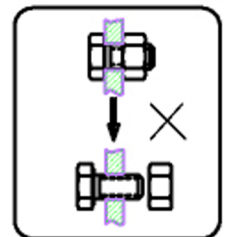


Outdoor Shower Installation Instructions



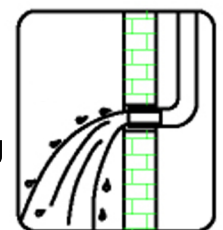
Product Inspection:

Please unpack and prepare all parts for installation.



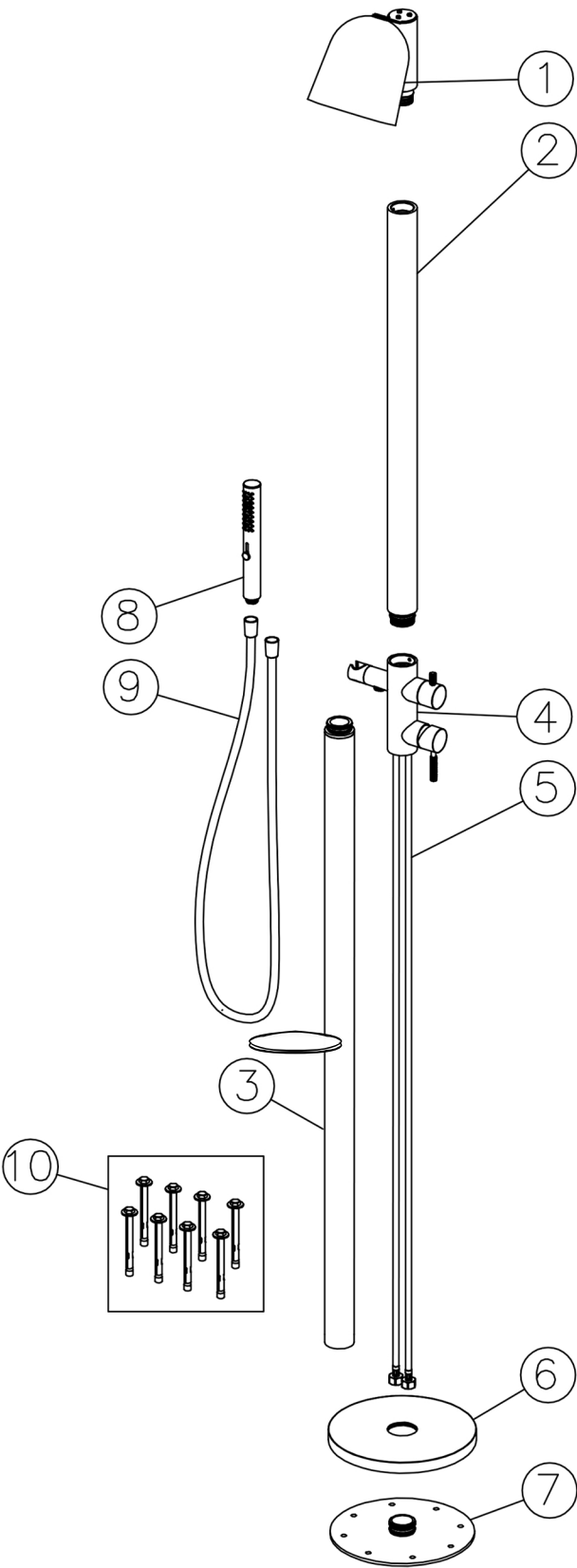
Before Installation:

Installation Steps:

