



UKTR / EUTR Supplier Timber Declaration

Regulation (EU) No 995/2010 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 October 2010 laying down the obligations of operators who place timber and timber products on the EU market (EUTR).

The EU Timber Regulation (EUTR) came into force on 3rd March 2013, making it illegal to place illegally harvested timber and timber products on the EU market. On 1st January 2021, EUTR became UK domestic legislation as the UK Timber Regulations (UKTR) which has similar requirements as the EU system it replaced.

As a supplier to Wayfair, we confirm and commit to only supply timber and timber containing products from legal and sustainable sources that don't cause deforestation or degradation. The UK Timber Regulations (UKTR) prohibits placing illegally harvested timber on the market and covers a broad range of timber products.

All our suppliers of timber, timber containing product are required to sign this statement agreeing to only supply timber from legal and sustainable sources according to UKTR.
