

MULTI-TIER PLANT STAND



ASSEMBLY

Read carefully and understand assembly before beginning.

Do not fully tighten any bolt all until all components have been loosely assembled.

IMPORTANT: The shelf supports install on the inside of all shelves.



STEP 1

A: 4 B1: 2 B2: 2 G: 8


Lay Bottom Shelf (C) on the ground with the slats facing upwards, as shown.

Locate the Inset End of Bottom Shelf (C) (see diagram).

Connect both 2-Hole Shelf Supports (B2) to the inside of the inset ends by hand-tightening two M6x40mm Bolts (G).

Connect both 3-Hole Shelf Supports (B1) to the inside edge of Bottom Shelf (C), as shown, by hand-tightening two M6x40mm Bolts (G).

Ensuring the closely-spaced holes are at the bottom, connect each 5-Hole Shelf Support (A) to the inside edge of the bottom shelf by hand-tightening four M6x40mm Bolts (G).



STEP 2

D: 1 G: 6

Place Single Shelf (D) over the 5-hole and 3-hole shelf supports, as shown.


Secure the shelf to the shelf supports by hand-tightening six M6x40mm Bolts (G).

STEP 3

E: 2 G: 8

With the flat edge facing outward, slide the first Double Shelf (E) over the 5-hole shelf supports and secure by hand-tightening four M6x40mm Bolts (G).

With the flat edge facing inward, slide the second Double Shelf (E) over the 5-hole shelf supports and secure by hand-tightening four M6x40mm Bolts (G).




STEP 4

F: 2 G: 8

Place the first Top Shelf (F) over the 5-hole shelf supports and secure by hand-tightening four M6x40mm Bolts (G).

Place the second Top Shelf (F) over the 2-hole and 3-hole shelf supports and secure by hand-tightening four M6x40mm Bolts (G).



STEP 5 (NOT SHOWN)

H: 1

Gently tighten all bolts using Hex Key (H).

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Care & Maintenance

INSPECT: Periodically check assembly points and tighten fittings as necessary.

PROTECT: Ensure there is a barrier, such as saucers or water trays, between planters and the wood. Runoff from over-watering could stain the wood.

EXPOSURE: Over time, sunlight and weather elements may change the color of natural wood. Avoid leaving wooden furniture in the rain or high-humidity climates as wood can expand and contract with humidity changes; you may need to tighten fittings periodically. If this item is not used for extended periods, we recommend covering or storing it indoors.

WINTER CARE & STORAGE: Protect this item from ice and snow. Store in a dry, indoor location. Covering the unit while in storage will help prevent dust buildup.

MAINTENANCE: This item was treated with teak oil at the factory. To maintain the appearance, apply a suitable penetrating Wood, Teak or Linseed Oil (not included) yearly, or when the wood looks particularly dry. Clean the unit and bring into a warm, indoors location. Allow the unit to thoroughly dry before applying oil; drying may take several days. Only apply oil to wooden surfaces. Use a soft cloth or soft brush and carefully apply oil as directed by the wood oil manufacturer.