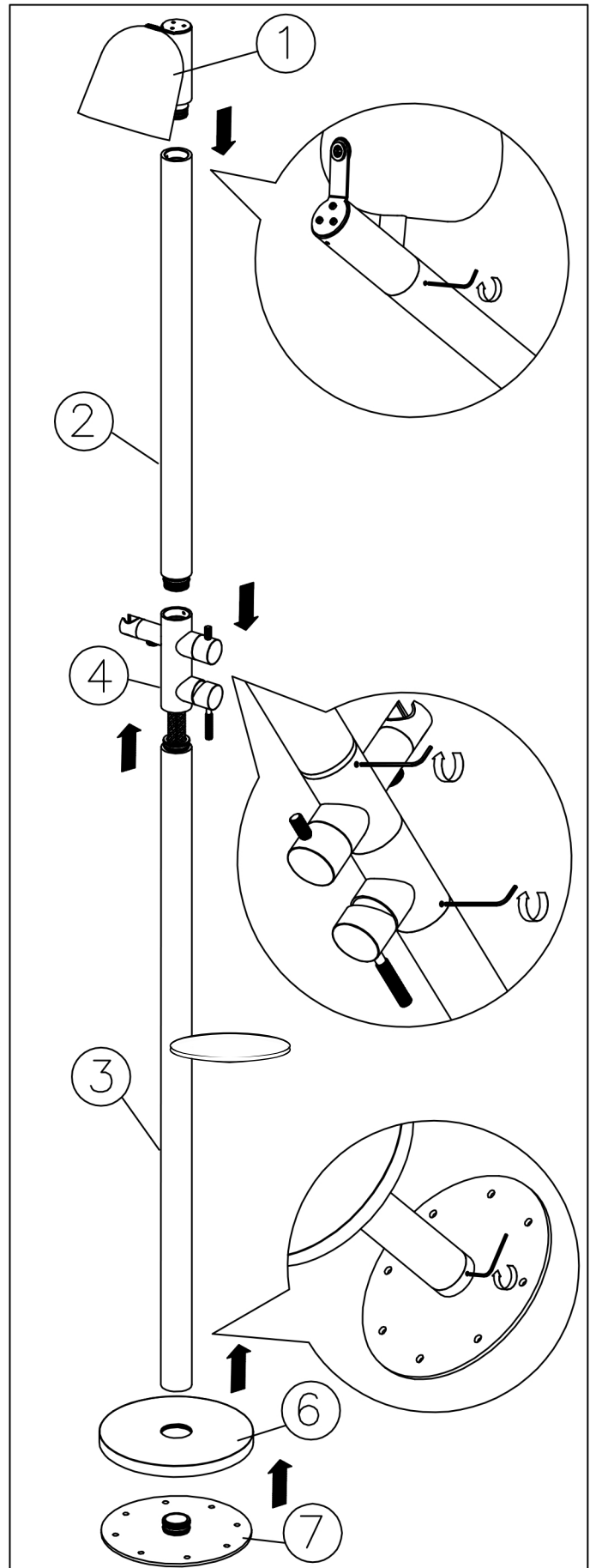
This product requires installation on the ground surface.

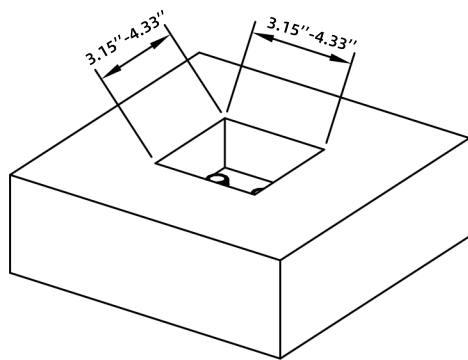
1.1. Screw the long tube (3) and the short tube (2) onto the upper and lower ends of the main body (4) respectively, with the long tube (3) at the bottom and the short tube (2) at the top, and tighten the screws with a hex wrench.

1.2. Insert the Top shower (1) into the short tube (2), adjust the direction, and then tighten the screws with a hex wrench.

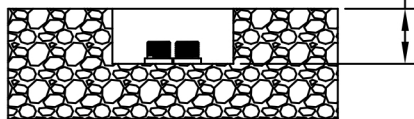
1.3. The long lower tube (3) passes through the decorative cover (6).

