

Base Cabinets



Assembly Instructions

Unpacking Precautions

If using a sharp object to unpack the cabinet components and the packing materials, be careful to avoid scratching or damaging the cabinet components. The various packing materials may be used to protect the cabinet components during assembly. During the unpacking process, place the various components away from and to the side of the work area so that they will not be inadvertently knocked over or otherwise damaged.

Base Cabinet Model Variations

These assembly instructions include all the steps required to assemble a Base Cabinet with a Shelf and Drawers. However, they can also be used to assemble a Sink-type Base Cabinet with a Shelf (skip the steps covering assembly of the drawers and installation of the rails and rail holders). The illustrations included in these assembly instructions are based on the Base Cabinet with a Shelf and Drawers.

Required tools Phillips screwdriver Rubber mallet Wood Glue



Hardware Considerations/Screw Size Clarification








Step 1: Lay the face frame with doors (A) on a soft surface, doors facing down.




Step 2:




Using the wood glue, squeeze a small bead of glue in all grooves before assembling the cabinet sides, bottom, top and back panels. Be careful not to use too much glue, this could cause access glue to squeeze out and onto the panels. If this should happen, be sure to remove quickly.

Slide the Right Side panel (R) in the groove of the face frame, and mount the male clip to the face frame with the screw driver. Each male clip will need 2 Small crews(I). fig 1


Step 3:
Slide the Left Side panel (L) in the left groove of the face frame, and mount the male clip to the face frame with the screw driver.
Each male clip will need 2 small crews(I).




Step 4:Slide bottom panel (B) into the grooves of the right and left side panels, and then into the groove in the frame below until it is fully seated.




Step 5:
Slide in the Back panel and attach the male clips to the back panel.
There're three clips on the left side and three clips on the right side. Each male clip will need 2 small crews(I).




Step 6:
Use the Long Screws (K), and the pre-drilled holes , to attach the back panel to the edges of the bottom panel.




Step 7:
Secure the toe kick into the bottom of the cabinet (two small screws(I) in each of the two clips)




Step 7-A
Secure the center support under the bottom panel only for the base cabinets 36" wide and larger.






Step 9:
Using one small screw attached the glide brackets to the interior sets of pre-drilled holes on the back panel.
Optional Holes: Exterior two sets are optional for soft-closing drawer glide.




Step 10:

Using two small screws to attach both the left and right exterior drawer glides to the interior edge of the face frame left & right for each drawer.




Step 11:


- Align the dovetails of one of the side drawer panels with the teeth on the back drawer panel and gently seat the side drawer panel into the back drawer panel. This can be done by gently tapping the side with a rubber mallet.
- 2. Repeat this procedure for the second side drawer panel.




Slide the drawer bottom into the grooves in the sides and back drawer panels until it is fully seated.



Step 13:
Attach the drawer fronts to the drawer box by aligning the dovetails of drawer panels with the teeth on the front drawer panel and gently seat as above.




Step 14:
attached the bottom drawer glides using the small screws(I) three on each side.




Step 15:

Install the drawers into the cabinet by aligning the bottom glides with the exterior glides in the cabinet.



Step 16:
Put the shelf pins on the left and right side panels using the holes provided.
Be sure pegs on the right & left are in the same position on each side to insure a level fit.



Step 17:
Use Two middle size screws(J) to attach 4 wooden triangle blocks in all four corners of the top of the cabinet.
