





ASSEMBLY PREPARATION

- 1. Remove all packaging materials, staples and packing straps from the carton.
- 2. Refer to Parts List and Hardware List, and ensure parts and hardware are complete before assembly.
- 3. Contact customer service for missing parts.
- 4. Place all wooden parts on a clean, flat and soft surface (e.g. carpet or rug) to prevent parts from getting scratched.

SAFETY PRECAUTION

- 1. KEEP ALL HARDWARE PARTS OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.
- 2. DISPOSE PLASTIC PACKAGING MATERIAL IMMEDIATELY TO AVOID ANY RISK OF SUFFOCATION TO CHILDREN AND ANIMALS.

TIPS FOR ASSEMBLY

- 1. Allow ample room for assembly and in close proximity to where product will be placed.
- 2. Assemble the product on a surface that does not scratch or damage the exterior gloss and finish of the furniture.
- 3. Identify all of the parts, hardware and quantities required for each step.
- 4. During assembly, do not over-tighten any fittings as this may cause damage.
- 5. DO NOT USE POWER TOOLS TO ASSEMBLE THIS PRODUCT.
- 6. Always place the product on a flat, level surface.
- 7. Do not sit or stand on the partially assembled product; only use the product for which it is intended.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Use a slightly damp cloth to clean the product. Do not use bleach or abrasive cleaning material.
- Check all the fittings periodically and re-tighten as necessary. Do not use the product if any of the parts is damaged or broken.
- Never allow any kind of liquid to remain on your furniture. Absorption can cause wood to warp or delaminate.
- Do not place hot items (e.g. hot drinks) directly onto the wood surface.
- Do not drag and/or pull the furniture.







- a) Place Shelf (C) as shown on a material that does not scratch or damage the part.
- b) Refer to Drawing 1A Fit Leg (B, D & E) to attach to Shelf (C) and align the bolt hole on each leg to the respective bolt hole on (C).
- c) Refer to Drawing 1B Use Bolt (1A) fitted with Spring Washer (1B) and Flat Washer (1C) to fasten (B & D) to (C). Use Allen Key (2) to drive (1A). Do not tighten (1A) completely at this time.


STEP 2 - INSTALL TABLE TOP



- a) Place Table Top (A) bottom-side up on a material that does not scratch or damage the part.
- b) Refer to Drawing 2A Insert the tenon-end of Leg (B) to fit into the mortise on (A), and attach Leg (D & E) to the left and right edges of (A & C), respectively.
- c) Refer to Drawing 1B Use Bolt (1A) fitted with Spring Washer (1B) and Flat Washer (1C) to fasten legs (B, D & E) to (A). Use Allen Key (2) to drive (1A). Tighten (1A) completely but do not over-tighten.

STEP 3 - Fasten Leg (D & E) to Shelf (C)



- a) Refer to Drawing 3B Fasten horizontal plate of Angle Bracket (4A) to the rim (top edge) of Shelf (C) next to Leg (E) using Screw (4B).
 - Note: Do not fasten the vertical plate of Angle Bracket (4A) to Leg (E) at this time.
- b) Fasten horizontal plate of Angle Bracket (4A) to the rim (top edge) of Shelf (C) next to Leg (D). Note: Do not fasten the vertical plate of Angle Bracket (4A) to Leg (D) at this time.
- c) Check and adjust Shelf (C) gently to ensure it is level and even, and then tighten Bolt (1A) completely on (C) that is not completely tighten in STEP 1c.
- d) Check and adjust Shelf (C) gently to ensure it is level and even again and use Screw (4B) to fasten the vertical plate of Angle Bracket (4A) to Leg (D & E). Tighten the screws completely at this time.
- e) Refer to Drawing 3A Use Screw (4B) to fasten Angle Plate (4A) to Leg (B) and Shelf (C).
- f) Refer to Drawing 3C Use Screw (3E) fitted with Washer (3B) to fasten Strap (3C) to the straight-back of Table Top (A) as shown.
- g) Set the Console Table right-side up.

The assembly of the Console Table is complete.

STEP 4 - Secure Console Table Do not ignore this step

- a) Select the location to place the console table.
- b) Drill a hole in the dry wall that would fit Anchor (3D) snugly.
- c) Push in or use a mallet to lightly tap in the Anchor (3D). Ensure that the anchor fits securely in the wall.
- d) Use Screw (3F) fitted with Washer (3A) to screw through Strap (3C) to screw into Anchor (3D).
