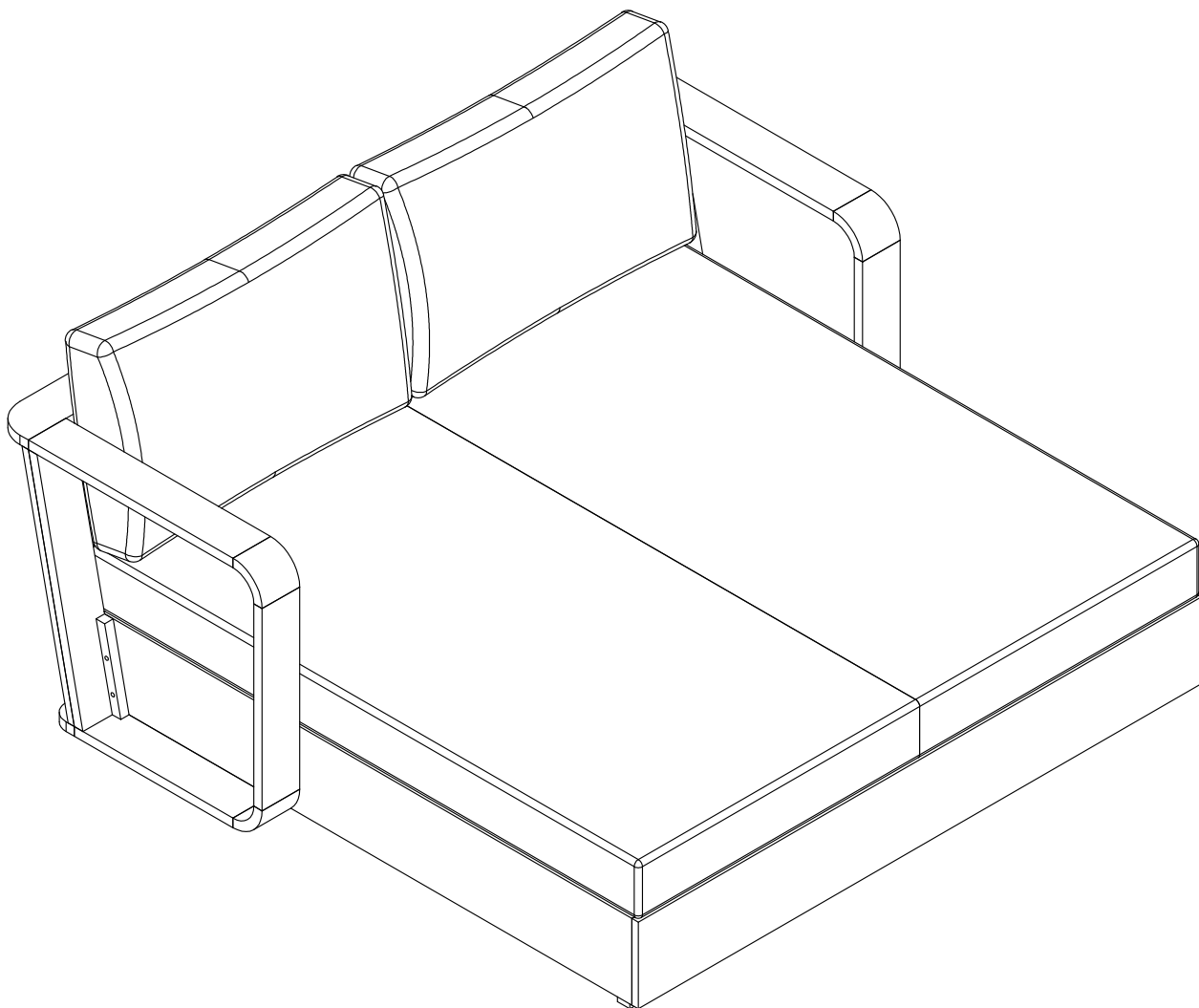

Care & Maintenance

-   • Not for commercial use. For residential use only
-   • Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.
-   • Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
-   • To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.
-   • Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
-   • Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
-   • To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.
-   • Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.
-   • Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.

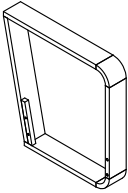
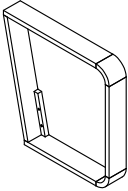
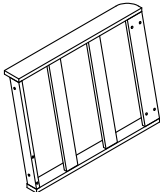
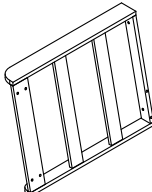
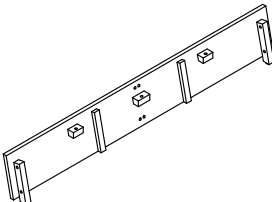
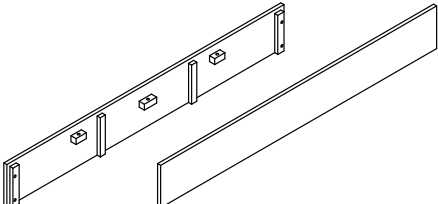
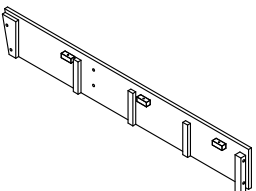
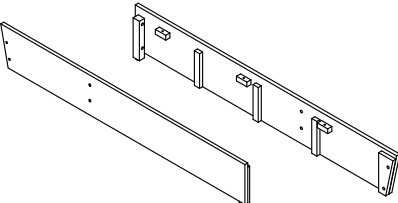

