## Installation:

- 1. Thoroughly clean the glass of the window or door where you will be installing your feeder.
- 2. Use a wet cloth to dampen the suction cups prior to placing on the window.
- 3. Attach suction cups to back of birdfeeder
- 4. With suction cups in place, press birdfeeder firmly onto the window and press each of the suction cups to guarantee a firm attachment to glass.
- 5. Tug gently down on the feeder to ensure the cups are secure and locked in place.
- 6. Insert the removable tray inside the bird feeder box.
- 7. Fill the feeder with up to 2 cups of fresh bird seed.
- 8. Enjoy the close up views of your feathered friends!

## **Tips For Attracting Birds:**

- 1. Be patient It can take up to 4 weeks for birds to discover this new food source.
- 2. Check the bird seed Is the seed fresh? Are there insects or moisture clumps? If so, refill it.
- 3. Deter squirrels This feeder is virtually squirrel proof but to ensure squirrels can't steal the seed, do not place it near tree limbs, water spouts, or decks. Also be sure the window has no screen that a squirrel could climb.
- 4. Attract birds quickly Try placing a dollop of peanut butter or lard on the edge of the feeder with seed sprinkled on top. Remove after a few days to avoid attracting ants.
- 5. Don't overfill the feeder This will cause the seed to spill over onto the ground or spoil because it is there for too long.

## **Cleaning and Maintaining:**

- 1. The feeder should be cleaned every two weeks to avoid mold or bacteria build up.
- 2. To remove the feeder from the window simply peel the suction cups away from the glass.
- 3. Soak the feeder in a sink or bucket filled with warm water and bleach (10 parts water to 1 part bleach) for at least 10 minutes.
- 4. Use a scrub brush to remove any seed or residue.
- 5. Alternatively, use warm soapy water and a soft cloth for light cleaning.
- 6. Never use alcohol or ammonia to clean the acrylic. It will cause cracking and/or yellowing.
