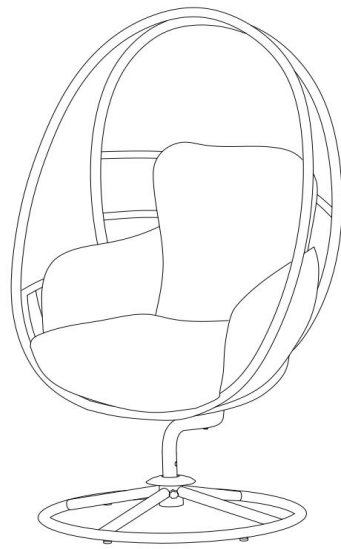

## Care & Maintenance

- ⊘  ● Not for commercial use. For residential use only.
- ⊘  ● Prolonged exposure to rain may cause rusting which can stain floors.
- ⊘  ● Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.
- ⊘  ● Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
- ✓  ● To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.
- ⊘  ● Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
- ⊘  ● Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
- ✓  ● To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.
- ⊘  ● Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.
- ✓  ● Keep away from sources of ignition.
- ✓  ● Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.





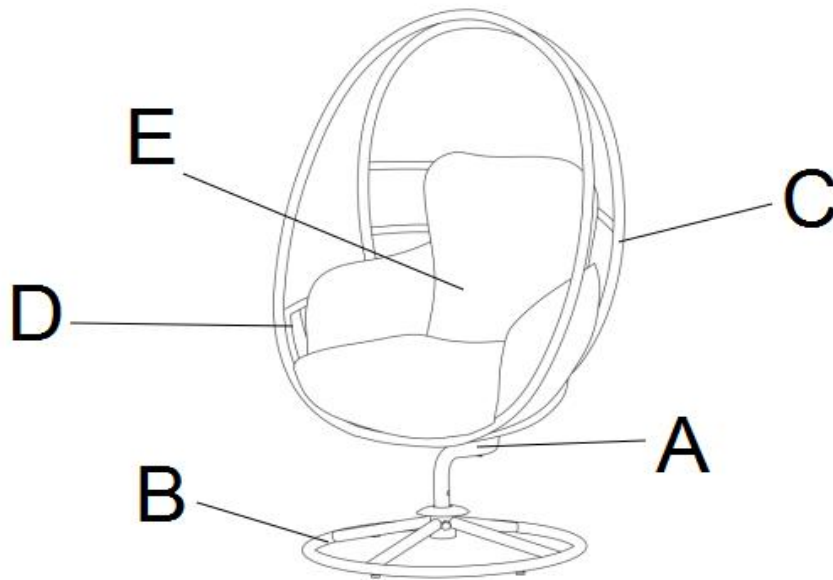
- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-

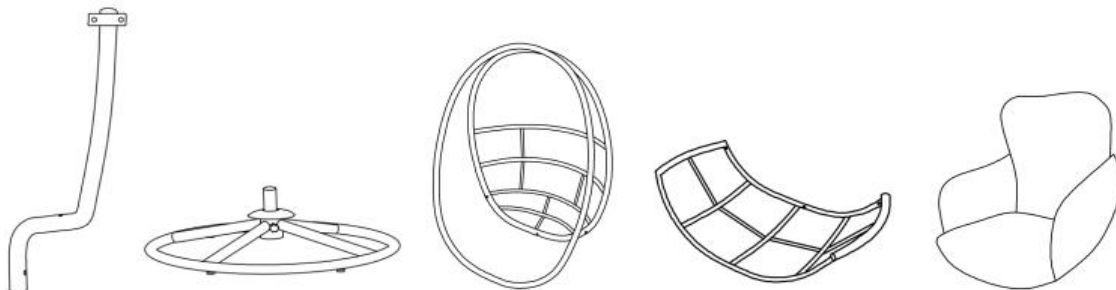
## Assembly Steps

### Overview



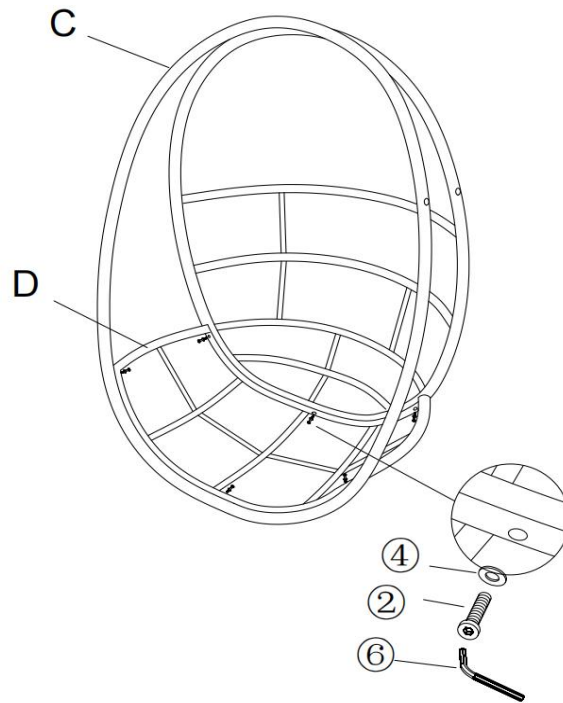
This swivel chair has multiple parts and may require up to 10 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the various parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

