Step 1. Insert Cam Bolts (part #2) into pre-drilled holes of parts A, B, C, X & Y using a Phillips head screw driver.

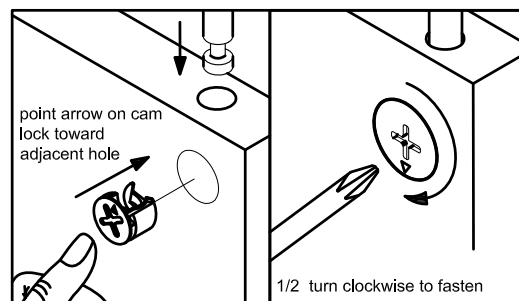
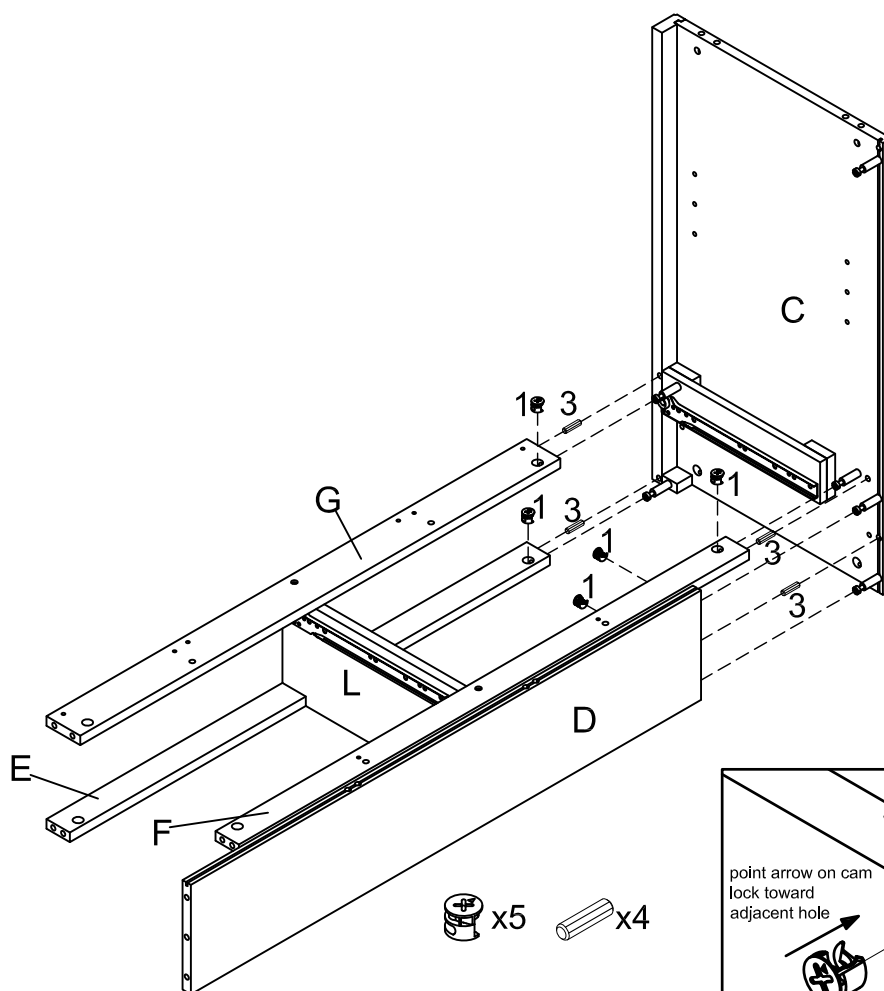


Step 2. Attach Rail E to the notched cutout in Center Panel L with Wood Dowels and Long Screw (Part #15) with Phillips Head screw driver as shown. With Rail E flat on ground, attach Rails G & F to Center Panel L with Wood Dowels and Long Screws (Part #15) with Phillips Head screw driver as shown.