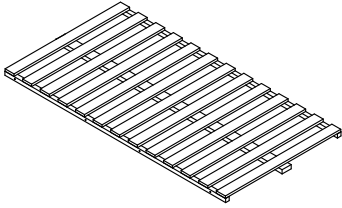
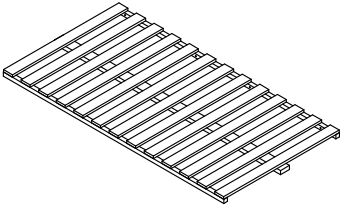
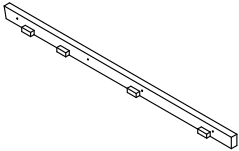
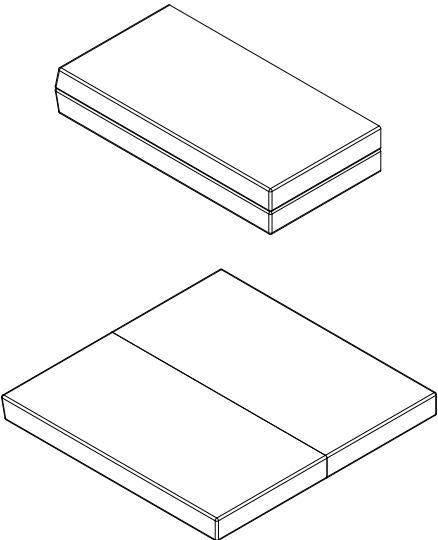
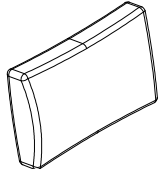


Caution: This Daybed is NOT a TOY.

two adults may be needed to execute these actions.

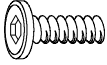
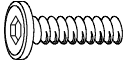
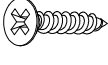
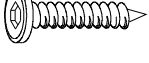
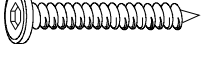

- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-



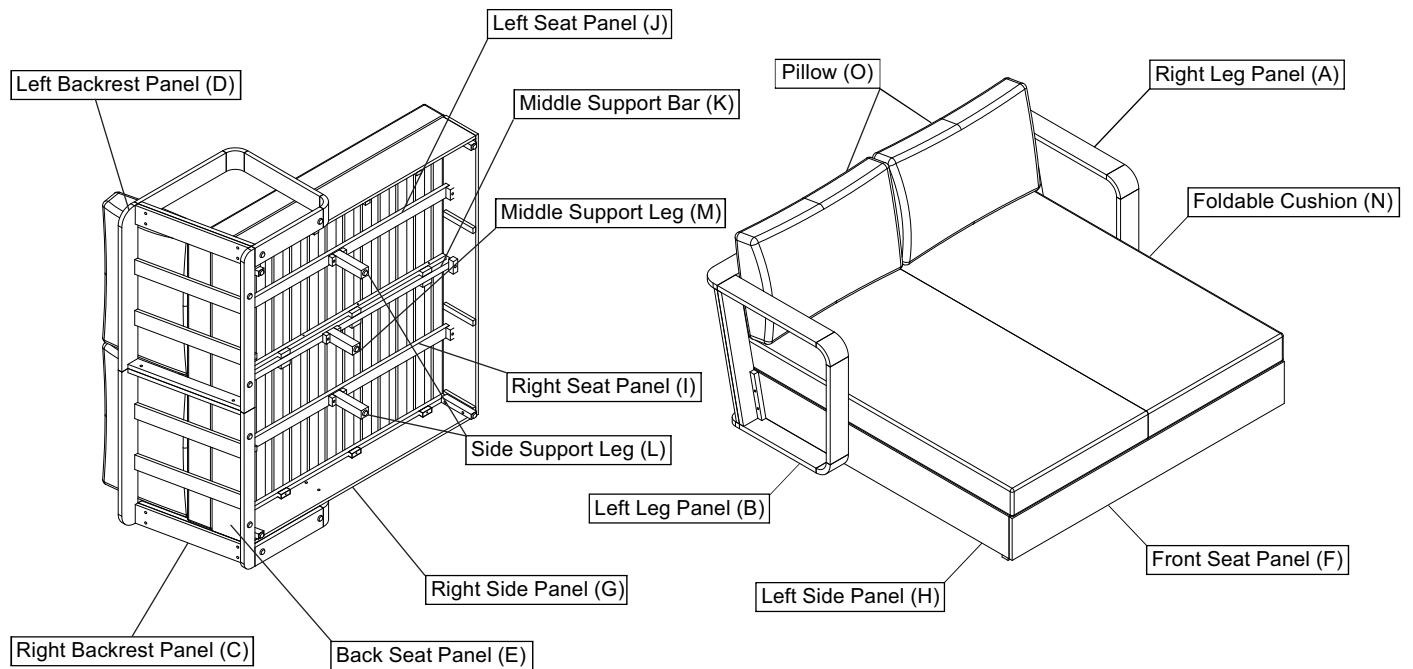
- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-

