Please follow all instructions and install the tip-over restraints provided.

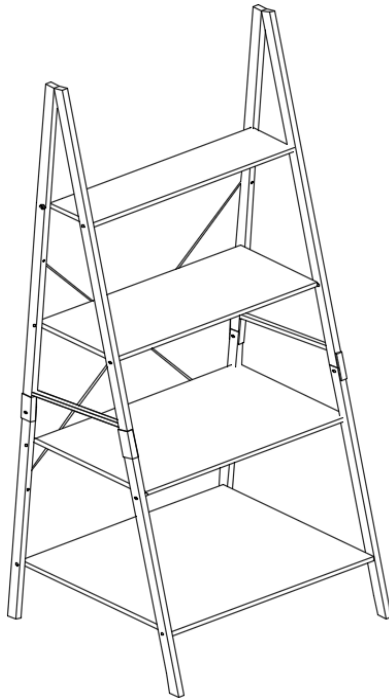
In addition to installing the restraints, to help prevent tip-over:

- 3. Do not step on the Bookshelf base.**

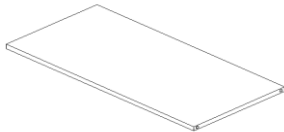

- Read instructions, cover to cover-

- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-



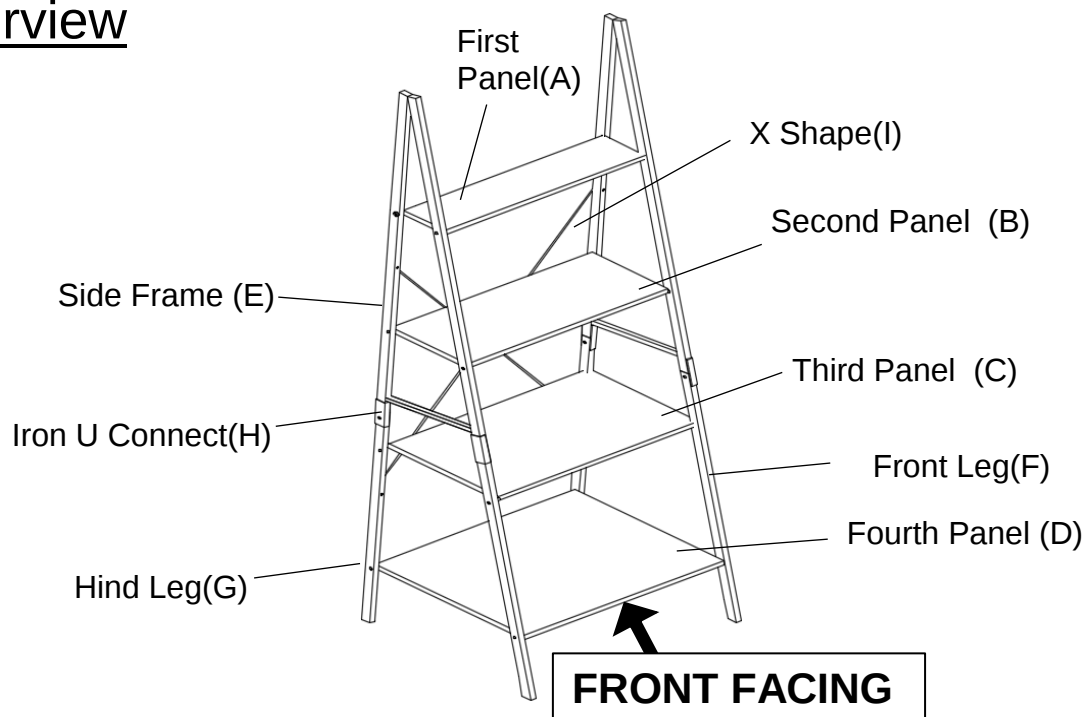
- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-