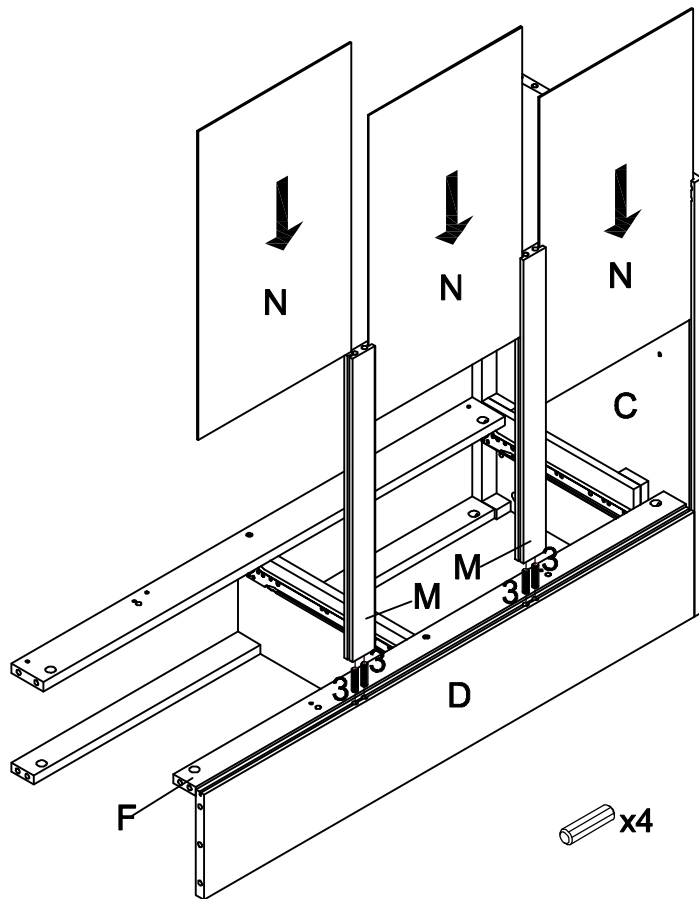
NOTE: Please ensure that wood screws are aligned with the pre-drilled holes in Panel L before tightening.



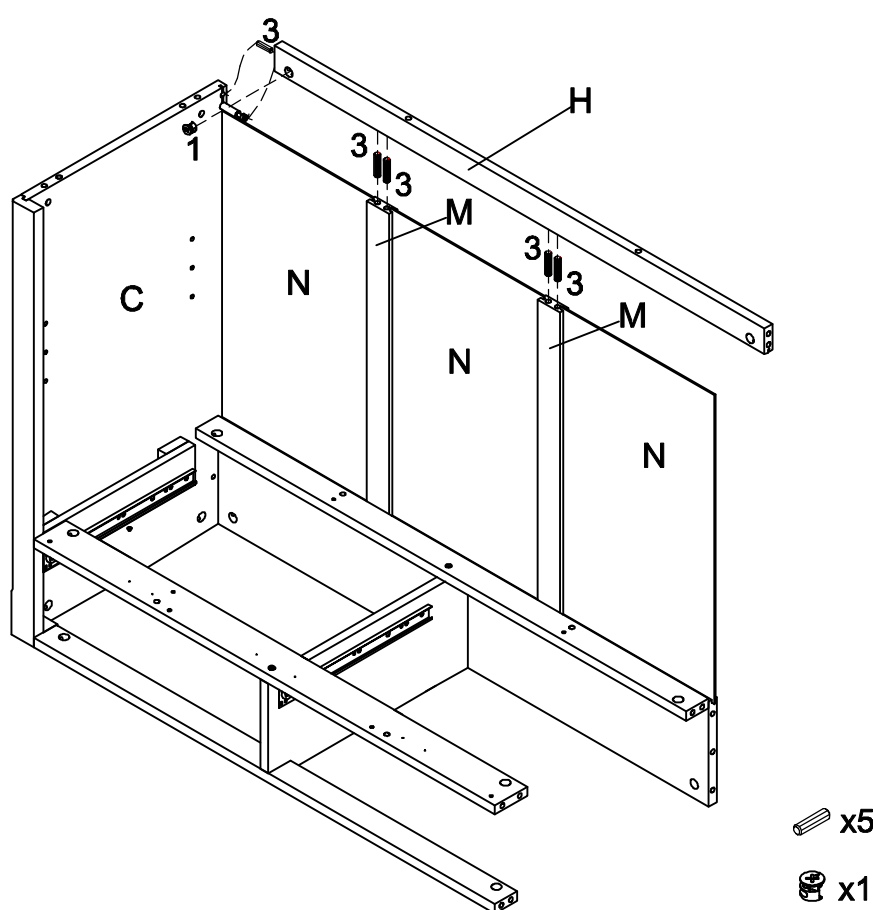
Step 3. Attach assembled parts E, F, G & L to Side Panel C with Wood Dowels & Cam Locks as shown. Attach Back Rail D to Side Panel C with Wood Dowels & Cam Locks as shown.