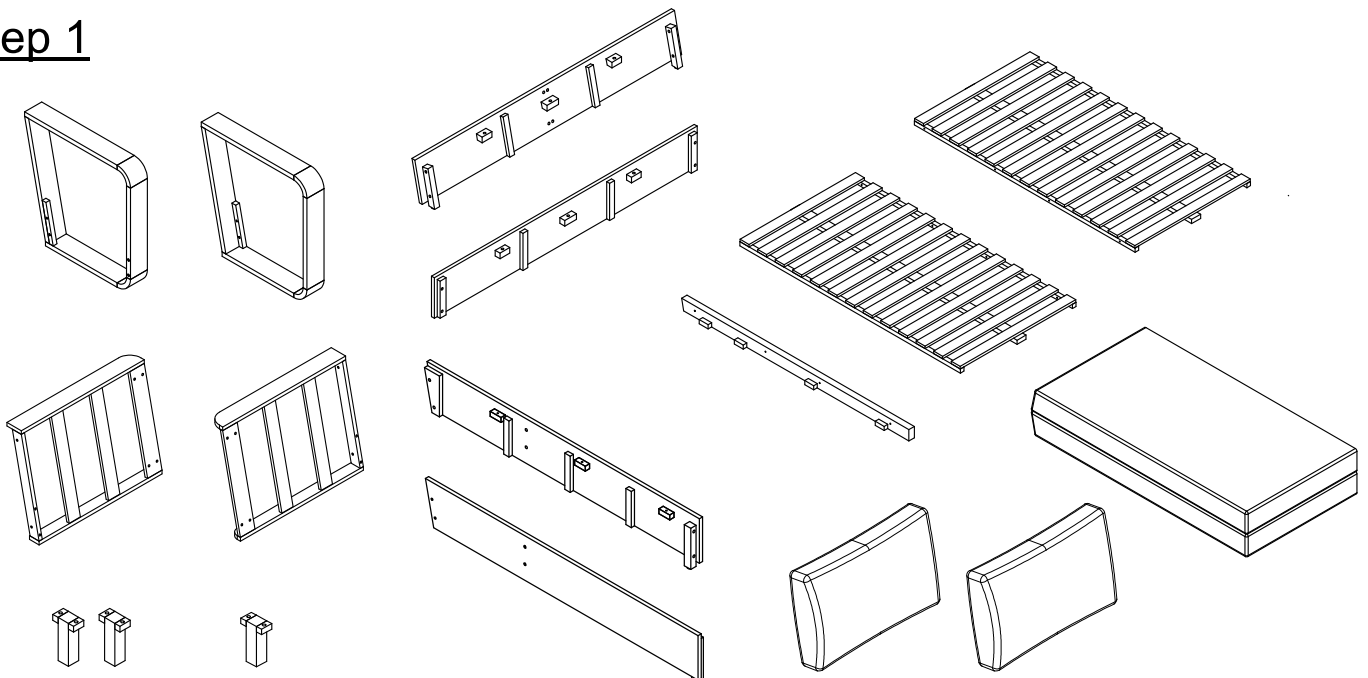
Overview



FRONT FACING

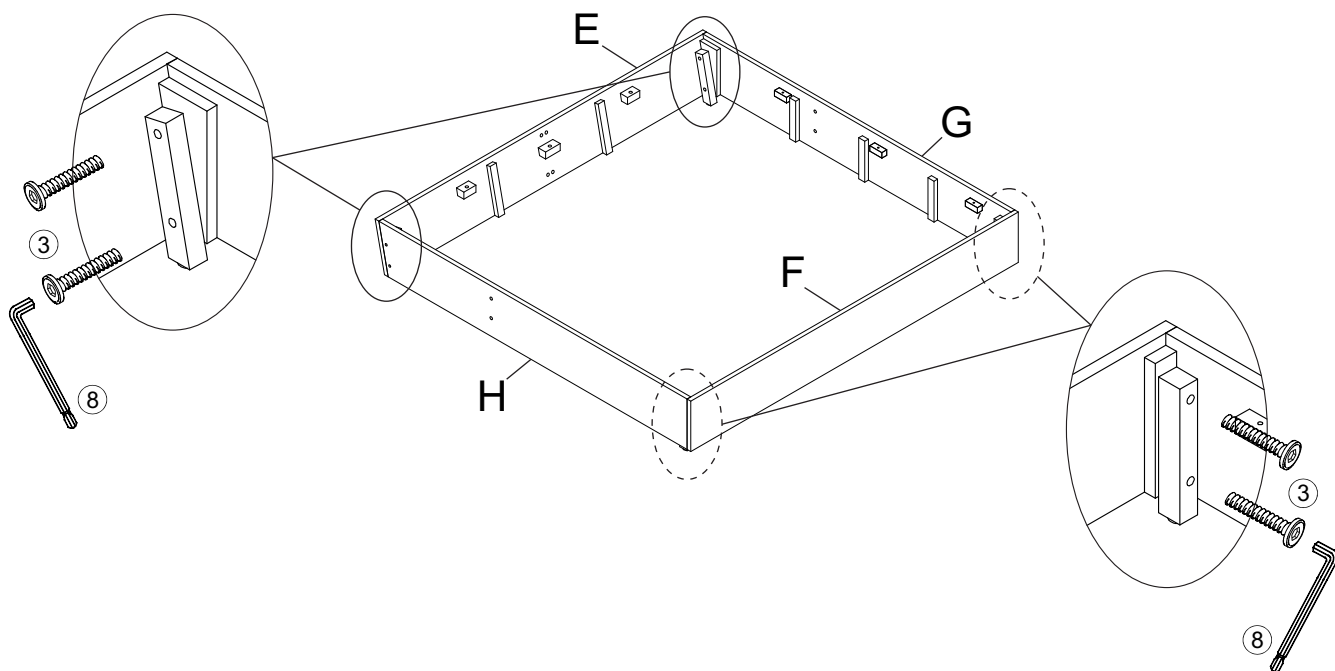
This Daybed has multiple parts and may require up to 45 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Daybed parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



