








# Assembly Instruction

## WARNING:

- Read all instructions carefully and completely before assembly and use.
- Retain for future reference.
- DO NOT use power tools.
- DO NOT over-tighten hardware.
- Periodically check all hardware and re-tighten as necessary.
- DO NOT use product if any component becomes damaged.
- For residential (non-commercial) use only.
- DO NOT sit or stand on product. Use only for intended purpose.
- DO NOT exceed 80lbs for the tabletop, 30lbs for the shelf evenly distributed.

## Parts List

Check all parts before assembly

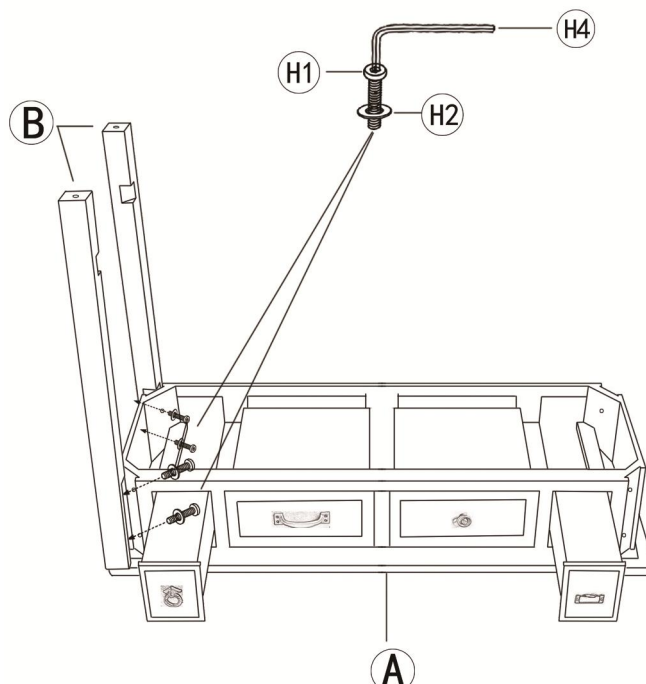
A. <u>Tabletop</u>   *4	B. <u>Leg</u>   *4	C. <u>Shelf</u>   *1	
H1. <u>Hex bolt</u>   *8 (+1 extra)	H2. <u>Washer</u>   *8 (+1 extra)	H3. <u>Foot pad</u>   *4	H4. <u>Allen Key</u>   *1

Step 1: Put the Tabletop (A) on a soft surface to protect the finish.

Put the (Left&right) drawers out.

Attach Leg (B) to the Tabletop(A) with Hex bolt (H1)& Washer (H2) by Allen Key (H4).

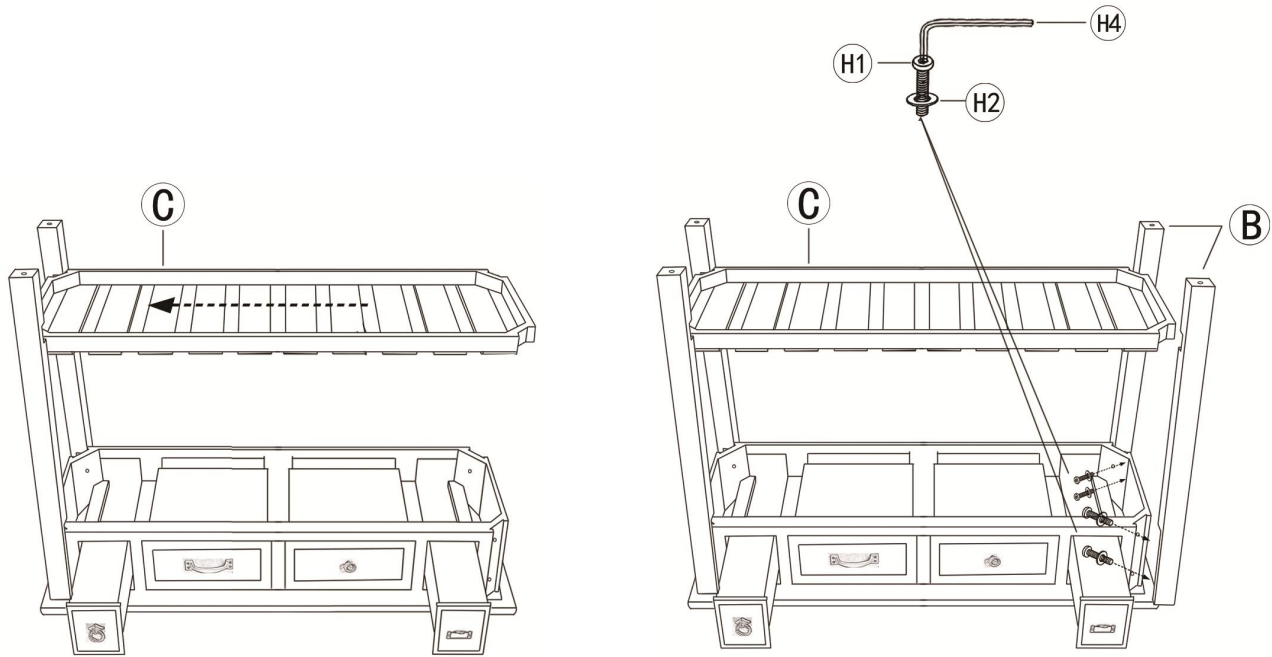
Leave hardware loose in this step.



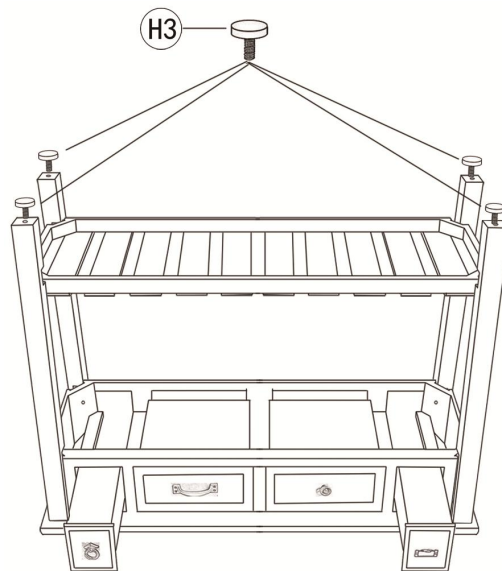
Step 2: Attach the Shelf (C) to the Legs (B).

Attach Leg (B) to the Tabletop(A) with Hex bolt (H1)& Washer (H2) by Allen Key (H4).

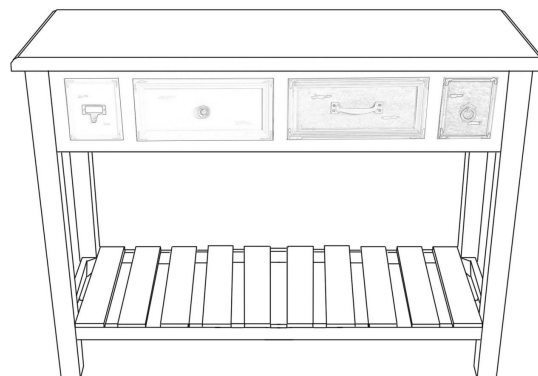
**Fully tighten all bolts from Step 1 to 2.**



Step 3: Attach the Foot pad (H3) to the bottom of the Legs (B) .