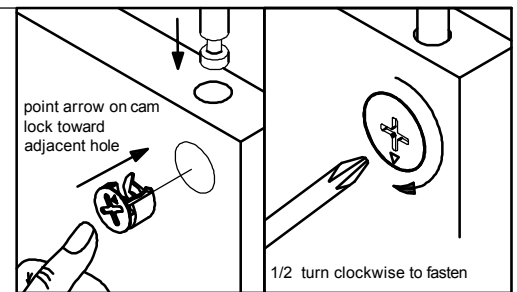
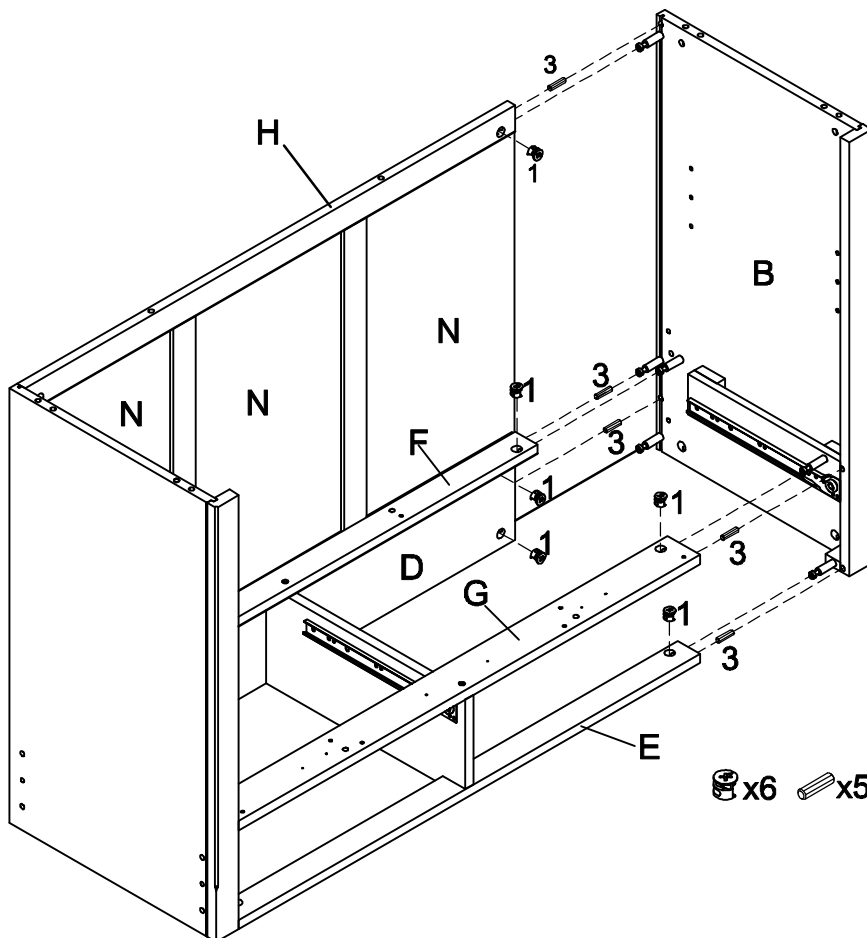
Step 4. Set Rails M into place on Back Rail D using Wood Dowels as shown. Slide Back Panels N into grooves of Parts C & M as shown.