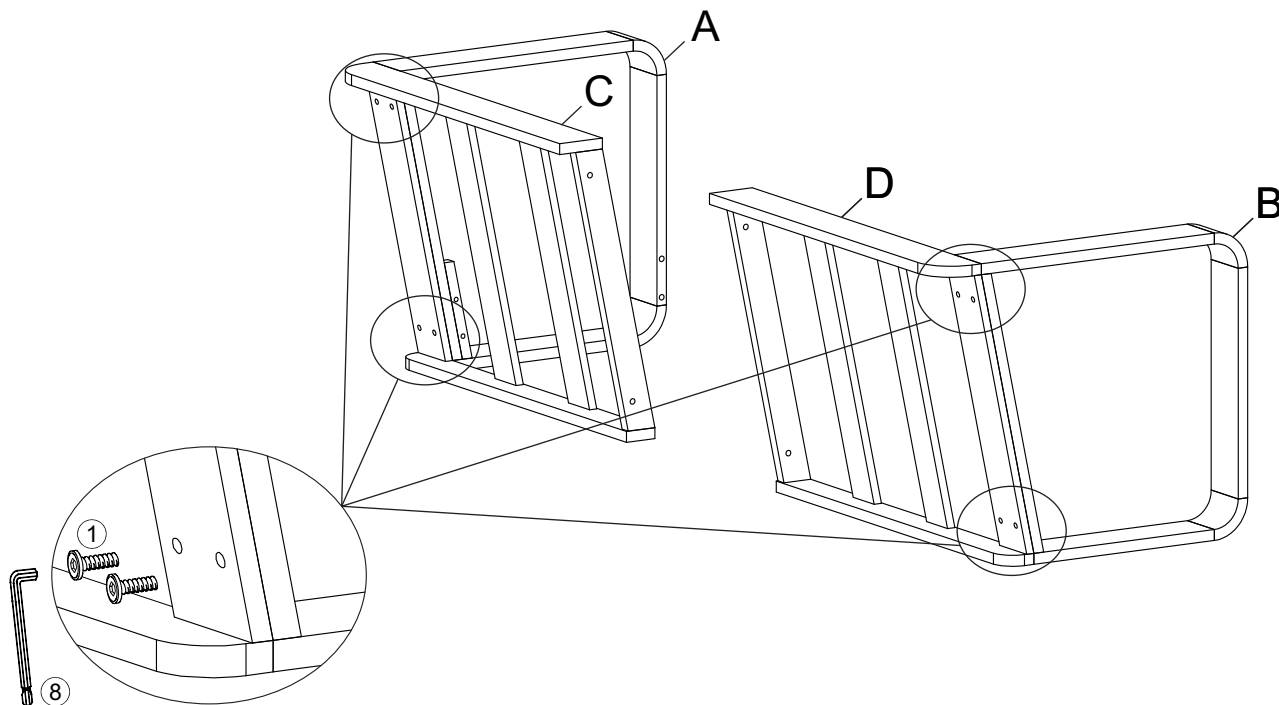
Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.

Step 2



Place the Back Seat Panel (E), Front Seat Panel (F), Right Side Panel (G) and Left Side Panel (H) on a clean, non-marring surface. Attach the Back Seat Panel (E), Front Seat Panel (F) to the Right Side Panel (G) and Left Side Panel (H) by using Bolts (③) with Allen Wrench (⑧) as shown above. **Do not fully tighten the bolts at this time.**

