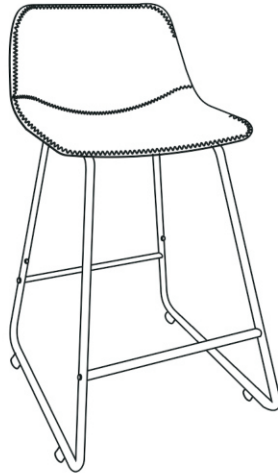


# USER'S MANUAL

### Warning

- It's kindly advised to assemble this product on a carpeted floor to protect it from being scratched.
- Small parts are included. Please keep the product away from children while assembling. Do not let children play or jump on the product. Do not stand on the item or use as a step.
- Please pay attention to the sharp corners during assembly. We recommend the use of gloves to prevent the undesired injury.
- Prior to use, please check to see if there's any loosening screw or part. Make sure that each screw and part is correctly installed and securely fastened.
- It's unnecessary to use any electric drill. Please at a low gear if you need.

### Care and Maintenance






- Use a soft, clean cloth that will not scratch the surface when dusting.
- There's no need to use furniture polish. If you need, test it first in an inconspicuous area.
- Using solvents of any kind on your furniture may damage the finish.
- Never use water to clean your furniture as it may cause damage to the finish.
- Liquid spills should be removed immediately. Gently blot the spill with a soft clean cloth to avoid rubbing.

### Further advice about the furniture care

- It is best to keep your furniture in a climate-controlled environment.
- Extreme temperatures and humidity changes can cause fading, warping, shrinking and spitting of wood.
- we recommend to keep furniture from sunlight exposure to avoid possible surface damage.
- Proper maintenance and cleaning at home will extend the life of your purchase.
- Following these important and helpful tips will help retain your furniture's performance even when it ages.
- Periodically (every 90 days) make sure the screws are fully tightened.







<b>④ ×2PCS</b> <b>Bottom Legs</b> 	<b>⑤ ×2PCS</b> <b>Foot Rests</b> 	

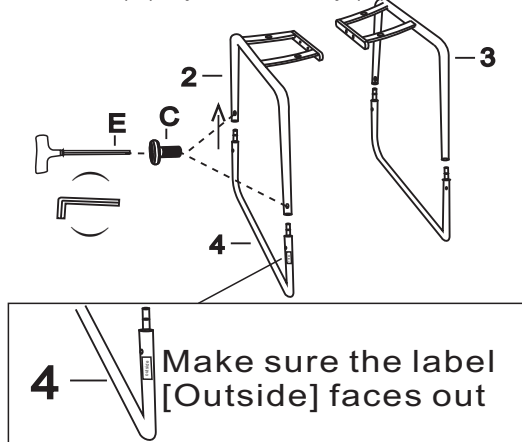
## Hardware List

Do not tighten all bolts until all the bolts haven been installed in their corresponding locations.

<b>A×4+1</b> <b>Bolts M6*18mm</b> 	<b>B×4+1</b> <b>Bolts M6*30mm</b> 	<b>C×4+1</b> <b>Bolts M6*10mm</b> 
<b>D×2+1</b> <b>Bolts M8*14mm</b> 	<b>E×1</b> <b>Allen Key</b> 	<p>This is a complete hardware package.</p> <p>We have an extra hardware package and extra Allen key for replacement.</p>

### Step1

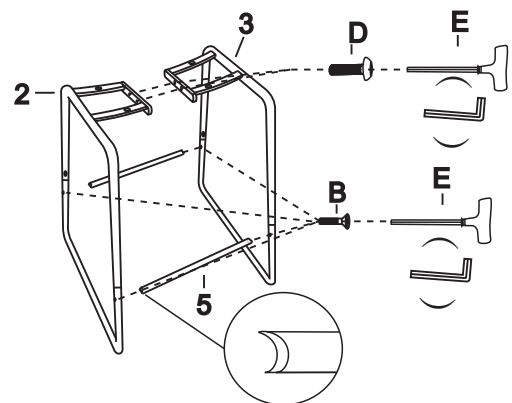
Hold the Chair legs (2/3), push in and downward sharply while aiming at the base Bottom Legs (4). Then fix them with four Bolts (C) by an Allen Key (E).



### Step2

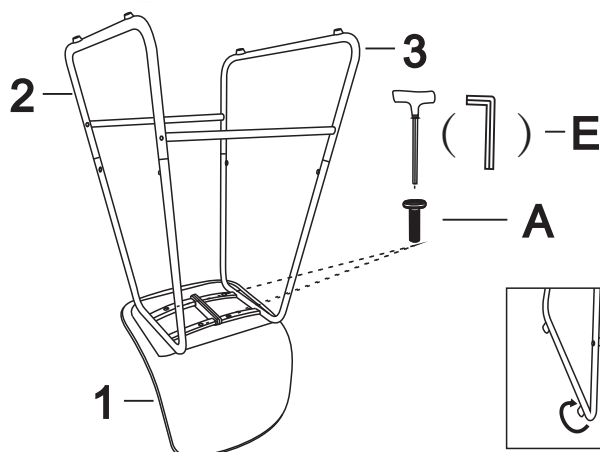
Fix Chair Legs (2) to (3) with Bolts (D) by an Allen Key (E)

Fix Foot Rests (5) to Chair Legs with Bolts (B) by an Allen Key (E).



### Step3

Fix Seat (1) to Chair Legs with Bolts (A) by an Allen Key (E)  
 Make sure a high in front and low in back design of the seat