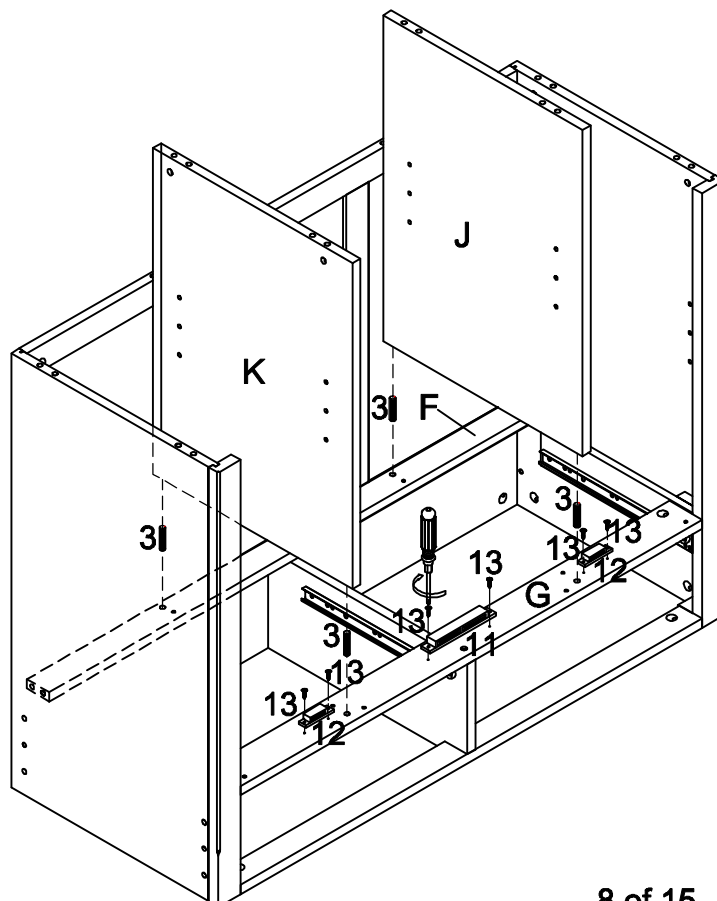
Step 5. Attach Rail H to Rails M & Side Panel C using Wood Dowels & Cam Lock as shown.