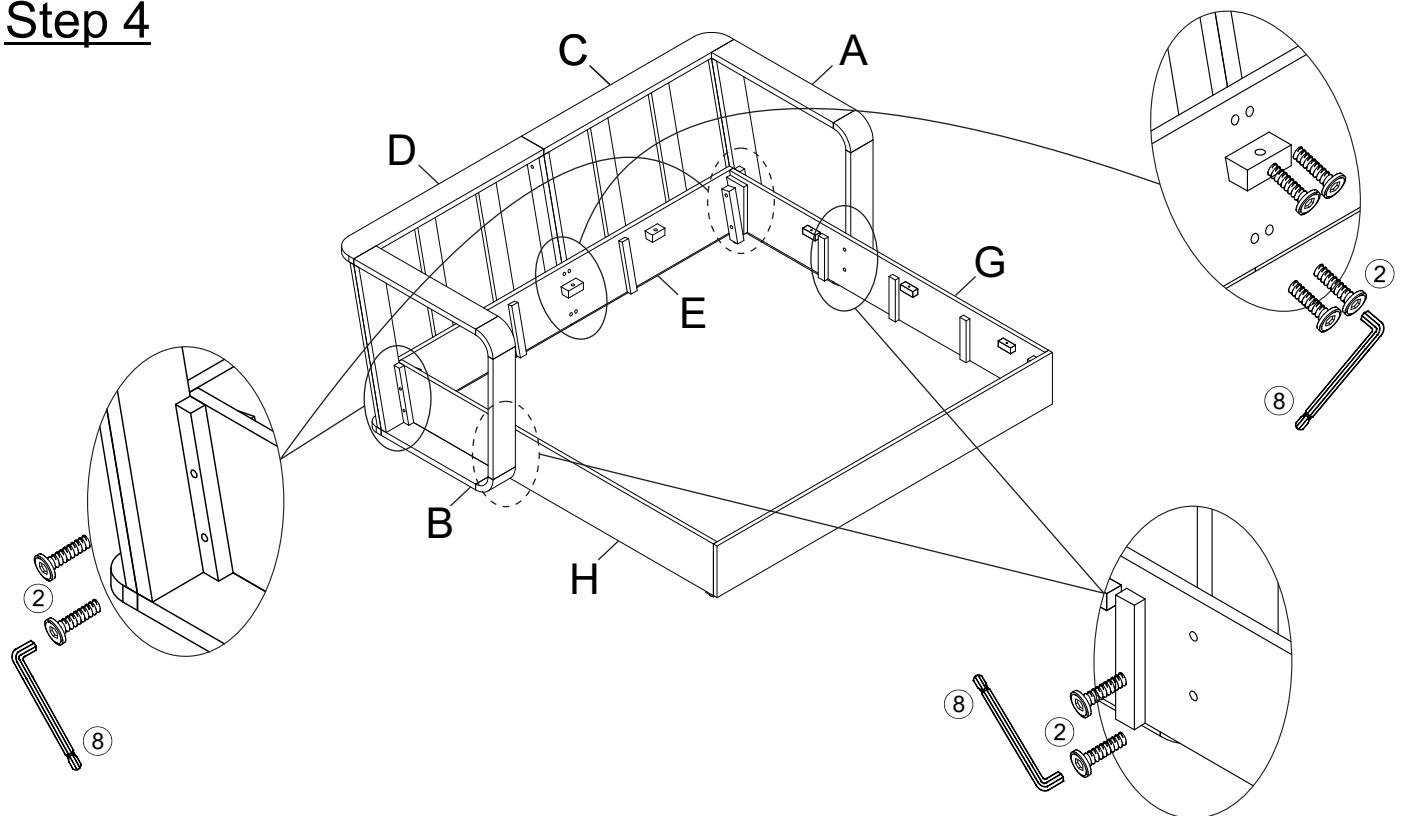
Step 3



With the help of your partner, attach the Right Backrest Panel (C) to the Right Leg Panel (A) and the Left Backrest Panel (D) to the Left Leg Panel (B) by using Bolts (①) with Allen Wrench (⑧) as shown above.

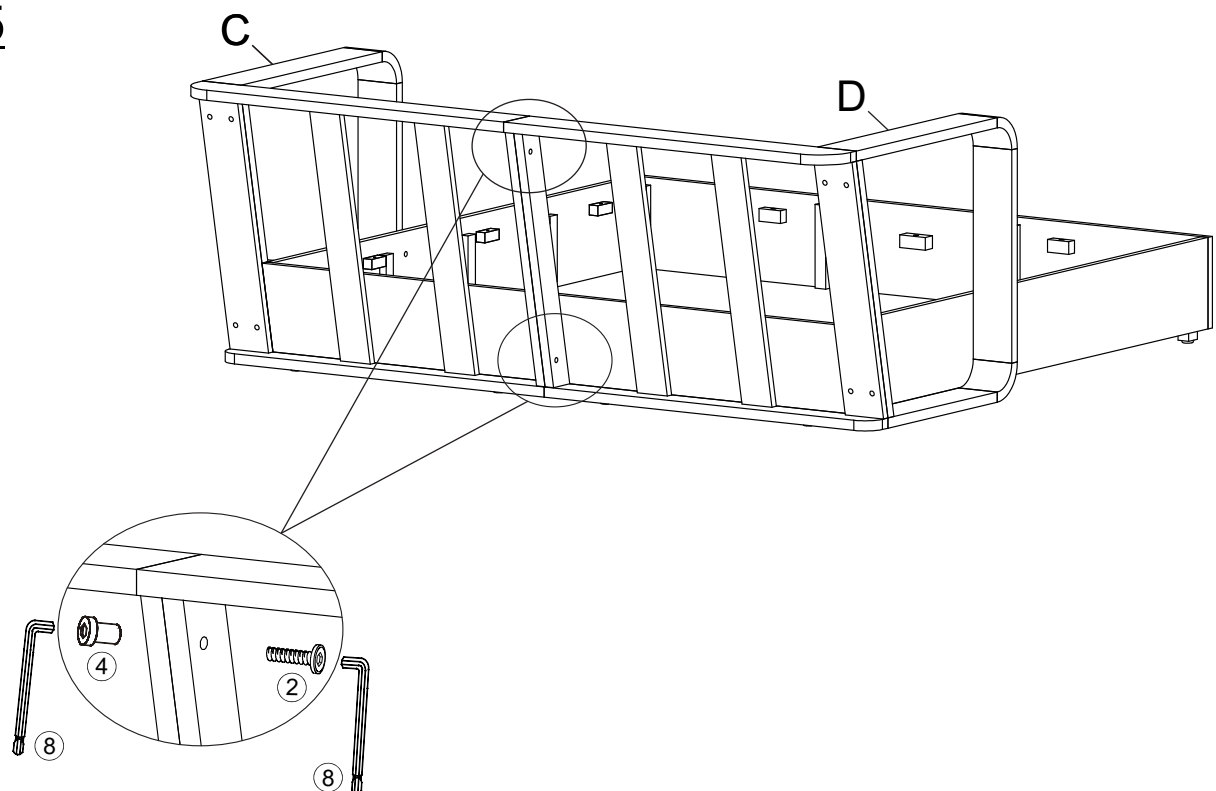
Do not fully tighten the bolts at this time.

