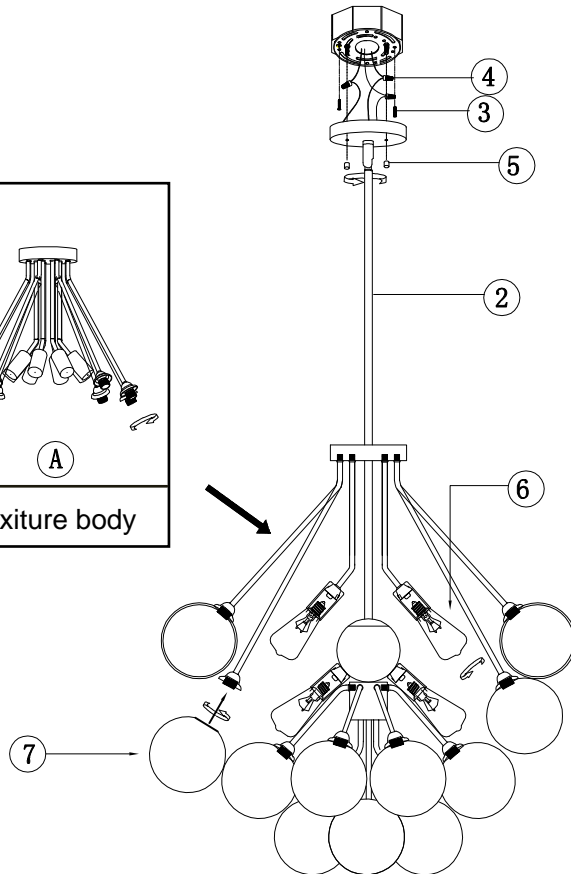
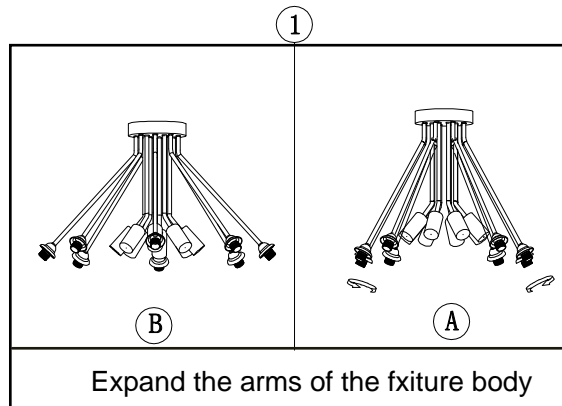


# ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

**WARNING:** TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.



## Installation Steps

### 1. Position the Arms of the Fixture:

Expand the arms of the fixture (Part A) to the appropriate position as shown in the diagram (Part B).

### 2. Install the Suspension Rod:

Attach the suspension rod to connect the fixture arms and the main body of the light fixture.

### 3. Secure the Mounting Plate:

Use the mounting screws to fix the mounting plate securely onto the electrical junction box.

### 4. Connect the Wiring:

- Connect the white wire (N) from the fixture to the white wire (negative) from the junction box.
  - Connect the black wire (L) from the fixture to the black wire (positive) from the junction box.
  - Use wire nuts to connect the ground wire from the junction box to the fixture's ground wire.
- \* Carefully tuck all the wires back into the junction box.

### 5. Attach the Ceiling Canopy:

Use the decorative screws to secure the ceiling canopy onto the mounting plate.

### 6. Install the Light Bulbs:

Install the appropriate light bulbs (bulbs are not included with the fixture).

### 7. Install the Glass Shade:

Attach the glass shade to the fixture, ensuring it is securely fitted.

## Safety Instructions:

If you feel you do not have enough electrical wiring knowledge or experience, have your light fixture installed by a licensed electrician. Any electrical work not described in this manual should be performed by a licensed electrician.