1.4. Screw the fixed base (7) into the long tube (3) and tighten the screws with a hex wrench.

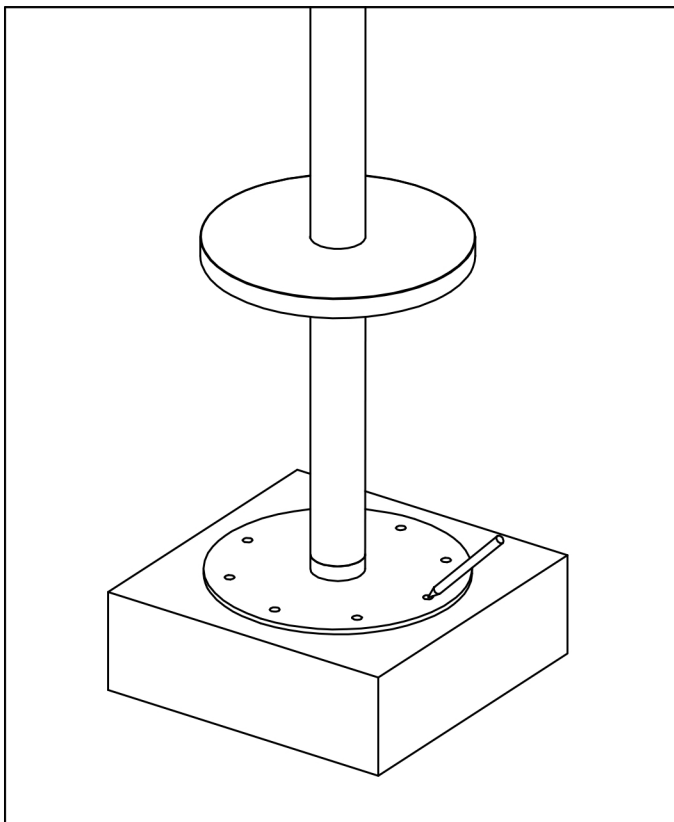




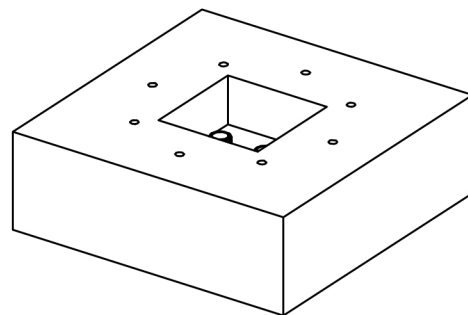

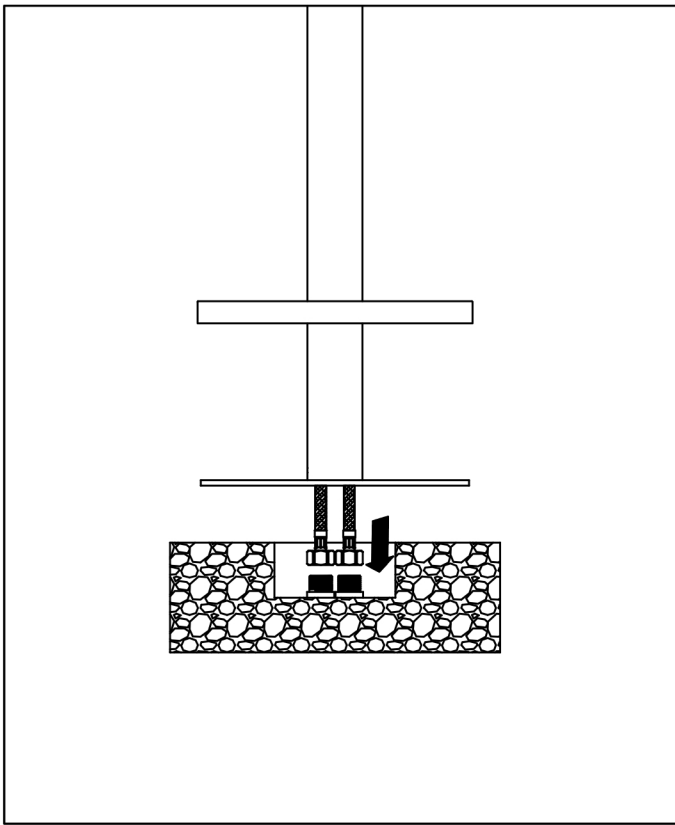
Clean the mud and sand in the pipeline before installation.



