure, floorwards, onto the Seat.

This pressure will help the Legs and seat panel reach alignment at all joints. Check for wobbles.

In a sequential manner, gradually tighten all Bolts, until evenly secured.

Inspect the Sunlounge and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

Your Sunlounge is ready for use.

This Sunlounge can only be used on a flat, level surface.

Caution: Be careful when folding Backrest to avoid the finger strapped at the folding joint.

Note: Align the Backrest of Sunlounge in position you want.
