## **Caring for Marble**

Marble is a limestone and it does not tolerate any kind of acid. Acid will leave burn marks on all marble surfaces (etching).

Marble is a porous stone and will become stained if coloured liquids are spilled and left on a marble surface (staining).

To protect the marble surface against staining, the marble surface should be sealed with a protecting sealer. All OX marble tables have received a surface treatment and are ready to use when purchased. However, the sealing of the stone is not a perfect protection. Coloured liquids can still penetrate the marble. The surface treatment does not protect against etching from acid (Fruit juices, soft drinks, coffee and wine are examples of acid liquids).

For ongoing caretaking of your marble table, we recommend Vaseline oil. The frequency depends on the intensity of the use of the table.

Hot items should not be left directly on the marble surface. If liquids are spilled on the surface, it should be cleaned as quickly as possible to minimize the marks from staining and etching.