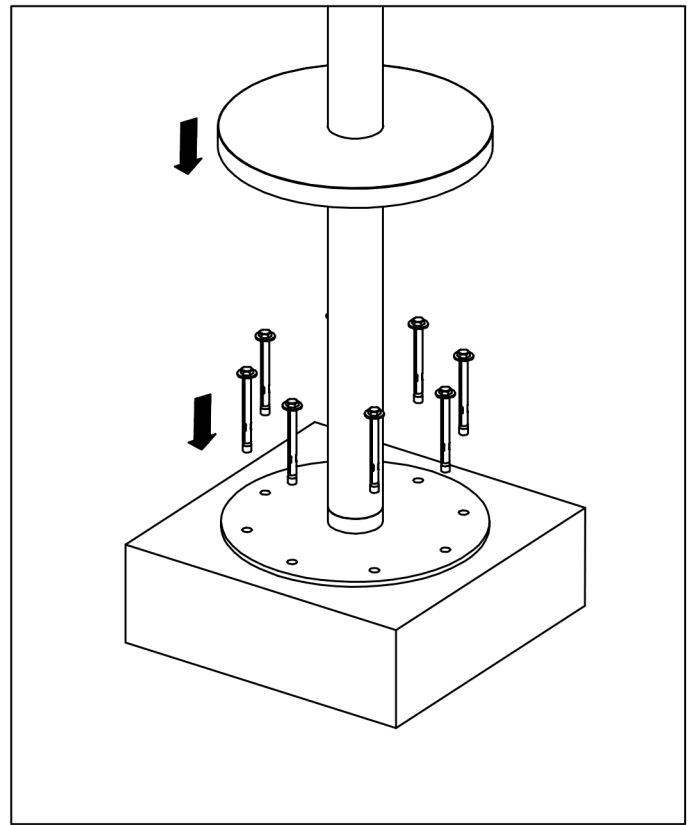
2. Set the outdoor shower upright at the installation position. After the direction is correct, make marks at the hole positions of the fixed base