Assembly Steps

Overview

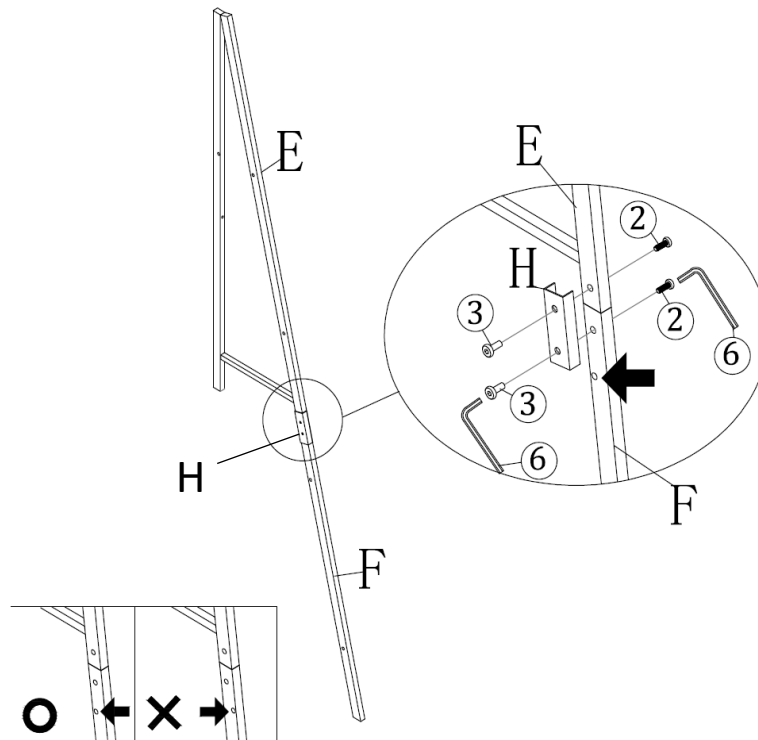


This bookshelf has several parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble.

To give you an overview of the bookshelf parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective.

Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1

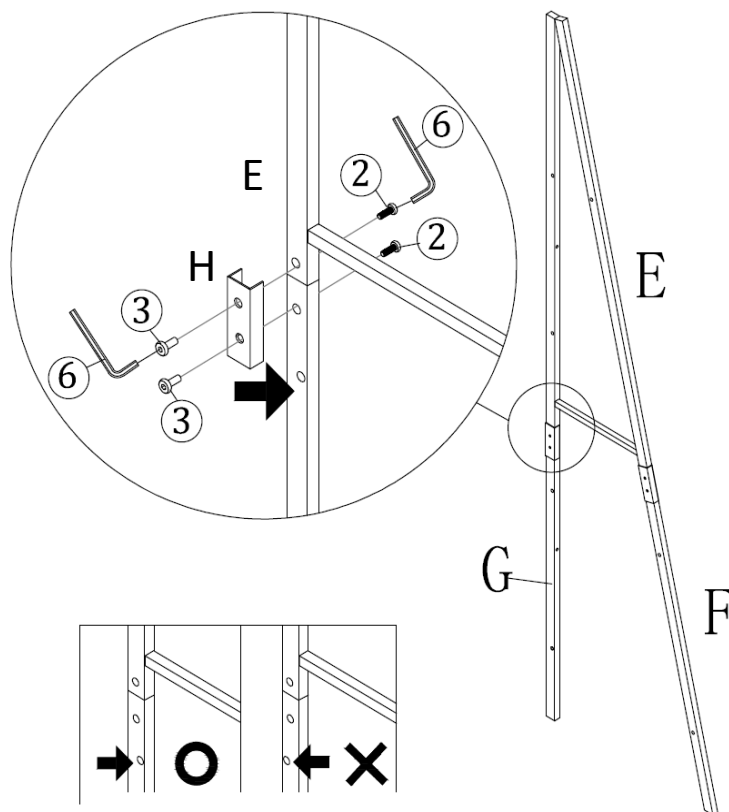


Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.

