

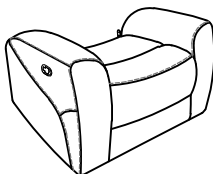
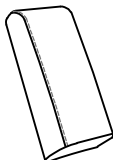
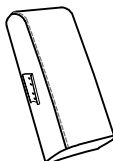

## Reclining Chair



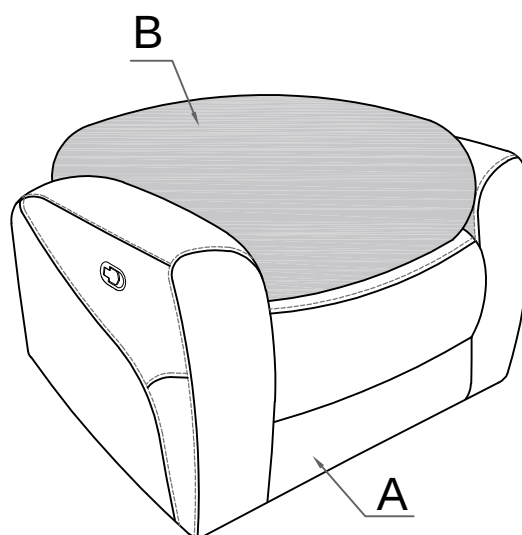
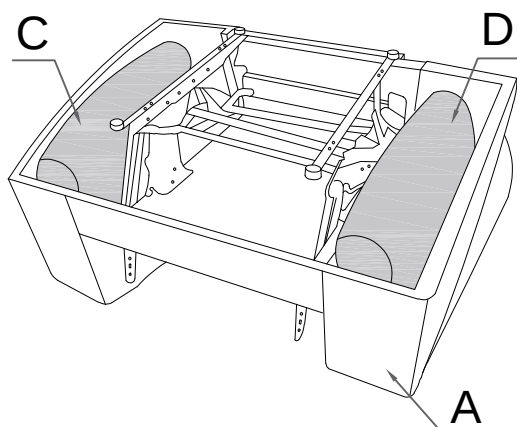

## Double Reclining Love Seat With Center Console



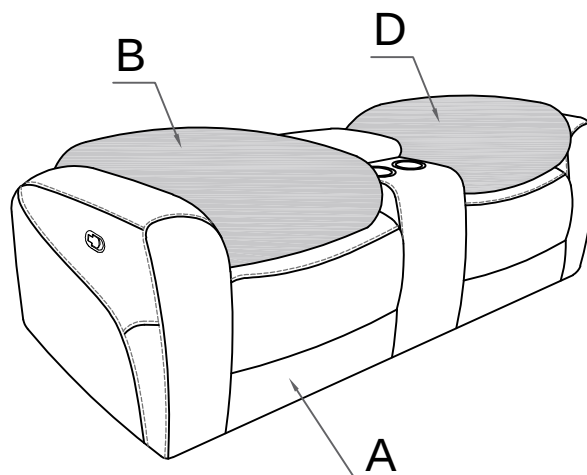
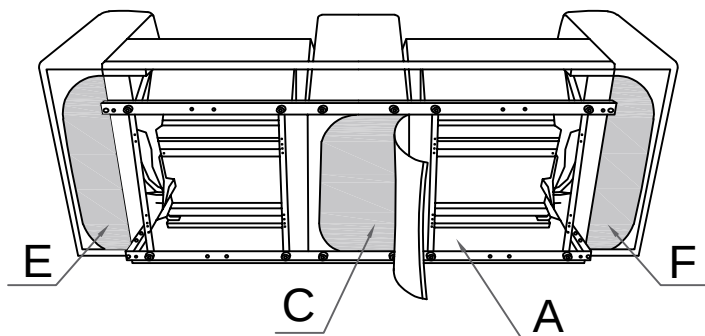