3. Drill eight $\varnothing 8$ holes with a depth of 100mm at the marked locations.

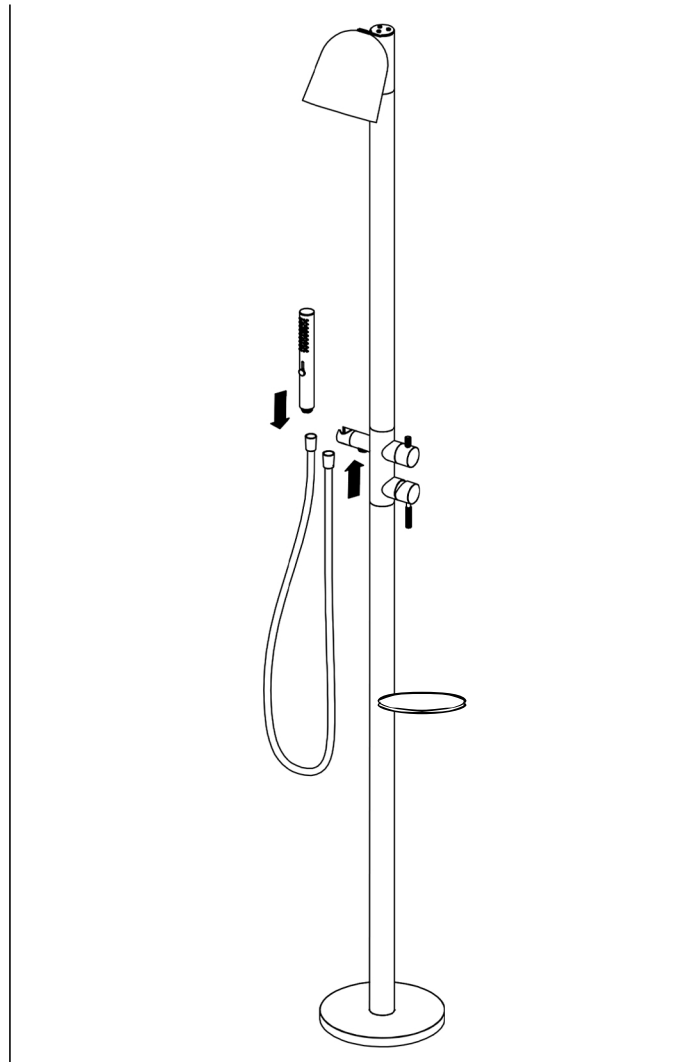


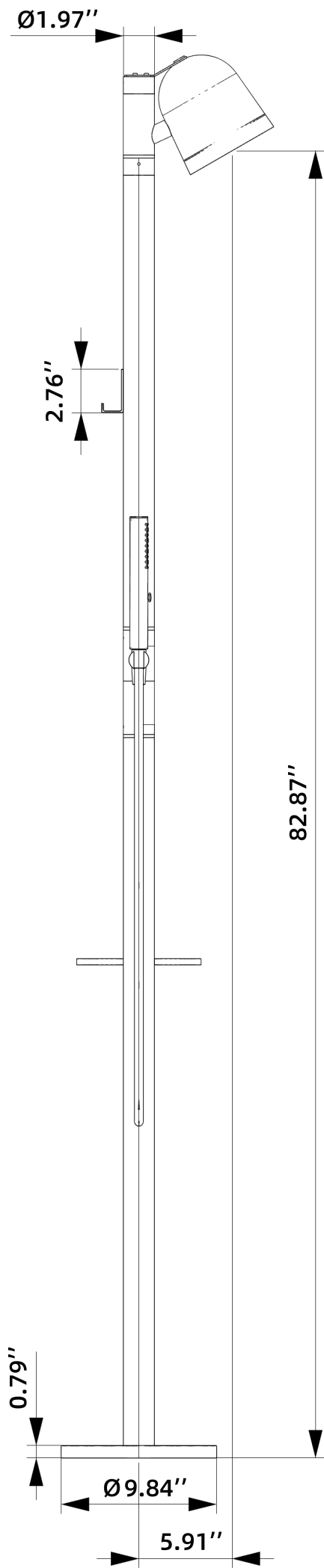