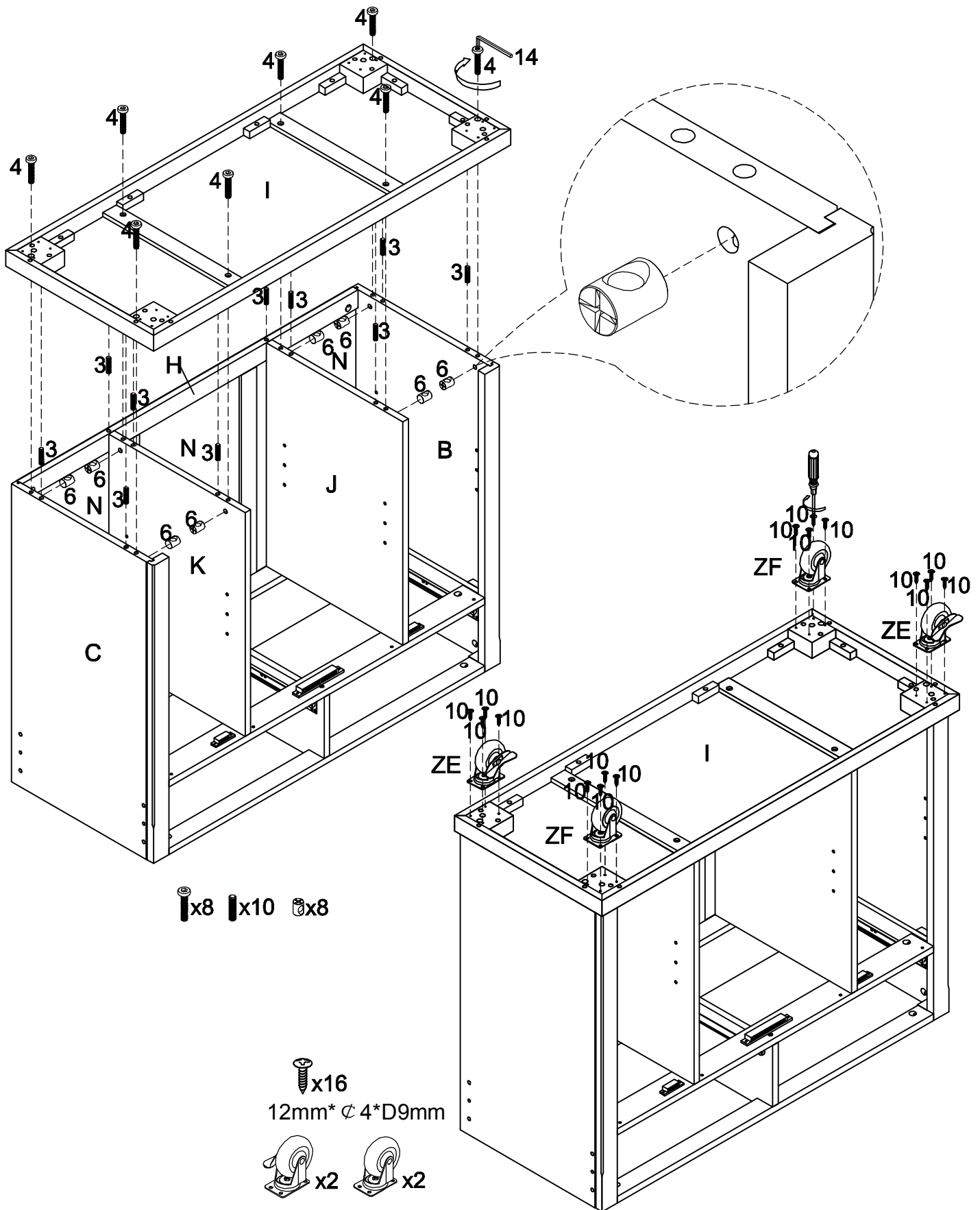
Step 6. Attach Side Panel B to Parts D, E, F, G, & H using Wood Dowels & Cam locks as shown.