Attach one end of the Front Legs (F) to the bottom end of Side Frame(E) by hand. Use Iron U Connect(H) them with Bolt(②) and Sleeve Nut (③) by Allen Key(⑥)

Do not fully tighten the Bolts at this time.

Step 2

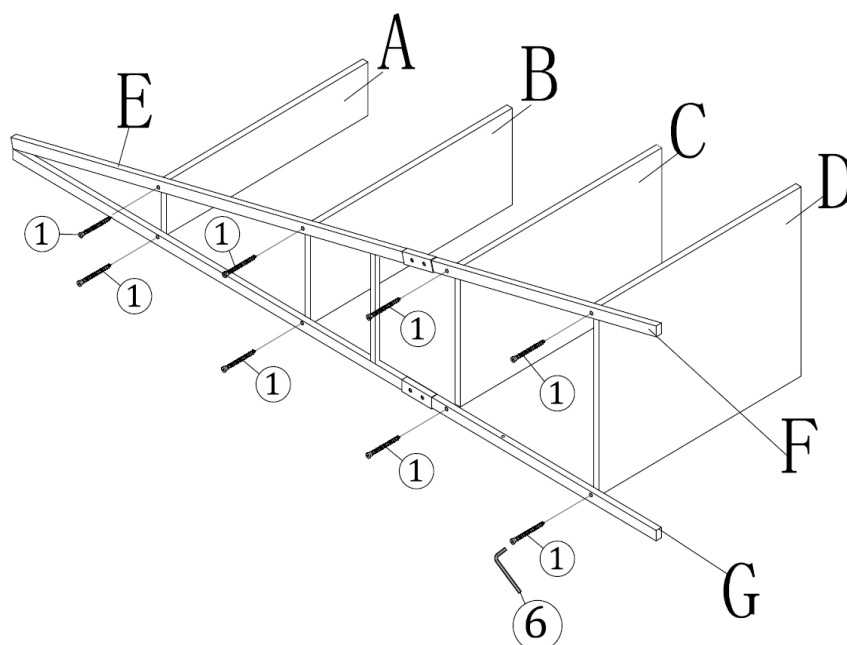


Attach one end of the Hind Leg (G) to the bottom end of Side Frame(E) by hand.

Use Iron U Connect(H) them with Bolt(②) and Sleeve Nut (③) by Allen Key(⑨). Repeat Step1 and Step2 to assemble another Front Leg(F) and Hind Leg(G) to bottom of another Side Frame(E) .

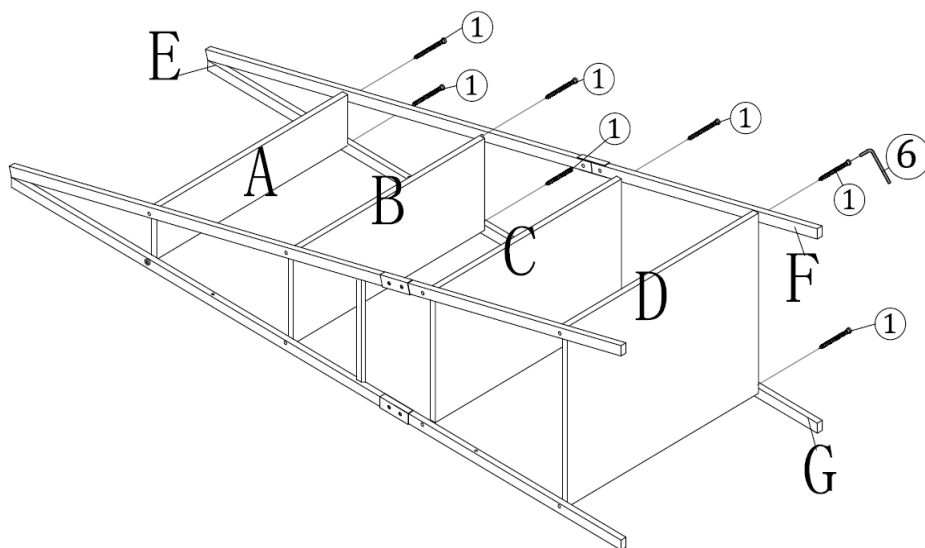
Do not fully tighten the Bolts at this time.

