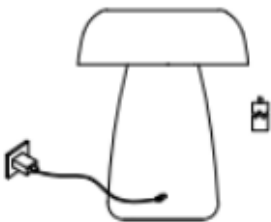
### LAMP TBL 10IN RIB MTL SHADE TOUCH LED



Turn on the lamp by touching the lower switch section of the lamp body.



Turn off the lamp by touching the middle of the sensor when light is on.



If the light on the lamp begins to dim on its own, that is when it needs to be charged.



Insert the USB cable into charging port . If you see the red light, it means the lamp is charging.



Lamp is fully charged once the light turns green.

Battery usage duration test:

Charging time: 5 hours

Duration of the dim light source on: 15 hours

Duration of the Intermediate light source on: 7 hours

Duration of the brightest light source on: 5 hours

### LAMP TBL 10IN RIB MTL SHADE TOUCH LED

#### Charge the Battery before initial use.

To correctly charge the lamp, we recommend you:

- 1) Connect the USB cable to the adaptor which comply safety regulations;
- 2) Put the plug into the electrical socket;
- 3) Place the charger into the charging port underneath the lamp shade;
- 4) When fully charged, disconnect the plug from the electrical socket.
- 5) Clean the lamp with soft dry cloth.
