- (2) Arm Rest
- (1) Back Assembly

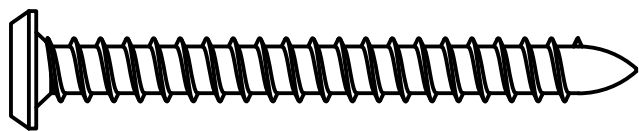
TOOLS REQUIRED

- Allen Wrench
(Included)
- Phillips Screw-Driver
(Not Included)

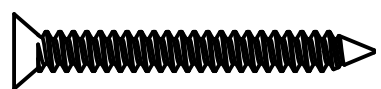
NOTE:

Do not use an impact driver to install hardware.
Use battery operated drill or provided Allen wrench

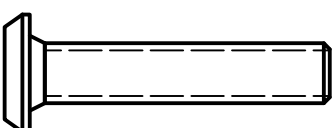
- (4) A - .273 x 2- $\frac{1}{2}$ " Hex Screw



- (4) B - 1- $\frac{1}{2}$ " Phillips Screw

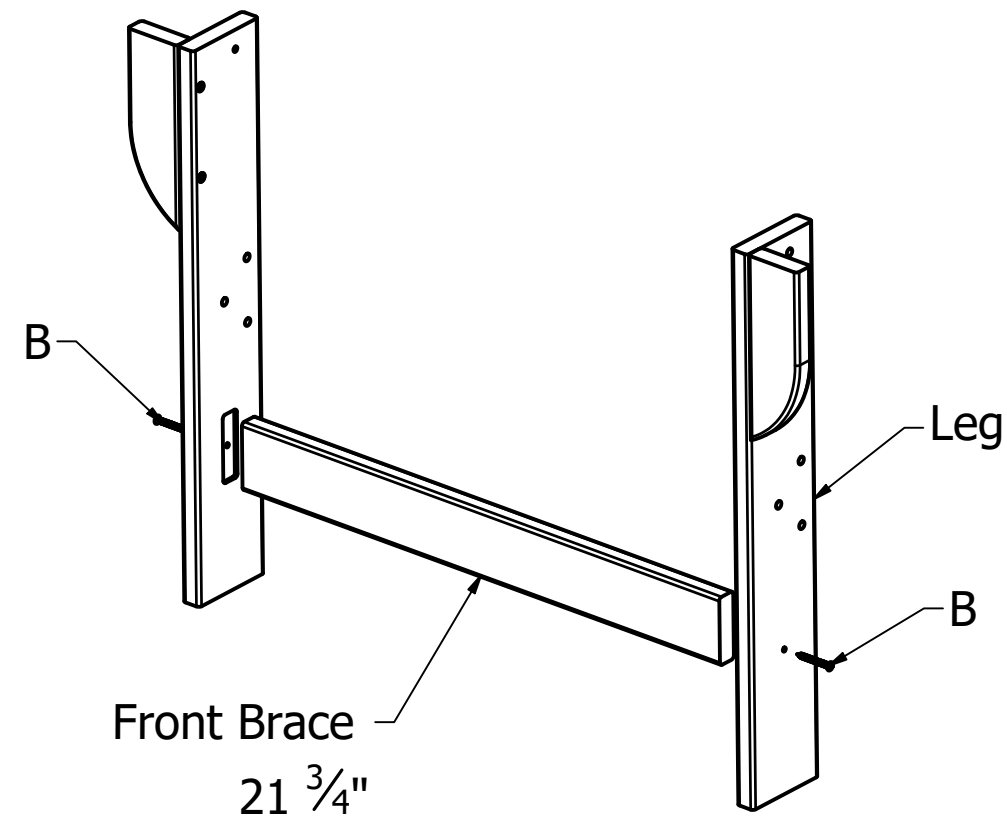


- (8) C - $\frac{1}{4}$ -20 x 1- $\frac{1}{4}$ " Machine Screw



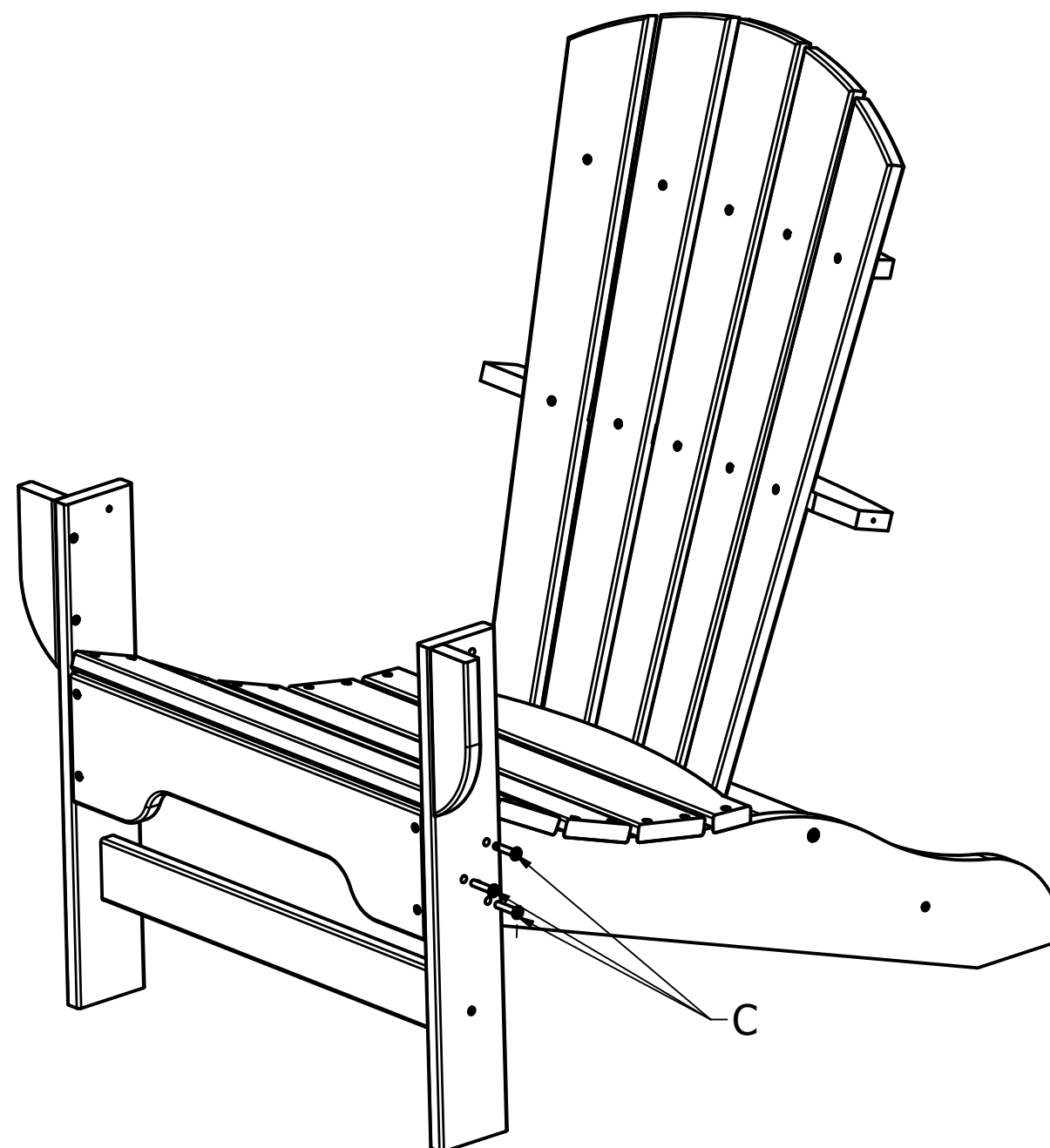
STEP 1:

Install front brace into leg slot and install using two (B) screws.



STEP 3:

Install the leg assembly on to the seat frame using six (C) screws.