Step 4



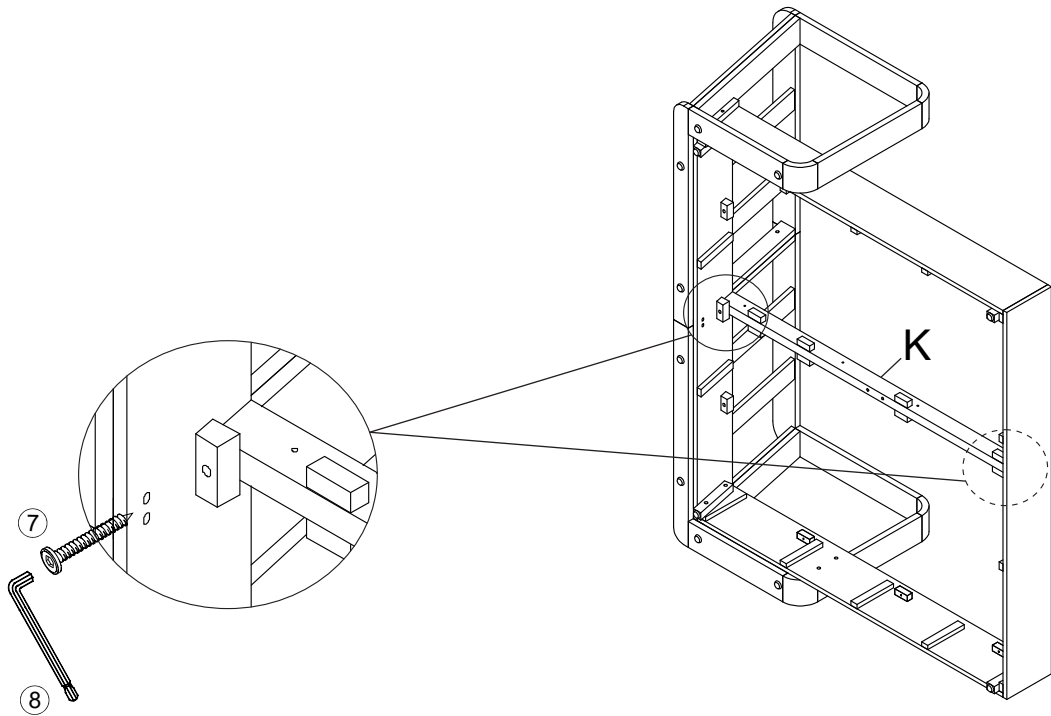
With the help of your partner, attach the Back Seat Panel (E) to the Right Backrest Panel (C) and the Left Backrest Panel (D), attach the Right Leg Panel (A) to the Right Side Panel (G) and the Left Leg Panel (B) to the Left Side Panel (H) by using Bolts (2) with Allen Wrench (8) as shown above. **Do not fully tighten the bolts at this time.**

Step 5



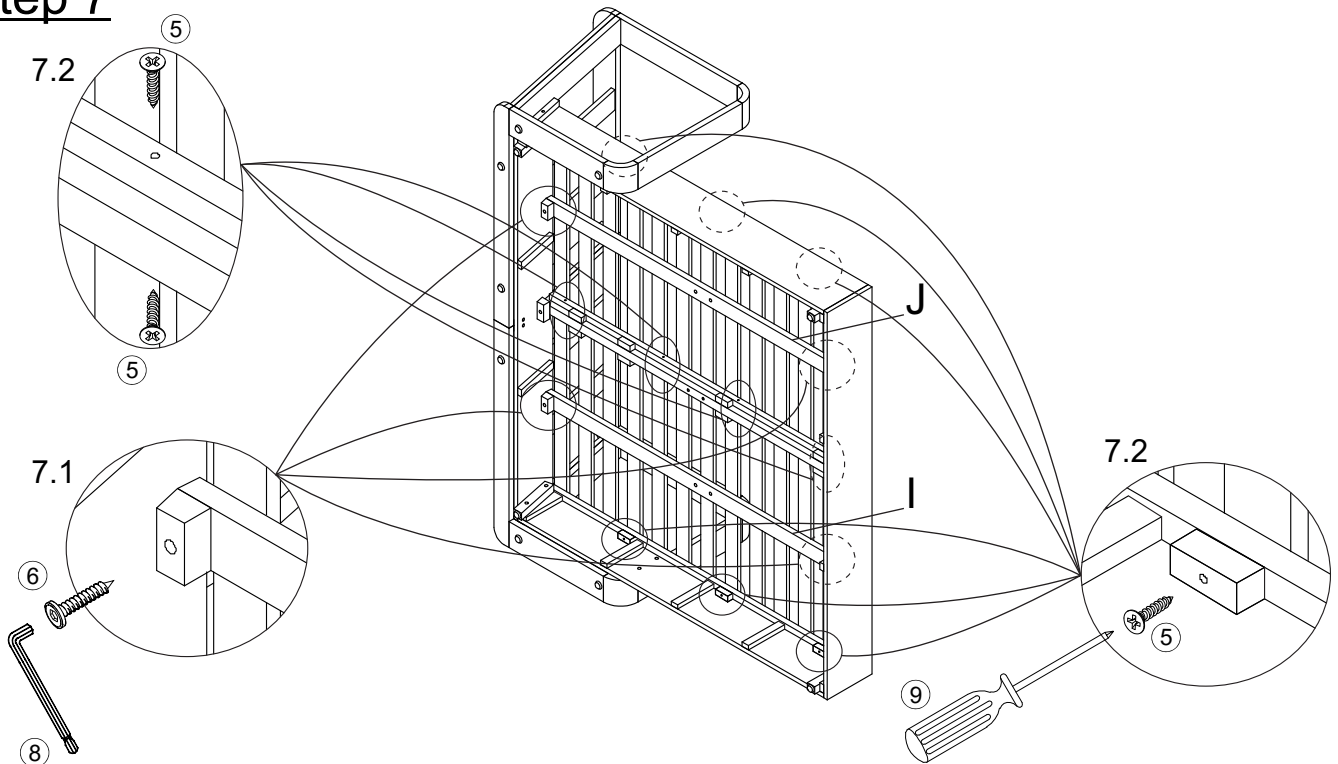
With the help of your partner, attach the Right Backrest Panel (C) to the Left Backrest Panel (D) using Bolts (2) and Sleeve Nuts (4) with Allen Wrench (8) as shown above. **Do not fully tighten the bolts at this time.**