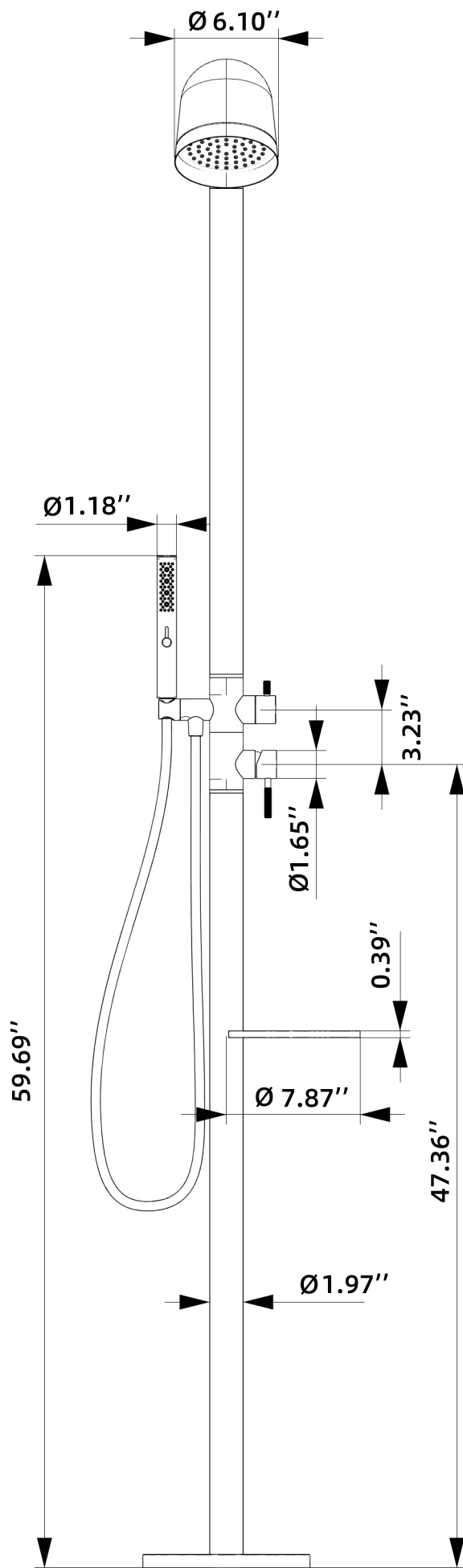
4. Connect the hot and cold water inlet hoses with the cold and hot water pipes of the tap water respectively.