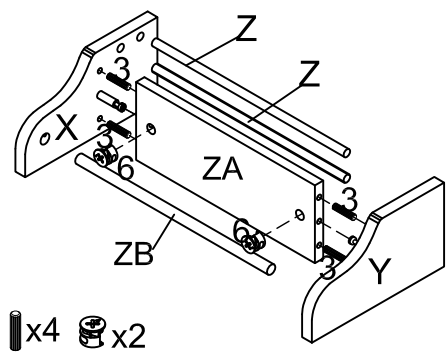
Step 7. Attach Double Magnet (Part #11) & Magnets (Part #12) to Rail G using Round Head Screws (Part #13) with Phillips Head screw driver as shown. Set Panels J & K into place on Rails F & G using Wood Dowels as shown.



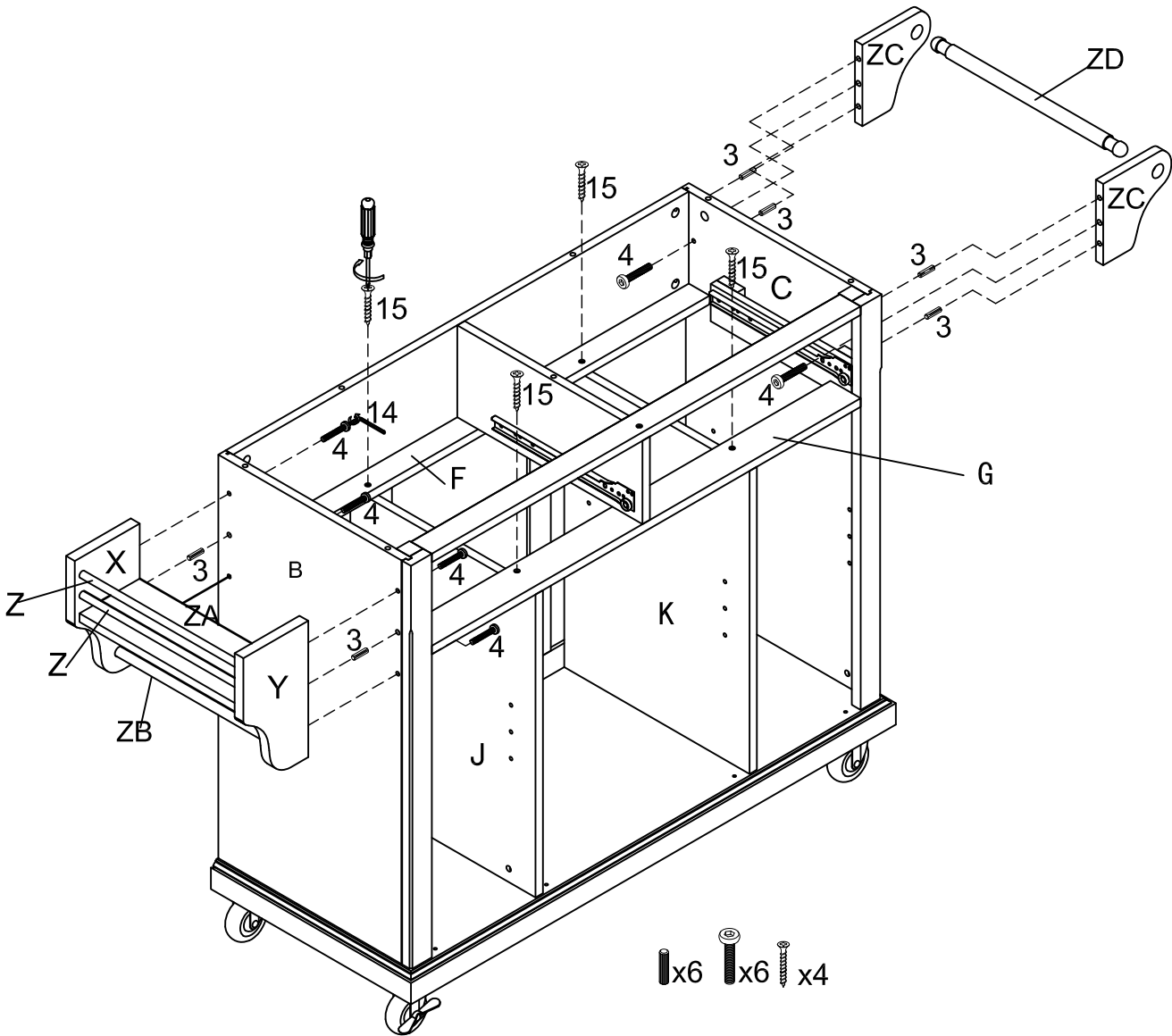
Step 8. Attach Base I to cabinet using Wood dowels, Hex Socket Head Bolts (Part #4) & Barrel nuts (Part #6) as shown. Attach Locking Casters (Part ZE) & Casters (Part ZF) to Base I, using Large Round Head Screws (Part #10) & Phillips Head screw driver as shown. **NOTE: IF YOU PURCHASED A KITCHEN ISLAND WITH WOOD LEGS, DO NOT ATTACH THE CASTERS.** Attach the wood legs using Hex Socket Head Bolts, & Wood Dowels (as shown in instruction manual included in carton with the legs). Carefully turn cabinet with legs or casters on the floor.



Step 9. Insert Wood Rods (Part ZB & Parts Z) into the pre-drilled holes in Part X as shown. Attach Part ZA to Part X using Wood Dowels and Cam Lock as shown. Attach Part Y to Parts Z, ZB, & ZA using Wood Dowels and Cam Lock as shown.

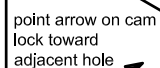
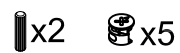


Step 10. Secure Panels J & K to Rails F & G using Long Screws (Part #15) & Phillips Head screw driver as shown. Attach Spice Rack (Assembled Parts X, Y, Z, & ZB) to Side Panel B using Hex Socket Head Bolts & Wood Dowels as shown. Attach Parts ZC (Towel Bar Sides) to Side Panel C using Hex Socket Head Bolts & Wood Dowels as shown. Insert Towel Bar (Part ZD) through the holes of Parts ZC. Note: Hex Socket Head Bolts will be inserted from the inside of the cabinet.