Step 6



With the help of your partner, attach the Middle Support Bar (K) to the Back Seat Panel (E) and the Front Seat Panel (F) by using Screws (7) with Allen Wrench (8) as shown above.
Do not fully tighten the screws at this time.

Step 7



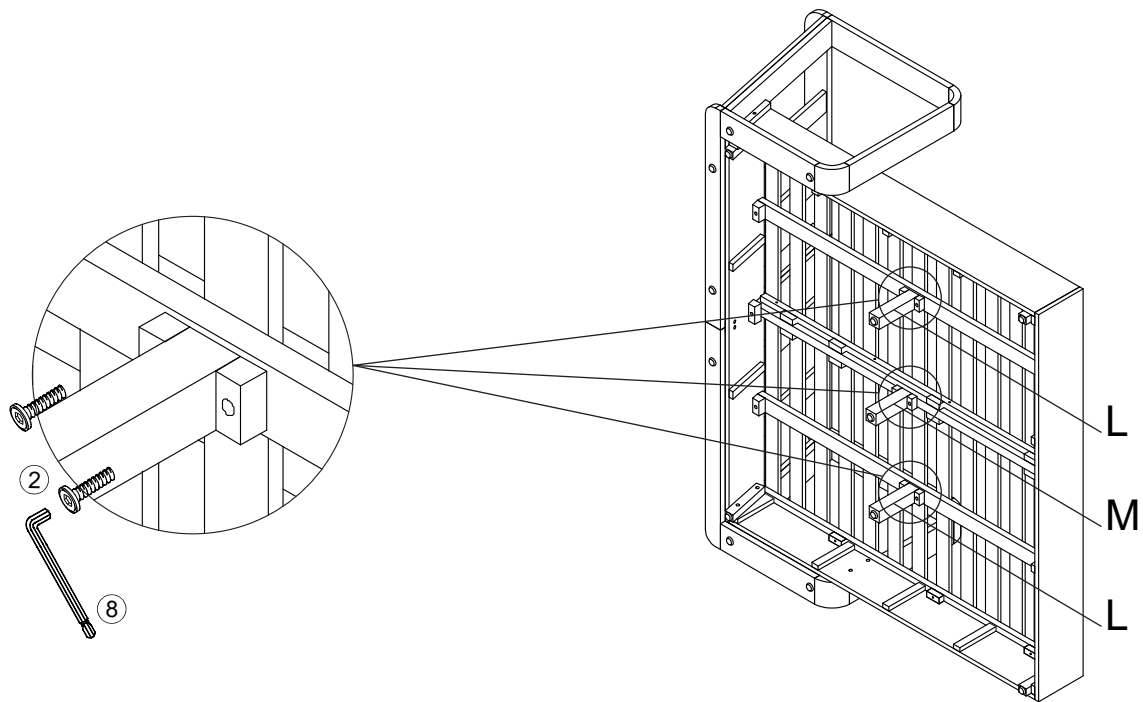
7.1 With the help of your partner, attach the Right Seat Panel (I) to the Back Seat Panel (E) and the Front Seat Panel (F) by using Screws (6) with Allen Wrench (8).

7.2 Attach the Right Seat Panel (I) to the Right Side Panel (G) and the Middle Support Bar (K) by using Screws (5) with Screwdriver (9) as shown above.

Repeat the same process in this step with Left Seat Panel (J).

Do not fully tighten the screws at this time.