STEP 2:

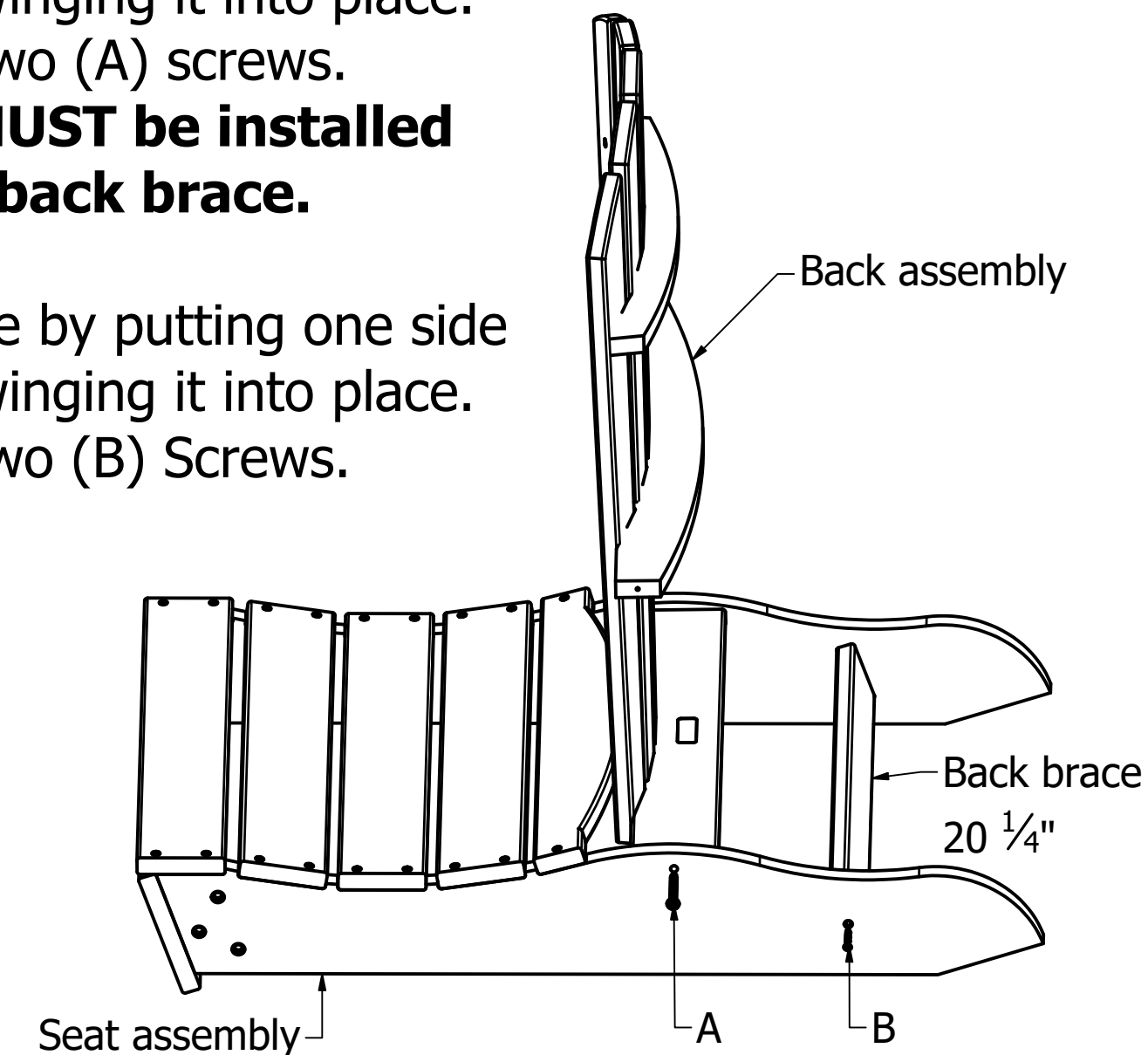
Lay seat frame on the ground.
Install the back frame by putting one side into the slot and swinging it into place.

Install using two (A) screws.

Back assembly MUST be installed before the back brace.

Install the back brace by putting one side into the slot and swinging it into place.

Install using two (B) Screws.



STEP 4:

Install the arm rests on to the chair using two (A) screws and two (C) screws
