

# Emerson Mailbox System *Installation Instructions*

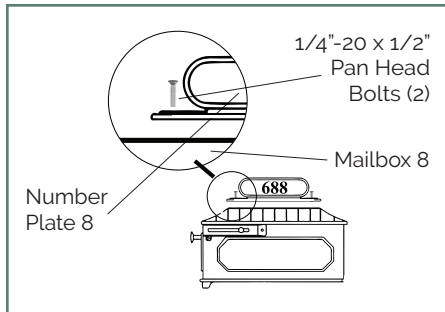
**ADDRESSES OF DISTINCTION**  
MAILBOXES + STREET SIGNS. INSTALLED.

**Tools Required:** phillips head screw driver, 7/16" wrench or pliers, and allen key.

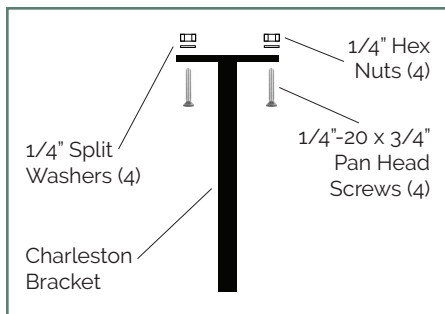
## STEP 1

Place (2) 1/4"-20 x 1/2" Pan Head Bolts through the top of the Number Plate 8. Place number plate on top of the Mailbox 8 and place the bolts through the pre-drilled holes on top of the mailbox. See *Illustration A1*

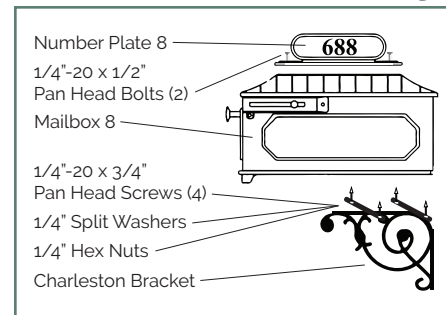

## STEP 2 (Fig 1)

Position the Charleston Bracket on the bottom of the mailbox. Insert (4) 1/4"-20 x 3/4" Pan Head Screws through the bottom of the Charleston Bracket into the pre-drilled holes on the Mailbox 8. Secure the Pan Head Screws using (4) 1/4" Split Washers and (4) 1/4" Hex Nuts. See *Illustration A2*

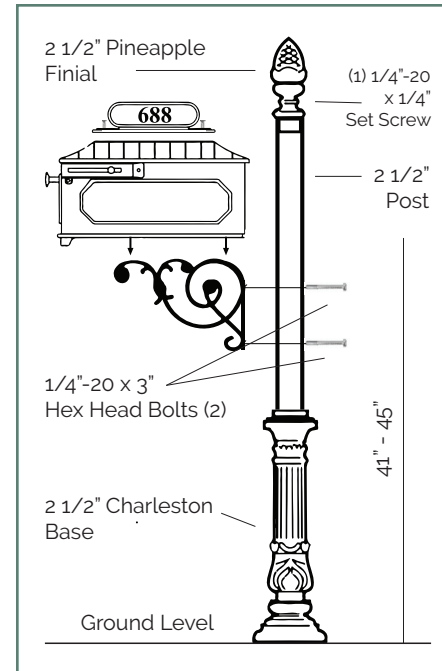
## STEP 3 (Fig 2)

Attach the mailbox and bracket assembly from Step 2 to the 2 1/2" Round Post using (2) 1/4" - 20 x 3" Hex Head Bolts.

## STEP 4 (Fig 2)

Finish the look of your mailbox by sliding the 2 1/2" Charleston Base onto bottom of the post. Insert the 2 1/2" Pineapple Finial on top of the post and secure with the (1) 1/4"-20 x 1/4" Set Screw. Secure the base with (3) 1/4"-20 x 3/8" Set Screws after the system is installed. Place the (1) Anti-Rotational Bolt near the bottom of the Post to secure in concrete. Your mailbox is ready to be installed in the ground.

Occasionally your mailbox may need cleaning. We suggest washing it with a mild, non-abrasive soap using a soft cloth or brush. Make sure to thoroughly rinse all the soap off the mailbox. If you are using brass numbers, they may be cleaned with a brass cleaner such as Brasso.

## What if my mailbox is damaged at some future point?

All of our mailboxes are bolted together so parts can be easily replaced. Simply call the number on the inside of the door and our team will be happy to help you bring your mailbox back to life.

## Do you install with concrete?

All mailboxes installed by Addresses of Distinction are installed using concrete. We warranty all installations for a period of one year. When your mailbox is installed, please wait 24 hours before applying pressure to the post, as it takes some time for the concrete to fully cure.
