

## **ASSEMBLING INTRUCTIONS**

Because solid wood can suffer from bending or any natural causes such as humidity, we are giving you some recommendations to install acrylic legs.

- Screw the acrylic legs to the wood tight, but not too tight or else there is a chance the acrylic can crack.
- 2. The acrylic legs should be facing up.
- After the legs have been tightened correctly flip the table on the air gently so that the legs DON'T touch the floor (if the acrylic is supported on the floor damage can occur.)
- Make sure to use the invisible round rubbers in each leg before you put the glass.
- 5. Put the glass on top of the acrylic legs.
- If for any reason the table is not totally stable, you must untighten the screw on the side that the leg does not touch the floor gently to get it proportionally balanced.
