
2.2M Garden Arch Instruction Manual

General information and safety warnings

- Wear gloves whilst assembling and disassembling.
- Do not hammer the stakes and arms,
- Do not exert too much force in case it alters the shape of the arch.
- Make sure that the stakes are inserted approximately 5 inches into the soil directly into the prepared ground. It is a good idea for stability to sprinkle some light gravel or pebbles around the trellis and plant on top of the soil.
- Do not use in adverse weather.
- Do not allow children to play with the trellis.
- Not suitable for commercial purposes.
- Make sure that the growth of the plants used are kept tightly pruned especially during windy seasons autumn and winter. If hardy plants are chosen, this will encourage fresh growth in the spring and add security to the arch.




Assembly


- Ensure that you have all parts as listed above.
- Remove all packaging and dispose of correctly.
- We recommend that 2 people assemble this garden arch.

1. Connect curved poles (A & B) together. Repeat this step twice so you


have 2 curved poles.




2. Connect the 2 curved poles together using poles (C) and secure with screws (F). The 2^{nd} person will need to support the weight of the top curved pole.



3. Connect 2 panels (D) together using screws and bolts (H). Repeat this step twice.



4. Lying on the ground, connect the large arched section to the panels using screws and bolts (H). Ensure that the arch is completely secure before standing upright and inserting into the ground.