Step 3



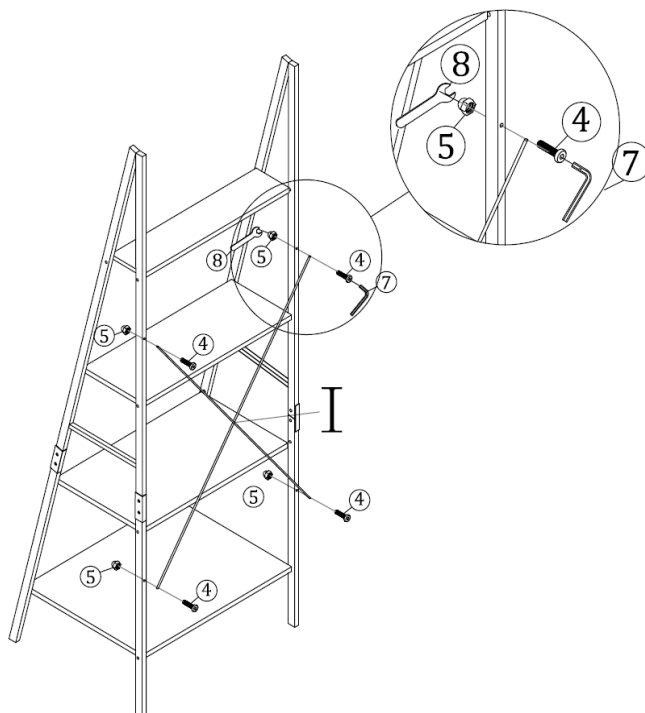
Connect the First Panel(A), Second Panel(B), Third Panel(C) and Fourth Panel(D) to one Side Frame(E),Front Leg(F) and Hind Leg(G) with Screw(①) by Allen Key(⑥) .
Do not fully tighten the Screws at this time.

Step 4



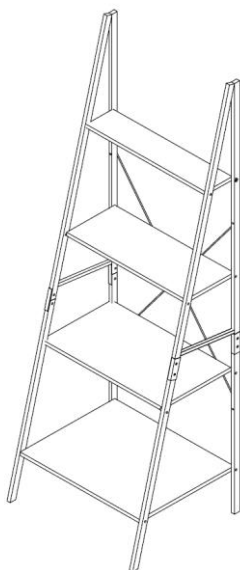
Connect the First Panel(A), Second Panel(B),Third Panel(C) and Fourth Panel(D) to another Side Frame(E),Front Leg(F) and Hind Leg(G) with Screw(①) by Allen Key(⑥) .
Do not fully tighten the Screws at this time.

Step 5



Please stand the bookshelf with the help of another adult.
Fasten X shape(I) with Bolt(④) and Bolt Cap(⑤) by Allen Key(⑦) and Open
Spanner(⑧).
Do not fully tighten the Bolts at this time.

Step 6



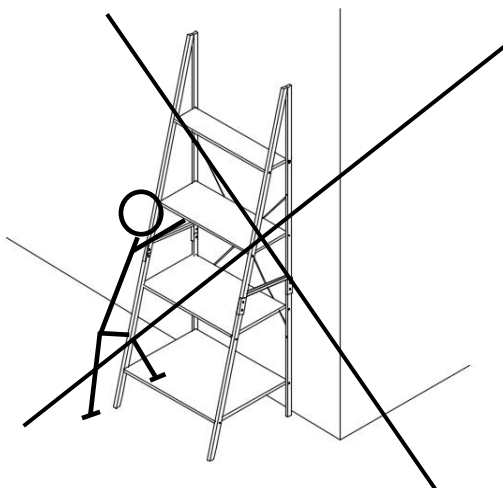
EXERT pressure, floorwards, onto the Bookshelf.
This pressure will help the Legs and Bookshel Top reach alignment at all joints.
Check for wobbles.
In a sequential manner, gradually tighten all Screws and Bolts until evenly
secured.
Inspect the Bookshelf and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