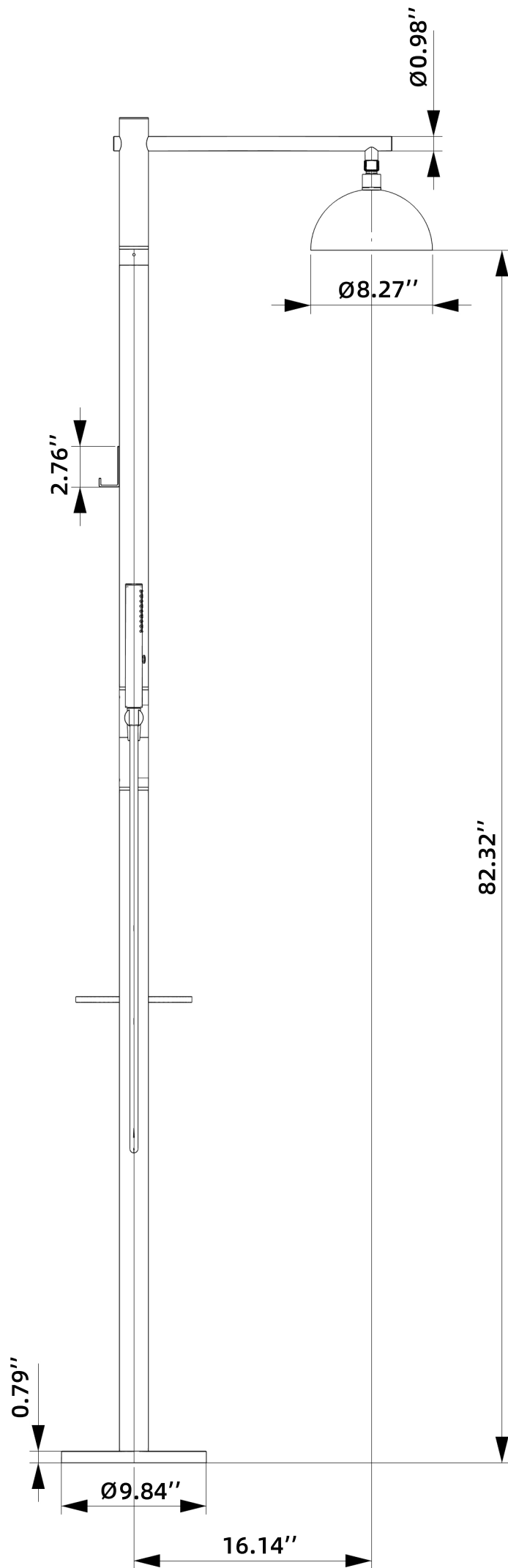
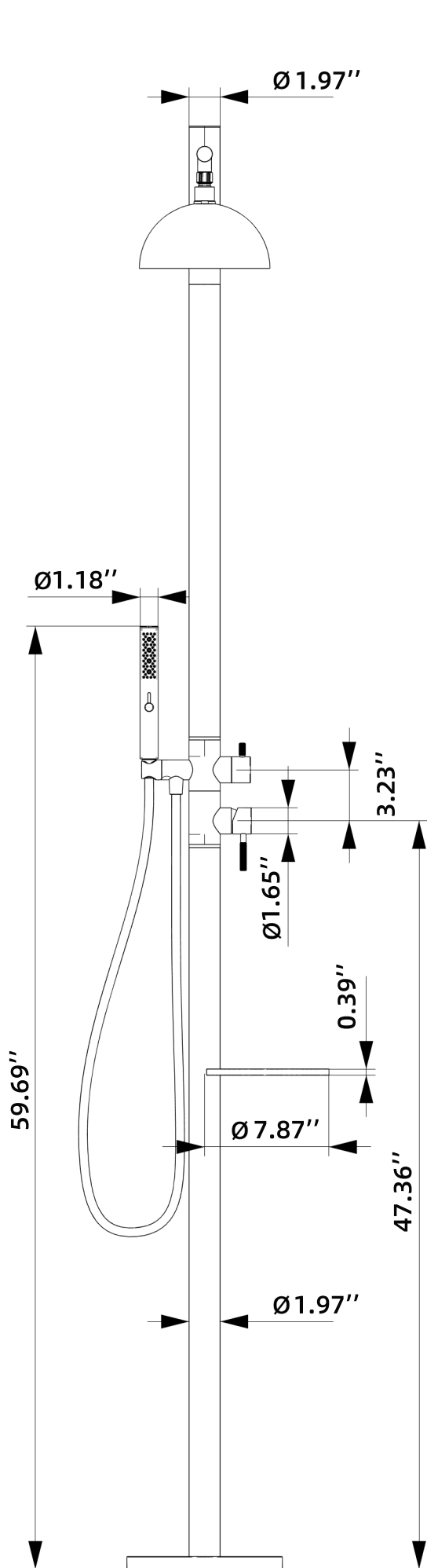


