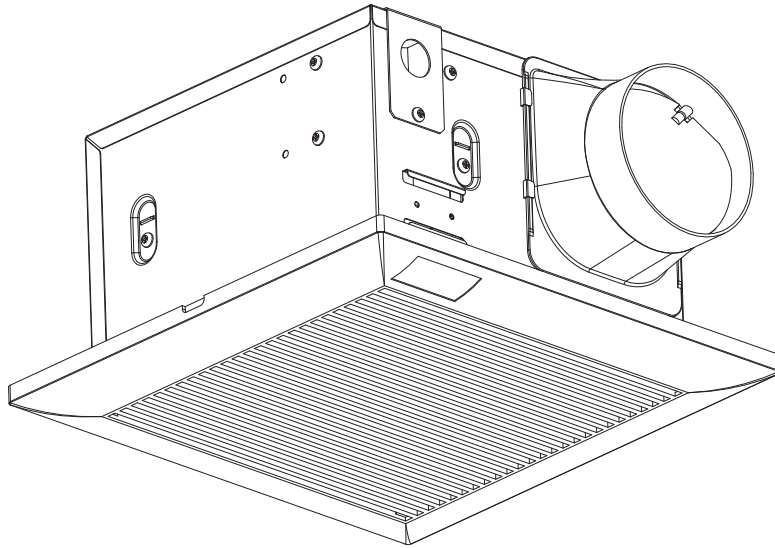

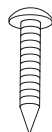
WARNING: TO REDUCE THE RISK OF FIRE, ELECTRIC SHOCK, OR INJURY TO PERSONS, OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING:

1. Installation work and electrical wiring must be done by qualified persons in accordance with all applicable codes and standard, including fire-rated construction.
2. Sufficient air is needed for proper combustion and exhausting of gases through the flue (chimney) of fuel burning-equipment to prevent back-drafting. Follow the heating equipment manufacturer's guideline and safety standards such as those published by the local code authorities.
3. When cutting or drilling into wall or ceiling, do not damage electrical wiring and other hidden utility.

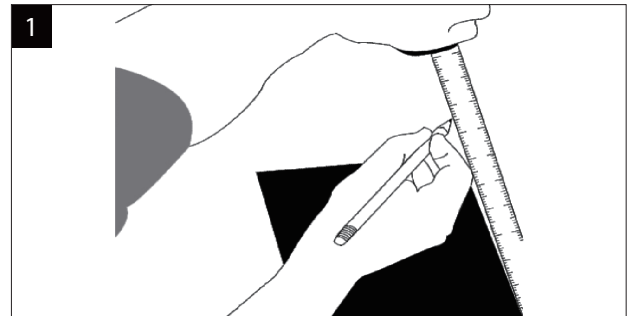

INSTALLATION

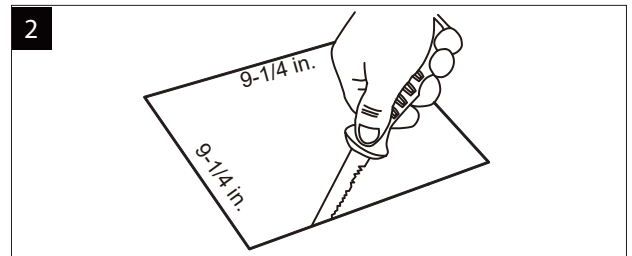
1. Remove existing fan.

Measure the opening to ensure it is large enough to accommodate the new fan housing.(Housing size :9" x 9")



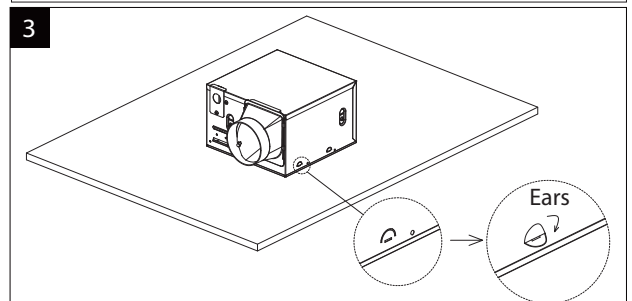
2. Cut the ceiling opening

If this fan is not replacing an old fan, be sure to cut a 9-1/4" x 9-1/4" opening for the fan housing.



3. Insert the fan housing through the existing hole in the ceiling.

Then bend the four ears to place the fan housing on the ceiling. The fan housing should be level and perpendicular to the joist.