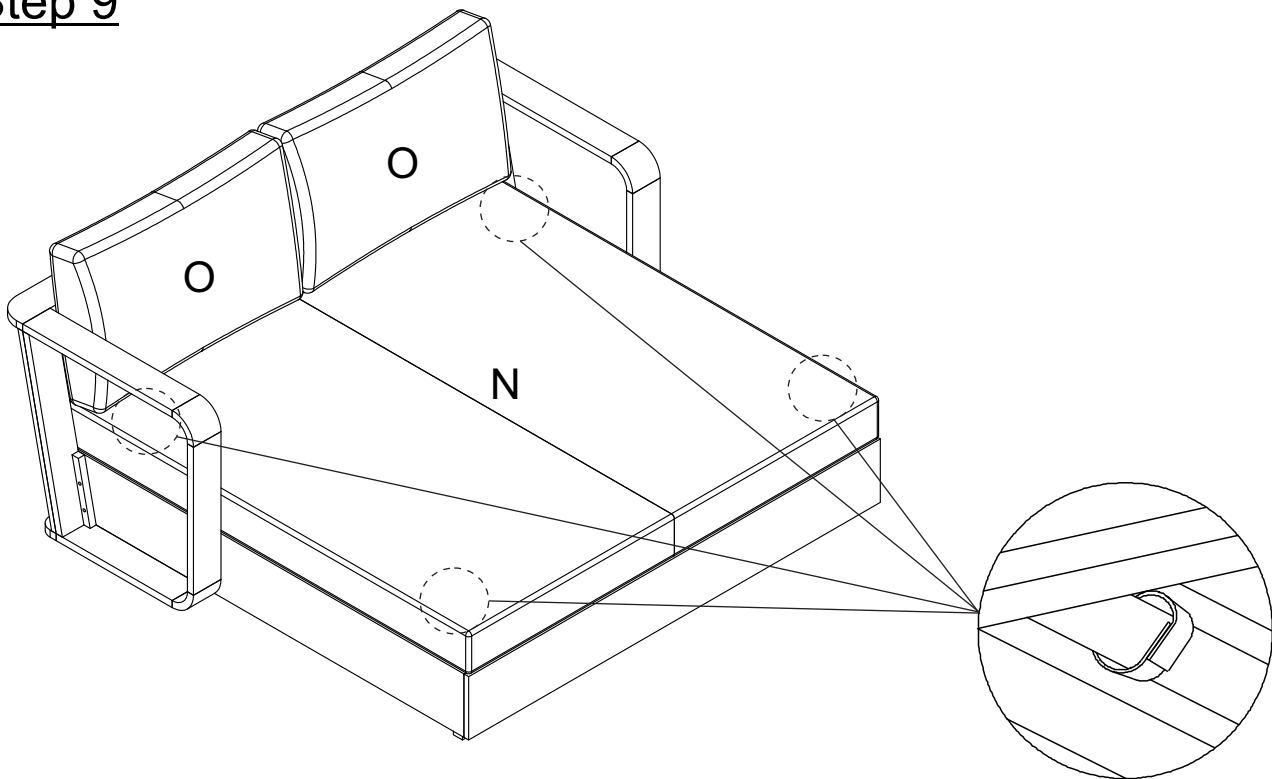
Step 8



With the help of your partner, attach the Middle Support Leg (M) to the Middle Support Bar (K) and attach the Side Support Legs (L) to Right Seat Panel (I) and Left Seat Panel (J) by using Bolts ((2)) with Allen Wrench ((8)) as shown above.

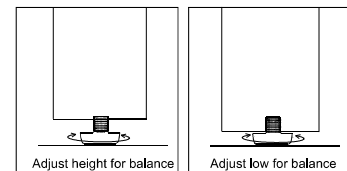
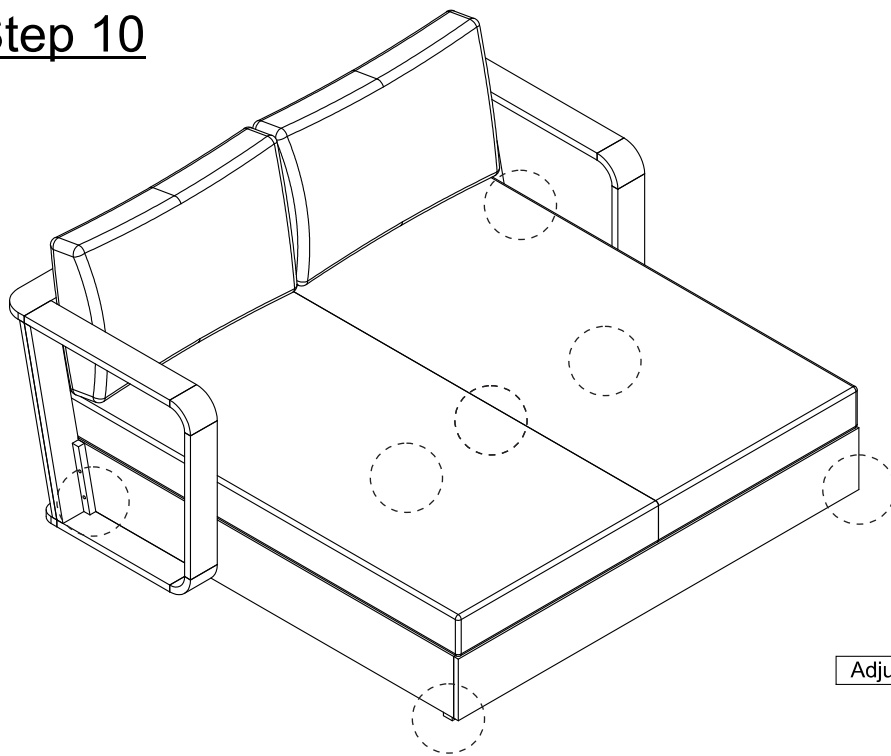
Do not fully tighten the bolts at this time.

Step 9



Place the Foldable Cushion (N) onto the Right Seat Panel (I), Left Seat Panel (J) and affix the magic tape around the slats of the Seat. Next, place the two Pillows (O) on the Seat Cushion as shown above.

Step 10



Adjust Pre-installed Levelers height for balance

EXPERT pressure, forwards, onto the Daybed with both your hands.
This Pressure will help the Legs and Daybed reach alignment at all joints.
In a sequence manner, gradually tighten all Bolts and Screws at all joints until evenly secured.
With assistance from your adult partners, turn the Daybed right side up.
Adjust the Pre-installed Levelers in Support Leg to desired height to avoid wobbles.

Your Daybed is ready for use.

This Daybed can only be used on a flat, level surface.

Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

• What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals. Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.

• What types of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list?

The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust.

• What does a warning mean?

If a warning is placed on a product label or posted or distributed at a workplace, a business, or in rental housing, the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing individuals to one or more listed chemicals.

By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
