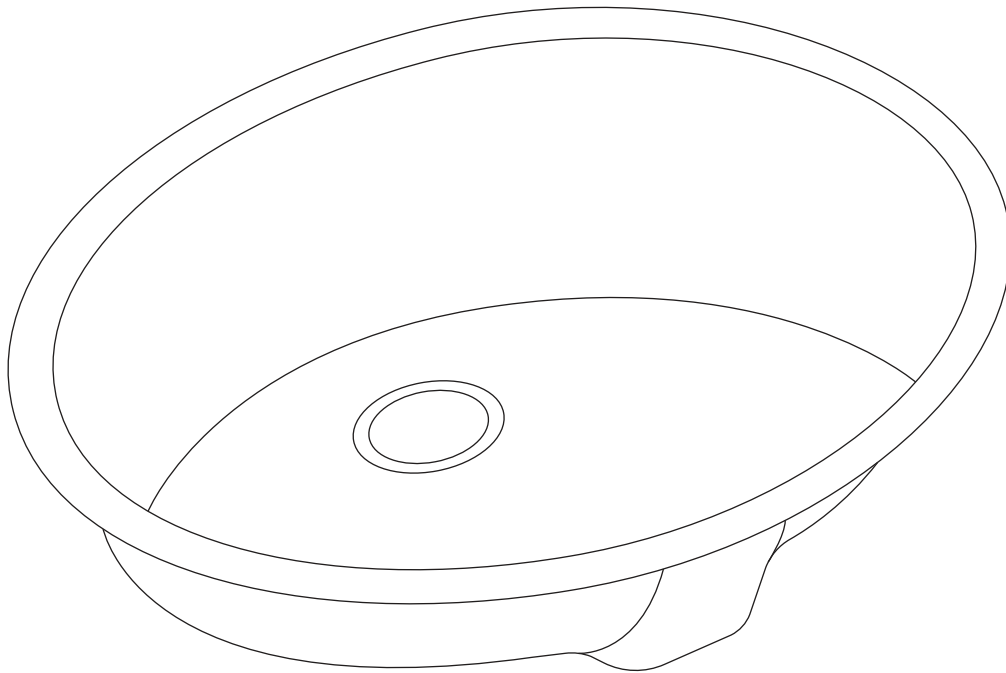

Prior to Installation:

- Inspect sink to ensure no damages have occurred while in shipping.
- Use the cutout template if provided by Swiss Madison.
- Observe all plumbing and building codes in accordance with your state and local requirements.
- Additional floor and wall preparations may be necessary to avoid damage to the product.
- We recommend professional countertop installers. Customer is responsible for damage to countertop and/or sink during installation.
- All dimensions are nominal! Be sure to measure your sink prior to installation.

General Recommendations: Read installation and maintenance instructions thoroughly before installing the sink. Be sure to use proper tools and always wear proper personal safety accessories for your protection.

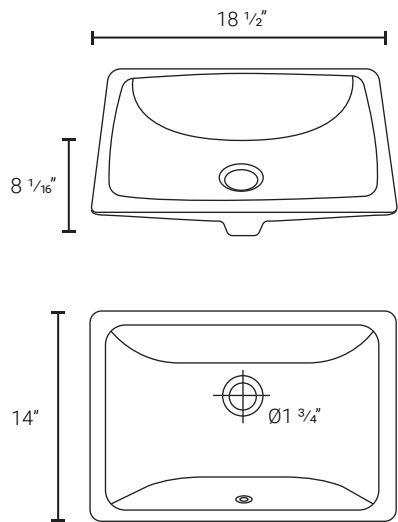

NOTE: Specialized tools may be necessary to install Swiss Madison Ceramic Undermount sinks with countertop materials other than wood, marble, or granite.