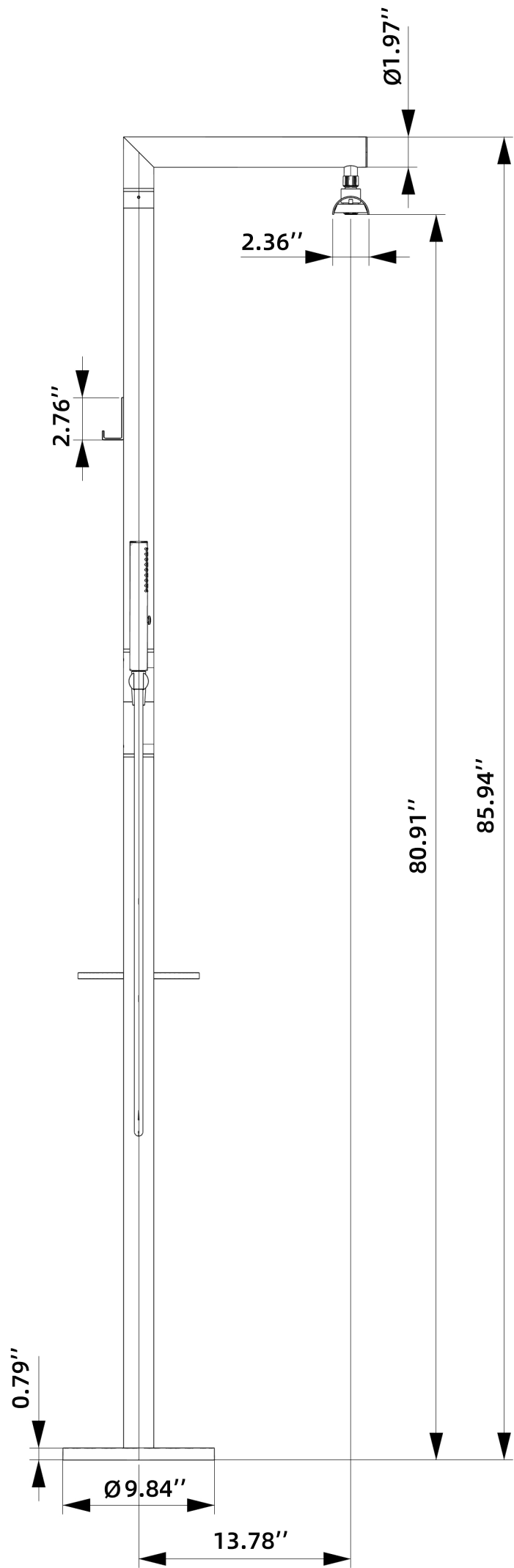
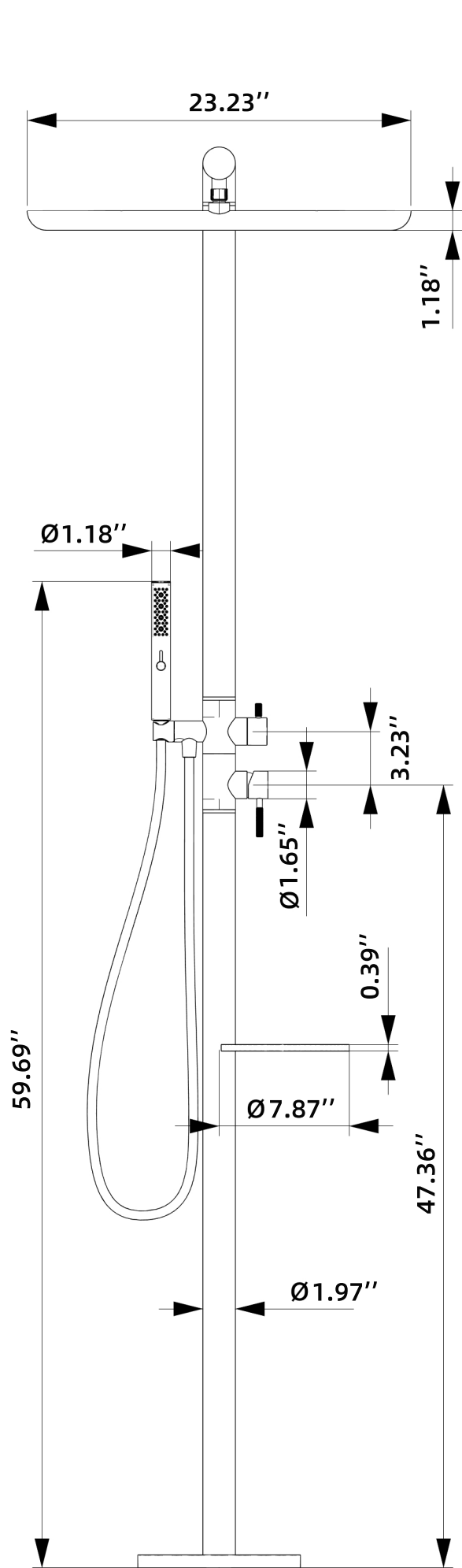
5.1. Install the expansion screws and tighten them with a wrench.
5.2. Move the decorative cover to the ground surface.

6. Connect the handheld shower









Cleaning & Care

To keep your outdoor shower looking its best and functioning properly, follow these maintenance tips:

1. Rinse after use:

After each use, rinse the shower with clean water to remove salt, sand, or pool chemicals. Wipe dry with a soft cloth to prevent water spots and mineral buildup.

2. Use mild cleaners:

For deeper cleaning, use a mild, non-abrasive liquid cleaner or a non-colored glass cleaner. Avoid acidic, bleach-based, or granular products that could damage the finish.

3. Avoid abrasives:

Do not use abrasive cleaners, polishing compounds, sandpaper, steel wool, or sharp tools.

4. Check for buildup:

Over time, mineral deposits or debris may accumulate in the showerhead or aerator, reducing water flow.

Unscrew the showerhead/aerator, rinse it thoroughly with clean water, and reinstall it.

5. Winter care:

In colder climates, disconnect the water supply and drain the shower before freezing temperatures to prevent damage.

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