### Step 1



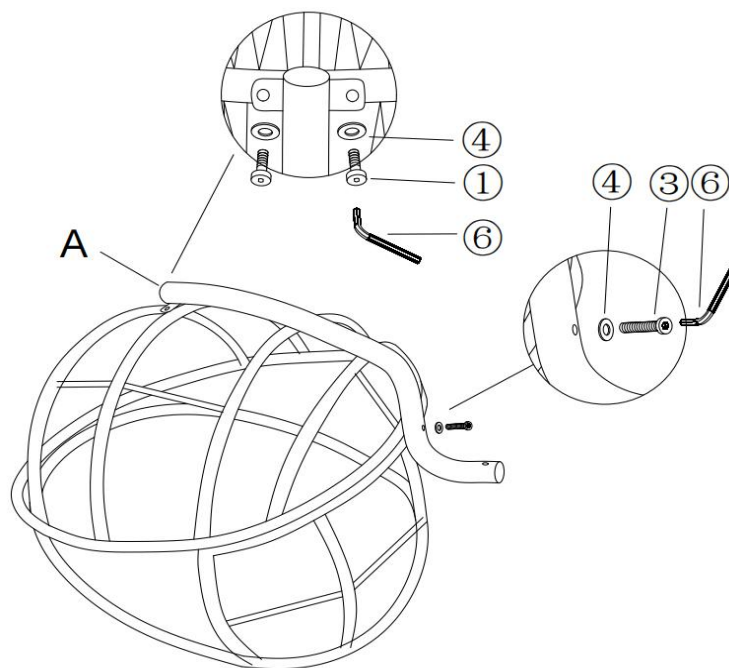
Unpack and place all parts on a clean, soft surface.

## Step 2



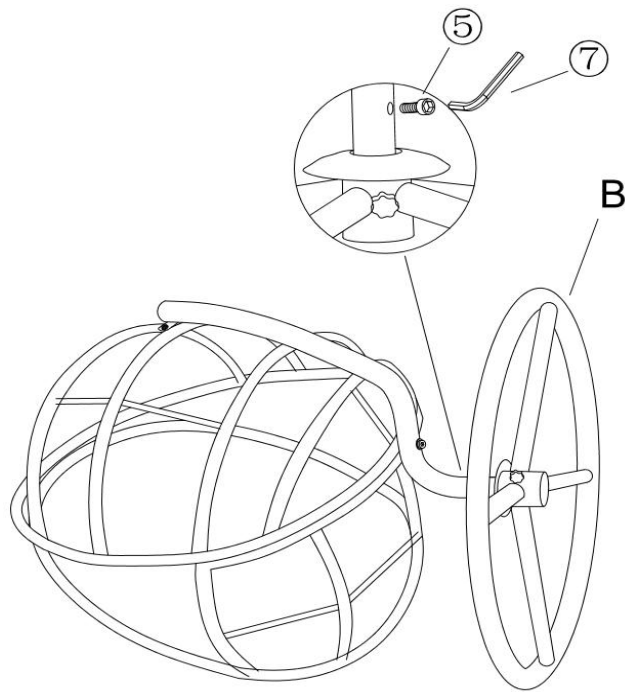
Place the Basket Frame(C) and Basket Front Part(D) on a clean, non-marring surface. Attach Basket Frame(C) and Basket Front Part(D) using Washer(④), and Bolts(②) with Allen Wrench(⑥). Fully tighten the Bolts.

## Step 3



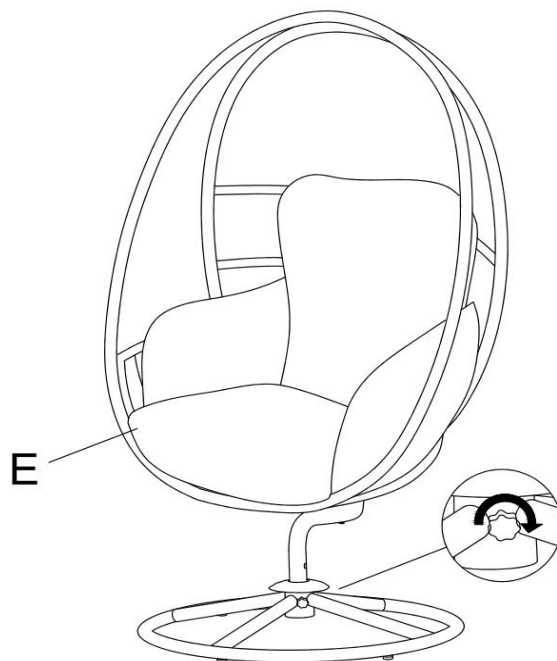
Attach Pole (A) and Basket Frame(C) using Washer(④), and Bolts(①) with Allen Wrench(⑥) and using Washer(④), and Bolts(③) with Allen Wrench(⑥). Fully tighten the Bolts.

## Step 4



Attach Pole (A) and Base(B) using Bolts(⑤) with Allen Wrench(⑦).  
Fully tighten the Bolts.

## Step 5



Put Cushion(E) and fix the cushion to the chair using belt of the cushion.  
The screw of the base can be controlled the speed of the swiveling.