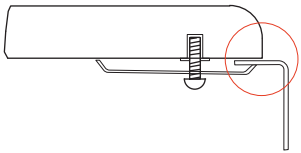

1. Read the complete instruction manual before beginning installation.
 2. Confirm that your model will fit in intended location and plumbing fixtures are located where legally required before beginning installation.
 3. Not all drawings on this manual are drawn to scale. Please refer to the model chart.
 4. Two people are recommended to install and move this product.

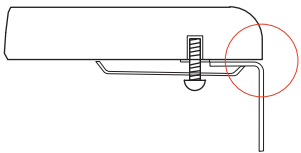
1. Determine Reveal Type



Negative: Counter edge extends past sink rim approximately 1/4" (Figure A)



Positive: Sink rim is exposed approximately 1/4" from edge of countertop (Figure B)



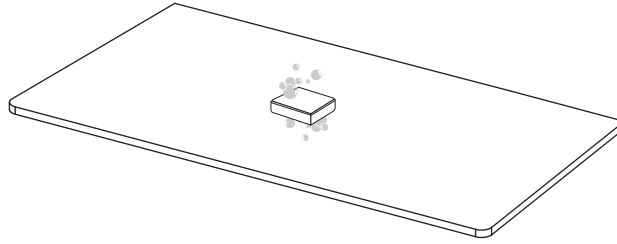
Flush: Sink edge is flush with countertop opening (Figure C)

NOTE: This manual instructs specifically for mounting a FLUSH reveal type. Make sure to consult your plumber about desired reveal type PRIOR to installation.

2. Clean Countertop

- Make sure to thoroughly clean the underside of the countertop and let it dry completely.

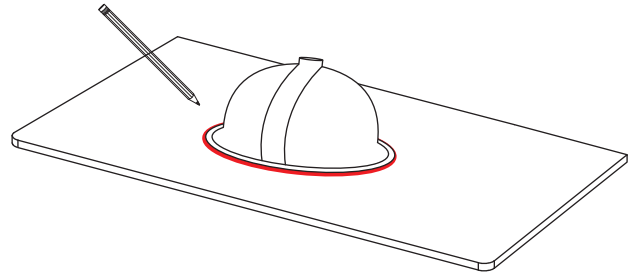
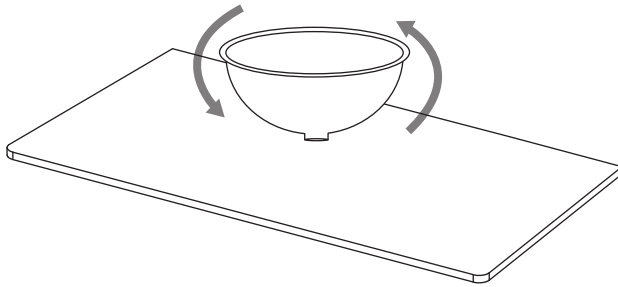
NOTE: The underside of counters tend to be rough and unfinished which makes it easy to hold debris. You want to make sure it's clean so nothing interferes with the bond between the adhesive and the countertop.



3. Position and Trace Sink

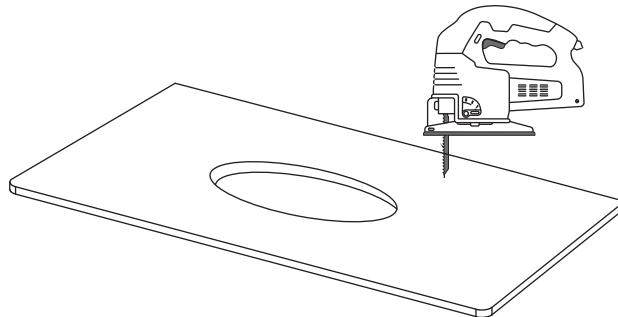
- Flip sink upside down on top of countertop in the desired location you want the sink to be.
- Trace the outline of the sink onto the countertop.

NOTE: Make sure clearance is suitable for back splash, faucet, and plumbing for the sink.