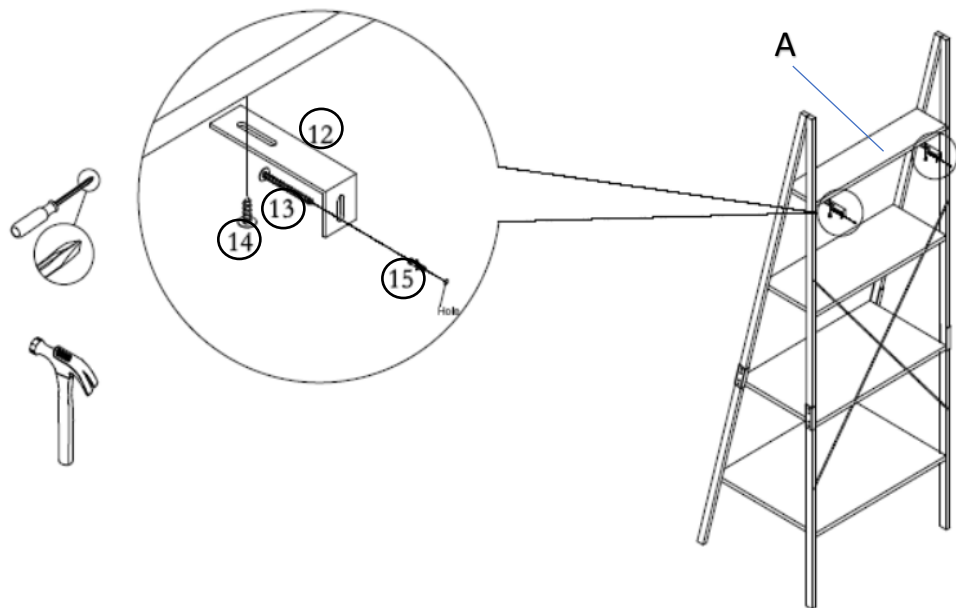
WARNING

Usage For Bookshelf Restraint Device:

Step 7

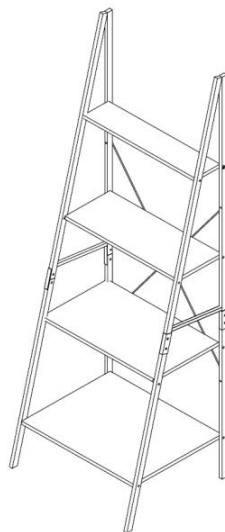


7.1) Use Power Drill(⑪) Drill two mounting positions on wall at same height, insert Plastic Dowel(⑮) into the mounting position with a Hammer(⑩)(Not provided)

7.2) Attach L-shape Metal Sheet(⑫) to plastic Dowel(⑮) using Screws(⑬) with Screwdriver(⑨). Note: The Metal sheet need to be secured to solid, load bearing surface. Please use a Stud Finder(not supplied) if needed to locate the Wall Frame.

7.3) Attach L-shape Metal Sheet(⑫) to First Panel(A) using Screws(⑭) with Screwdriver(⑨).

Step 7



Your Bookshelf is ready for use.

This Bookshelf can only be used on a flat, level surface.

Care & Maintenance



- Furniture may scratch floors. We recommend using furniture pads to protect your floors.



- Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.



- Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.



- Do not place furniture under direct sunlight.



- Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents.



- Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.



- Do not place furniture outside . For indoor use only.



- Not for commercial use. For residential use only.



- Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.



- Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.



- Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.