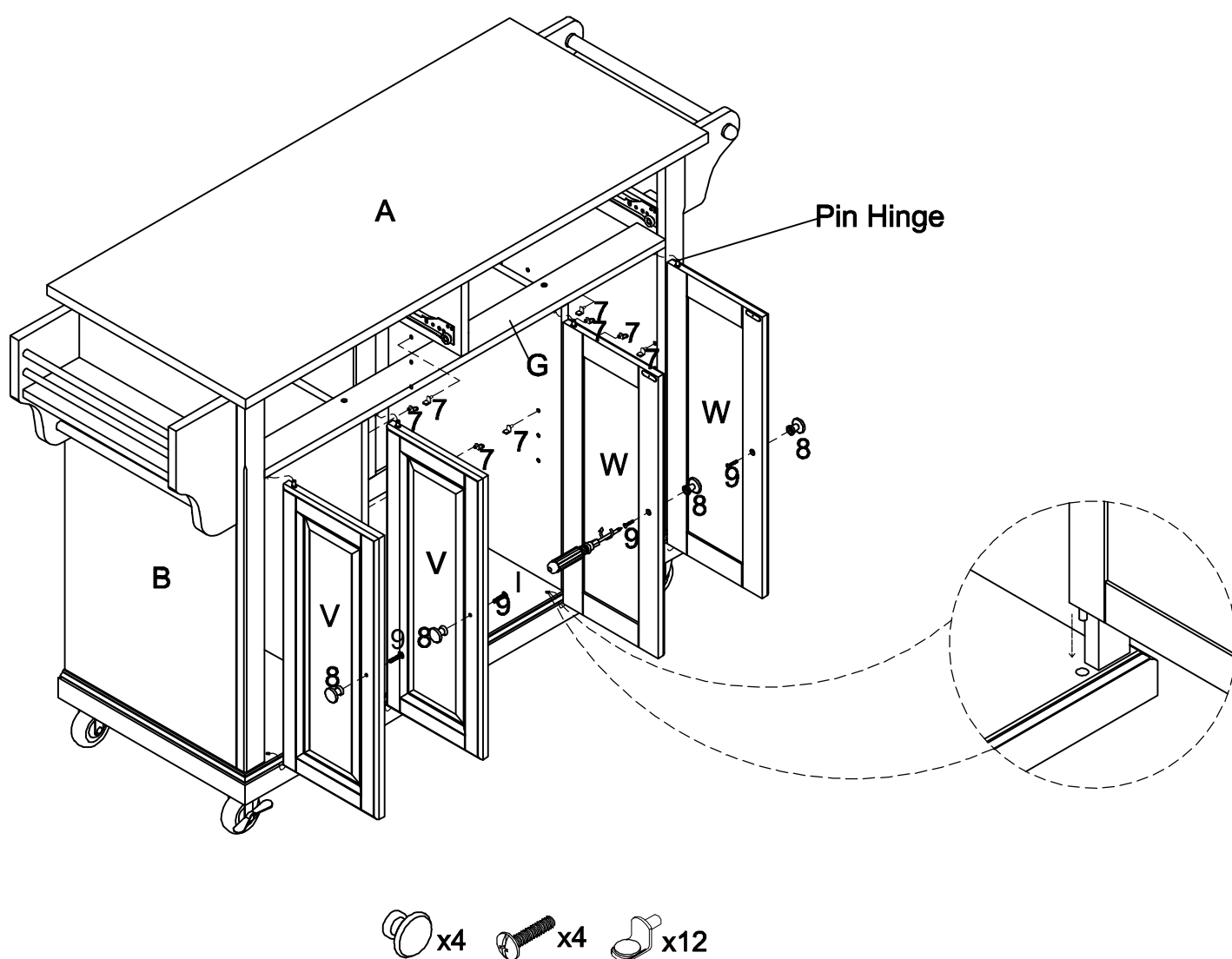

Step 12. Attach Hardware Knobs to Doors (Parts V & W) using Round Head Bolts (Part #9) & Phillips Head screw driver as shown. Attach doors to cabinet by placing bottom Pin Hinge into pre-drilled holes in Base I & depressing top spring loaded Pin Hinge to fit door into place in Rail G. **Note: Be sure Pin Hinges (top & bottom) have fully extended into the pre-drilled holes in Base I and Rail G to secure doors into place. Insert the Shelf Holders (Part #7) into desired position.**



Step 13 Assemble drawers by Attaching Drawer Front Q to Drawer Sides S & R using Screws (Part #5) & Phillips Head screw driver as shown. **NOTE: BE SURE THAT THE WHEELS ON DRAWER GLIDES ARE AT THE OPPOSITE SIDE OF THE DRAWER FRONT.** Insert Bottom Panel U into the grooves of Parts S, R & Q. Attach Back Panel T to Parts S & R using Screws (Part #5) & Phillips Head screw driver as shown. Repeat this step for the other drawer. Insert drawers and shelves into cabinet as shown in diagram on page 14.