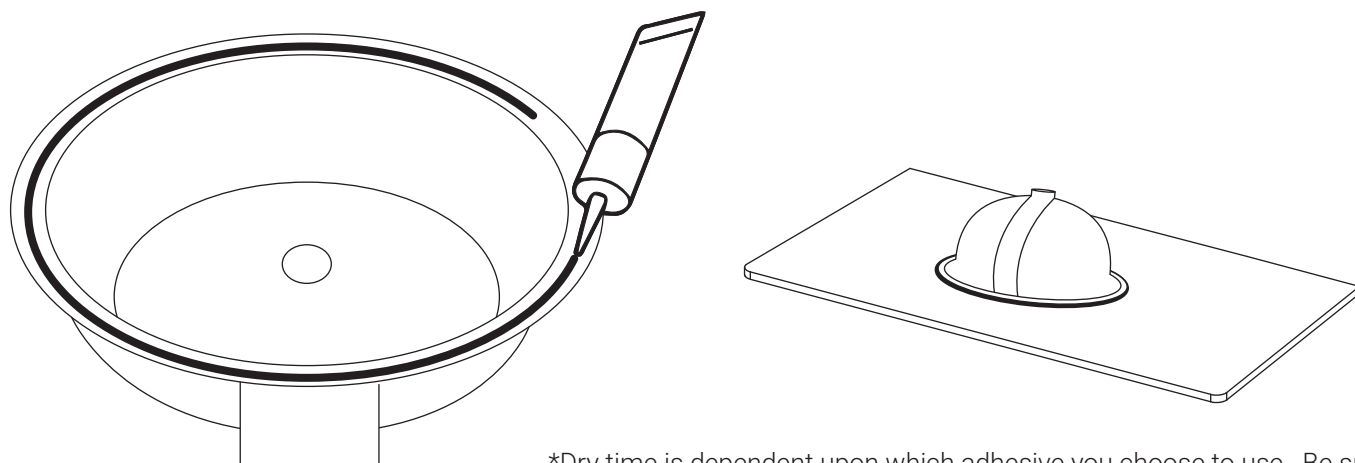
4. Cut Countertop

- Cut an opening in the countertop by carefully following the traced line.
- Please use the appropriate saw that best fits your countertop material.
- Professional should be consulted for cutting the countertop.



5. Affix Countertop

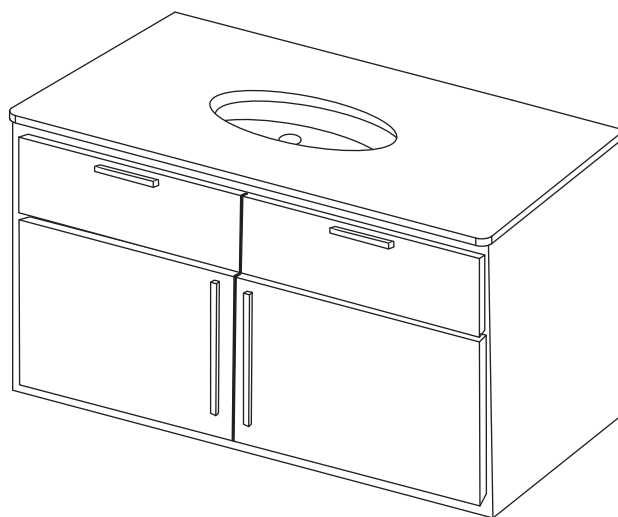
- Once again clean underside of the countertop and cutout area making sure area is free of defects.
- Apply liquid nail or adhesive of choice to the rim of the sink near the inside edge. Be careful not to miss or skip any area.
- Carefully lift sink squarely under countertop cutout. Press firmly on sink to form seal and seal sink. Immediately wipe excess sealant with a damp cloth. Be careful not to smear or spread sealant onto countertop or sink.



*Dry time is dependent upon which adhesive you choose to use. Be sure to check your adhesive instructions before use.

6. Installing Plumbing Fixtures

- Turn counter back over.
- Connect drain, trap to drain, and water supply connections to faucet according to manufacturer's instruction.
- Test run water into sink and check for leaks.