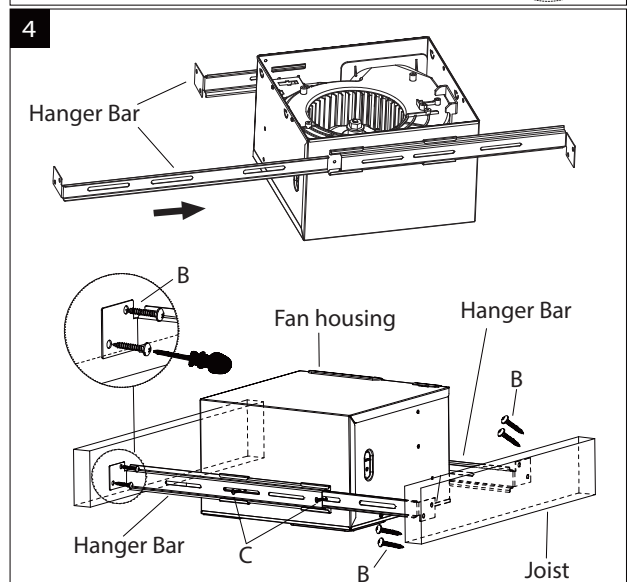


4. Install hanger bars

Install sliding hanger bars onto the fan housing by inserting the hanger bars into the hanger bar support guide rail.

After adjusting the installation length of the hanger bars, using wood screws(B), attach the end tab of the hanger bar to the framing.

Using hanger bar positioning screws(C), attach the hanger bar onto the fan housing.

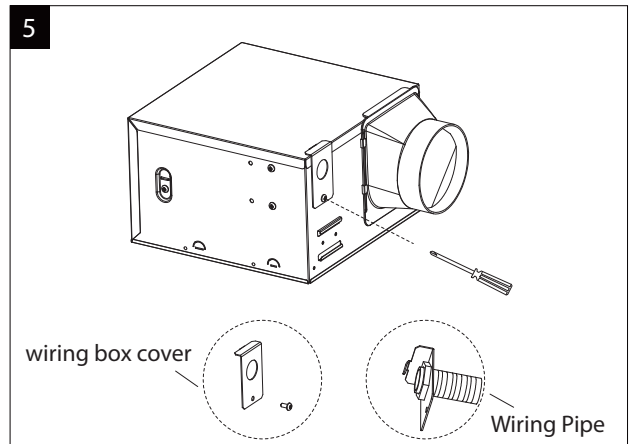

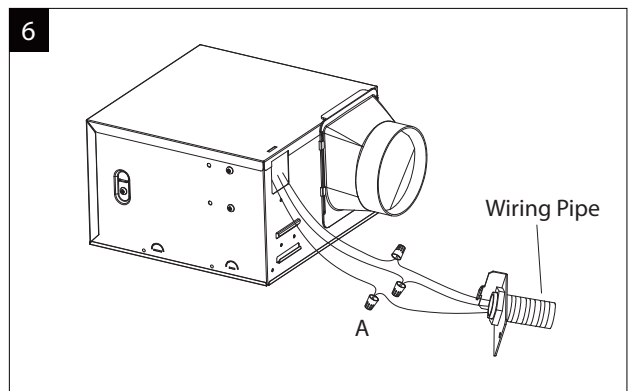

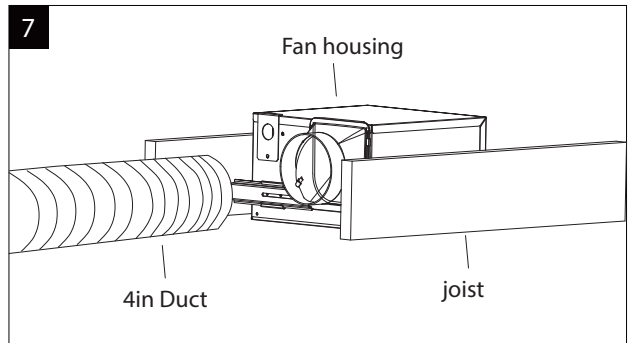
5. Loosen the screw to remove the wiring box cover.
Install the wiring pipe into the wiring hole.



6. Connect the white wire of the fan to the neutral wire.
Connect the green wire of the fan to the ground wire.
Connect the black wire of the fan to the hot wire.



7. Attach the duct connector to the fan housing.
Connect a 4 in. circular duct to the duct connector on the fan housing ,
securing it with duct tape or a clamp. Vent the duct to the outside.
Finish ceiling work.
The ceiling hole should be aligned with the edge of the fan housing.



8. Attach grille by pinching the mounting springs and inserting them into the narrow rectangular slots in the fan housing.
Turn on power source. Test the unit.
